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TRUMP LEADS IN EARLY 2024 NH GOP NOMINATION RACE BUT OVERALL REMAINS UNPOPULAR IN NH

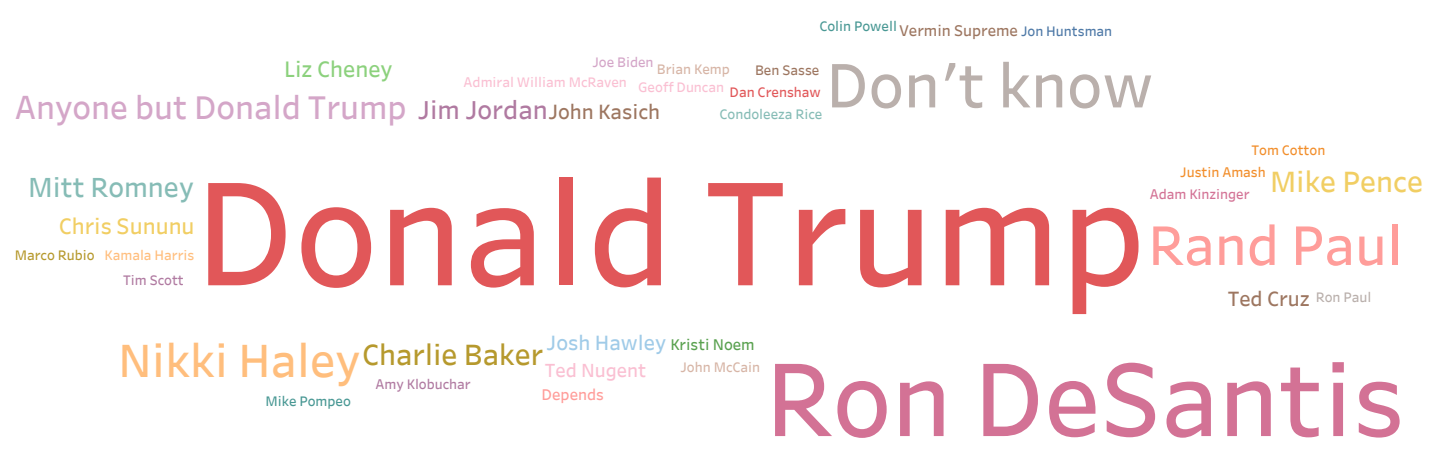
DURHAM, NH - Nearly half of likely 2024 Republican primary voters in New Hampshire currently support former President Donald Trump for the 2024 presidential nomination and a majority say Trump was one of the best presidents in history. However, Trump's favorability among Granite Staters overall has fallen and most don't want him to run again. Florida Governor Ron DeSantis has the second highest support for 2024.

These findings are based on the latest **Granite State Poll***, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand seven hundred and ninety-four (1,794) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between July 15 and July 19, 2021. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.3 percent. Included in the sample were 770 likely 2024 Republican Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 3.5 percent). Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and 2020 election results in NH. Granite State Panel members are recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers across New Hampshire and surveys are sent periodically to panel members.

2024 New Hampshire Republican Presidential Primary

Since the 2020 election, Republicans have been positioning themselves for the GOP nomination in 2024. The New Hampshire Primary has historically been one of the most important events in determining who the next nominee will be. When asked an open-ended question about whom they will vote for in the 2024 primary, former President Donald Trump is named by nearly half (49%) of likely Republican voters, followed by Florida Governor Ron DeSantis (18%), Kentucky Senator Rand Paul (5%), former UN Ambassador Nikki Haley (3%), former Vice President Mike Pence (1%), Massachusetts Governor Charlie Baker (1%), Utah Senator Mitt Romney (1%), Ohio Representative Jim Jordan (1%), and Wyoming Representative Liz Cheney (1%). Fifteen percent of likely Republican primary voters could not name a candidate. "While Trump is currently the first choice of New Hampshire Republicans, it is important to remember that this is based largely on name recognition" said Andrew Smith, Director of the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. "Past party nominees are almost always the early front runner in nomination contests, but as other candidates begin to actually campaign, support for the candidate who lost the last election drops."

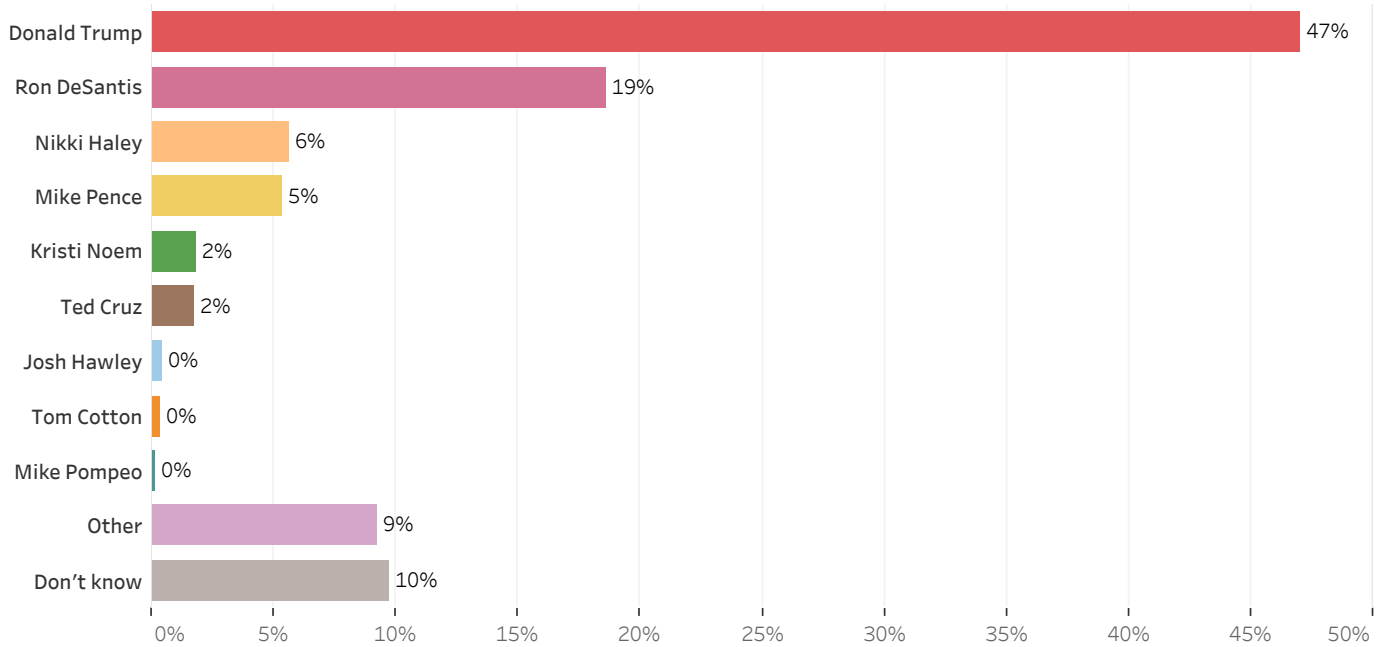
Preferred Candidate - Republican 2024 Presidential Nomination - Open-Ended - July 2021

When provided a list of Republicans who are thought to be considering running for the 2024 Republican nomination, 47% of likely New Hampshire Republican primary voters say they will vote for Trump, 19% support DeSantis, 6% support Haley, 5% support Pence, 2% support South Dakota Governor Kristi Noem, 2% support Texas Senator Ted Cruz, and less than 1% each support Missouri Senator Josh Hawley, Arkansas Senator Tom Cotton, or Former Secretary of State Mike Pompeo. Another 9% support another candidate while 10% are unsure.

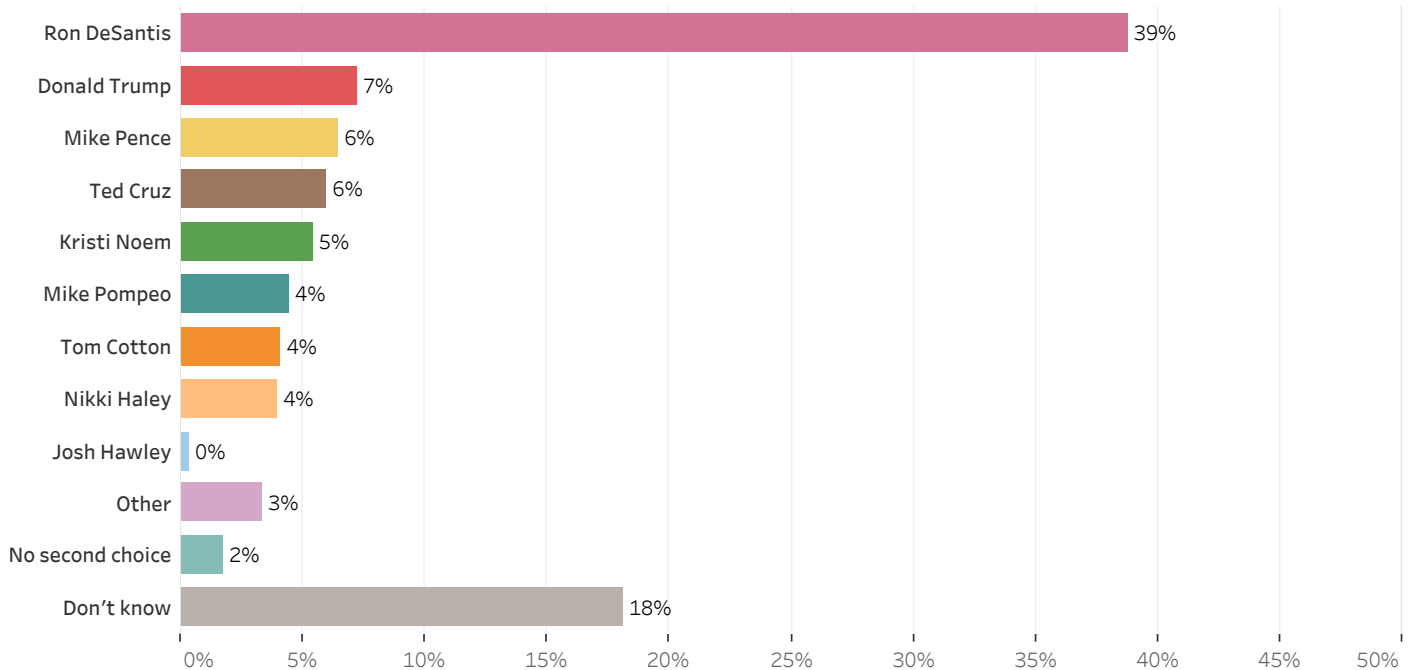
Preferred Candidate - Republican 2024 Presidential Nomination - July 2021



When asked for their second choice, 39% of likely Republican primary voters support DeSantis, 7% support Trump, 6% each support Pence or Cruz, 5% support Noem, 4% each support Pompeo, Cotton, or Haley, and less than 1% would support Hawley. Three percent would support another candidate, 2% say they don't have a second choice, and 18% don't know or are unsure.

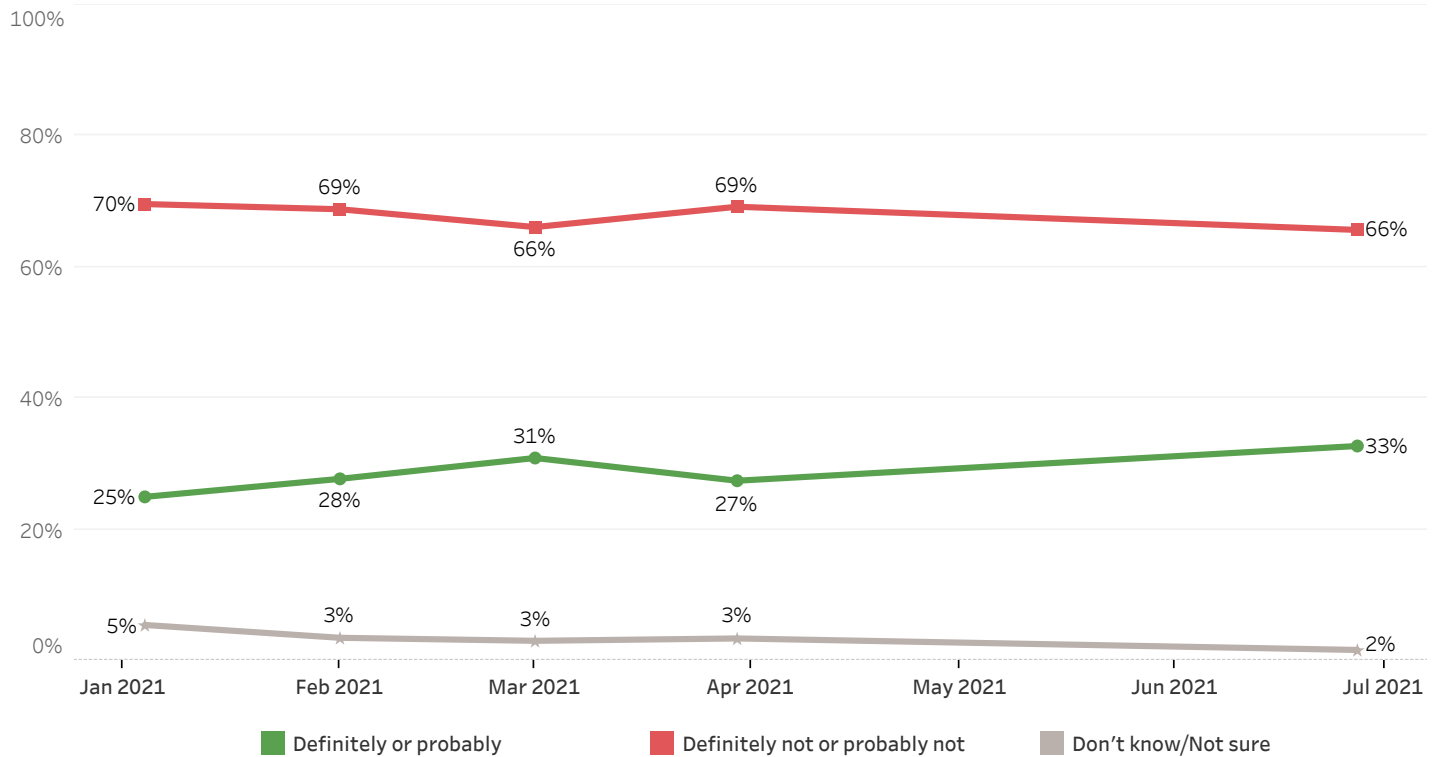
Among those who say their first choice would be Trump, half (50%) say their second choice would be DeSantis, while 11% say their second choice is Pence and 8% say their second choice is Cruz.

Second Choice - Republican 2024 Presidential Nomination - July 2021



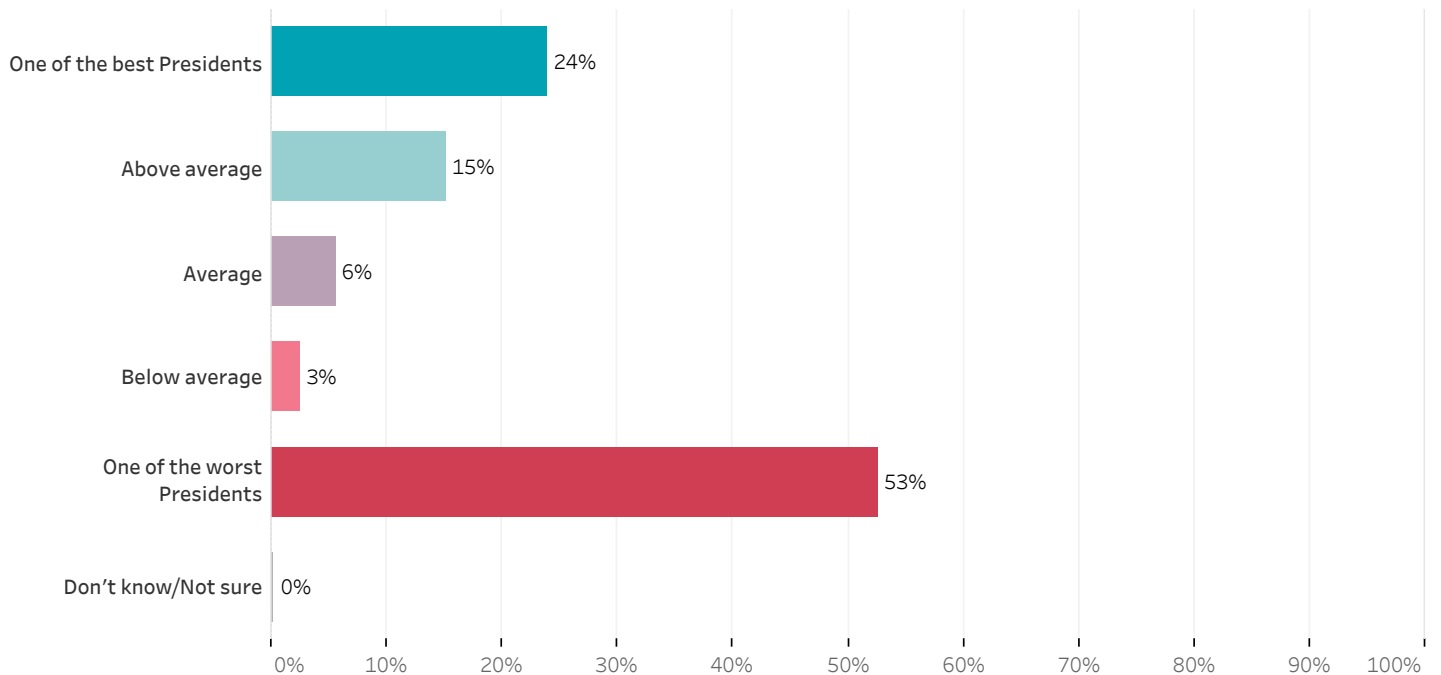
While Trump is popular among many New Hampshire Republicans, only one-third (33%) of all Granite Staters say they want him to run for President in 2024, two-thirds (66%) don't want him to run in 2024, and 2% are unsure. Sixty-nine percent of Republicans want Trump to run again in 2024, a new high, but only 18% of Independents and 1% of Democrats feel this way.

Would Like to See Trump Run for President Again in 2024



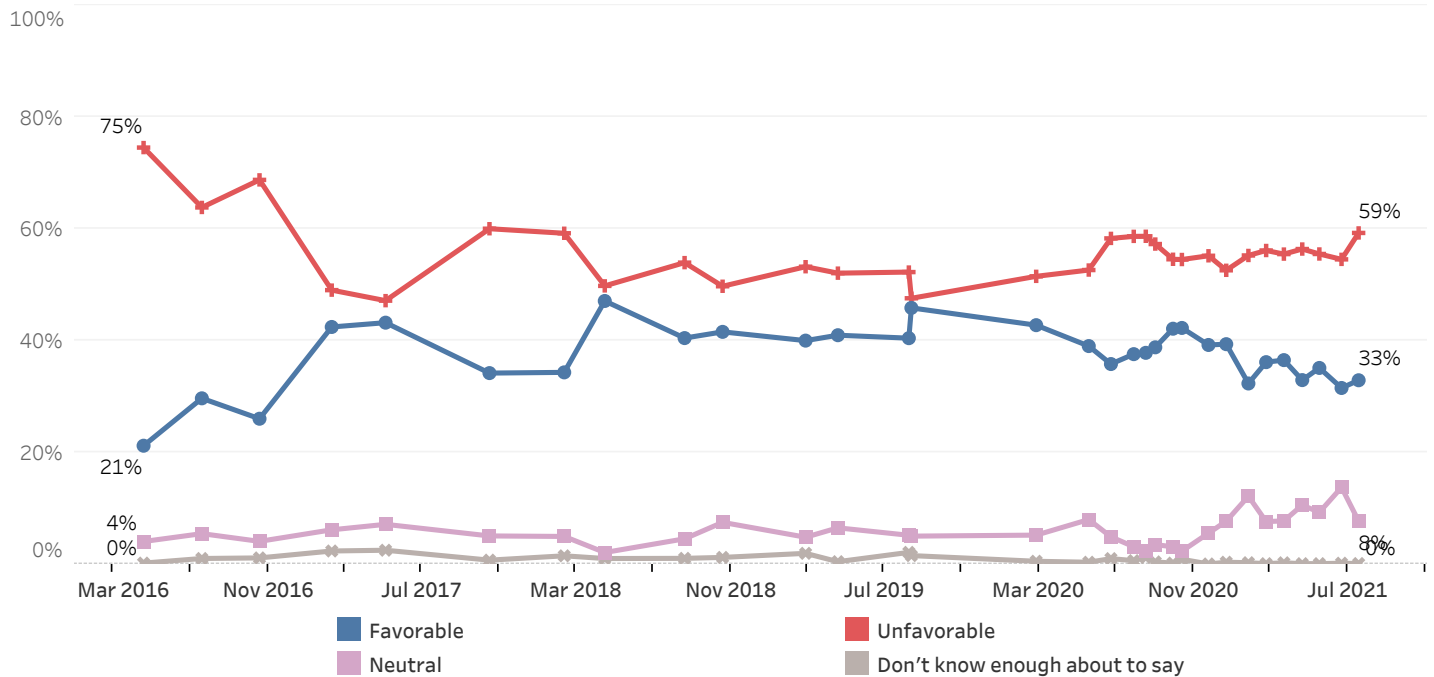
When asked to compare Trump to previous presidents, 53% say he was one of the worst presidents in history and 3% say he was below average. Only 24% of Granite Staters say that he was one of the best presidents in American history and 15% say he was above average, while 6% say he was average. More than half of Republicans (53%) believe Trump was one of the best presidents in history but a slim majority of Independents (54%) and nearly all Democrats (98%) say he was one of the worst presidents.

Trump continues to be seen unfavorably in New Hampshire. Only 33% have a favorable opinion of Trump, 59% have an unfavorable opinion of him, 8% neutral, and less than 1% are unsure. Trump's net favorability rating, the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion, is -26, its lowest point since October 2017. Trump is popular among Republicans (+51 net favorability rating), but is unpopular among Independents (-42) and very unpopular among Democrats (-99). Among likely Republican primary voters, Trump's net favorability rating is +46.

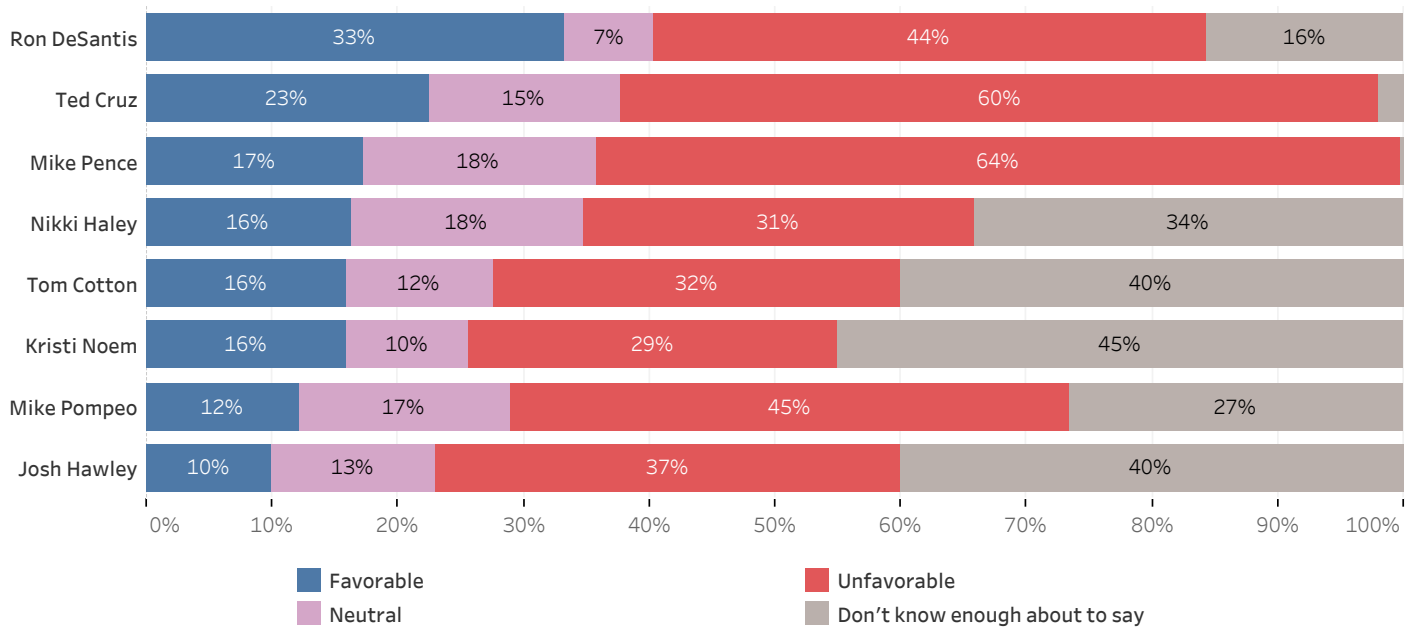
Favorability - Donald Trump (R)



Other potential 2024 Republican presidential candidates are also largely unpopular in New Hampshire overall. DeSantis (-11 net favorability rating), Noem (-14), Haley (-15), and Cotton (-17) are somewhat unpopular in the state, while Hawley (-27), Pompeo (-32), Cruz (-38), and Pence (-47) are even less popular.

Among likely Republican primary voters however, DeSantis (+64) is popular, while Cotton (+23), Noem (+22), Haley (+21), and Cruz (+18) are somewhat popular. Hawley (+11) and Pompeo (+9) are less popular among Republican primary voters, while they are divided in their opinion on Pence (+0).

Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand seven hundred and ninety-four (1,794) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between July 15 and July 19, 2021. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.3 percent. Included in the sample were 770 likely 2024 Republican Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 3.5 percent). These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the July 2021 Granite State Poll is 28%. The design effect for the survey is 2.9%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 6,250 New Hampshire adults were recruited from randomly selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
