## ADULT VACCINATIONS STALL; MOST NEW HAMPSHIRE PARENTS SAY CHILDREN ARE VACCINATED AGAINST COVID-19 OR LIKELY TO BE

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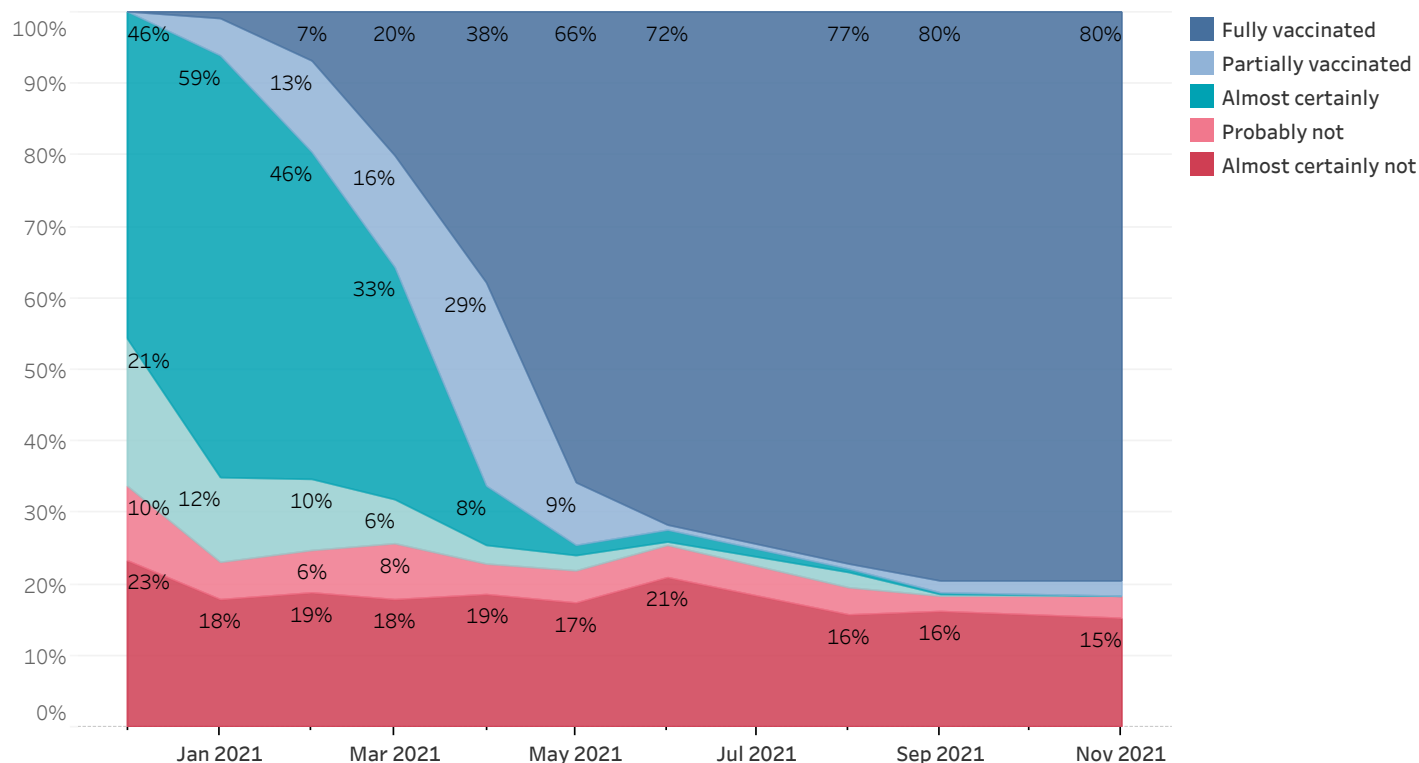
DURHAM, NH - Four in five New Hampshire adults say they are fully or partially vaccinated against COVID-19, but this figure has stalled in recent months. Almost no unvaccinated adults plan to get vaccinated. Most vaccinated adults plan to get a booster. Among parents of children under 18, six in ten say their children are already vaccinated or are likely to be vaccinated.

These findings are based on the latest **Granite State Poll\***, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand, one hundred and twenty-five (1,125) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between November 11 and November 15, 2021. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.9 percent. Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and 2020 election results in NH. Granite State Panel members are recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers across New Hampshire and surveys are sent periodically to panel members.

### COVID-19 Vaccination Decision

Eighty-two percent of New Hampshire adults say they have been fully (80%) or partially (2%) vaccinated against COVID while less than 1% say they will almost certainly or probably get vaccinated. Eighteen percent of New Hampshire residents say they will probably not (3%) or almost certainly not (15%) get vaccinated, unchanged since September (18%). Nearly all (>99%) of self-identified Democrats and 75% of Independents in the state say they are fully or partially vaccinated but only 59% of Republicans are vaccinated.

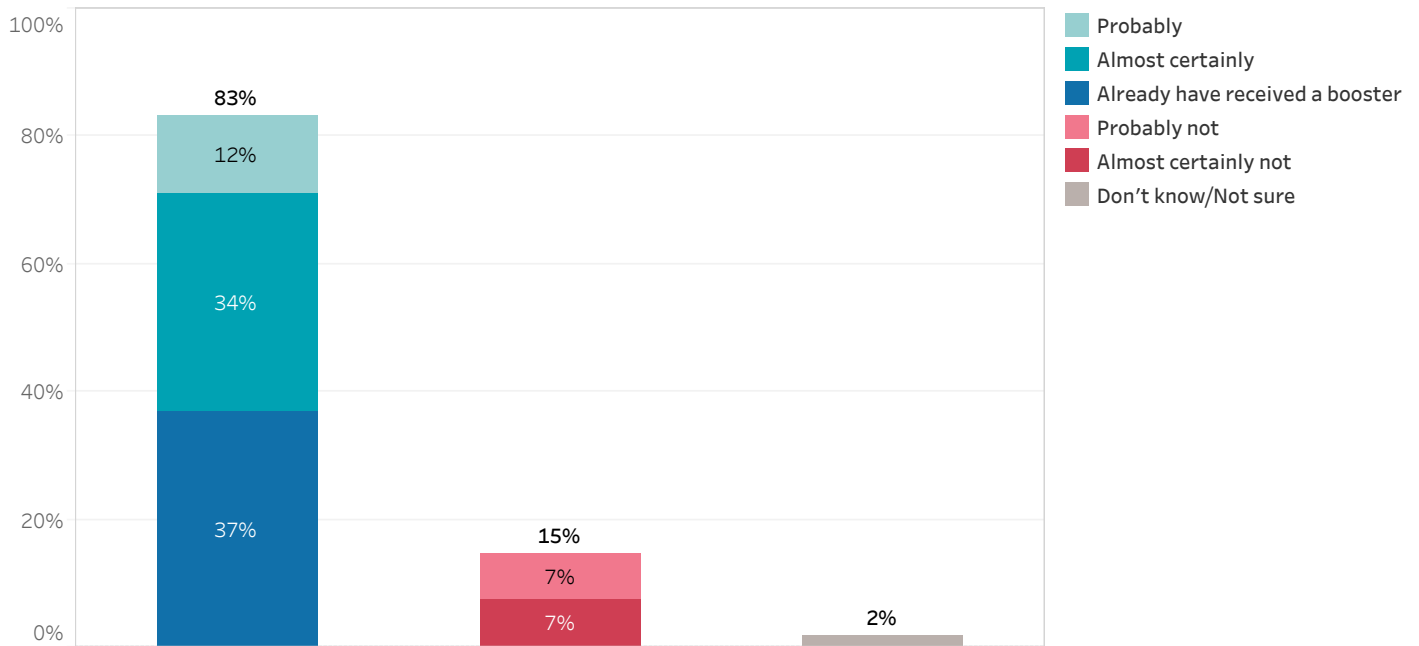
Likelihood of Receiving COVID-19 Vaccine

Among those who say they are fully or partially vaccinated against COVID-19 (N=899), 37% say they have already received a booster shot, 34% say they will almost certainly get one, and 12% say they will probably get one. Only 15% say they will probably not (7%) or almost certainly not (7%) get a booster shot and 2% are unsure. Among those aged 65 and older, two-thirds (66%) say they have already received a booster and only 4% say they will probably or almost certainly not get one. By contrast, one in five of vaccinated residents aged 35 to 64 (20%) say they are unlikely to get a booster.

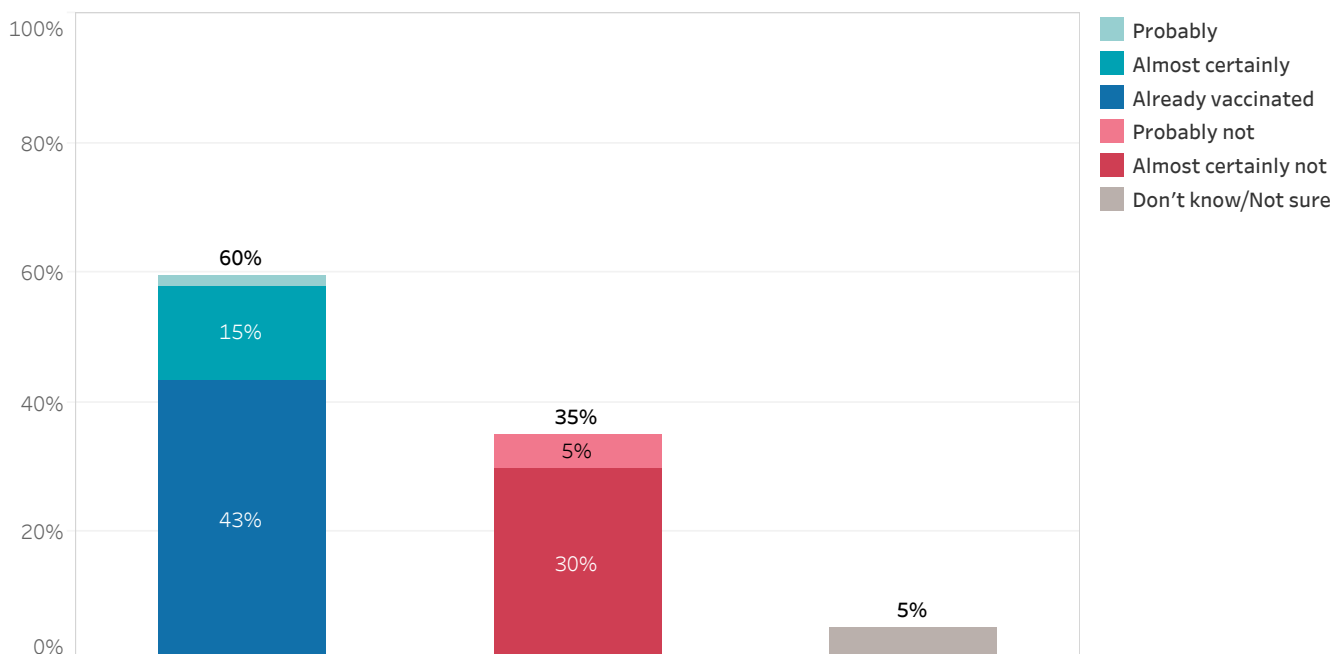
**Likelihood of Receiving COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Shot - November 2021**



**COVID-19 Vaccination for Children & Students**

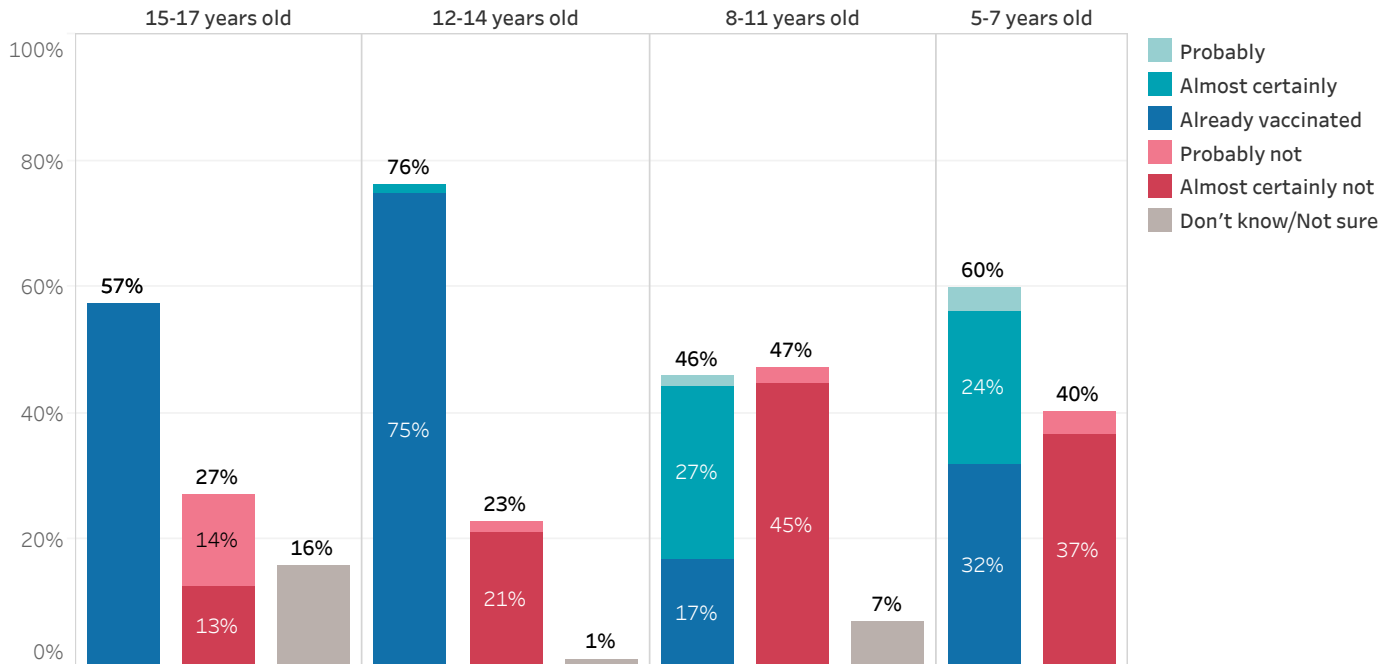
School aged children are now able to get COVID vaccines. Among New Hampshire parents of children between the ages of 5 and 17, 43% say their children have already been vaccinated while 17% will almost certainly (15%) or probably (2%) get vaccinated. Thirty-five percent say they will probably not (5%) or almost certainly not (30%) vaccinate their kids while 5% are unsure. Among parents who are vaccinated themselves, 72% of their children are vaccinated or are likely to be, while among those who are unvaccinated, only 1% indicate that they are likely to vaccinate their children or already have.

**Likelihood of Child Receiving COVID-19 Vaccine - November 2021**



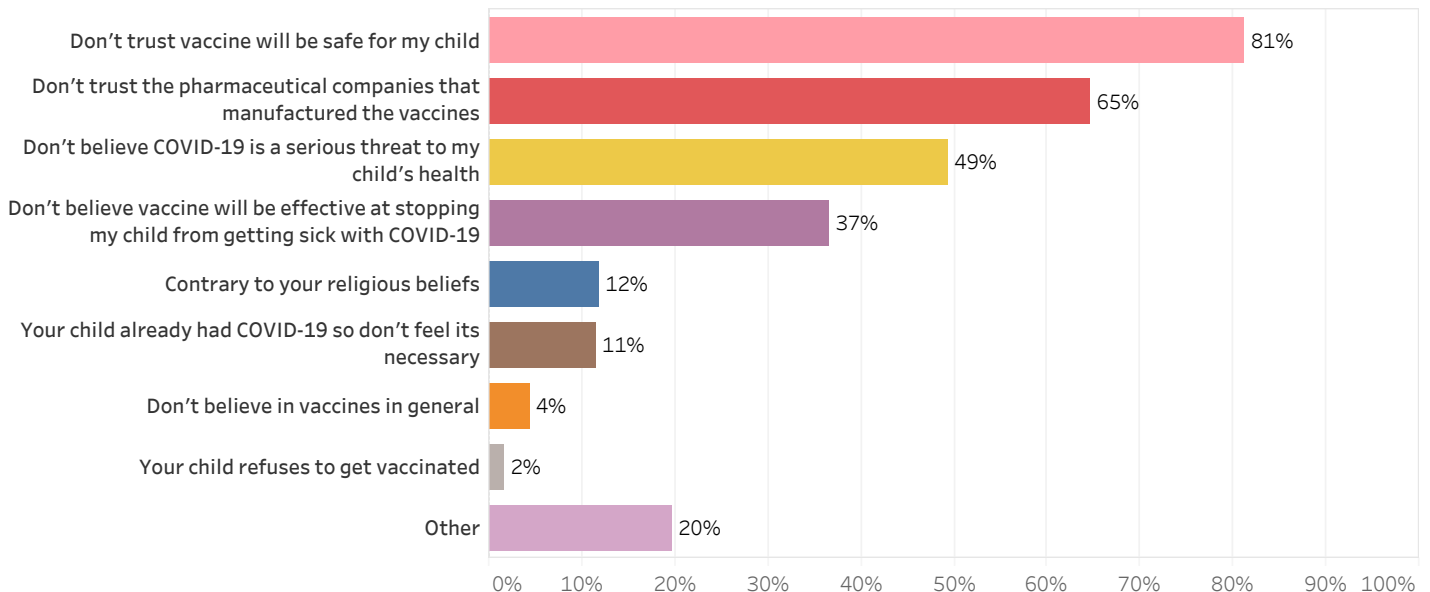
There are large differences based on age in the likelihood of children in New Hampshire being vaccinated against COVID-19. Those aged 12-17 have been eligible to receive a vaccine since the spring, and parents indicate that 57% of those aged 15-17 and 75% of those aged 12-14 are already vaccinated but almost none of those who are still unvaccinated are likely to get vaccinated. Those aged 5-11 are newly eligible for the vaccine and parents indicate that relatively few are already vaccinated. Their overall vaccination rate will likely increase over time, as 46% of children aged 8-11 and 60% of those aged 5-7 are already vaccinated or are likely to be vaccinated. However, parents indicate that just under half of children in these age ranges (47% for 8-11 year olds, 40% for 5-7 year olds) are unlikely to be vaccinated.

**Likelihood of Child Receiving COVID-19 Vaccine - by Age Group - November 2021**



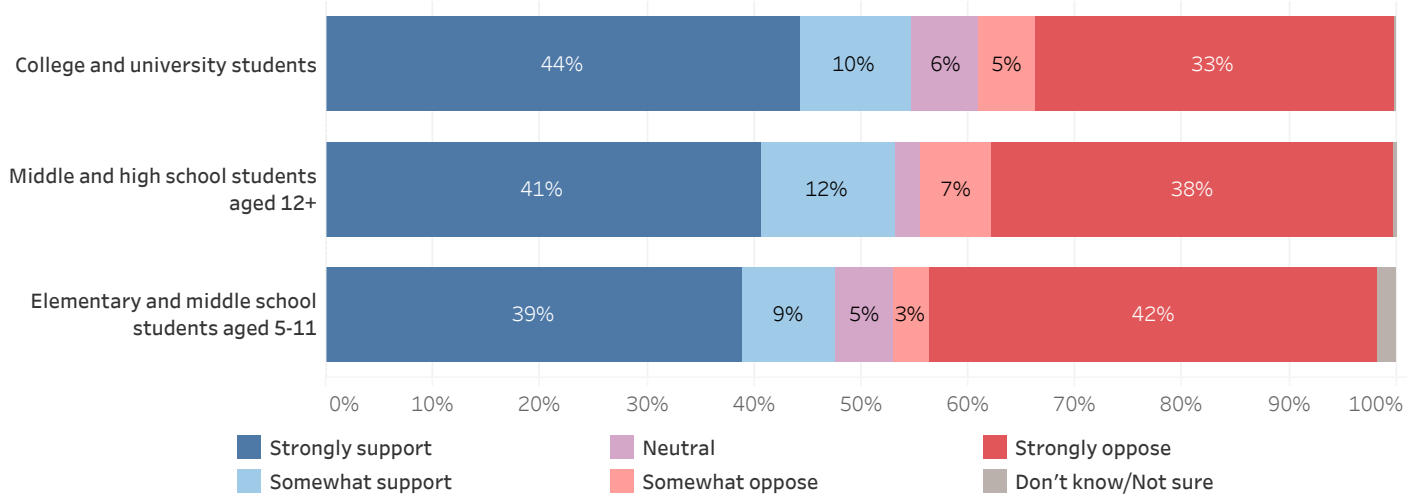
Among parents who say they are unlikely to vaccinate at least one of their children, 81% say they are unlikely to vaccinate their child because they don't trust the vaccine will be safe for their child while 65% are unlikely to do so because they don't trust the pharmaceutical companies that manufactured the vaccines. Forty-nine percent don't believe COVID-19 is a serious threat to their child's health and 35% don't believe it will be effective at stopping their child from getting sick with COVID-19, while fewer respondents say the vaccine is contrary to their religious beliefs (12%), their child has already had COVID-19 so they don't feel vaccination is necessary (11%), they don't believe in vaccines in general (4%), or say their child refuses to get vaccinated (2%).

A majority (55%) of Granite Staters strongly (44%) or somewhat (10%) support New Hampshire requiring all college and university students in the state to receive a COVID-19 vaccine in order to attend school in-person, 39% are strongly (33%) or somewhat (5%) opposed to such a measure while 6% are neutral. A similar percentage (53%) support requiring all middle and high school students aged twelve and up to be vaccinated in order to attend school in-person while 44% are opposed, but Granite Staters are more evenly divided on requiring elementary and middle school students aged five to eleven to be vaccinated to attend school in-person, with 48% in support and 45% opposed. Clear majorities of those with children in their household are opposed to elementary, middle, and high school students being required to get vaccinated while majorities of those without children would be in support of these policies.

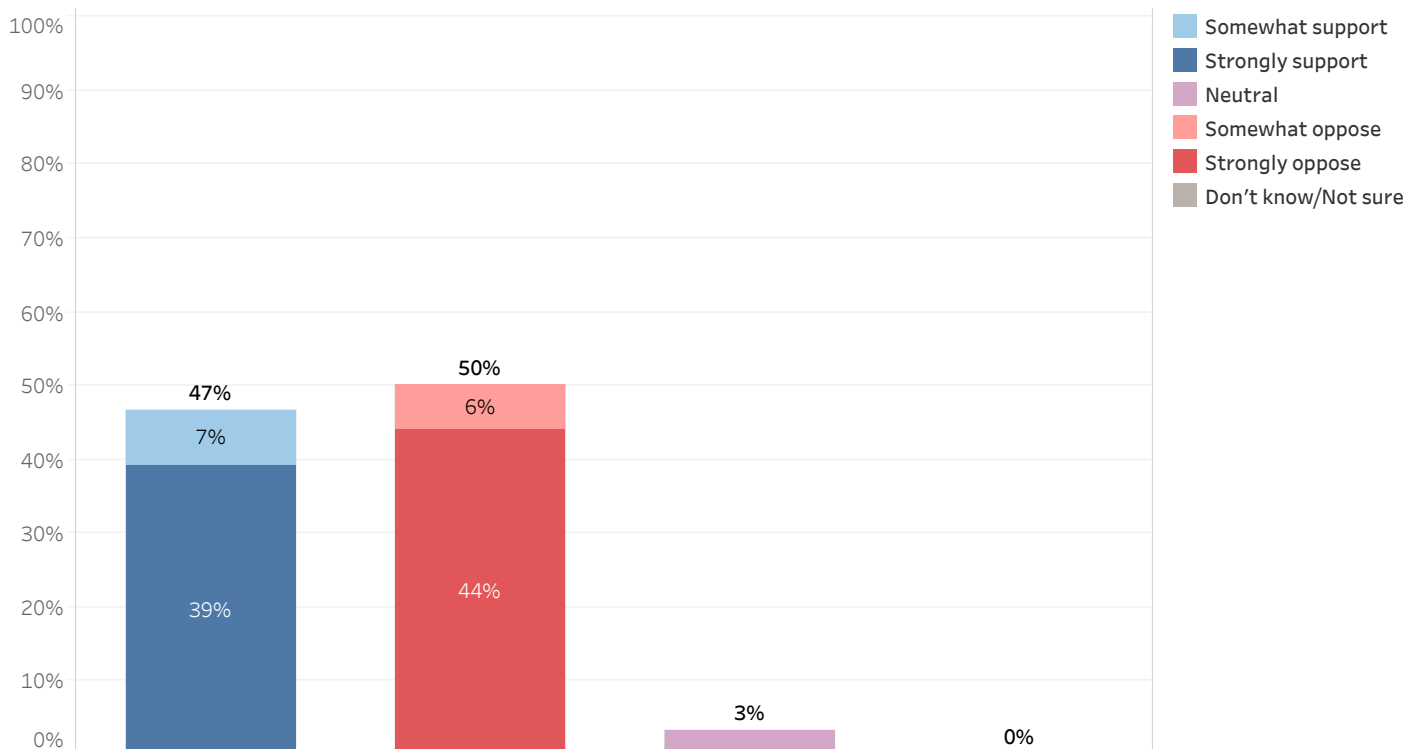
### Support or Oppose Student Vaccine Mandates - November 2021



### Large Employers Vaccination or Testing Mandate

Granite Staters are evenly divided on an order from the Biden administration requiring all employers with 100 or more employees to ensure their workers are vaccinated or tested weekly by January 4th, 2022: 47% are strongly (39%) or somewhat (7%) in support of this action, 50% are strongly (44%) or somewhat (6%) opposed, 3% are neutral, and less than 1% are unsure.

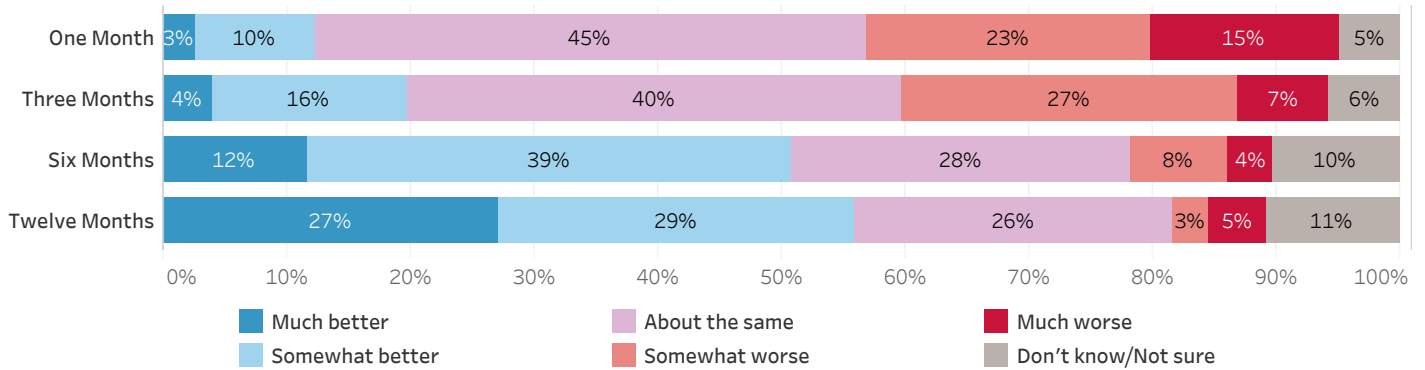
### Support or Oppose Vaccine or Test Mandate for Large Employers - November 2021



### Feelings About COVID-19 Pandemic

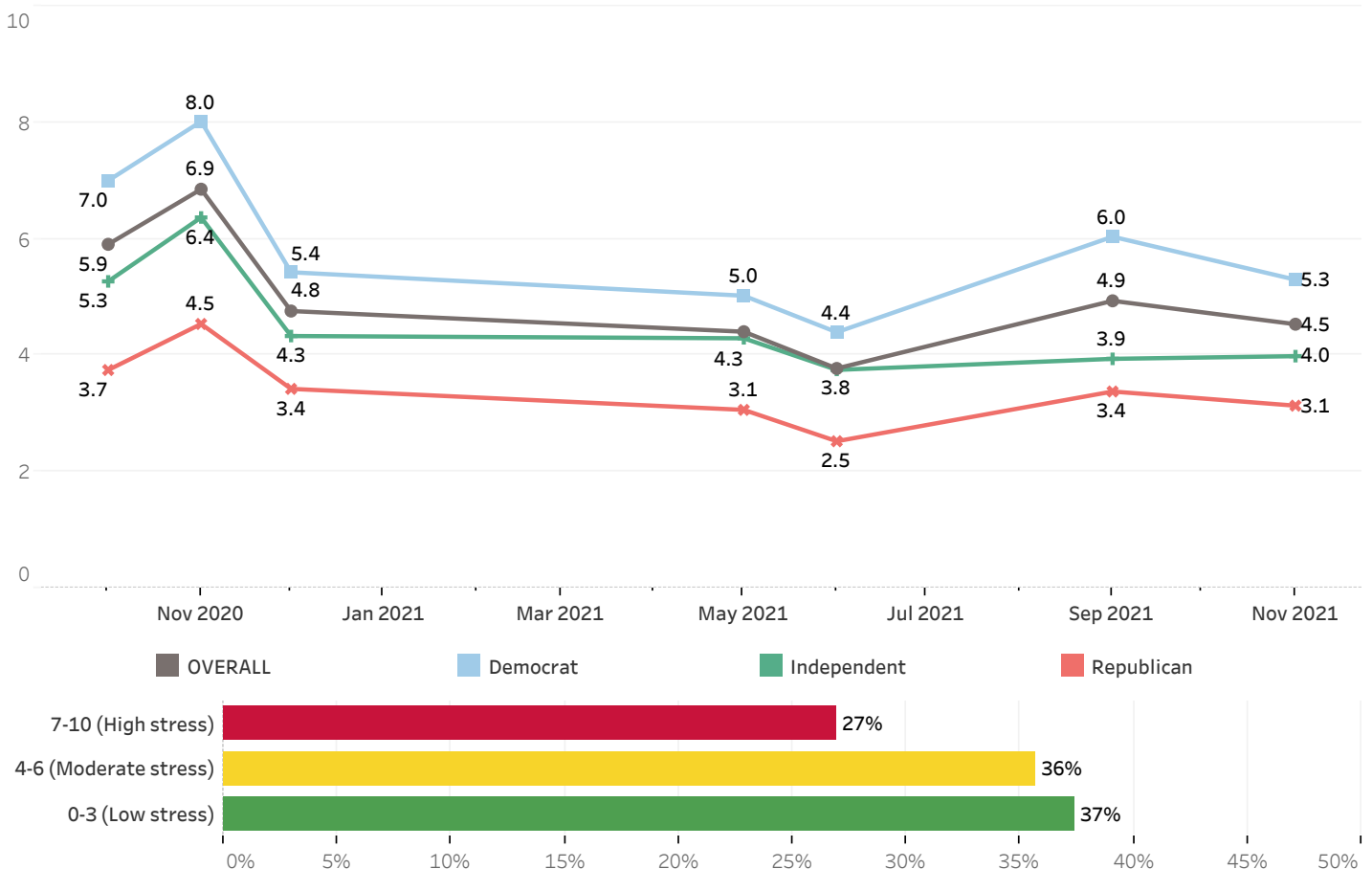
Granite Staters are largely pessimistic in their short-term assessment of the COVID-19 pandemic: only 13% believe things related to the pandemic will be much (3%) or somewhat (10%) better in one month than they are now while 38% believe things will be somewhat (23%) or much (15%) worse. Most New Hampshire residents also do not expect things to improve within three months - only 20% predict things will be better while 34% predict things will be worse. However, more than half of residents (51%) expect things to be better in six months and only 12% expect things to be worse, while 56% expect things to be better in twelve months and only 8% expect things to be worse than they are now. Granite Staters are slightly more positive in their short-term outlook then they were in September, when 46% believed things would be worse in one month and 41% believed things would be worse in three months.

The average New Hampshire resident reports experiencing stress related to the COVID-19 pandemic of 4.5 on a 0-10 scale, down slightly since September (4.9). Democrats (5.3) are experiencing higher levels of stress than Independents (4.0) and Republicans (3.1). Twenty-seven percent of Granite Staters place themselves at 7, 8, 9, or 10 on a 0-10 scale rating their overall level of stress as a result of COVID-19, 36% report moderate stress (4, 5, or 6 on a 0-10 scale) and 37% report low stress (0, 1, 2, or 3 on a 0-10 scale).

## Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand, one hundred and twenty-five (1,125) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between November 11 and November 15, 2021. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.9 percent. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the November 2021 Granite State Poll is 32%. The design effect for the survey is 2.6%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
