OMICRON COMES TO NH: ONE IN EIGHT GRANITE STATERS REPORT TESTING POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 IN PAST MONTH

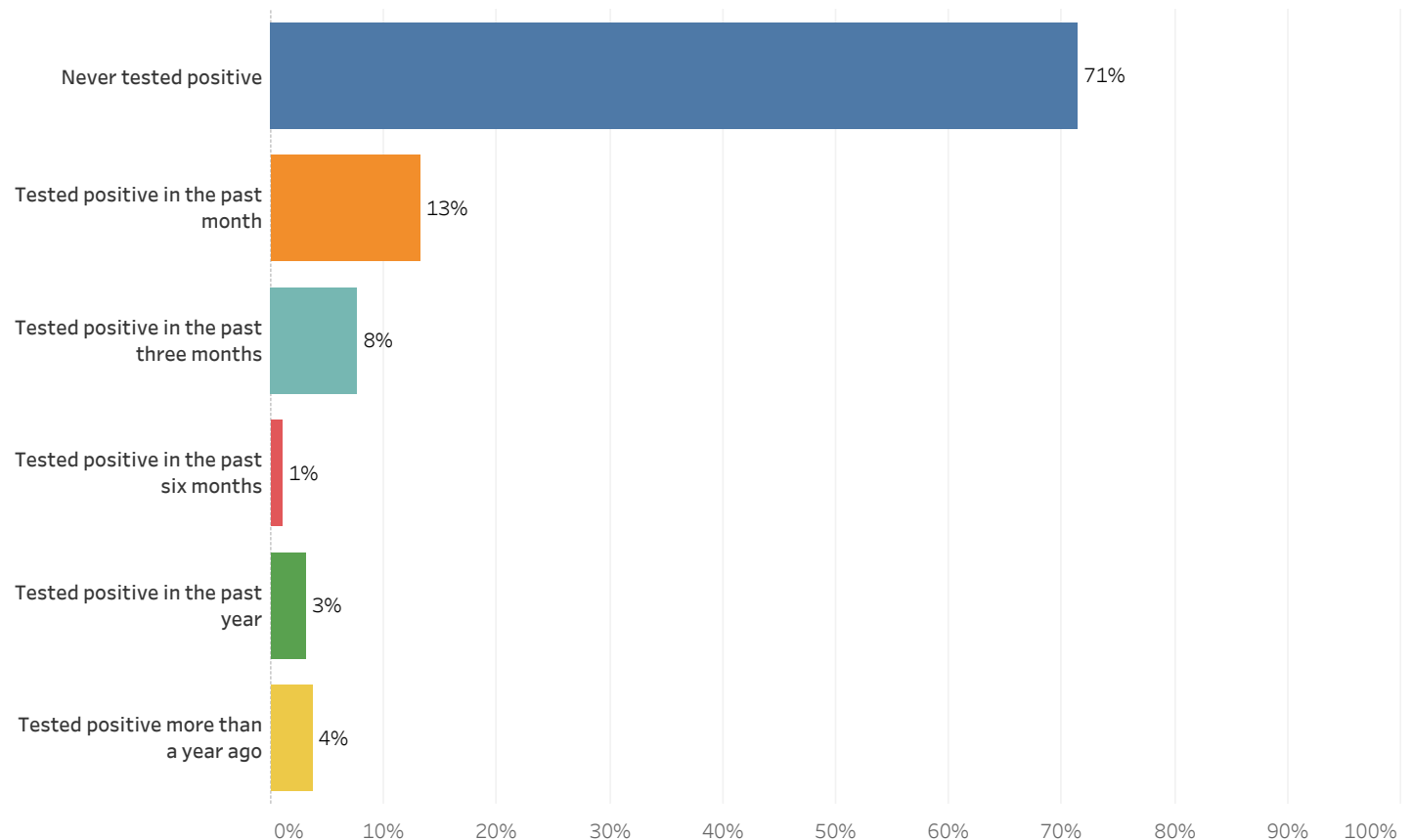
DURHAM, NH - COVID-19 cases have been rising across the country. Nearly three in ten Granite Staters say they have tested positive for COVID at some point and 13% say they have tested positive in the past month. Despite the number of COVID-19 cases in the state, most Granite Staters are more comfortable going to places like restaurants and barber shops, though many remain uncomfortable going to sporting events or concerts at larger venues. A majority continue to approve of Governor Chris Sununu's handling of the COVID-19 pandemic.

COVID-19 Positive Tests

Almost two years into the pandemic, 29% of New Hampshire residents say that they have tested positive for COVID-19 at least once - 13% have tested positive in the past month, 8% tested positive in the past three months, 1% tested positive in the past six months, 3% tested positive in the past year, and 4% tested positive more than a year ago. By comparison, 13% of adults in neighboring Vermont say they have tested positive for COVID, 6% in the past month.

Those with children in their household, those who voted for Donald Trump in 2020, and those with lower levels of education are more likely than others to say they have tested positive for COVID-19 at some point.

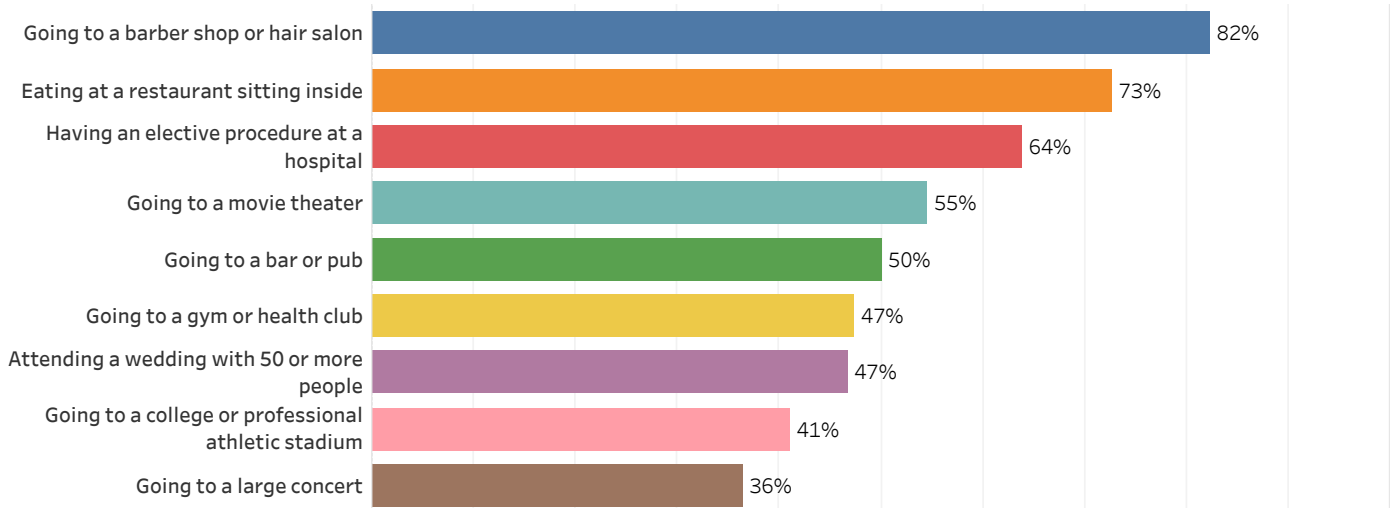
Ever Tested Positive for COVID-19

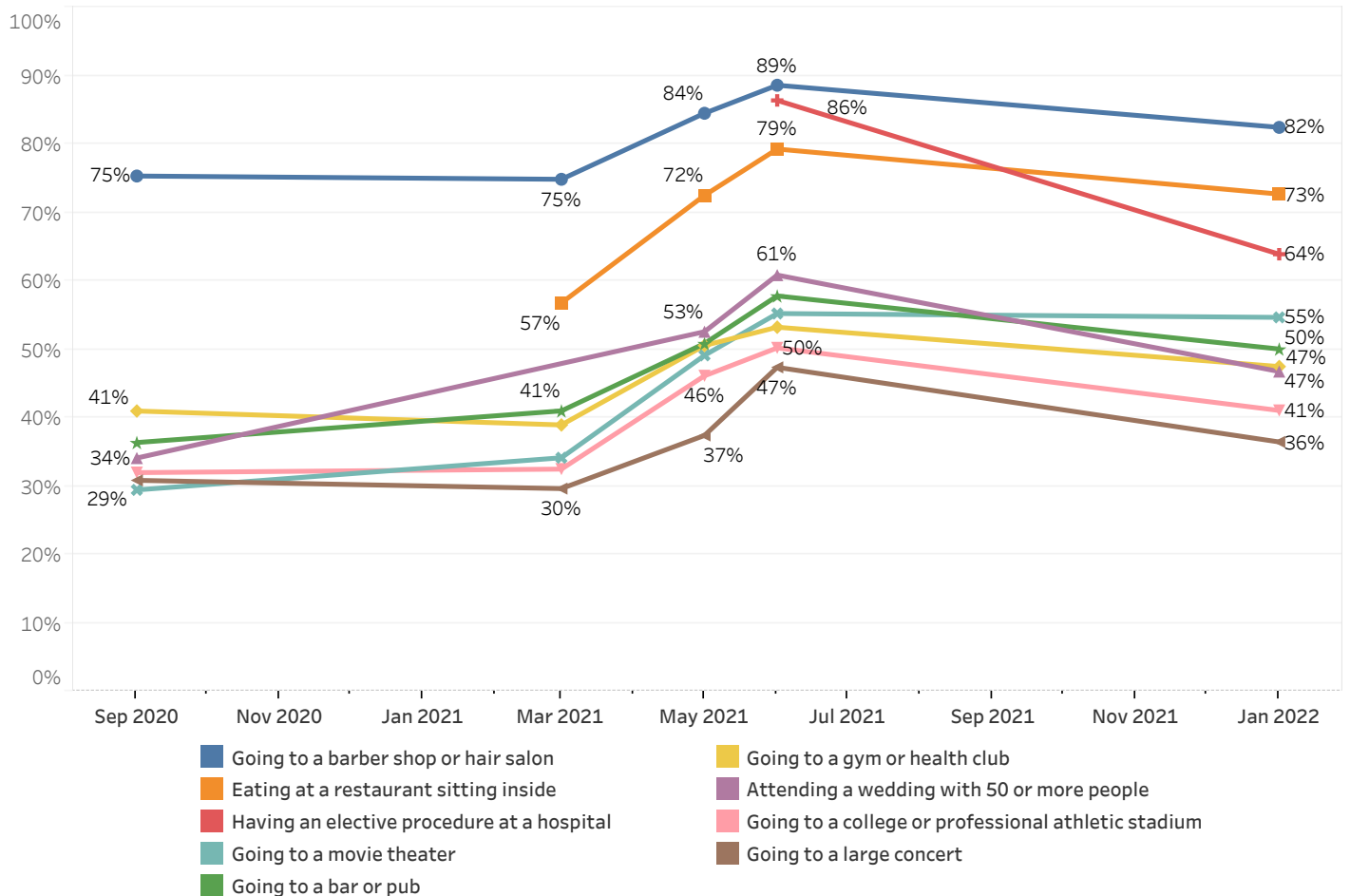
Despite the recent increase in cases, most Granite Staters say they are comfortable going to a barber shop or hair salon (82%), eating at a restaurant sitting inside (73%), or having an elective procedure at a hospital (64%), while about half are comfortable going to a movie theater (55%), a bar or pub (50%), or a gym or health club (47%), or attending a wedding with 50 or more people (47%). Fewer New Hampshire residents are comfortable going to a stadium (41%) or to a large concert (36%). Republicans remain more likely than Democrats to be comfortable doing these things.

Currently Comfortable Doing the Following Things - January 2022



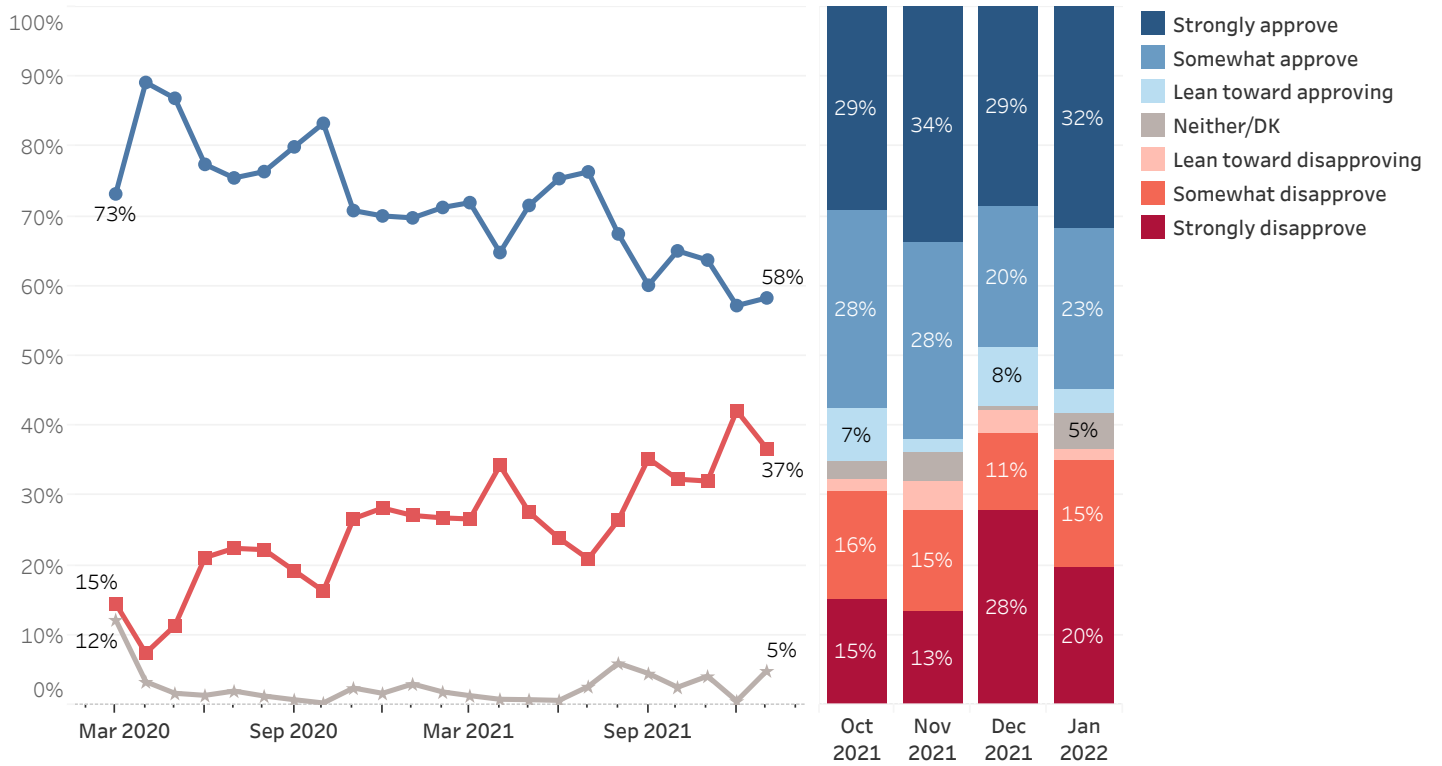
Granite Staters are slightly less comfortable doing these things than they were in May and June 2021 but are more comfortable than they were in March 2021 and September 2020.

A majority of Granite Staters (58%) approve of Governor Sununu's handling of the COVID-19 pandemic, 37% disapprove, and 5% neither approve nor disapprove or don't know. Eighty-six percent of Republicans and 59% of Independents approve of Sununu's handling of the pandemic but only 33% of Democrats agree.

Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand, one hundred and twenty-one (1,121) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between January 20 and January 24, 2022. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.9 percent. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the January 2022 Granite State Poll is 30%. The design effect for the survey is 2.6%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
