**HASSAN & GOP CHALLENGERS TIED IN RACE FOR SENATE IN NH; SUNUNU LEADS LITTLE-KNOWN SHERMAN IN GOVERNOR'S RACE**

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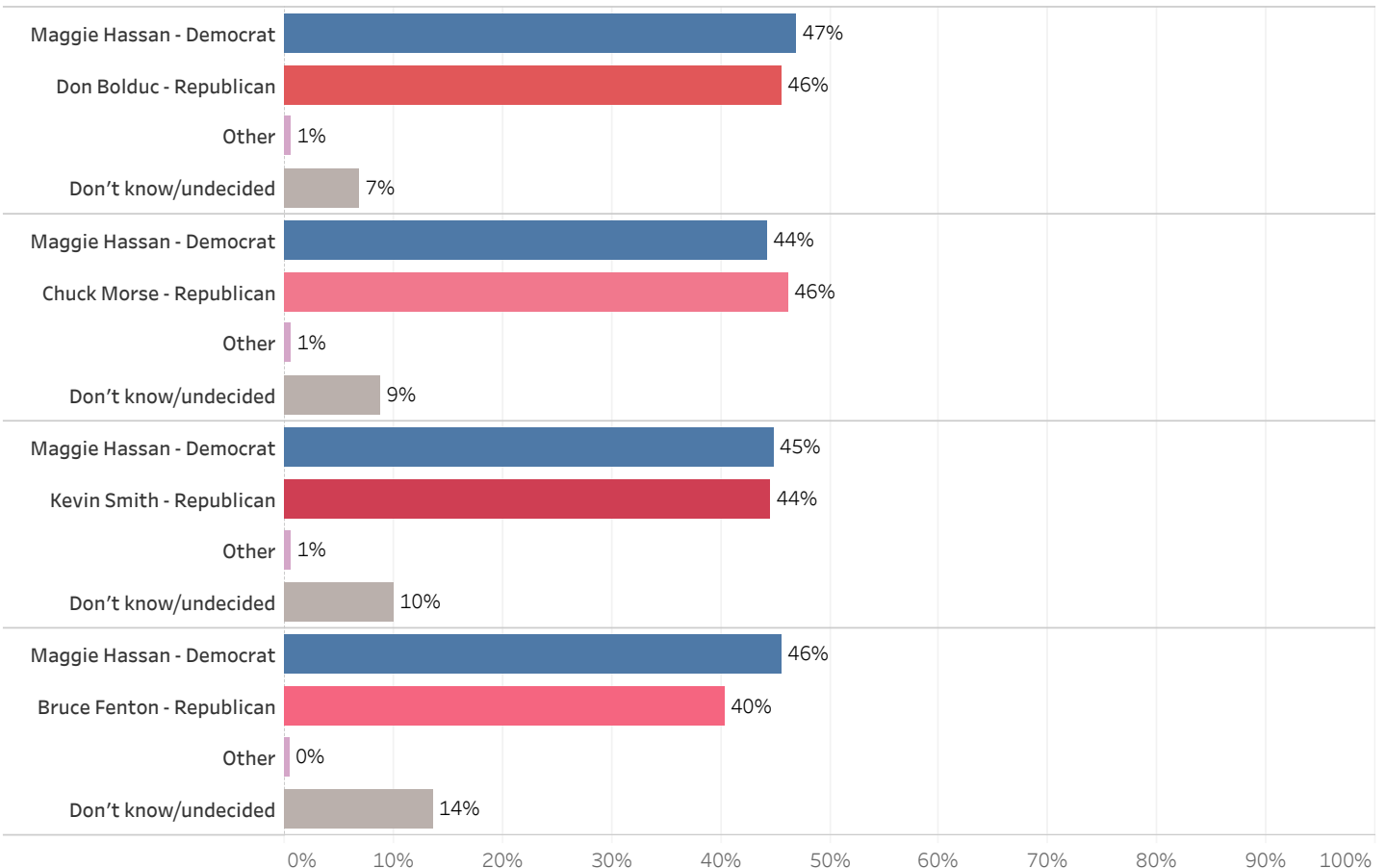
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DURHAM, NH - Incumbent Senator Maggie Hassan is in a statistical tie with four potential Republican challengers. Retired General Don Bolduc is the most well-known Republican candidate and leads in the primary field among likely GOP primary voters, though more than half are undecided. Governor Chris Sununu leads prospective, but little-known Democratic challenger, State Senator Tom Sherman.

**2022 U.S. Senate Election**

Since Governor Sununu decided not to challenge Senator Maggie Hassan for her seat in November, several Republicans have announced they are running. Current challengers include retired General Don Bolduc, former Londonderry Town Manager Kevin Smith, New Hampshire Senate President Chuck Morse, and entrepreneur Bruce Fenton. Although it is more than six months until the election, a matchup between Hassan and any of these Republicans is very close. When asked how they would vote in the 2022 general election for the U.S. Senate, likely voters (N=868) indicate that each of these potential matchups is effectively tied, with only a small number undecided. "This election is being driven almost exclusively by partisanship" said Andrew Smith, Director of the UNH Survey Center. "President Biden remains unpopular in New Hampshire and that means turnout in November will favor Republicans, and Republicans are likely to vote for whomever the Republican candidate is."

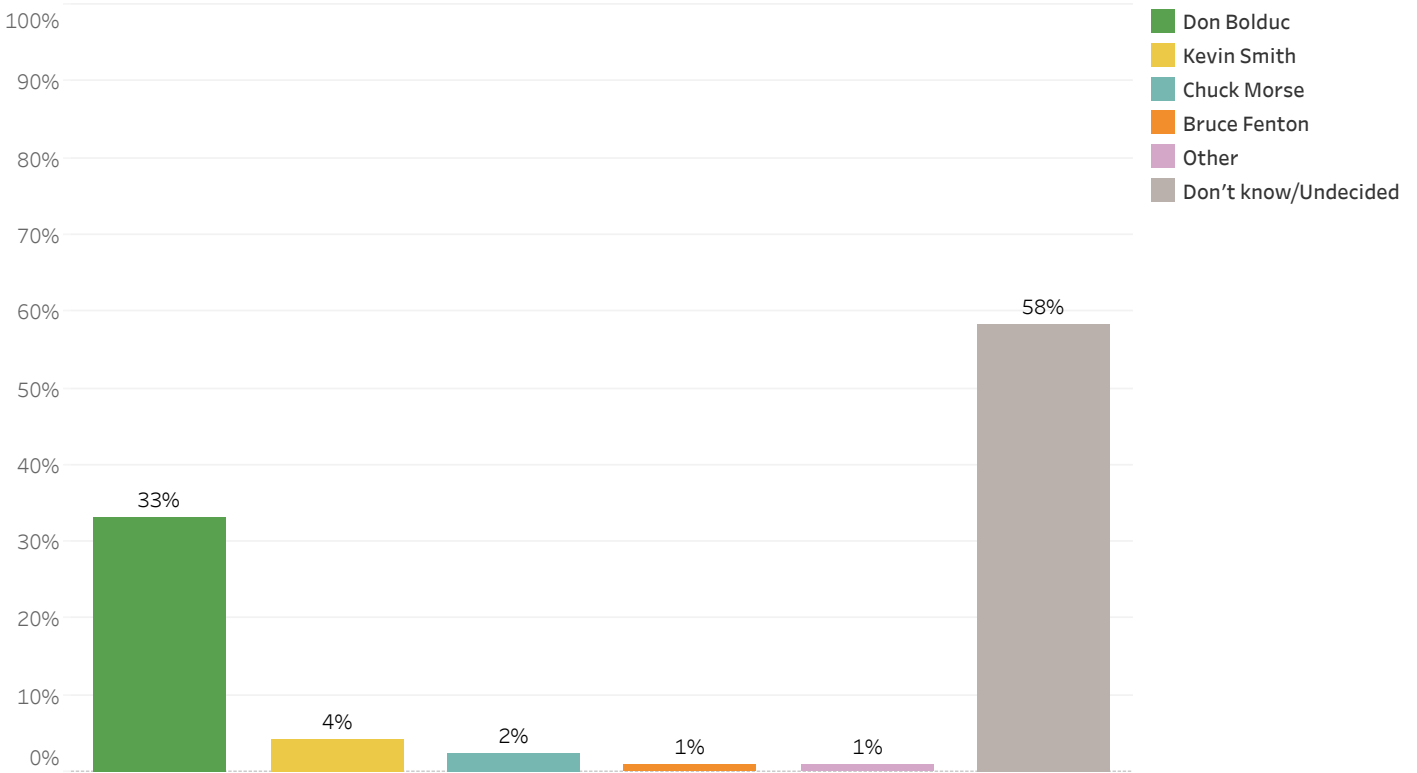
**Possible 2022 U.S. Senate Matchups - April 2022**

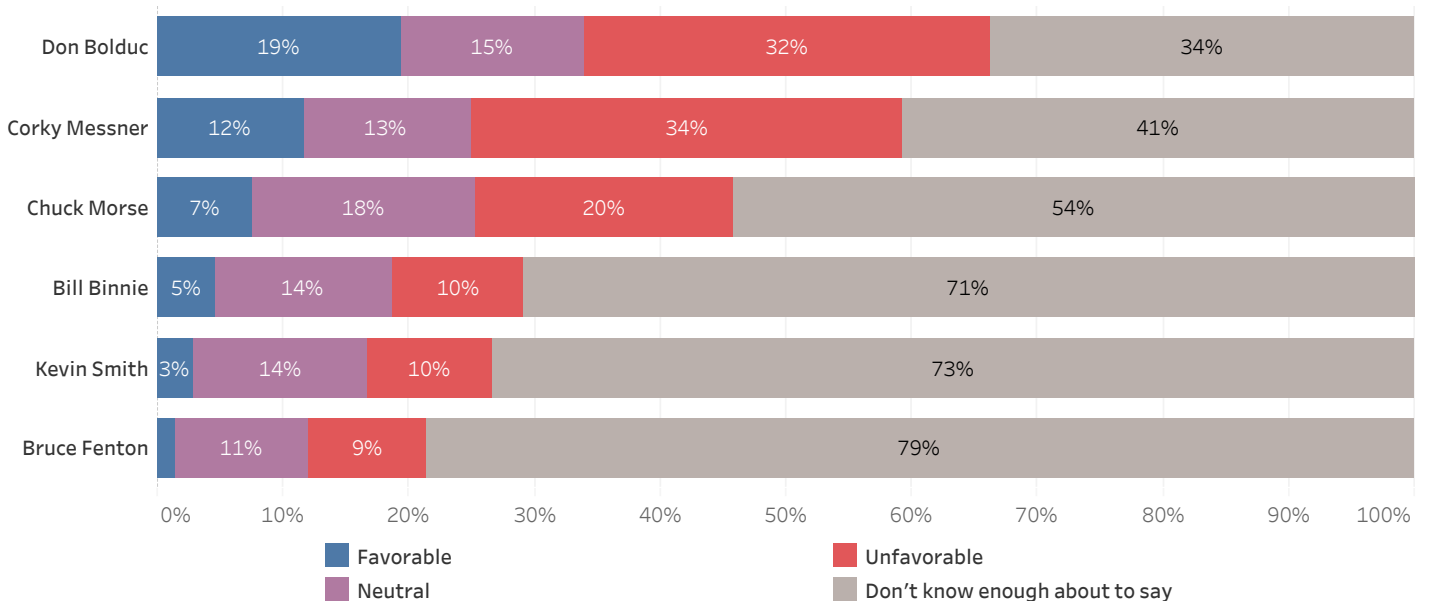
Among those who plan to vote in the Republican primary in September (N=359), more than half (58%) are undecided on who they will vote for, 33% plan to vote for Bolduc, 4% plan to vote for Smith, 2% plan to vote for Morse, 1% plan to vote for Fenton, and 1% plan to vote for another candidate. The high percentage of undecided voters reflect the lack of knowledge that Republicans have of these candidates.

### 2022 U.S. Senate Election - Republican Primary Election - April 2022



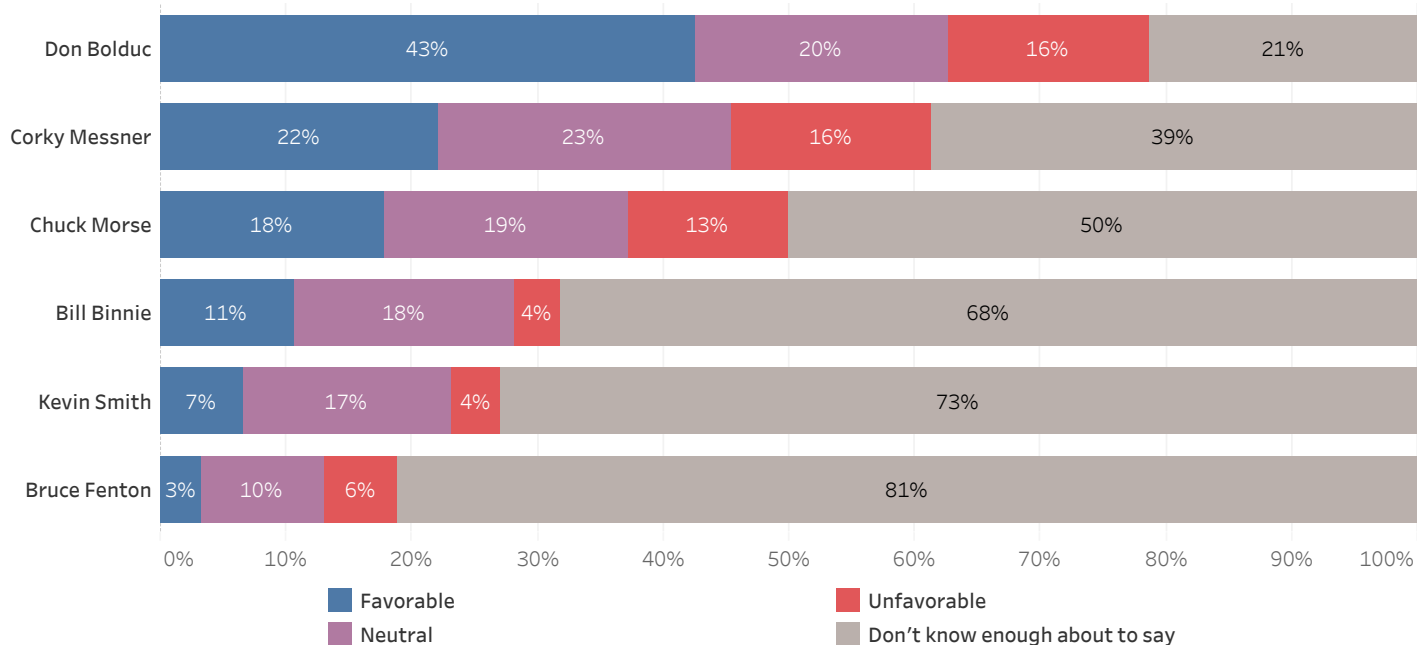
Bolduc, who unsuccessfully sought the Republican nomination for U.S. Senate in 2020, is the best-known candidate, with 19% viewing him favorably, 15% having a neutral opinion, and 32% viewing him unfavorably, while 34% don't know enough to say. Corky Messner, the 2020 Republican nominee for U.S. Senate, and potential 2022 candidate, is also known by more than half the state, with 12% viewing him favorably, 13% having a neutral opinion of him, and 34% viewing him unfavorably, while 41% don't know enough to say. More than half of Granite Staters don't know enough to have an opinion on Morse (54%), possible candidate Bill Binnie (71%), Smith (73%), and Fenton (79%).

### Favorability - Announced and Possible 2022 U.S. Senate Republican Candidates - April 2022



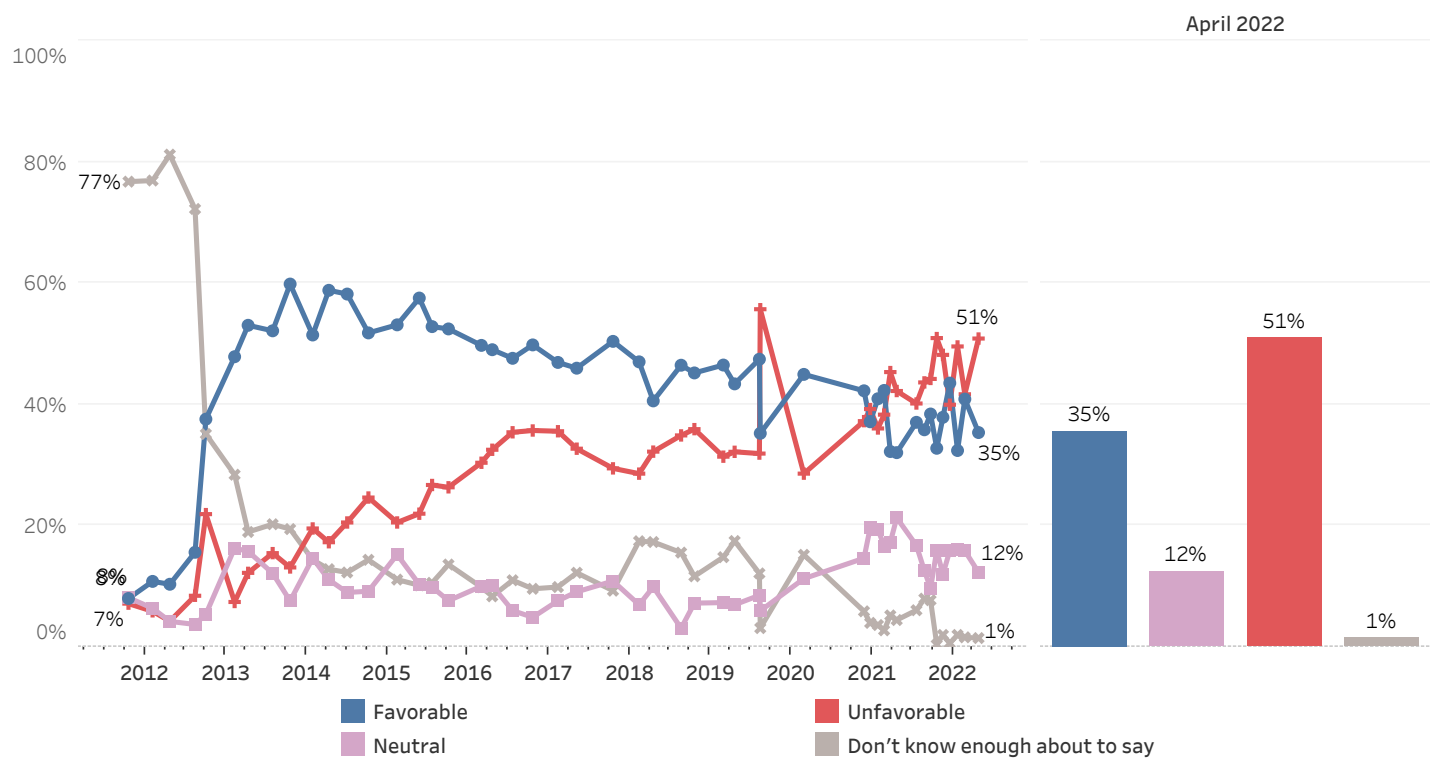
Even among likely Republican primary voters, many of the candidates are largely unknown. Most likely Republican primary voters are aware of Bolduc and Messner but they have a far more positive opinion of Bolduc (+27 net favorability rating) than Messner (+6), while Morse has a net favorability rating of +5 but is unknown to half (50%) of likely Republican primary voters. Two-thirds or more of likely Republican primary voters don't know enough about Binnie (68%), Smith (73%), and Fenton (81%) to have an opinion.

On the Democratic side, incumbent Senator Maggie Hassan faces the same sour national mood that is hurting Democrats across the country. Currently 35% of Granite Staters have a favorable opinion of Hassan, 51% view her unfavorably, 12% have a neutral opinion, and 1% don't know enough to say. Hassan's net favorability (-16) has fallen since February (-2) but matches results in January (-17). Hassan is popular among Democrats (+55 net favorability rating) but is somewhat unpopular among Independents (-32) and very unpopular among Republicans (-84).

**Favorability - Maggie Hassan**

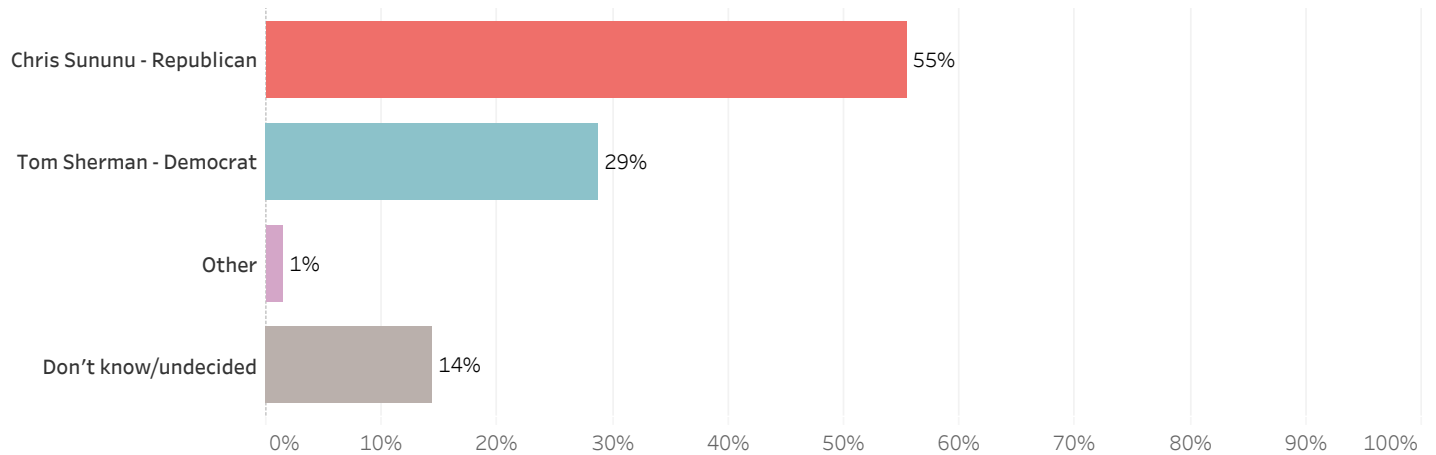


## 2022 NH Gubernatorial Election

New Hampshire Governor Chris Sununu is seeking a fourth term as governor. This could lead to a matchup with State Senator Tom Sherman of Rye, who has decided to seek the Democratic nomination. Sununu holds a clear lead over Sherman if the election were held today - 55% of likely 2022 general election voters say they would vote for Sununu, 29% would vote for Sherman, 1% would vote for another candidate, and 14% are undecided.

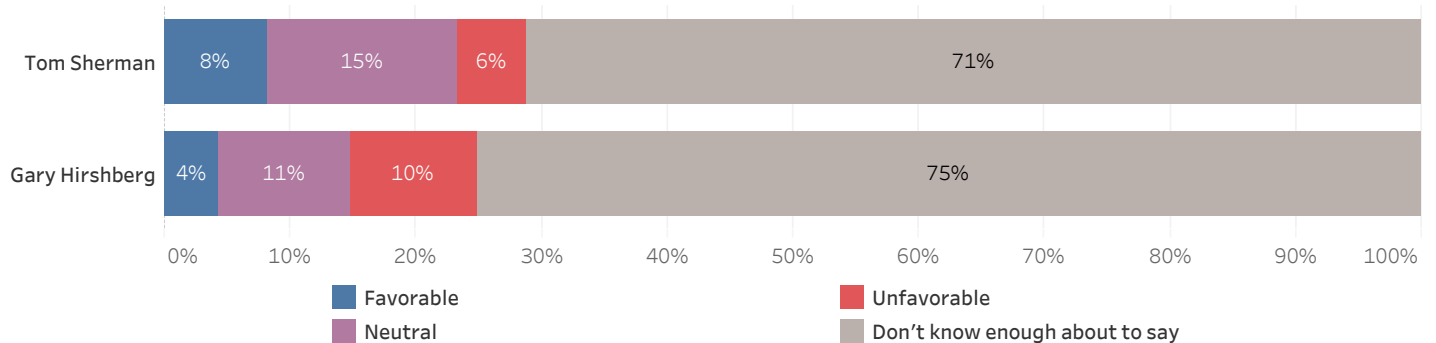
Nearly all Republicans (94%) and most Independents (61%) would support Sununu in this matchup while 59% of Democrats would support Sherman.

### 2022 Gubernatorial Election - Sununu vs. Sherman - April 2022



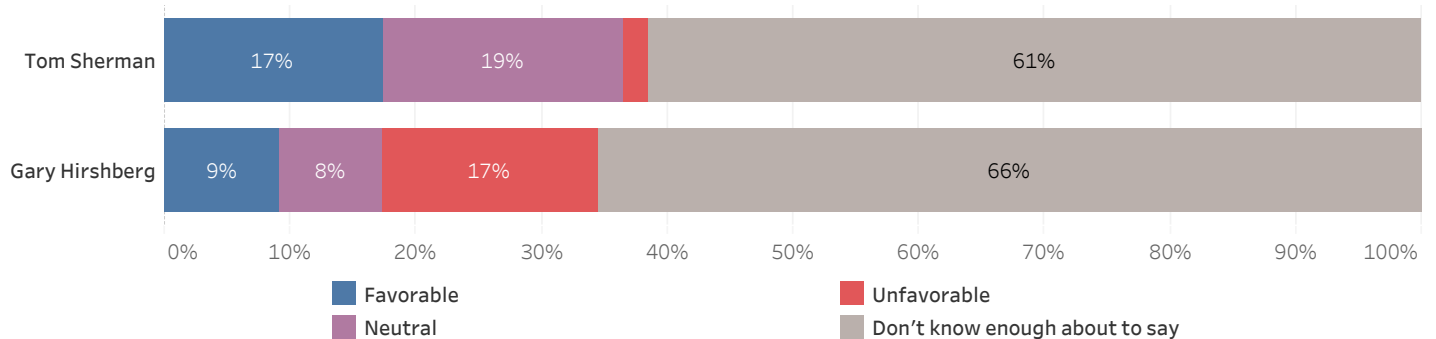
Few Granite Staters are aware of Sherman or another possible Democratic candidate for governor, businessman Gary Hirshberg. Only 8% view Sherman favorably, 6% view him unfavorably, 15% have a neutral opinion, and 71% don't know enough to say, while 4% only view Hirshberg favorably, 10% view him unfavorably, 11% have a neutral opinion, and 75% don't know enough to say.

Both Sherman and Hirshberg are mostly unknown among likely Democratic primary voters (N=357) - 17% view Sherman favorably, 2% view him unfavorably, 19% have a neutral opinion, and 61% don't know enough to say. Only 9% view Hirshberg favorably, 17% view him unfavorably, 8% have a neutral opinion, and 66% don't know enough to say.

### Favorability - Announced and Possible 2022 NH Governor Democratic Candidates - DEM Primary Voters - April 2022

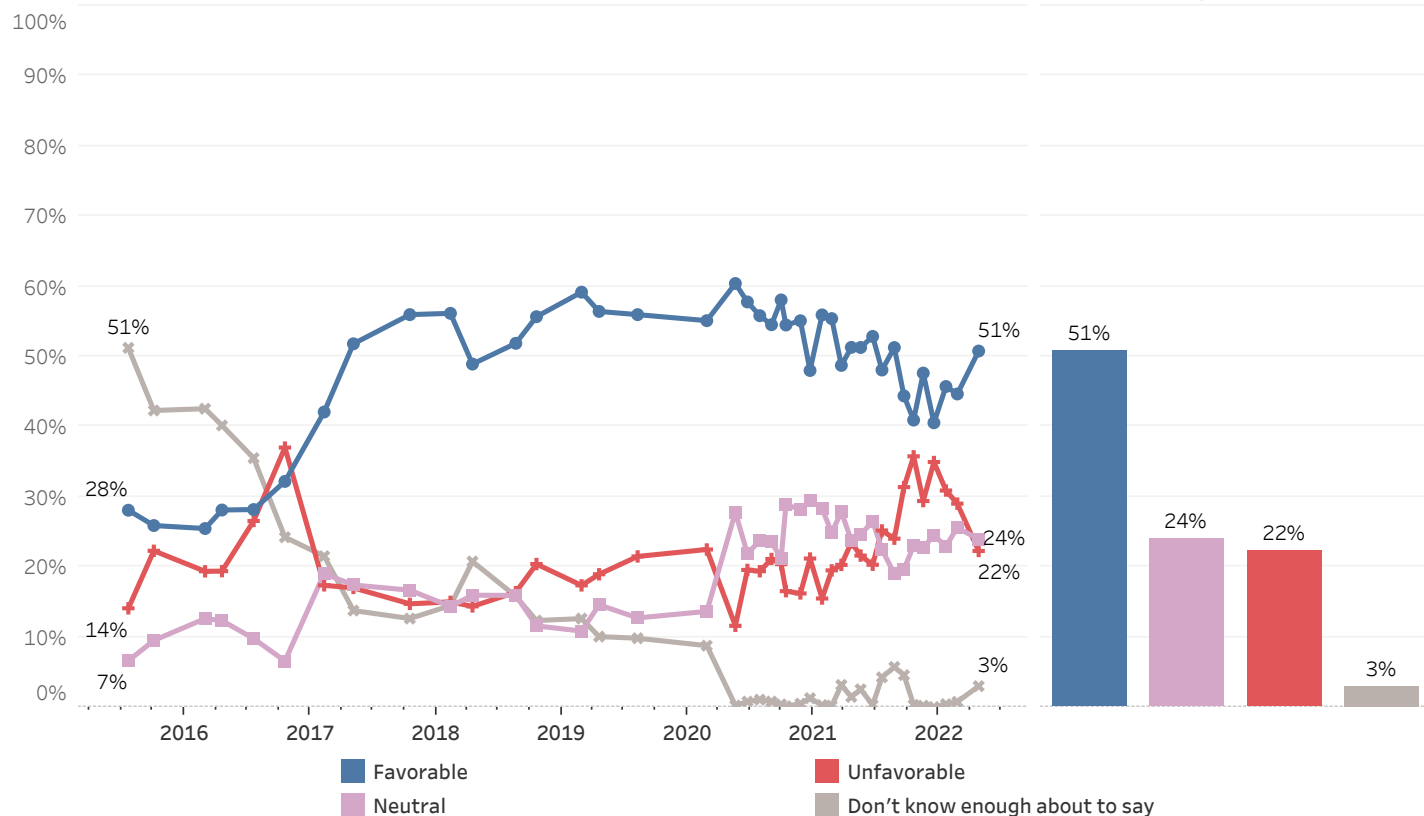


Granite Staters continue to have a largely positive view of Sununu - 51% view him favorably, 22% view him unfavorably, 24% have a neutral opinion, and 3% don't know enough to say. Sununu's net favorability (+29) has increased since February (+16) and is at its highest point since June 2021 (+33).

Sununu is very popular among Republicans (+75 net favorability rating) and is popular among Independents (+38). He is only somewhat unpopular among Democrats (-22) and this figure has increased markedly since December 2021 (-58).

## Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Nine hundred seventy-five (975) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between April 14 and April 18, 2022. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.1 percent. Included were 868 likely 2022 general election voters (MSE = +/-3.5 percent) and 315 likely Republican primary voters (MSE = +/- 5.5 percent). These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the April 2022 Granite State Poll is 26%. The design effect for the survey is 2.7%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
