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## SUPPORT FOR BIDEN RE-ELECTION BID PLUMMETS AMONG NH DEMS; BIDEN & BUTTIGIEG TIED IN NH 2024 DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY

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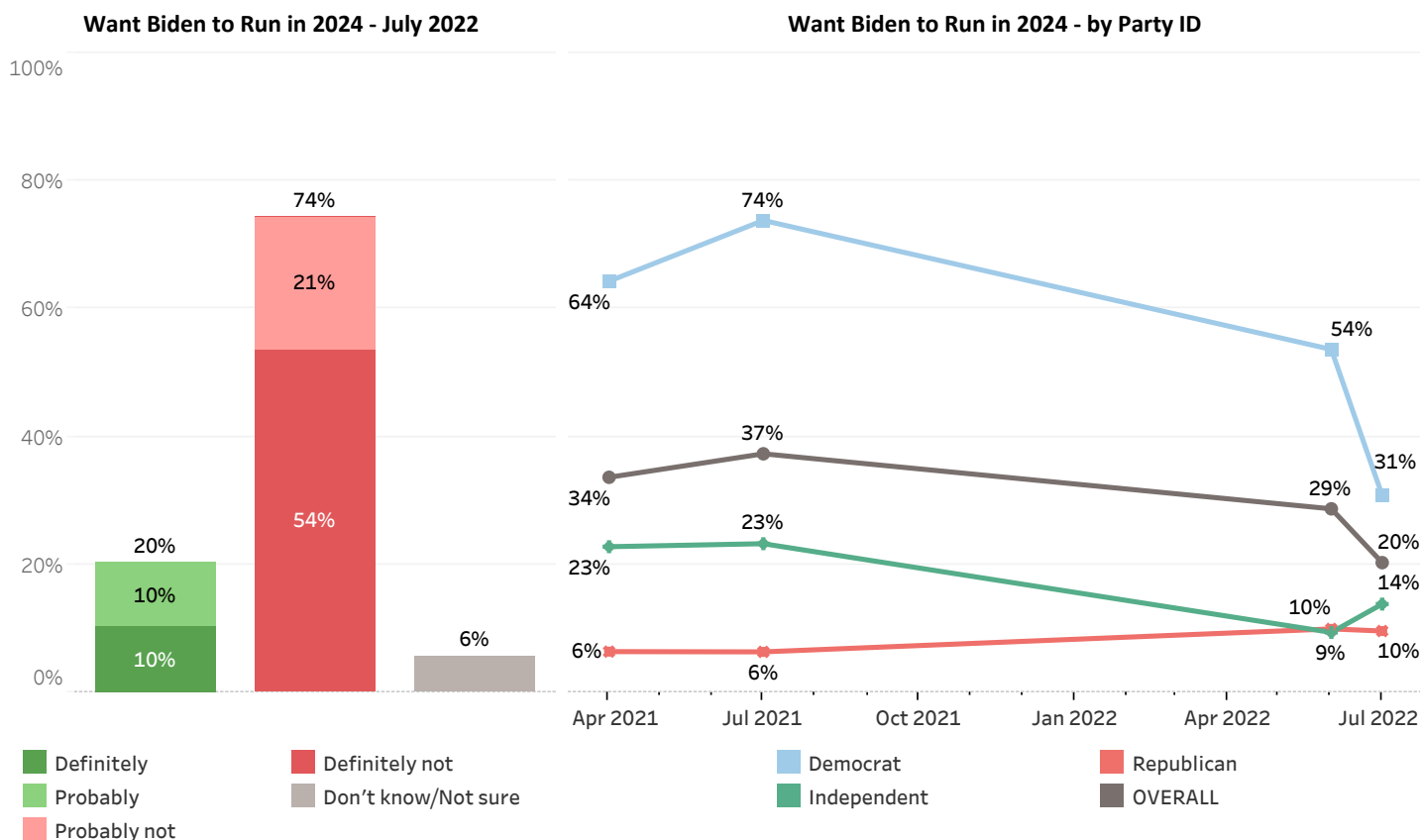
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DURHAM, NH - Only one-fifth of Granite Staters want President Biden to seek another term in 2024 and support among Democrats has fallen dramatically since last summer. When asked who they would support in a 2024 presidential primary, Biden is tied with Transportation Secretary Pete Buttigieg. Biden's personal favorability is at an all-time low and is lower than many possible 2024 candidates among New Hampshire Democrats.

### 2024 Democratic Presidential Primary

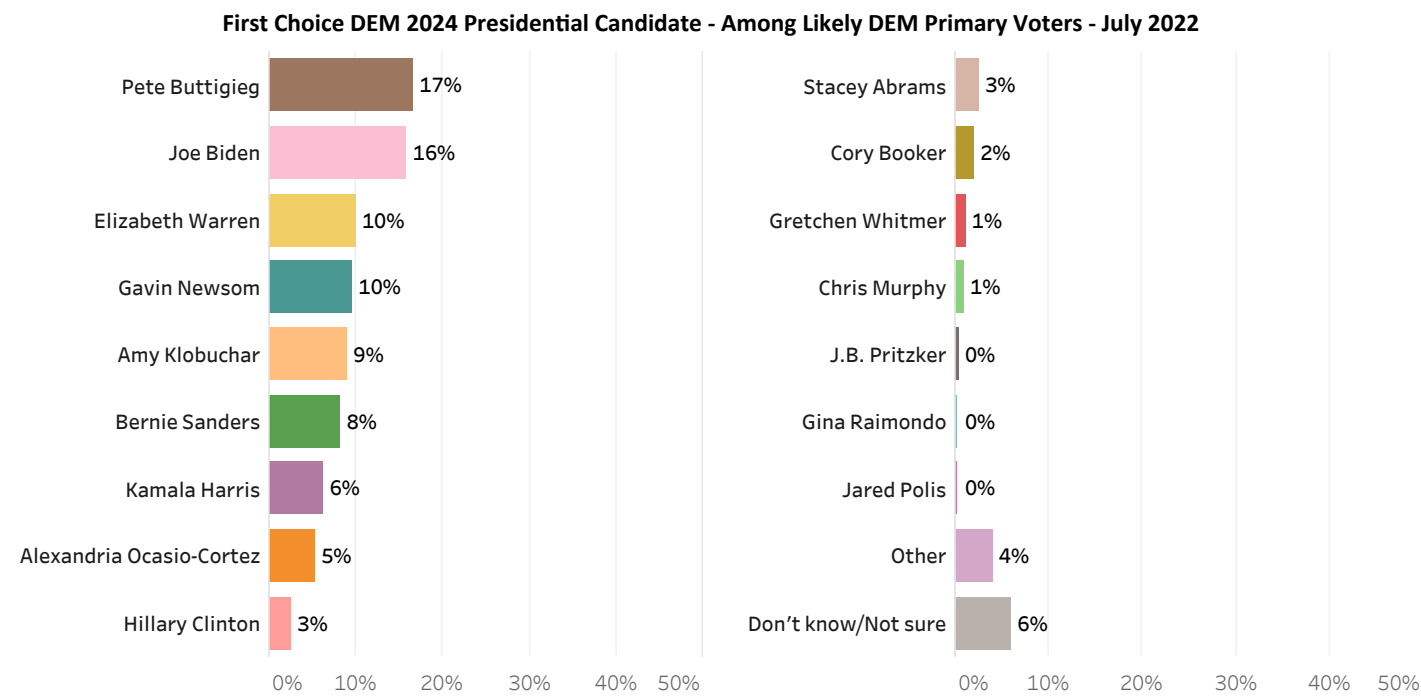
Less than two years into his presidency, only 20% of New Hampshire residents want President Joe Biden to run for re-election in 2024, 74% do not want him to run for president again, and 6% are unsure. In June, 65% of Granite Staters said they did not want Biden to run again. As in June, few New Hampshire Independents (14%) or Republicans (10%) want Biden to run again. However, support for Biden running again has dropped dramatically among Democrats - only 31% want Biden to run again, down from 54% in June and from 74% in July 2021. "President Biden is increasingly seen as an electoral liability for Democrats, both in the 2022 midterms and the 2024 presidential election" said Andrew Smith, Director of the UNH Survey Center.

There is also broad bipartisan concern among New Hampshire residents about Biden's age. Seventy-eight percent say that they are very or somewhat concerned about Biden's age, including 88% of Republicans, 75% of Democrats, and 65% of Independents.

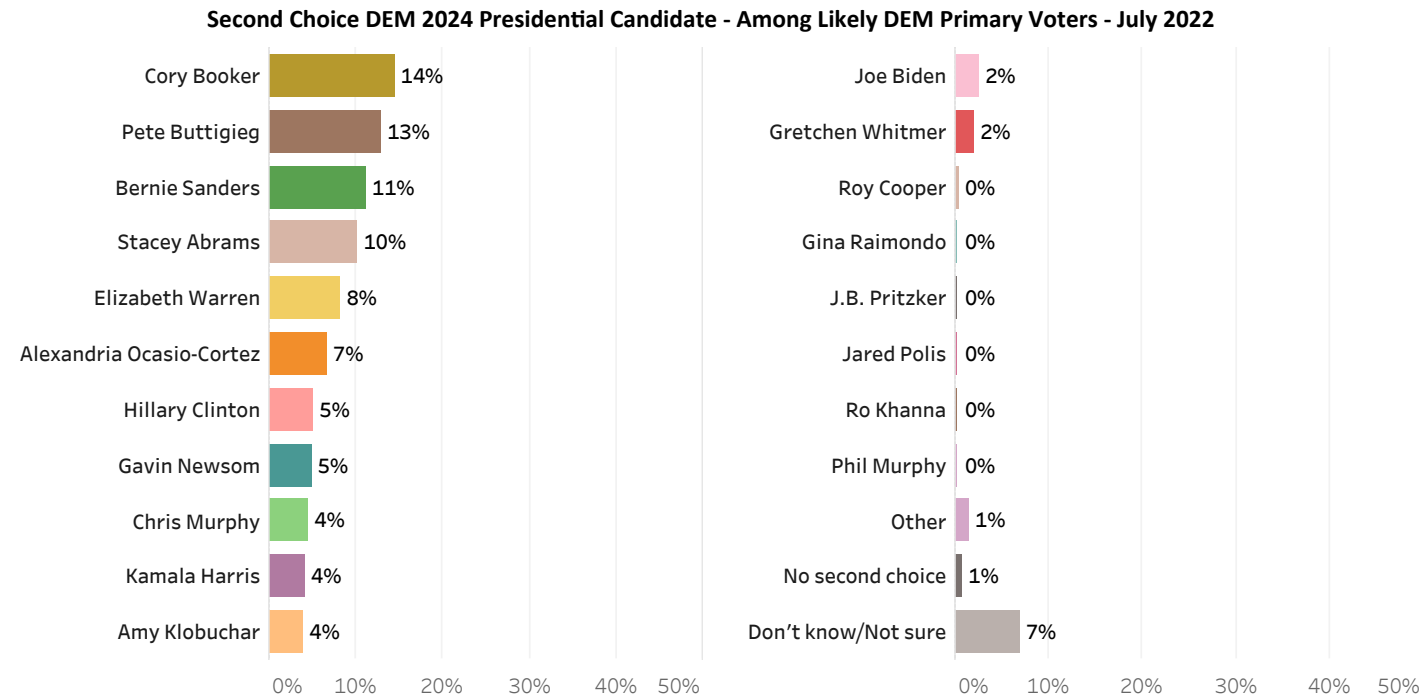

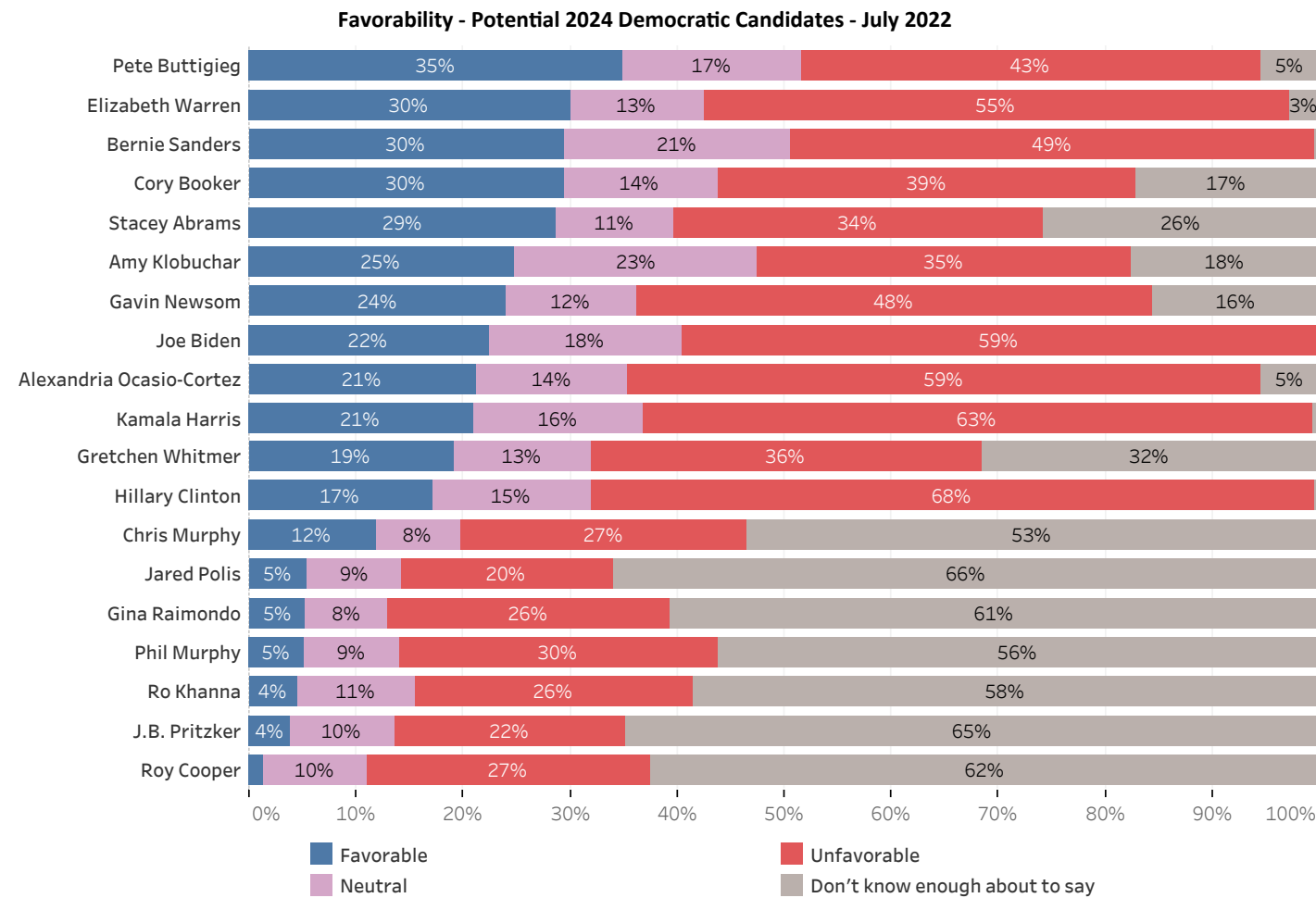
When provided with a list of Democrats who are thought by national political observers to be considering running for President in 2024, Biden (16%) is statistically tied with Transportation Secretary Pete Buttigieg (17%) among likely 2024 New Hampshire Democratic Primary voters. Ten percent of likely primary voters say they support Massachusetts Senator Elizabeth Warren, another 10% support California Governor Gavin Newsom, 9% support Minnesota Senator Amy Klobuchar, 8% support Vermont Senator Bernie Sanders, 6% support Vice President Kamala Harris, and 5% support New York Congresswoman Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez. Less than 5% say they support former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton (3%), Georgia Gubernatorial candidate Stacey Abrams (3%), New Jersey Senator Cory Booker (2%), Michigan Governor Gretchen Whitmer (1%), Connecticut Senator Chris Murphy (1%), Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker (<1%), Commerce Secretary Gina Raimondo (<1%), or Colorado Governor Jared Polis (<1%). Four percent say they would support another candidate while 6% are unsure.



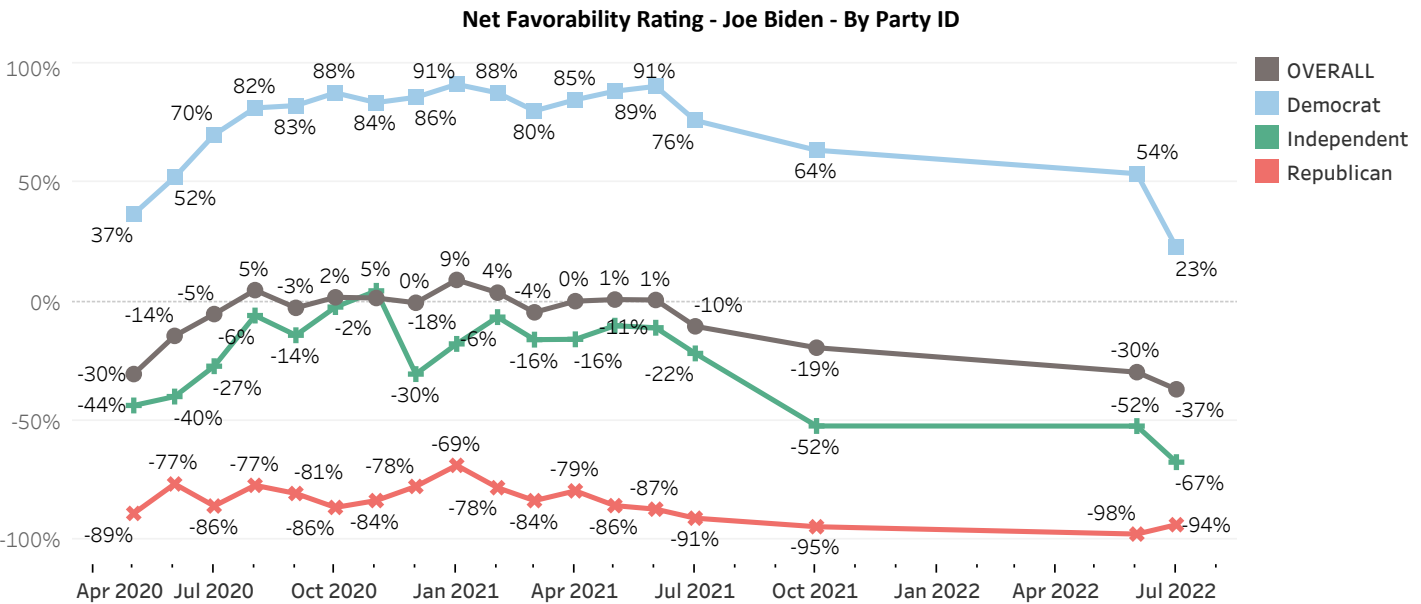
When asked their second choice, 14% of likely Democratic primary voters prefer Booker, followed by Buttigieg (13%), Sanders (11%), Abrams (10%), Warren (8%), Ocasio-Cortez (7%), Clinton (5%), Newsom (5%), Murphy (4%), Harris (4%), Klobuchar (4%), Biden (2%), and Whitmer (2%). One percent prefer another candidate, 1% say they don't have a second choice, and 7% are unsure.



Among all Granite Staters, these potential 2024 Democratic presidential candidates are largely unpopular or unknown. Abrams is the least unpopular possible candidate, with a net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion) of -6, followed by Buttigieg (-8), Booker (-10), and Klobuchar (-10). Clinton (-50), Harris (-42), Ocasio-Cortez (-38), and Biden (-37) are the most unpopular of these possible candidates among all New Hampshire residents.



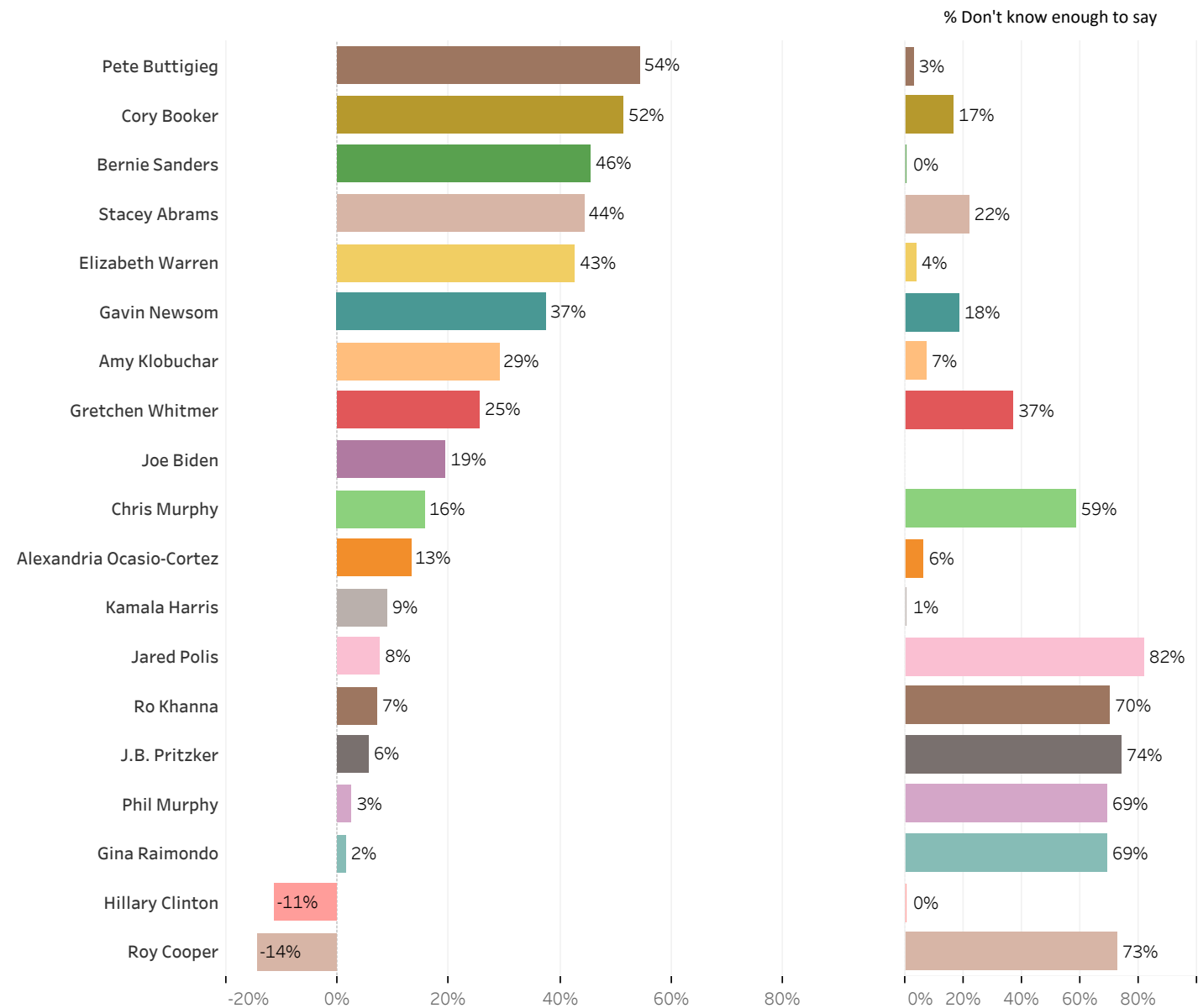
Biden's net favorability (-37) has fallen precipitously since June 2021 (+1) and is at an all-time low.

These potential candidates are far more popular among likely Democratic Primary voters than among Granite Staters overall. Buttigieg (+54) and Booker (+52) have the highest net favorability among this group, followed by Sanders (+46), Abrams (+44), and Warren (+43). Newsom (+37), Klobuchar (+29), and Whitmer (+25) are all somewhat popular among likely Democratic primary voters, while likely primary voters are more neutral on Biden (+19), Chris Murphy (+16), Ocasio-Cortez (+13), Harris (+9) Polis (+8%), California Congressman Ro Khanna (+7), Pritzker (+6), New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy (+3), Raimondo (+2), Clinton (-11), and North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper (-14).

## Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand and forty-three (1,043) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between July 21 and July 25, 2022. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.0 percent. Included in the sample were 430 likely 2024 Democratic Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 4.7 percent). These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the July 2022 Granite State Poll is 28%. The design effect for the survey is 2.8%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
