## BIDEN APPROVAL REMAINS MIRED IN LOW 40s IN NH; MAJORITY APPROVE OF FBI SEARCH OF TRUMP'S HOME IN FLORIDA

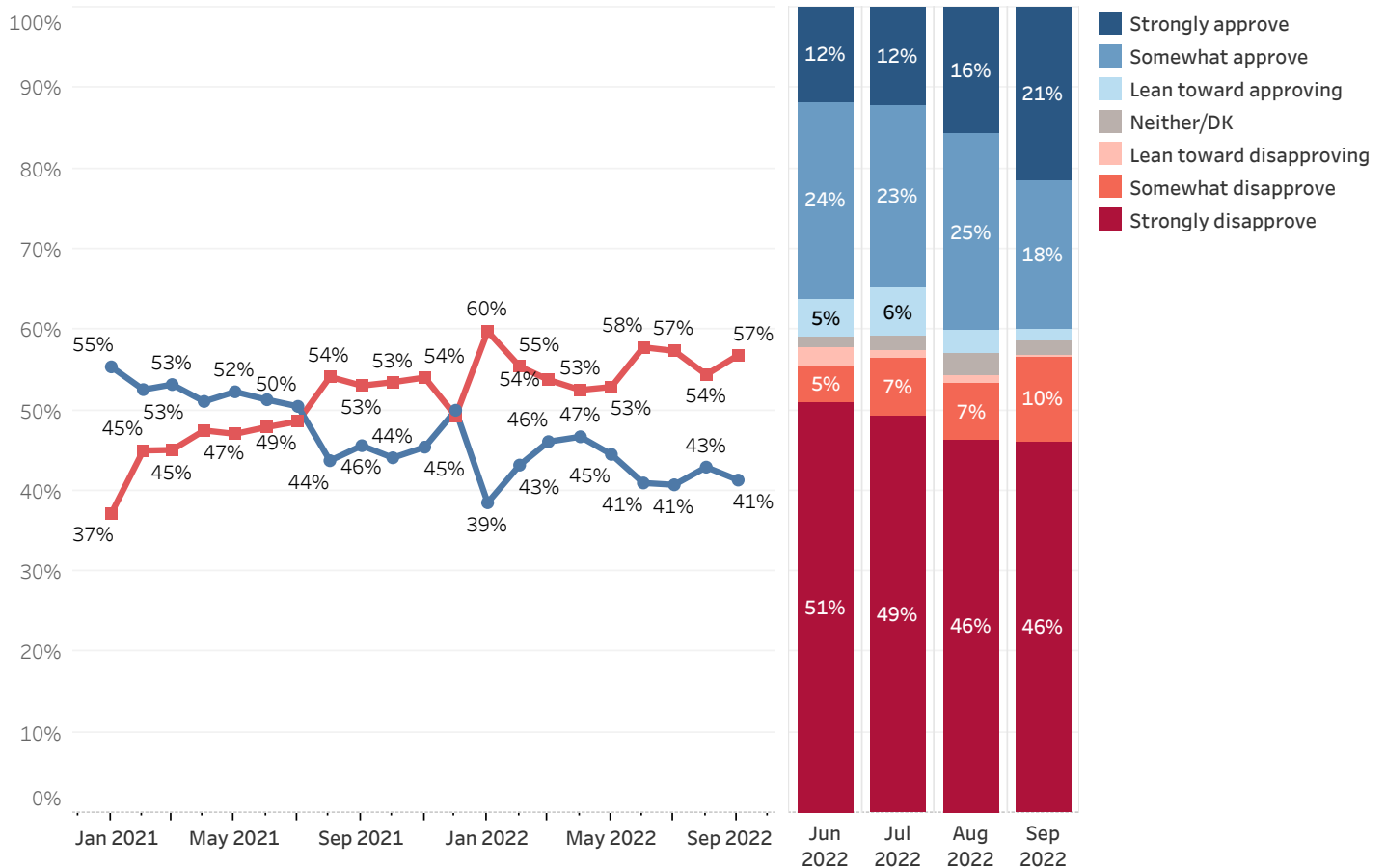
DURHAM, NH - President Joe Biden continues to get low performance ratings in New Hampshire, particularly his handling of the economy. A small majority of Granite Staters approve of the FBI's decision to conduct a search of former President Donald Trump's home in Florida and few think that Trump's handling of classified material after his term in office has been appropriate.

### Presidential Approval

Ahead of the November midterm elections, a majority of New Hampshire adults continue to disapprove of the job Joe Biden is doing as President. Overall, 41% of Granite Staters approve of Biden's performance as President, 57% disapprove, and 2% are unsure. Biden's net approval rating (the percentage who approve minus the percentage who disapprove) among Granite Staters is -16, slightly lower than in August (-11).

Ninety-one percent of Democrats approve of Biden's performance as president, his highest showing among Democrats since April (94%). However, only 22% of Independents approve, representing Biden's lowest approval since August 2021 among that group, while only 2% of Republicans approve.

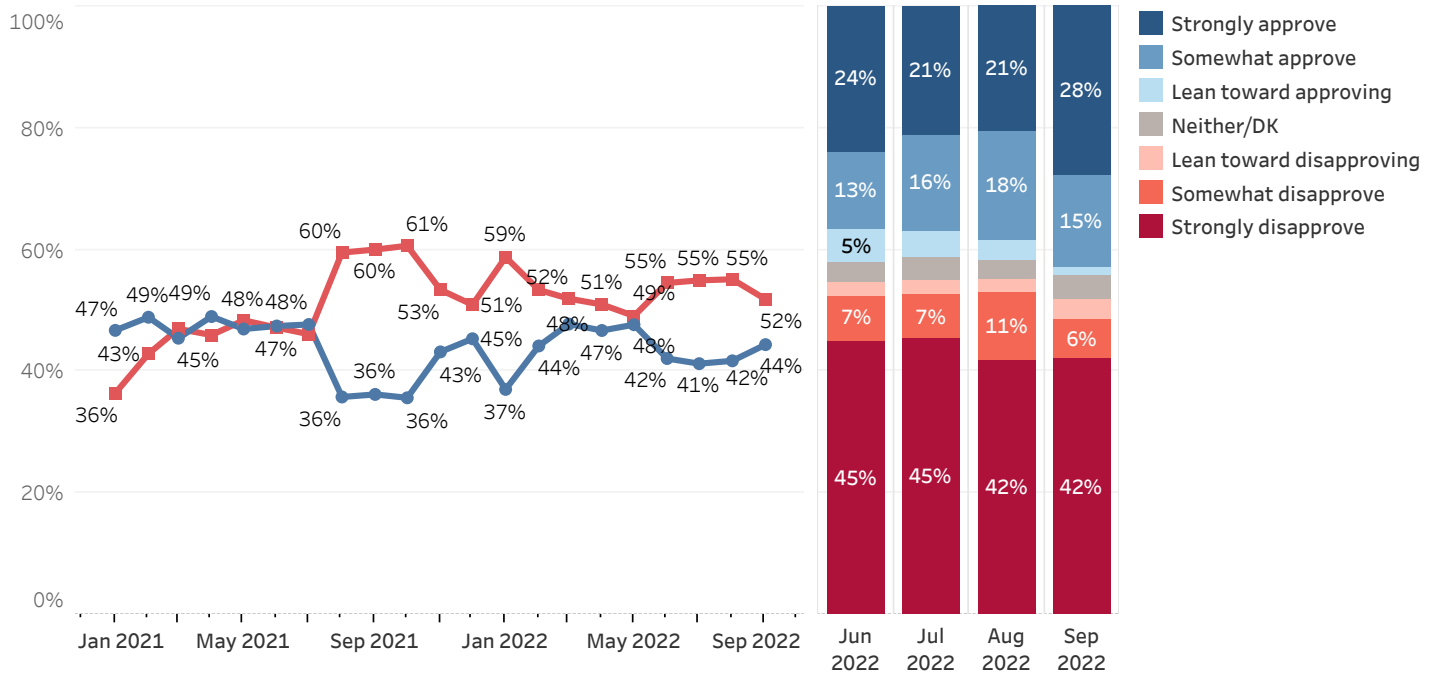
Approval of President Biden's Job Performance

Amid a string of victories by Ukraine in their war with Russia, Granite Staters have become slightly more positive in their assessment of Biden's handling of foreign affairs. Forty-four percent approve of his handling of foreign affairs, 52% disapprove, and 4% are unsure. Net approval of Biden's handling of foreign affairs (-7) is slightly higher than in August (-13). Eighty-nine percent of Democrats approve of Biden's handling of foreign affairs, but only 25% of Independents and 11% of Republicans approve.

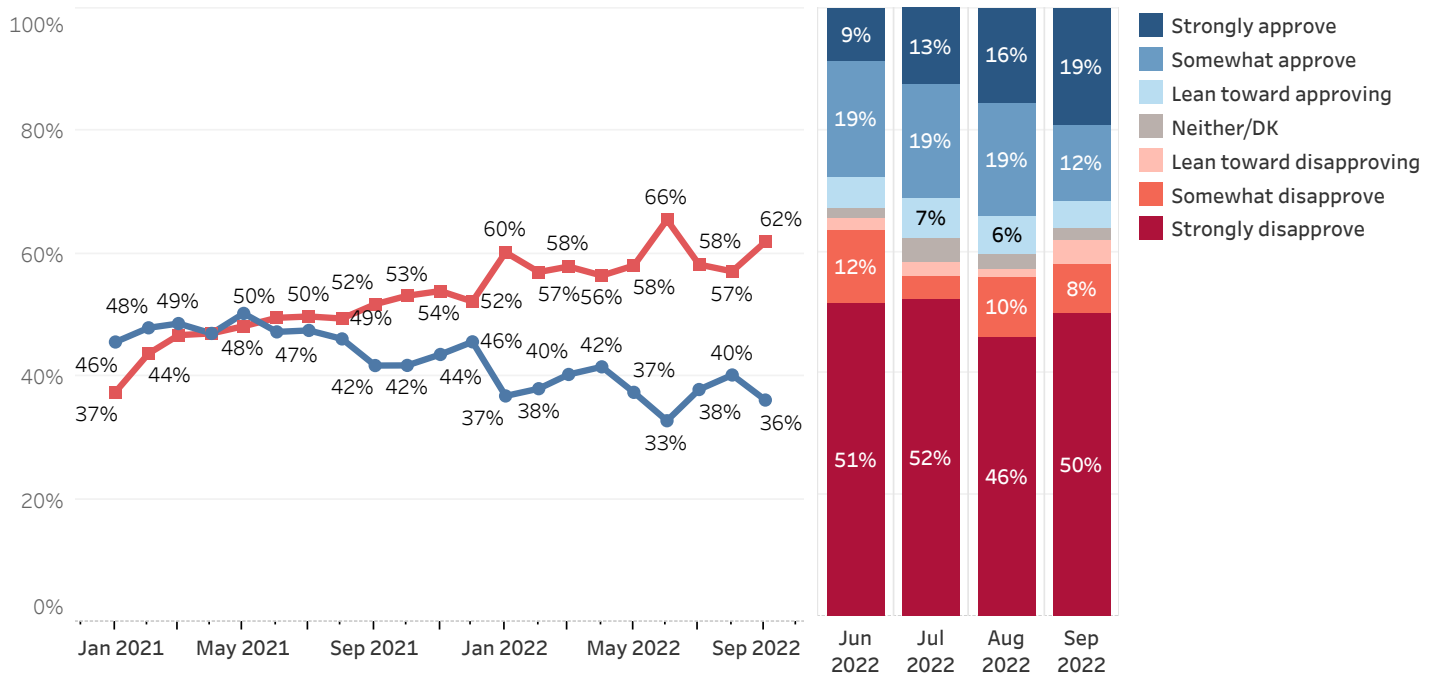
**Approval of President Biden's Handling of Foreign Affairs**



Ratings of Biden's handling of the economy remain quite low. Only thirty-six percent of New Hampshire residents approve of Biden's handling of the economy, 62% disapprove, and 2% are unsure. Net approval of Biden's handling of the economy (-26) has declined since August (-17). Eighty percent of Democrats approve of Biden's handling of the economy, but only 18% of Independents and 2% of Republicans approve.

Approval of Biden's handling of the economy is lower than Granite Staters' assessment of former President Trump's handling of the economy at any point in his tenure in office.

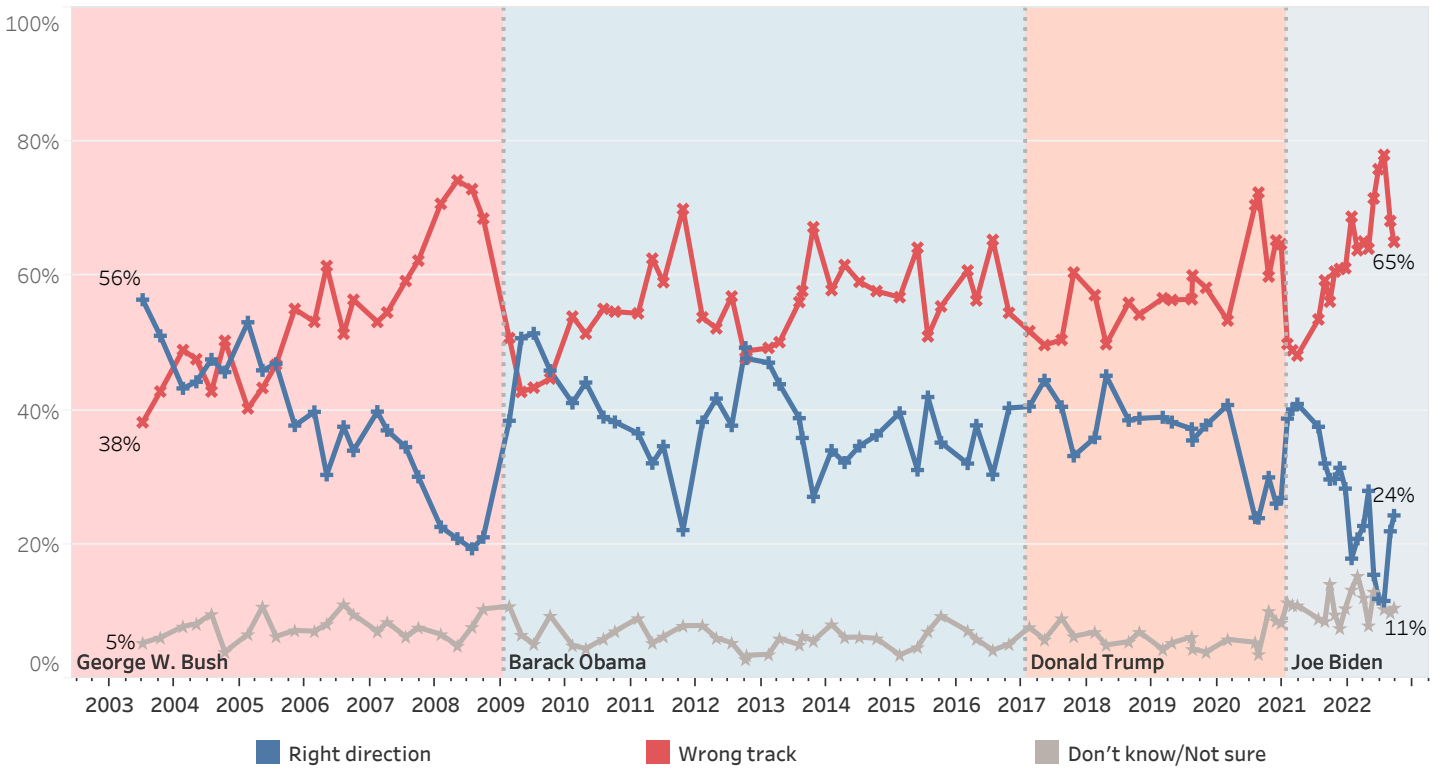
**Approval of President Biden's Handling of the Economy**



### Direction of U.S.

Twenty-four percent of Granite Staters believe that things in the United States are headed in the right direction, largely unchanged since August (22%), while 65% believe things are seriously off on the wrong track, and 11% are unsure. Forty-seven percent of Democrats say the country is headed in the right direction, up from 30% in July, while 12% of Independents and 8% of Republicans feel the same way.

#### U.S. Heading in Right Direction or On Wrong Track

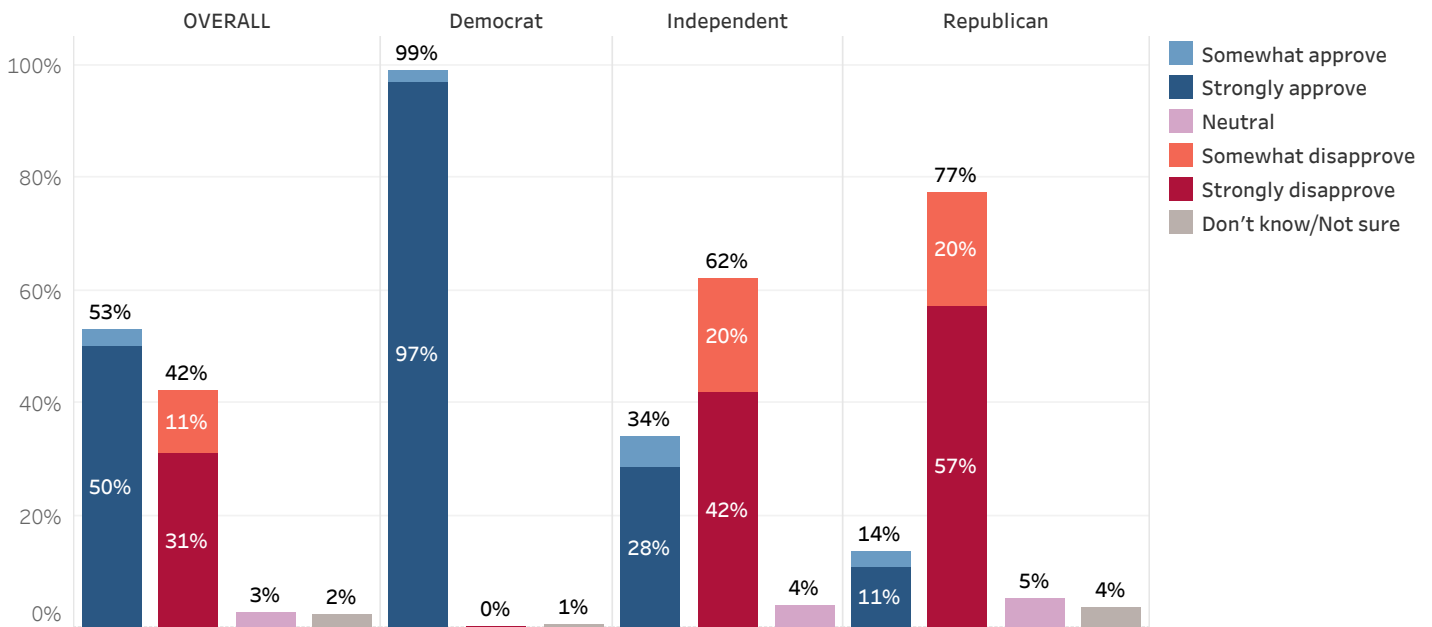


## FBI Search of Mar-a-Lago

On August 8th, the FBI conducted a search of former President Donald Trump's Mar-a-Lago club in Florida, reportedly in connection with Trump's alleged mishandling and wrongful keeping of potentially classified documents. A small majority (53%) of New Hampshire residents say that they strongly (50%) or somewhat (3%) approve of the FBI's decision to execute this search, 42% strongly (31%) or somewhat (11%) disapprove, 3% are neutral, and 2% don't know or are unsure. Nearly all Democrats (99%) approve of the search, but majorities of Independents (62%) and Republicans (77%) disapprove.

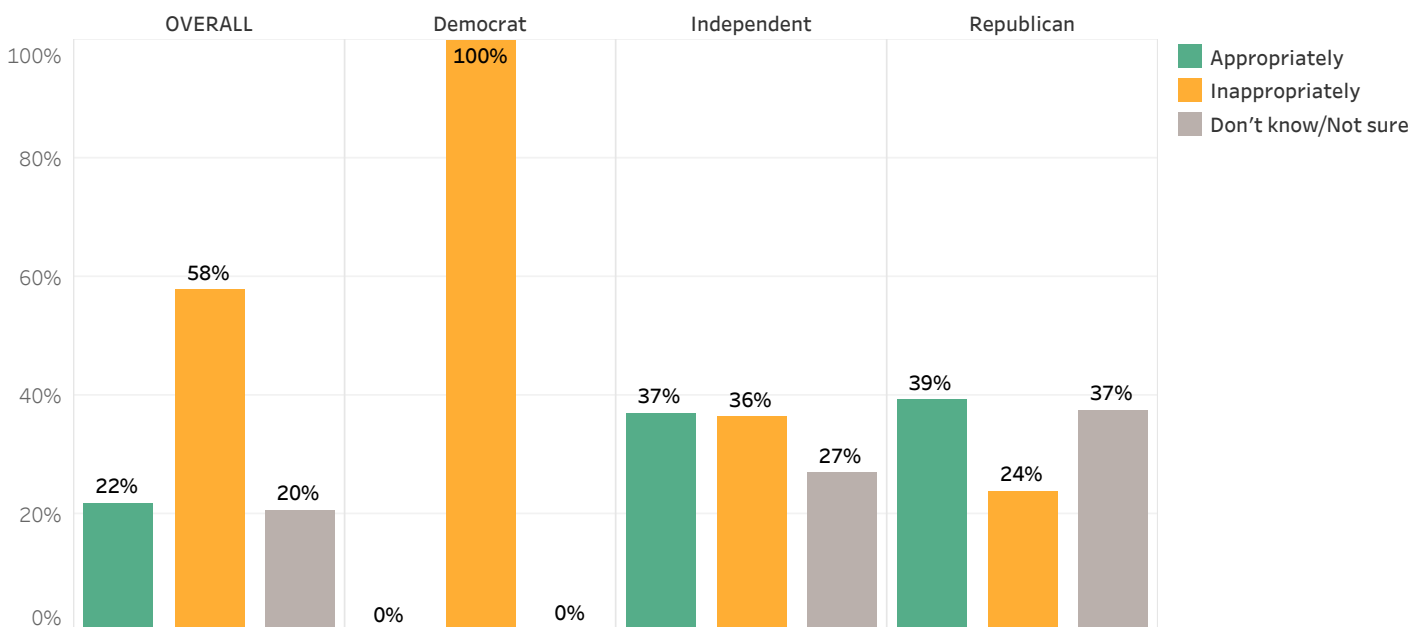
Nearly all Granite Staters have heard a lot (68%) or some (28%) about the FBI search, 4% have heard not that much, and 1% have heard nothing at all about it.

Among those who have heard at least something about the raid (N=932), less than a quarter (22%) think Trump acted appropriately in his handling of classified documents, a majority (58%) think he acted inappropriately, and 20% are unsure. Nearly all Democrats (100%) believe Trump acted inappropriately, but a plurality of Republicans think he acted appropriately (39%) while Independents are closely divided, with 37% saying that he acted appropriately, 36% saying that he acted inappropriately, and 27% unsure.

## Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Nine hundred seventy-six (976) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between September 15 and September 19, 2022. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.1 percent. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the September 2022 Granite State Poll is 27%. The design effect for the survey is 2.9%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,250 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
