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MILLS LEADS LEPAGE IN RACE FOR MAINE GOVERNOR; DEMOCRATS HOLD EDGE OVER GOP IN RACES FOR STATE SENATE & HOUSE

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DURHAM, NH - Incumbent Governor Janet Mills holds a double-digit lead over former Governor Paul LePage in the contest for Governor of Maine. A plurality of Mainers have a positive opinion of Mills while a majority have an unfavorable view of LePage. Likely voters lean towards Democrats in races for the Maine State Senate and House of Representatives.


2022 ME Gubernatorial General Election

Incumbent Democrat Janet Mills will face former Governor Paul LePage and Independent candidate Sam Hunkler in the 2022 Maine gubernatorial race. If the election were held today, 53% of likely voters say they would vote for Mills, 39% would vote for LePage, 1% would vote for Hunkler, 1% would vote for another candidate, and 5% are undecided.

Nearly all Democrats (97%) support Mills while 86% of Republicans support LePage. Mills holds a small lead among Independents, 49% to 38%. Mills holds clear leads among those under the age of thirty-five, women, those with a college degree, and Southern Maine residents, while LePage leads among those aged 35-49 and Northern Maine residents.

“Mills has solid support among Democrats which puts her in a good position to win this race,” said Andrew Smith, Director of the UNH Survey Center. “LePage has little margin for error. In order for him to win, he will have to secure the support of almost all Republicans.”

2022 Maine Gubernatorial Election - September 2022



Mainers have a slightly positive view of Mills: 49% have a favorable opinion of her, 40% have an unfavorable opinion of her, 10% are neutral, and less than 1% don't know enough about her to say. Mills's net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion of her minus the percentage who have an unfavorable opinion) is +8.

Mills is very popular among Democrats (+87) in the state but is very unpopular among Republicans (-80), while Independents are neutral (-2).


Favorability - Janet Mills - September 2022



LePage is considerably less popular than Mills. Only 36% of Mainers have a favorable opinion of him, 55% have an unfavorable opinion of him, 8% are neutral, and 2% don't know enough about him to say. LePage's net favorability rating is -19.

LePage is very popular among Republicans (+74) in the state but is unpopular among Independents (-27) and is very unpopular among Democrats (-95).


Favorability - Paul LePage - September 2022



Hunkler is unknown to most Mainers. Only 1% have a favorable opinion of him, 6% have an unfavorable opinion of him, 8% are neutral, and 85% don't know enough about him to say. Hunkler's net favorability rating is -6.

Twenty-six percent of Independents know enough about Hunkler to have an opinion about him, but only 18% of Democrats and 8% of Republicans say the same.


Favorability - Sam Hunkler - September 2022



Just over half (54%) of Maine residents approve of Governor Mills's job as Governor, 43% disapprove, and 3% neither approve nor disapprove or don't know. Mills's net approval rating (the percentage who approve minus the percentage who disapprove) is +11.

Ninety-five percent of Democrats and 48% of Independents approve of Mills's performance as Governor, but only 9% of Republicans agree.

Approval of Governor Mills's Job Performance - September 2022




2022 Maine State Senate Election

When asked the party of the State Senate candidate they would vote for if the election were held today, 42% of likely voters say that they would vote for the Democratic candidate, 33% say they would vote for the Republican candidate, 7% would vote for another candidate, and 18% are undecided.

Among Democrats, 85% plan on voting for the Democratic candidate and 9% are undecided, while among Republicans, 76% plan to vote for the Republican candidate and 17% are undecided. Among Independents, 15% plan to vote for the Democratic candidate, 16% plan to vote for the Republican candidate, 13% plan to vote for another candidate, and 56% are undecided.

2022 Maine State Senate Election - September 2022




2022 Maine State House Election

When asked the party of the State House of Representatives candidate they would vote for if the election were held today, 43% of likely voters say that they would vote for the Democratic candidate, 34% say they would vote for the Republican candidate, 7% would vote for another candidate, and 15% are undecided.

Among Democrats, 86% plan on voting for the Democratic candidate and 9% are undecided, while among Republicans, 77% plan to vote for the Republican candidate and 17% are undecided. Among Independents, 17% plan to vote for the Democratic candidate, 20% plan to vote for the Republican candidate, 23% plan to vote for another candidate, and 39% are undecided.

Pine Tree State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Pine Tree State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Seven hundred fifty-two (752) Pine Tree State Panel members completed the survey online between September 15 and September 19, 2022. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.6 percent. Included in the sample were 694 likely 2022 general election voters (MSE = +/- 3.7%). These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the September 2022 Pine Tree State Poll is 32%. The design effect for the survey is 2.4%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the ME Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Maine.

The Pine Tree State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of Maine residents. Approximately 2,500 Maine adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
