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MOST NH 2024 DEM PRIMARY VOTERS DON'T WANT BIDEN TO RUN FOR REELECTION, PRESIDENT TIED WITH 2020 CANDIDATES

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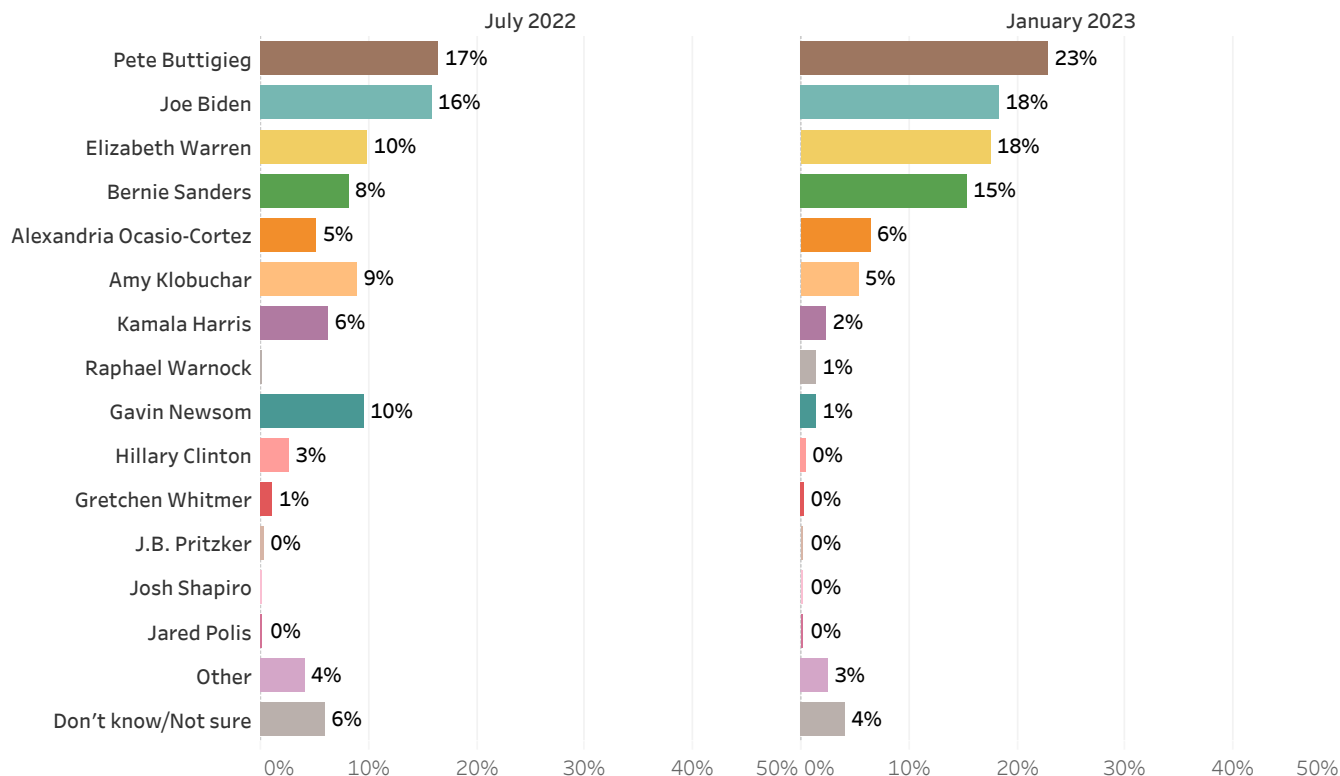
DURHAM, NH - Amid uncertainty about the fate of the 2024 New Hampshire Democratic primary, two-thirds of likely Democratic primary voters don't want President Joe Biden to seek reelection. Biden is statistically tied with several 2020 rivals, including Transportation Secretary Pete Buttigieg, Massachusetts Senator Elizabeth Warren, and Vermont Senator Bernie Sanders, all of whom are more personally popular than Biden among likely Democratic primary voters in New Hampshire.

2024 Democratic Presidential Primary

Recently, the Democratic National Committee (DNC) proposed changing the primary calendar to bump New Hampshire from holding the "first-in-the-nation" primary. President Biden finds himself in difficult straits with New Hampshire presidential primary voters, statistically tied with many of his 2020 rivals. When provided with a list of Democrats who are thought by national political observers to be considering running for President in 2024, Transportation Secretary Pete Buttigieg leads the field with 23% of support, followed by Biden (18%), Massachusetts Senator Elizabeth Warren (18%), and Vermont Senator Bernie Sanders (15%). Six percent support New York Congresswoman Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez, 5% support Minnesota Senator Amy Klobuchar, 2% support Vice President Kamala Harris, and 1% each support Georgia Senator Raphael Warnock or California Governor Gavin Newsom. No other candidate was chosen by 1% or more of respondents, while 4% are unsure.

Support for Buttigieg, Warren, and Sanders has increased slightly compared to July 2022, while support for Biden is largely unchanged.

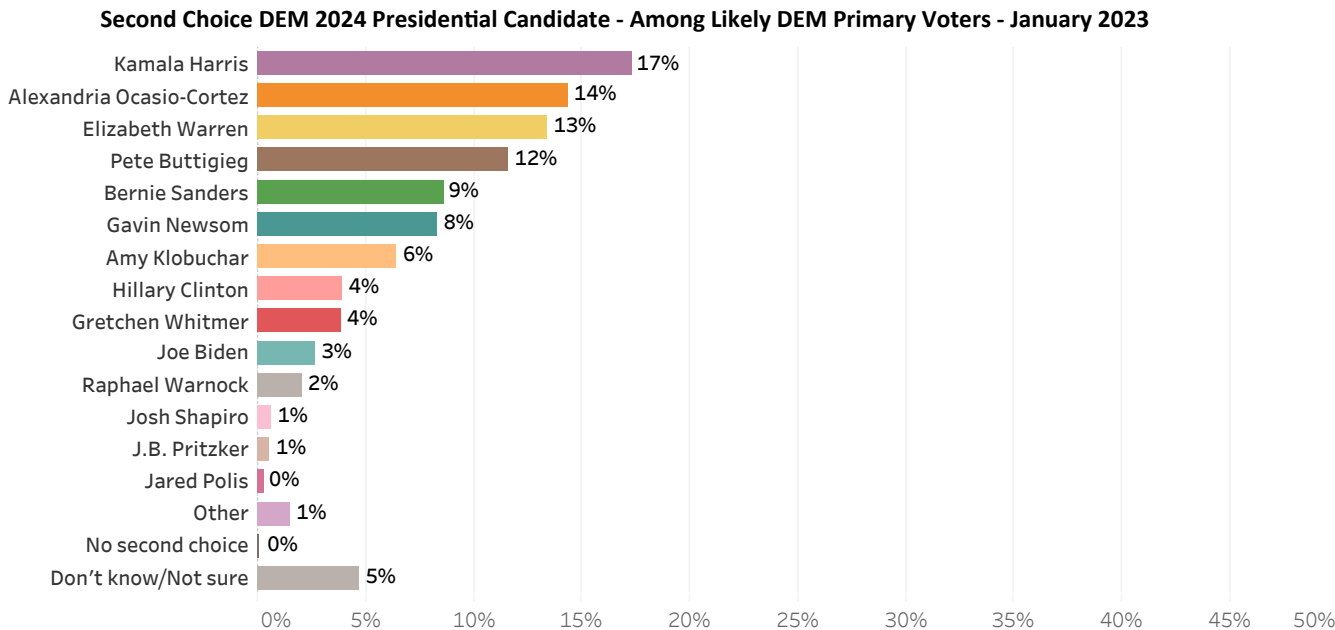
First Choice DEM 2024 Presidential Candidate - Among Likely DEM Primary Voters

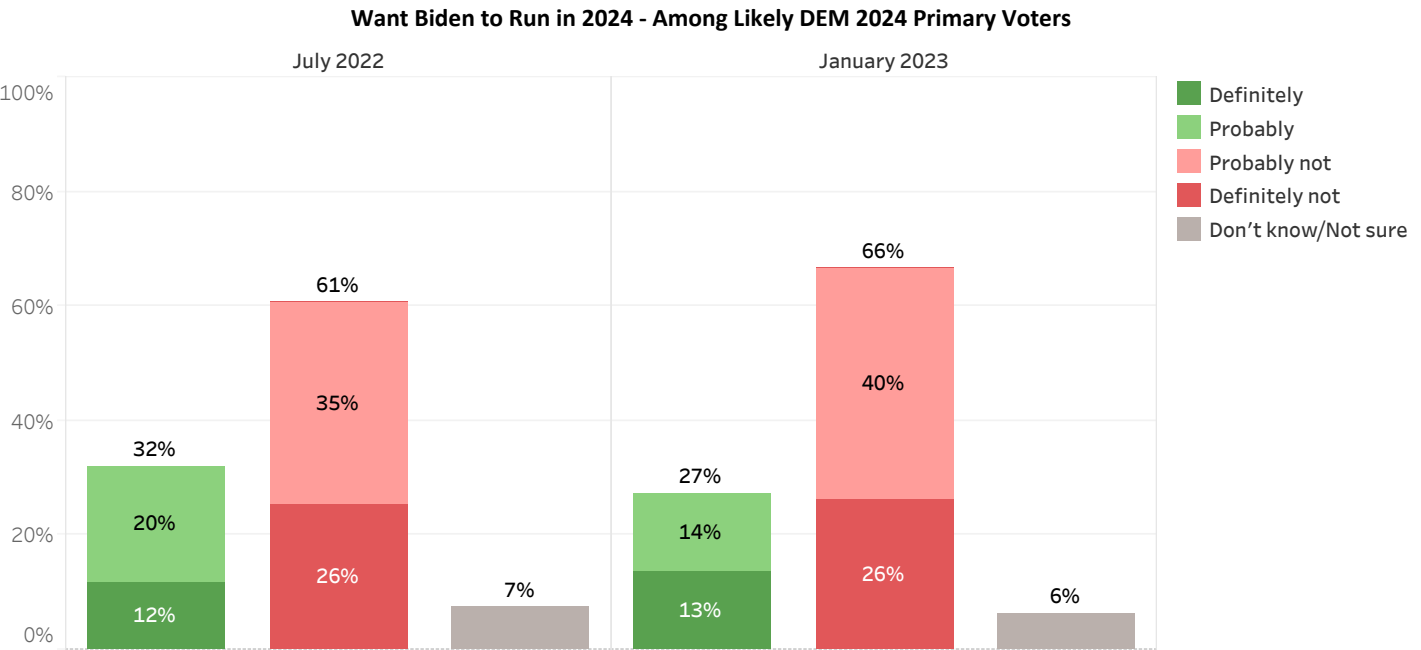
When asked for their second choice, 17% of likely Democratic primary voters support Harris, 14% support Ocasio-Cortez, 13% support Warren, and 12% support Buttigieg. Less than 10% support Sanders (9%), Newsom (8%), Klobuchar (6%), former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton (4%), Michigan Governor Gretchen Whitmer (4%), Biden (3%), or Warnock (2%). No other candidate was chosen by more than 1% of respondents, while 5% are unsure who would be their second choice.

Those whose first choice is Buttigieg most frequently mention Warren and Harris as their second choice, those whose first choice is Biden most frequently mention Newsom or Buttigieg as their second choice, Warren supporters most frequently mention Harris and Buttigieg as their second choice, and most Sanders supporters say that Ocasio-Cortez is their second choice.

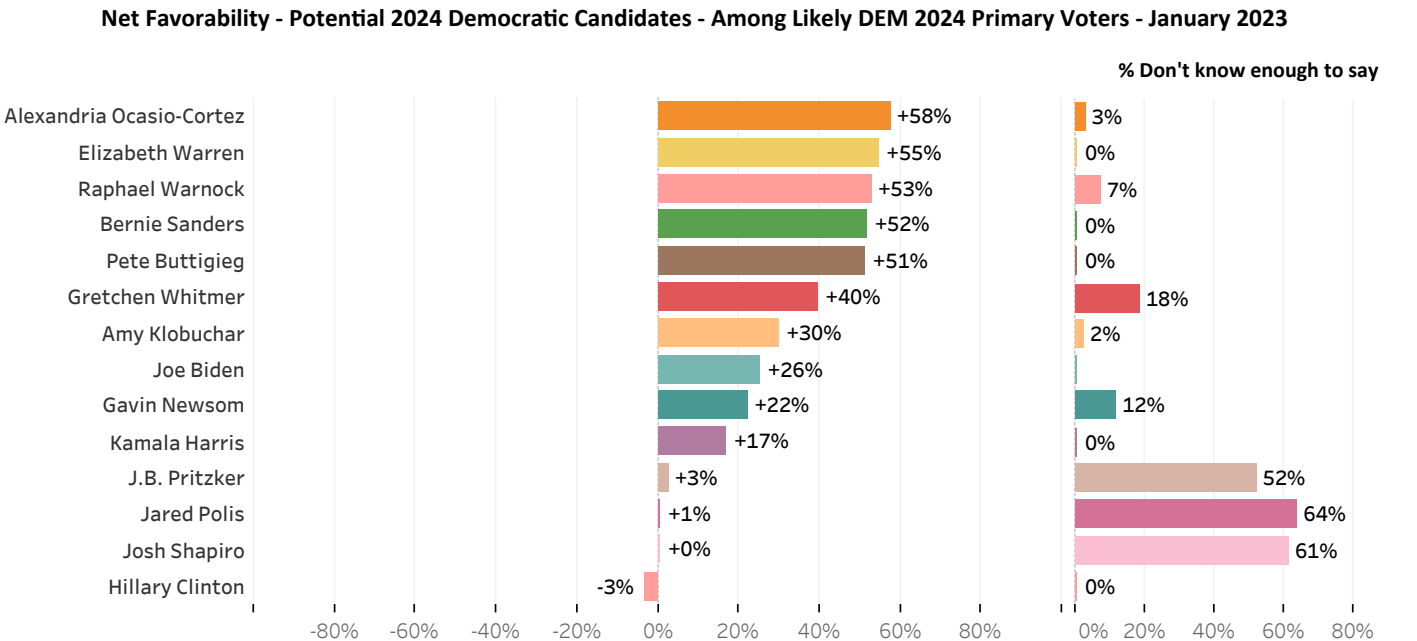
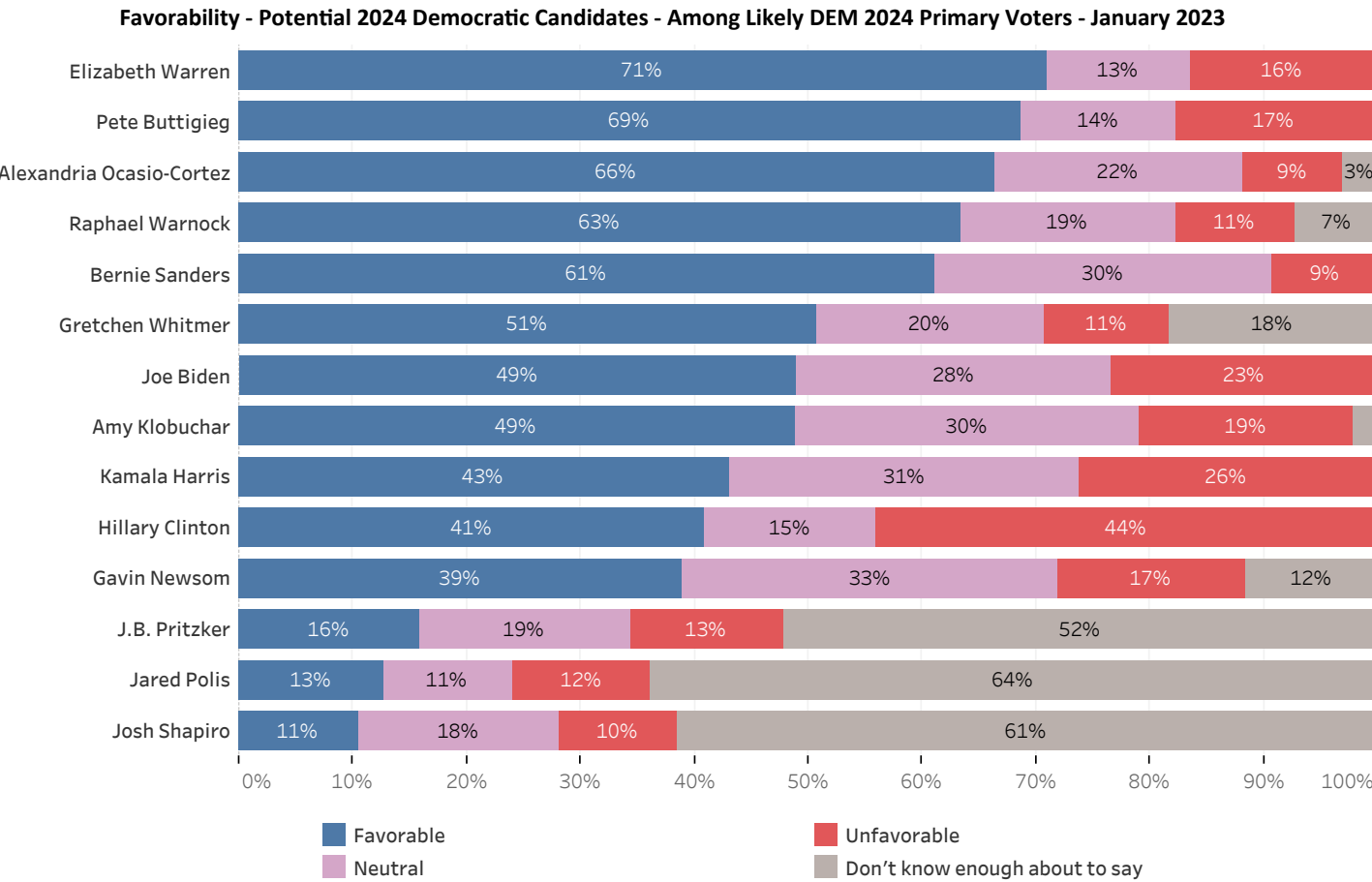


More troubling for President Biden is that two-thirds of New Hampshire Democrats don't want him to run for reelection. Only 27% of likely New Hampshire 2024 Democratic primary voters think Biden definitely (13%) or probably (14%) should run for President in 2024, 66% think he definitely (26%) or probably (40%) should not run, and 6% are unsure. In July 2022, 32% said Biden should definitely or probably run, while 61% said he definitely or probably should not. About four in ten self-described liberal (41%) and moderate (40%) likely Democratic primary voters think Biden should run, but only 22% of socialists and 17% of progressives agree.

Among all Granite Staters, only 18% think Biden definitely (10%) or probably (9%) should run for President again, while 75% think he definitely (55%) or probably (20%) should not.



Among likely 2024 Democratic New Hampshire presidential primary voters, Ocasio-Cortez is most popular: 66% have a favorable opinion of her, 22% have a neutral opinion of her, and only 9% have an unfavorable opinion of her, yielding a net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion) of +58. Warren (+55), Warnock (+53), Sanders (+52), and Buttigieg (+51) are similarly popular among likely Democratic primary voters, followed by Whitmer (+40), Klobuchar (+30), Biden (+26), Newsom (+22), and Harris (+17). Likely Democratic primary voters are largely neutral in their feelings towards Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker (+3), Colorado Governor Jared Polis (+1), Pennsylvania Governor Josh Shapiro (+0), and former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton (-3), with more than half saying that they don't know enough about Polis (64%), Shapiro (61%), and Pritzker (52%).



Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Eight hundred ninety-two (892) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between January 19 and January 23, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.3 percent. Included in the sample were 349 likely 2024 Republican Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 5.2 percent) and 346 likely 2024 Democratic Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 5.3 percent). These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the January 2023 Granite State Poll is 26%. The design effect for the survey is 3.0%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
