## GRANITE STATERS APPROVE OF SUNUNU'S PERFORMANCE AS GOVERNOR, MOST POPULAR STATEWIDE ELECTED OFFICIAL

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
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DURHAM, NH - As New Hampshire Governor Chris Sununu reportedly weighs whether to seek the Republican nomination for President, two-thirds of Granite Staters approve of his job performance. Sununu also enjoys higher favorability ratings than Democratic senators Jeanne Shaheen and Maggie Hassan.

#### **Gubernatorial Approval**

Entering his fourth term as governor, Chris Sununu remains a popular governor. Currently, 66% of New Hampshire residents approve of Governor Sununu's job performance, 30% disapprove, and 5% neither approve nor disapprove or don't know. Sununu's net approval rating (the percentage who approve minus the percentage who disapprove) is +36, up from only +13 in December.


Ninety percent of Republicans and 72% of Independents approve of Sununu's performance as governor. Sununu even has relatively high job performance ratings among Democrats, as 40% approve and 58% disapprove of his job as governor.


Sununu's net approval (+36) is comparable to former Governor John Lynch (+44) at the same point in his governorship.



#### Net Job Approval of NH Governor - By Months of Governorship

Respondents were asked why they feel that way about Governor Sununu's performance. Those who approve of Sununu's performance most often mention how they believe Sununu represents the people of the state (16%), exhibits strong leadership (13%), handled a specific issue well (11%), or is honest (10%). Those who disapprove of Sununu's performance most often mention how they believe Sununu handled a specific issue poorly (42%), how he doesn't represent the people of the state (12%), exhibits weak leadership (12%), or is too partisan (11%).


#### Why Feel That Way About Governor Sununu's Job Performance (coded) - By Approval of Sununu's Job Performance - February 2023



Disapprove

Just under half (49%) of Granite Staters have a favorable opinion of Sununu, 24% have a neutral opinion of him, and 26% have an unfavorable opinion of him. Sununu's net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion of him minus the percentage who have an unfavorable opinion) is +23, up from +8 in January but lower than in February of 2022 (+36).


Sununu is very popular among Republicans (+74) and is popular among Independents (+46) in the state but is unpopular among Democrats (-33).



**Favorability - Chris Sununu** 

Granite Staters are divided in their rating of U.S. Senator Jeanne Shaheen. Forty-one percent have a favorable opinion of Shaheen, 35% have an unfavorable opinion, and 23% are neutral. Shaheen's net favorability rating is +6, largely unchanged since January (+3) and from February 2022 (+4).


Shaheen is very popular among Democrats (+78) but is very unpopular among Republicans (-65), while Independents (+3) are divided about her.



#### Favorability - Jeanne Shaheen

Granite Staters are also divided in their rating of Maggie Hassan. Forty percent have a favorable opinion of her, 38% have an unfavorable opinion of her, 17% are neutral, and 5% don't know enough about her to say. Hassan's net favorability rating is +2, up from -8 in January but largely unchanged since February 2022 (-1).

Hassan is very popular among Democrats (+78) but is very unpopular among Republicans (-70), while Independents (-9) are divided on her.

#### **Granite State Poll Methodology**

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Eight hundred sixty-three (863) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between February 16 and February 20, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.3 percent. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the February 2023 Granite State Poll is 24%. The design effect for the survey is 3.3%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,000 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
