MAINERS OPEN TO PROPOSED TIKTOK BAN, WANT MORE REGULATION OF SPEECH ON SOCIAL MEDIA

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
DURHAM, NH - Six in ten Maine residents believe the social media platform TikTok poses a high or moderate threat to national security and a slim majority support a ban on the platform. A plurality of Mainers believe social media companies should regulate more content on their platforms. A plurality also believe social media companies in general are biased against the political right. A majority disapprove of how Joe Biden has handled his job as president but six in ten approve of Janet Mills' performance as governor.

TikTok

TikTok is a popular social media platform, especially among young people in the U.S. But recently, increased tensions with China have raised concerns in the U.S. and in other countries about the data TikTok may be providing to the Chinese government. Fifteen percent of Maine residents say that they are current users of TikTok, while 16% say they used it in the past but no longer do and 69% say they have never used the platform. About one-fifth of those aged 18 to 34 (21%) and those aged 35 to 49 (20%) say that they currently use the platform, while 17% of those aged 50 to 64 and only 3% of those aged 65 and older say they currently use it.

The U.S. House of Representatives is considering several bills to regulate TikTok, including a possible ban on the platform in the United States, with some calling the platform a security risk given its ownership by a Chinese corporation. Just over half (51%) of Mainers strongly (31%) or somewhat (20%) support banning TikTok, 28% strongly (13%) or somewhat (15%) oppose banning TikTok, 15% are neutral, and 7% are unsure. A majority of Republicans (68%) and half of Independents (50%) support banning TikTok while Democrats are divided with 36% in support of banning the platform and 40% opposed. Only 9% of current users of TikTok support banning it while 52% oppose banning it.


Support or Oppose Ban on TikTok - By Party ID


Overall, 31% of Mainers think TikTok poses a high risk to the country's national security, another 31% think it poses a moderate risk, 11% think it poses a low risk, 5% think it poses no risk, and 22% are unsure. Among those who are current users of TikTok, 42% think that TikTok poses a high or moderate risk to national security. Nearly two-thirds (63%) of past users and two-thirds (67%) of those who have never used the platform believe it poses a high or moderate risk to national security.

Threat of TikTok to National Security - By Use of TikTok




During recent elections, there have been concerns raised about whether social media platforms are biased in how they block the posting of controversial political information. One in five (21%) Maine residents believe that social media companies are biased against the political left, 39% think social media companies are biased against the political right, 29% think they are not biased toward either side, and 11% are unsure. Nearly two-thirds of Democrats (65%) think that social media companies are not biased towards either side or are unsure. By contrast, three-quarters (76%) of Republicans believe that social media companies are biased against the political right.

Elon Musk, who purchased Twitter in 2022, has called for posts on Twitter to be less heavily regulated for potential misinformation than before his purchase of the company. Others argue that Twitter and other social media companies need to more heavily regulate what is said on their platforms to slow the spread of hateful speech and misinformation.


A plurality (42%) of Maine residents believe social media companies should regulate content more, 15% think they should regulate it about the same as they do now, one-third (33%) believe they should regulate it less, and 10% are unsure. More than two-thirds (68%) of Democrats and a plurality of Independents (49%) believe social media companies should regulate speech on their platforms more while nearly three-quarters of Republicans (72%) think they should regulate content less.

Few Maine residents hold positive views of several prominent public figures in the technology industry: 27% have a favorable opinion of Twitter, Tesla, and SpaceX CEO Elon Musk, 17% have a neutral opinion of him, and 54% have an unfavorable opinion of him, yielding a net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion) of -27. State residents are also somewhat negative in their opinion of former Microsoft CEO Bill Gates (-22) and a plurality (46%) don't know enough to have an opinion about Apple CEO Tim Cook. Mainers have strongly negative views of Amazon CEO Jeff Bezos (-50) and Meta CEO Mark Zuckerberg (-72).

Musk is a particularly divisive figure in Maine, as he enjoys a +47 net favorability among Republicans in the state but it is -89 among Democrats and -27 among Independents. Gates is also divisive, with a +17 net favorability among Democrats but -13 among Independents and -72 among Republicans. By contrast, all three groups have a clearly negative view of Bezos and Zuckerberg.




Favorability - Technology Industry Figures - April 2023

Presidential Approval

A majority (53%) of Maine residents disapprove of President Joe Biden's handling of his job as president, 47% approve, and 1% are unsure. Biden's net approval rating among Mainers is -6, down from +2 in March.

Eighty-four percent of Democrats approve of Biden's performance as president but only 40% of Independents and 2% of Republicans approve.




Respondents were asked what one word they would use to describe President Biden. Those who approve of Biden's performance as president most often mention the words "old," "empathetic," "average," experienced," and "honest," while those who disapprove of Biden's performance most often mention "incompetent," "idiot," "useless," "old," and "inept."

Gubernatorial Approval

Governor Janet Mills continues to be a popular governor among Maine residents. Currently, 60% of Maine residents approve of Governor Mills' job performance, 37% disapprove, and 4% neither approve nor disapprove or don't know. Mills' net approval rating (the percentage who approve minus the percentage who disapprove) is +23, up from +18 in February.

Ninety-seven percent of Democrats and 52% of Independents approve of Mills' performance as governor, but only 17% of Republicans approve.



Respondents were asked what one word they would use to describe Governor Mills. Those who approve of Mills' performance as governor most often mention the words "strong," "competent," "fair," "honest," and "caring," while those who disapprove of Mills' performance most often mention "liberal," "fake," "puppet," "evil," and "useless."

Pine Tree State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Pine Tree State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Seven hundred and fifty (750) Pine Tree State Panel members completed the survey online between April 13 and April 17, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.6 percent. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the April 2023 Pine Tree State Poll is 29%. The design effect for the survey is 2.4%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the ME Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Maine.

The Pine Tree State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of Maine residents. Approximately 2,250 Maine adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
