## TRUMP MAINTAINS LEAD OVER DESANTIS IN NEW HAMPSHIRE GOP 2024 RACE

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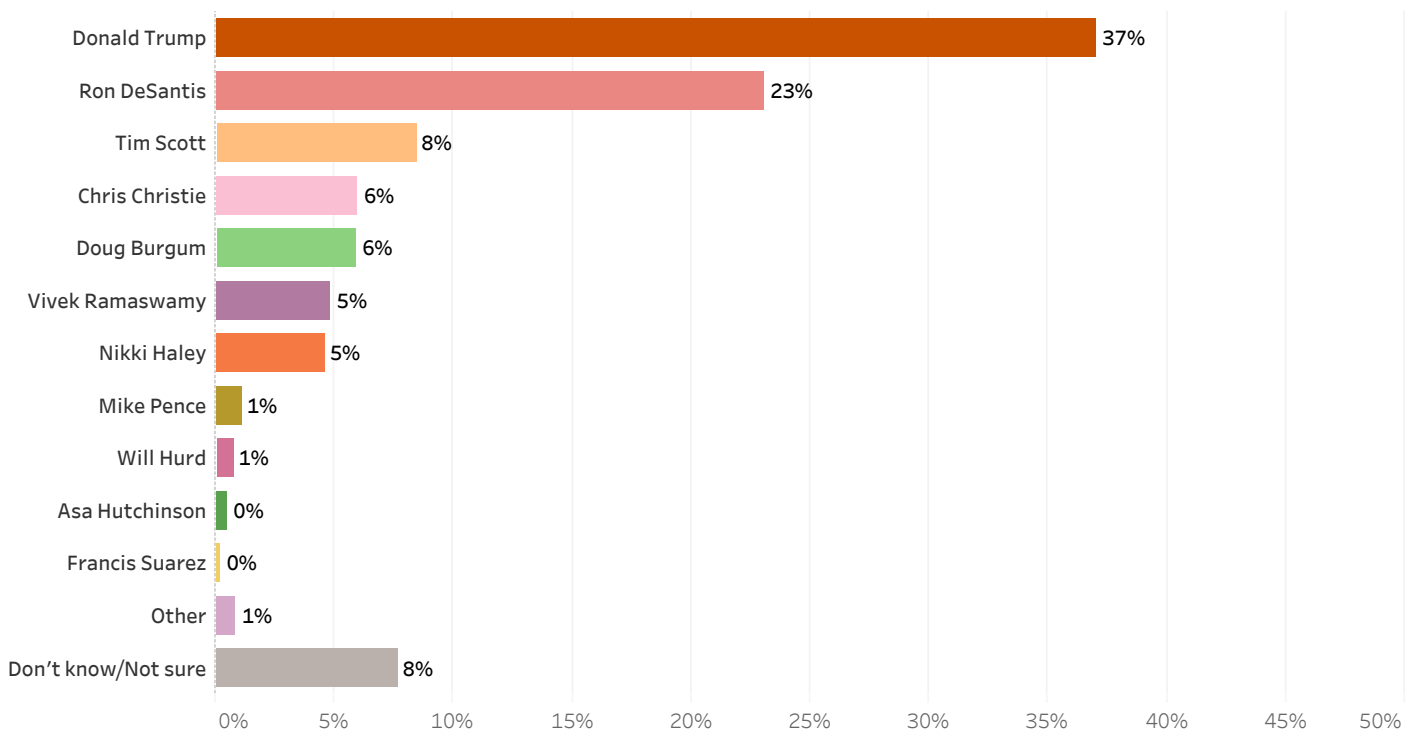
DURHAM, NH - Former President Donald Trump continues to lead his GOP rivals in the New Hampshire 2024 Republican presidential primary. Florida Governor Ron DeSantis is his closest rival but trails Trump by double digits. Trump supporters are far more likely than DeSantis voters to say they have made up their mind. South Carolina Senator Tim Scott is the most personally well-liked candidate while former New Jersey Governor Chris Christie is very unpopular and is most likely to be mentioned by likely primary voters as the candidate they would not vote for under any circumstances.

### 2024 Republican Presidential Primary

The official date for the 2024 New Hampshire presidential primary election has not been set, but it will likely be in January of 2024. Six months before the election, former President Donald Trump continues to lead among likely Republican primary voters. Thirty-seven percent of likely primary voters support Trump, followed by Ron DeSantis (23%). Other Republicans are in single digits - Scott (8%), Christie (6%), North Dakota Governor Doug Burgum (6%), entrepreneur Vivek Ramaswamy (5%), and former UN Ambassador Nikki Haley (5%) are at 5% or higher. Very few support former Vice President Mike Pence (1%), former Texas Congressman Will Hurd (1%), Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson (<1%), or Miami Mayor Francis Suarez (<1%). One percent support another candidate while 8% are unsure whom they would support. Talk show host Larry Elder and businessman Perry Johnson are not supported by any likely Republican primary voters.

A majority (52%) of self-described conservatives and a plurality of libertarians (39%) support Trump, but moderates are split, with 26% supporting DeSantis, 16% supporting Scott, 15% supporting Christie, 11% supporting Trump, and 10% supporting Burgum.

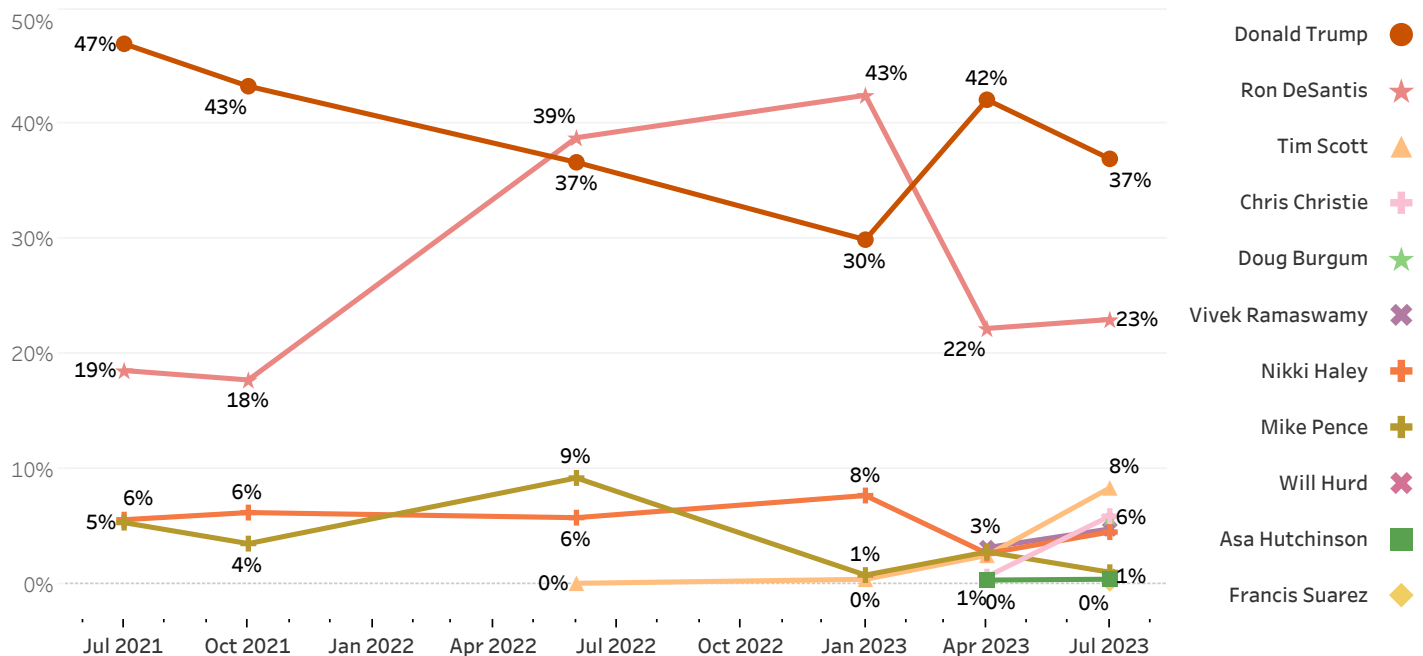
**First Choice GOP 2024 Presidential Candidate - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - July 2023**

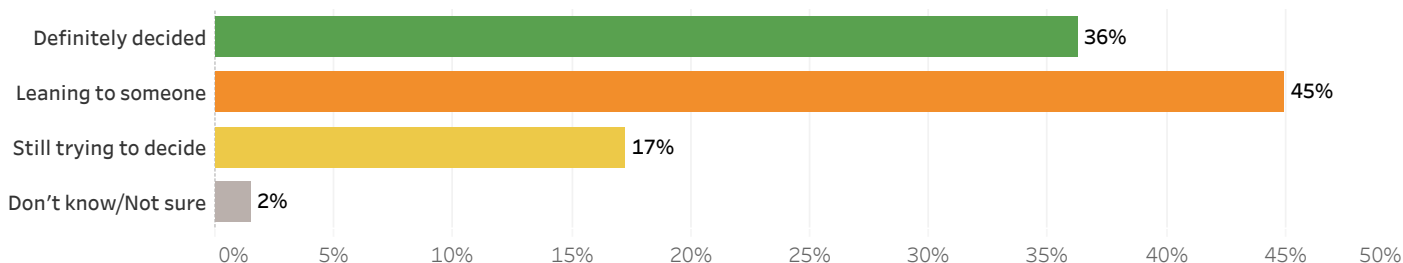
Since April, support for Trump has declined slightly (-5 percentage points) and matches his level of support in June 2022 while support for DeSantis is unchanged. Support for Scott (+6) and Christie (+5) has increased slightly since April.

**First Choice GOP 2024 Presidential Candidate - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters**



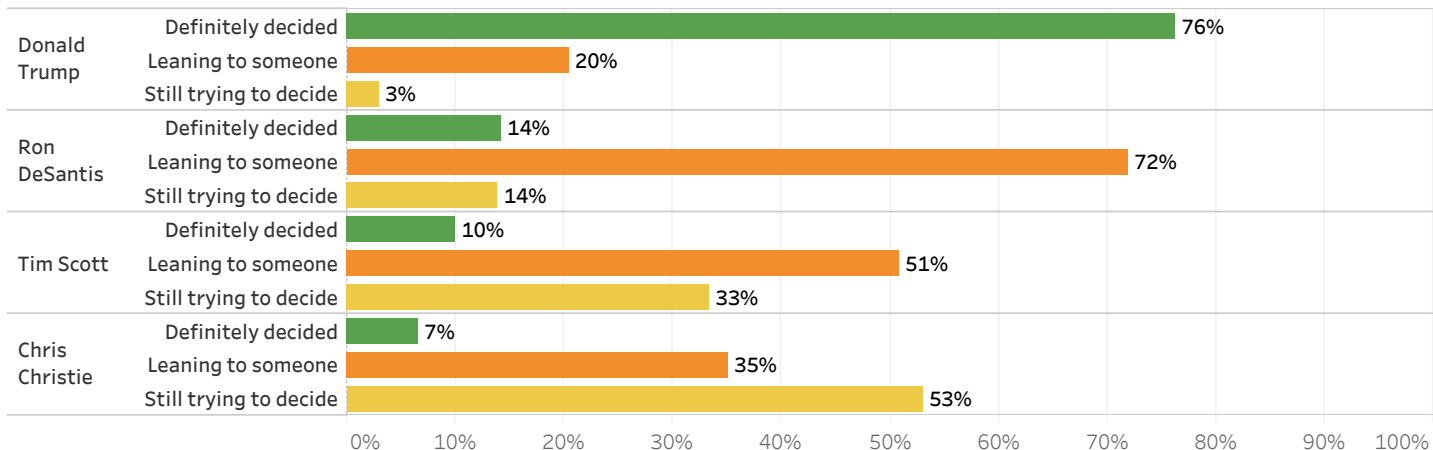
Despite Trump's lead, only 36% of likely 2024 Republican primary voters say that they have definitely decided who they will vote for, 45% say they are leaning toward someone, and 17% are still trying to decide.

However, more than three-quarters (76%) of Trump supporters say they have definitely decided, far higher than his closest current rivals DeSantis (14%), Scott (10%), and Christie (7%).

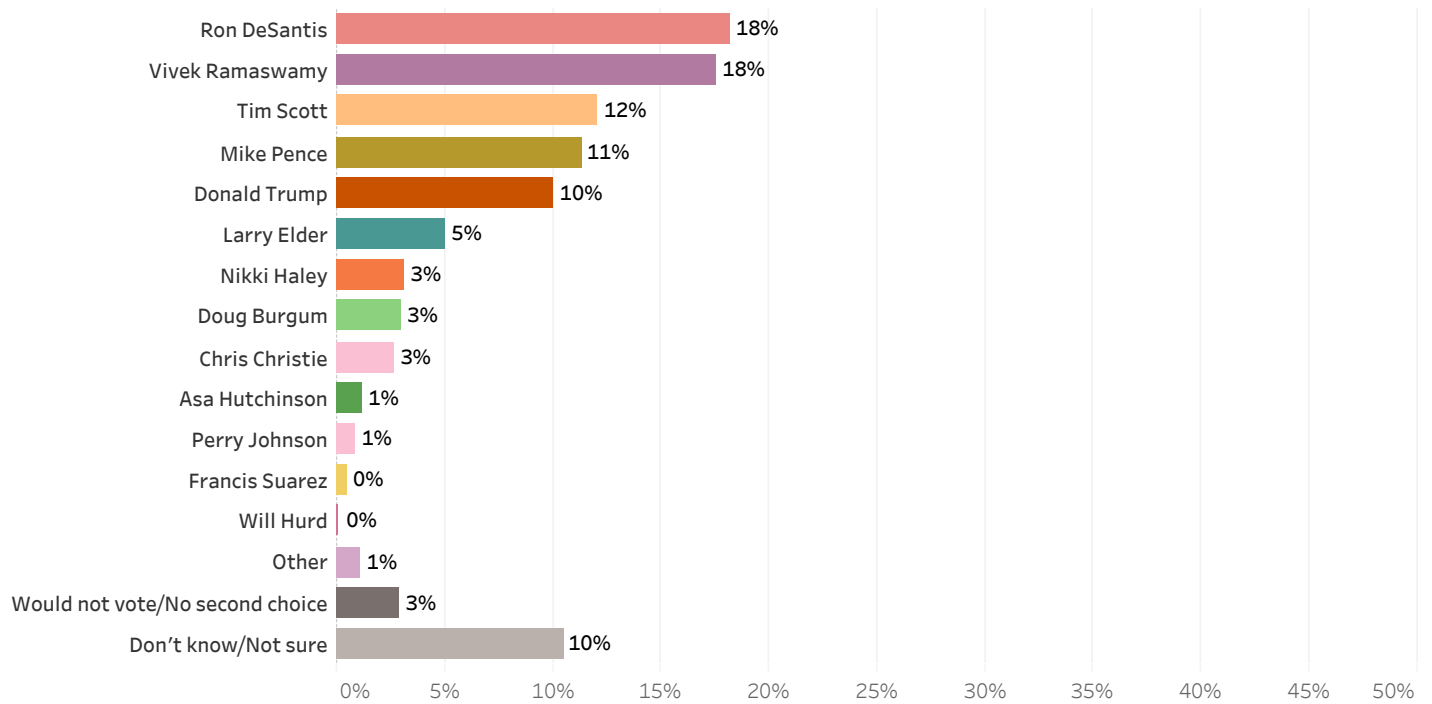

When asked which candidate is their second choice, 18% of likely New Hampshire Republican primary voters choose DeSantis, followed by Ramaswamy (18%), Scott (12%), Pence (11%), and Trump (10%). Five percent or less each say their second choice would be Elder (5%), Haley (3%), Burgum (3%), Christie (3%), Hutchinson (1%), Johnson (1%), Suarez (<1%), or Hurd (<1%).

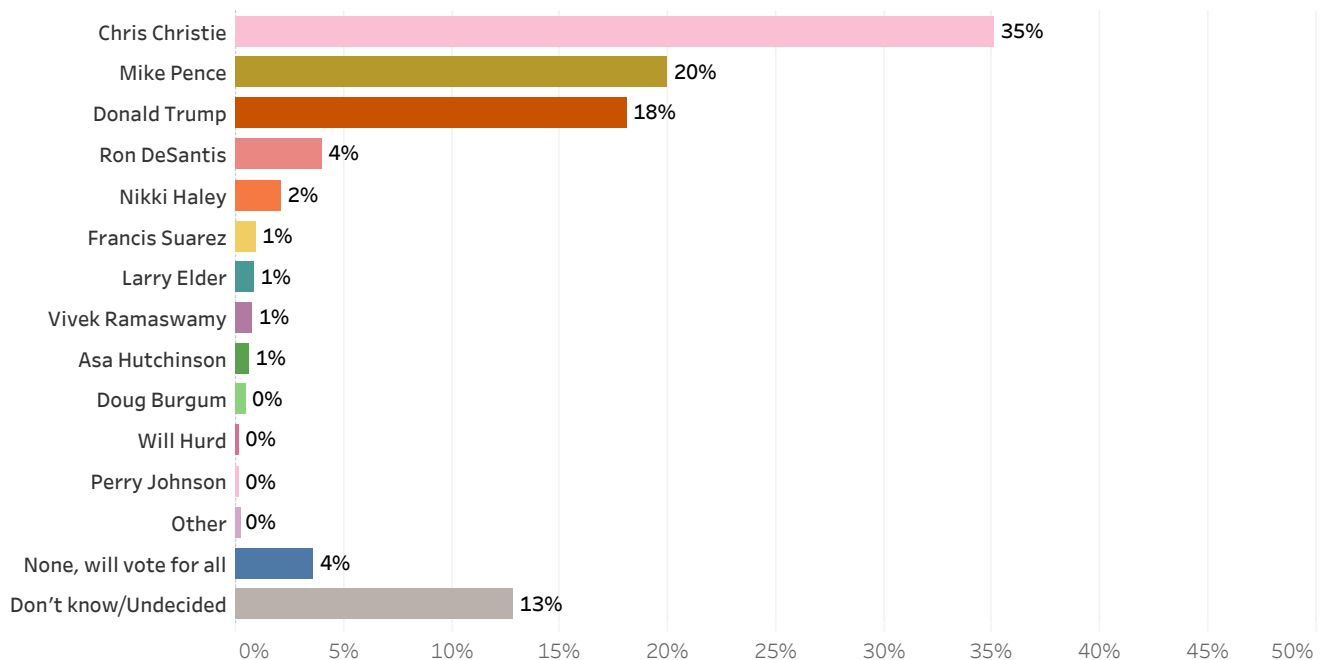
Among those who support Trump, 37% say DeSantis is their second choice, 17% choose Ramaswamy, and 16% choose Pence. Among DeSantis supporters, 30% say that Ramaswamy is their second choice, while 20% each say that Trump or Scott is their second choice.

When asked which candidate they would not vote for under any circumstances, 35% name Christie, followed by Pence (20%), and Trump (18%). Far fewer likely Republican primary voters mention DeSantis (4%), Haley (2%), Suarez (1%), Elder (1%), Ramaswamy (1%), Hutchinson (1%), Burgum (<1%), Hurd (<1%), or Johnson (<1%) while 4% say they will vote for all of them. Only 9% of DeSantis voters say they would not vote for Trump under any circumstances while only 3% of Trump voters say they would not vote for DeSantis under any circumstances.

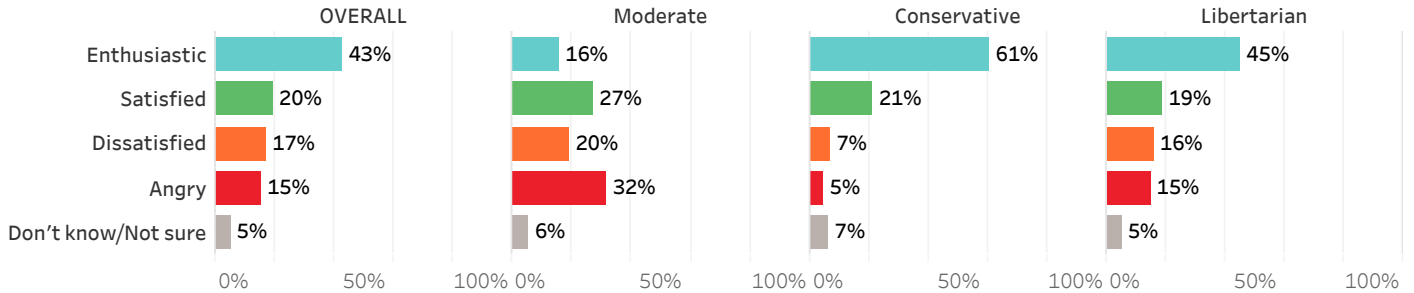
### 2024 GOP Presidential Candidate Would Not Vote for Under Any Circumstances - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - July 2023



### Feelings About Republican Candidates

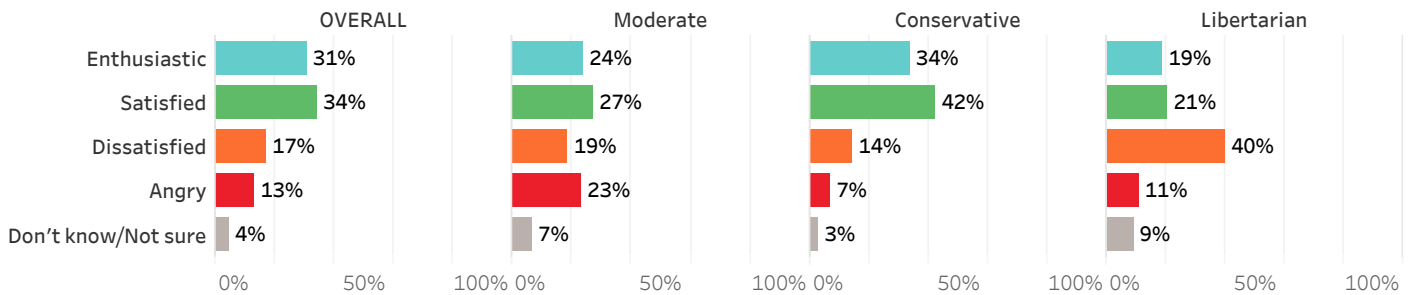
Forty-three percent of likely 2024 New Hampshire Republican primary voters say they would be enthusiastic if Trump were the 2024 Republican presidential nominee, 20% would be satisfied, 17% would be dissatisfied, 15% would be angry, and 5% are unsure how they would feel. A majority (52%) of moderates would be dissatisfied or angry, while 82% of conservatives and 64% of libertarians would be enthusiastic or satisfied if this were to happen.

Thirty-one percent of likely 2024 New Hampshire Republican primary voters say they would be enthusiastic if DeSantis were the 2024 Republican presidential nominee, 34% would be satisfied, 17% would be dissatisfied, 13% would be angry, and 4% are unsure how they would feel. Three-quarters (76%) of conservatives say they would be enthusiastic or satisfied if DeSantis were the nominee, but 51% of moderates and only 40% of libertarians would be enthusiastic or satisfied if this were to happen.

Respondents were asked what one word they would use to describe Trump and DeSantis. Respondents most often use the words "patriot," "leader," "competent," "fantastic," "great," and "narcissist" to describe Trump, while they most often use the words "strong," "leader," "awesome," "RINO," and "good" to describe DeSantis.

One Word to Describe Trump & DeSantis - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - July 2023

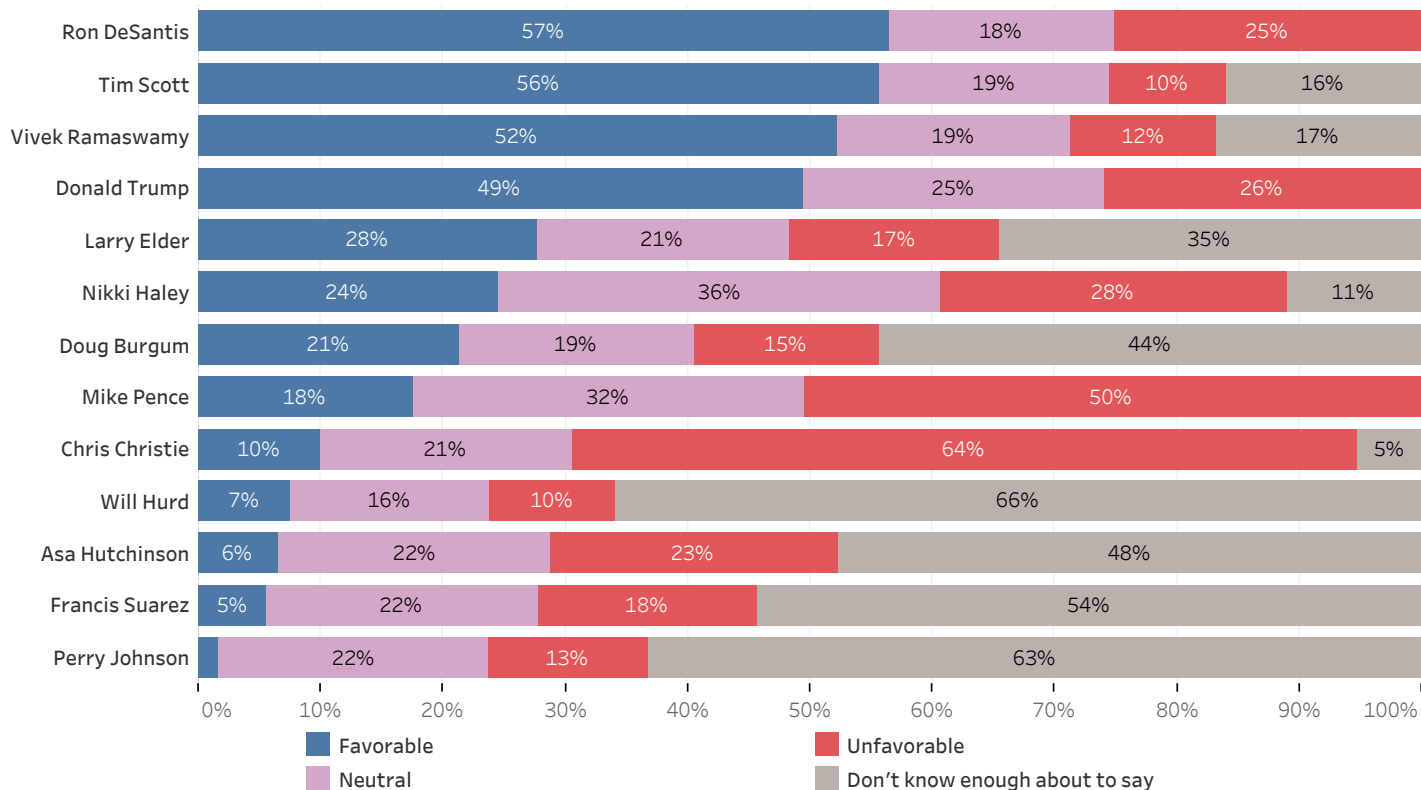


### Awareness of GOP Candidates

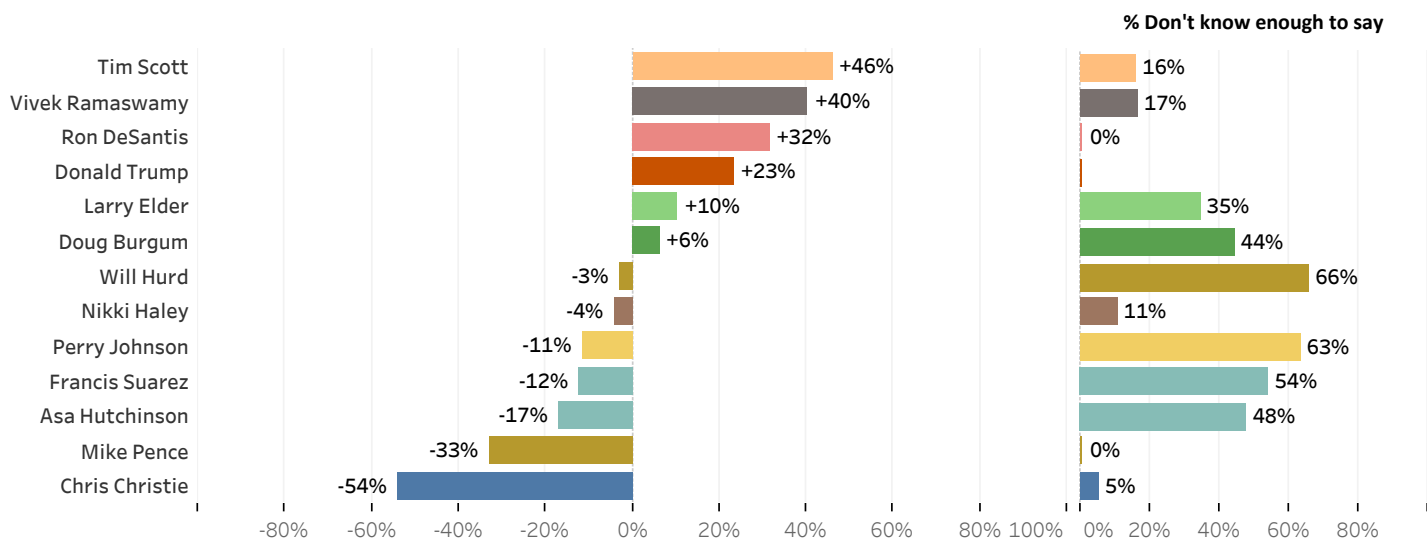
Among likely 2024 Republican New Hampshire presidential primary voters, Scott is the most popular candidate: 56% of likely Republican primary voters have a favorable opinion of Scott, only 10% have an unfavorable opinion of him, 19% are neutral, and 16% don't know enough about him to say. Scott's net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion) is +46. Ramaswamy (+40) has the next highest net favorability among likely Republican primary voters, followed by DeSantis (+32), Trump (+23), and Elder (+10). Likely Republican primary voters are largely neutral on Burgum (+6), Hurd (-3), and Haley (-4), while likely GOP primary voters are slightly negative in their feelings towards Johnson (-11), Suarez (-12), and Hutchinson (-17), while Pence (-33) and Christie (-54) are generally unpopular among likely GOP primary voters.

Many likely GOP primary voters don't know enough to say about Hurd (66%), Johnson (63%), Suarez (54%), Hutchinson (48%), Burgum (44%), and Elder (35%).

**Favorability - Potential 2024 Republican Candidates - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - July 2023**

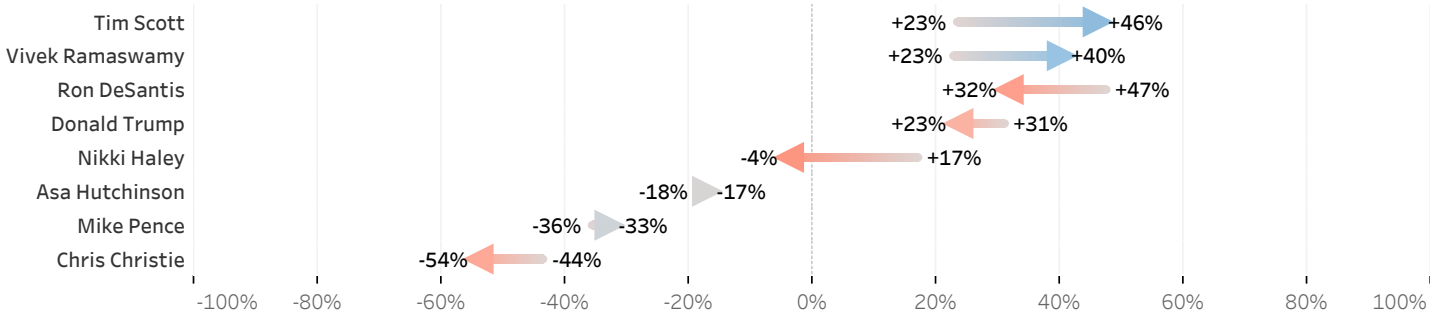


**Net Favorability - Potential 2024 Republican Candidates - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - July 2023**



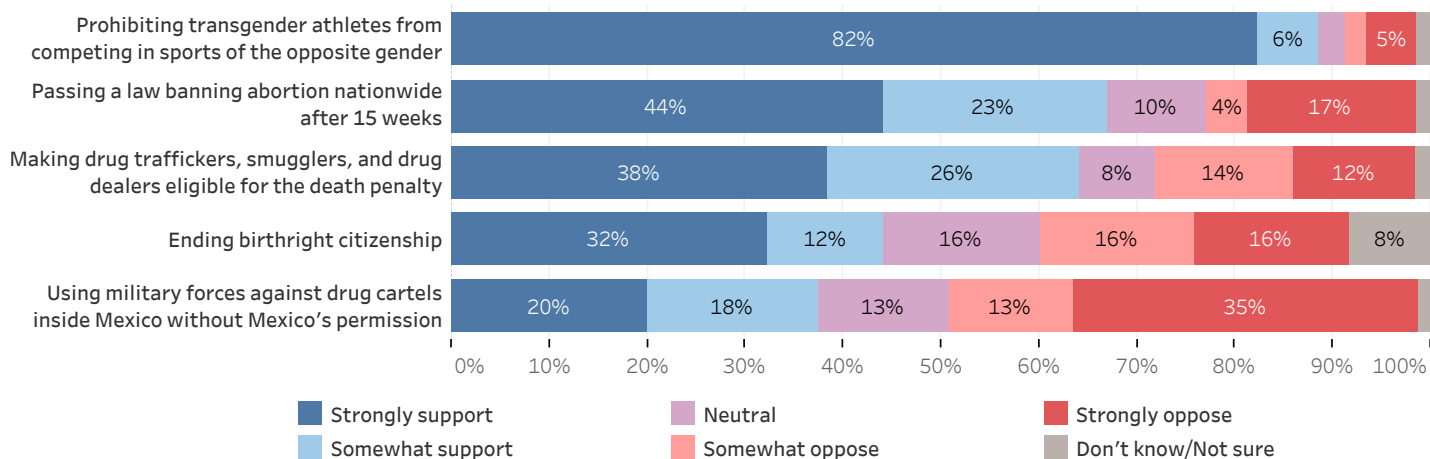
Scott's net favorability among likely 2024 GOP primary voters has increased (+23 percentage points) since April, while Ramaswamy (+17) has experienced a similar increase in favorability. By contrast, Haley (-21), DeSantis (-15), and Christie (-10) have all seen double-digit declines since April in their net favorability among likely Republican primary voters.

### Net Favorability - Potential 2024 Republican Candidates - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - Change from April to July 2023



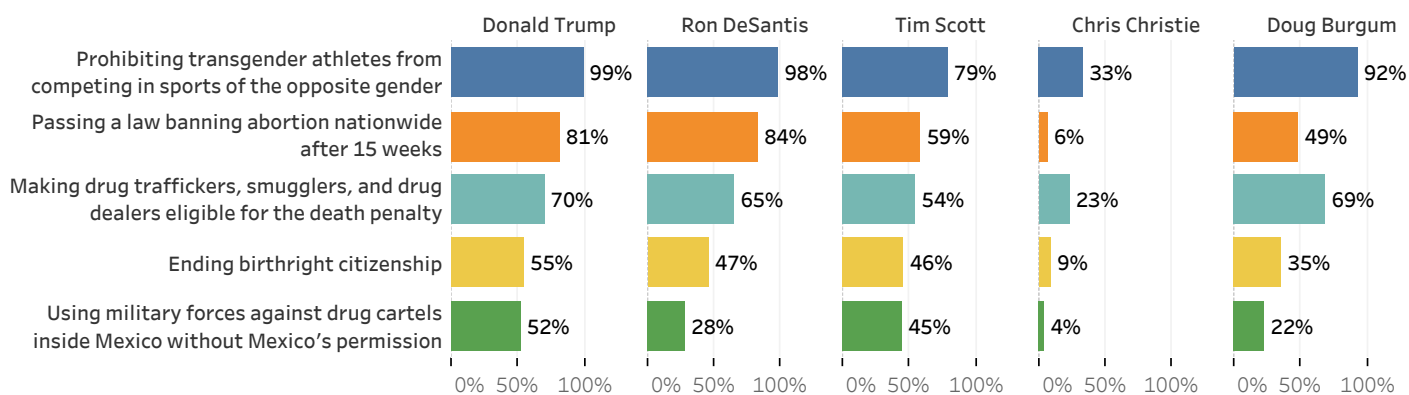
Likely 2024 Republican primary voters were asked whether they support or oppose several policies which have been proposed by one or more Republican presidential candidates. Most likely Republican primary voters (87%) strongly (82%) or somewhat (6%) support prohibiting transgender athletes from competing in sports of the opposite gender, while only 7% somewhat (2%) or strongly (5%) oppose this policy and 1% are unsure about it. Two-thirds support passing a law banning abortion nationwide after 15 weeks (67%) and making drug traffickers, smugglers, and drug dealers eligible for the death penalty (64%) while less than half support ending birthright citizenship (44%) or using military forces against drug cartels inside Mexico without Mexico's permission (37%).

### Support or Oppose Policies Proposed by Some 2024 GOP Presidential Candidates - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - July 2023



Majorities of Trump voters support each of these policies, while less than half of DeSantis and Scott voters support ending birthright citizenship or using military force against drug cartels in Mexico without permission. Less than half of Burgum supporters support these two policies and only about half support banning abortion nationwide after 15 weeks, while few Christie supporters support any of these five policies.

## Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Two thousand and twenty-eight (2,028) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between July 13 and July 17, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.2 percent. Included in the sample were 898 likely 2024 Republican Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 3.3 percent). These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the July 2023 Granite State Poll is 25%. The design effect for the survey is 2.8%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 8,000 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
