NEW HAMPSHIRE DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY VOTERS UNENTHUSIASTIC BUT BACK BIDEN

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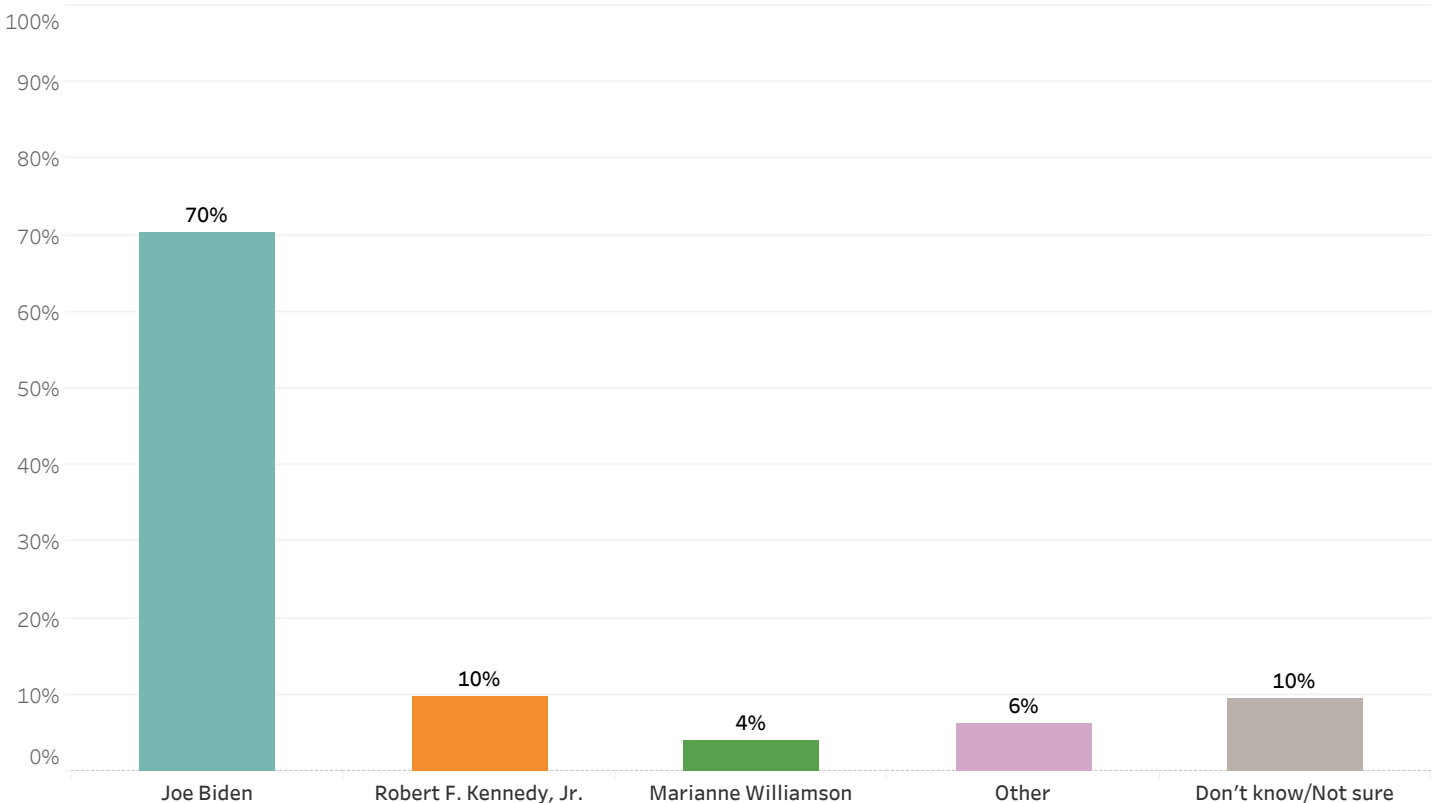
DURHAM, NH - Seven in ten likely 2024 New Hampshire Democratic presidential primary voters currently back President Joe Biden. Half of Biden supporters are not enthusiastic if Biden is the 2024 Democratic nominee, but most supporters plan to vote for Biden even if he does not appear on the ballot. There is little interest in challengers Robert F. Kennedy Jr. or Marianne Williamson, both of whom are unpopular among likely Democratic primary voters and few Biden supporters even consider either Kennedy or Williamson to be their second choice.

2024 Democratic Presidential Primary

Amid continued uncertainty about whether the 2024 New Hampshire Democratic Primary will be recognized by the Democratic National Committee (DNC) and whether President Biden's name will even appear on the ballot, Biden remains the clear frontrunner in the contest. Seventy percent of likely Democratic primary voters support Biden, 10% support environmental lawyer Robert F. Kennedy Jr., 4% support author Marianne Williamson, 6% support another candidate, and 10% are unsure whom they would support. Support for Kennedy is highest among self-described moderates and those who identify as an Independent or Republican, while Williamson's support is highest among self-described socialists.

To compare to the last incumbent President running in their party's primary, in April of 2019, 63% of likely 2020 Republican primary voters said that they planned to vote for then President Donald Trump as the Republican nominee.

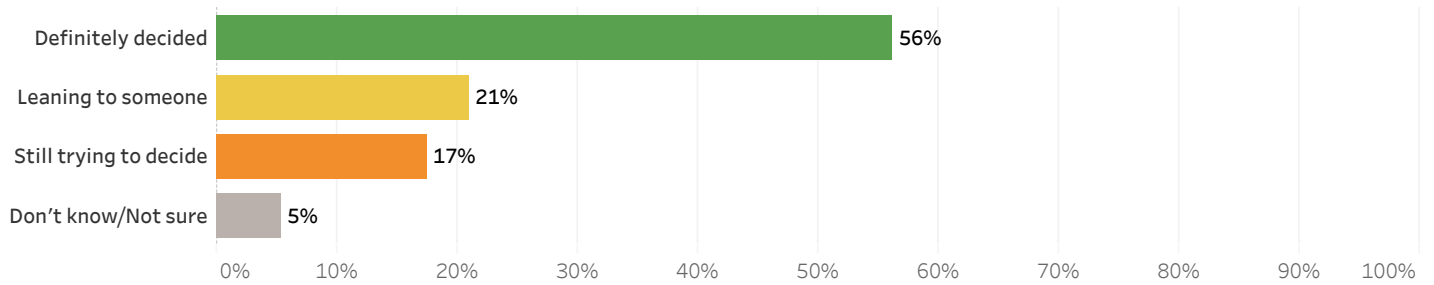
First Choice DEM 2024 Presidential Candidate - Among Likely DEM Primary Voters - July 2023

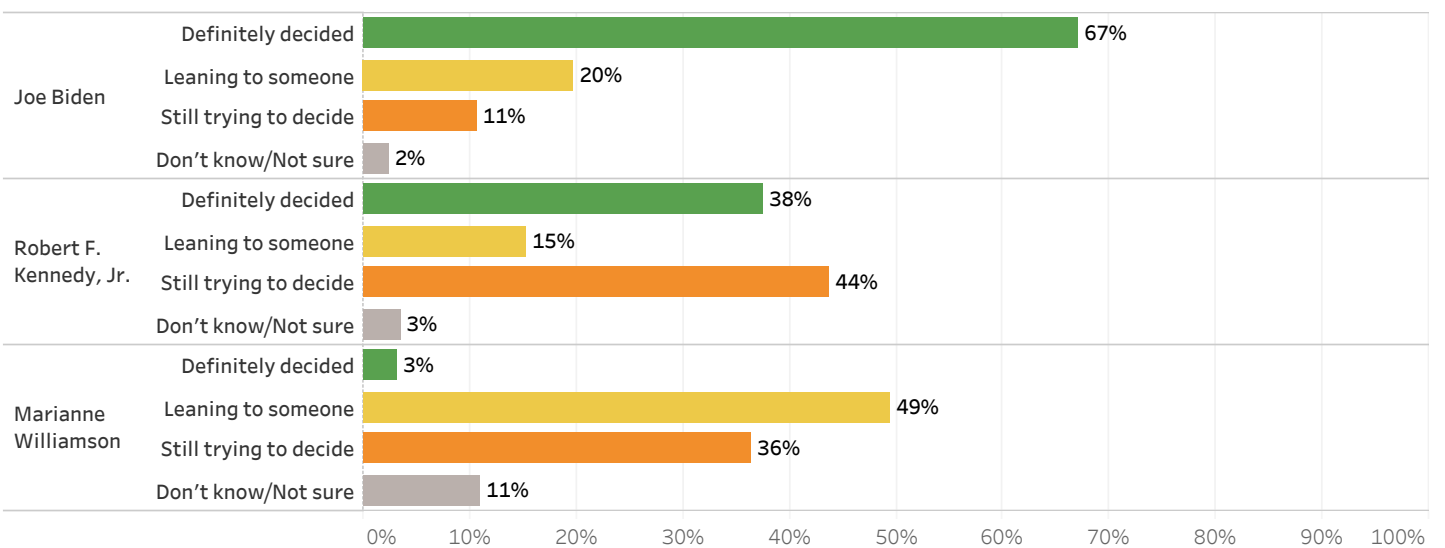
More than half (56%) of likely 2024 Democratic primary voters say they have definitely decided who they will vote for, while 21% say they are leaning toward someone and 17% are still trying to decide.

Definitely Decided on 2024 DEM Presidential Nominee Choice - July 2023



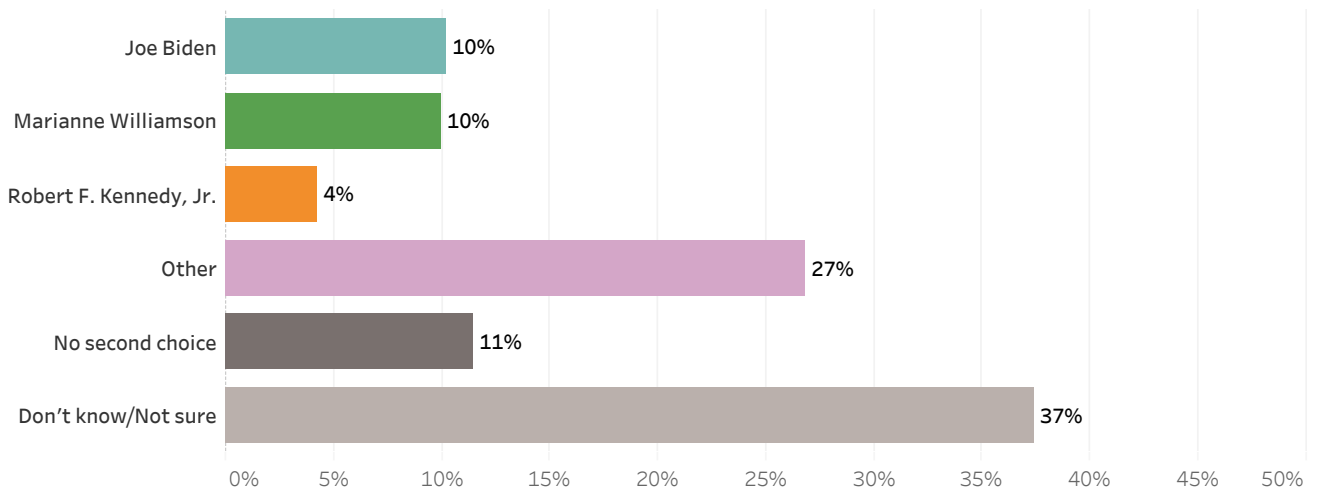
Two-thirds of Biden (67%) supporters say that they have definitely decided but only 38% of Kennedy supporters and 3% of Williamson supporters say the same.

Definitely Decided on 2024 DEM Presidential Nominee Choice - By Preferred 2024 DEM Primary Candidate - July 2023



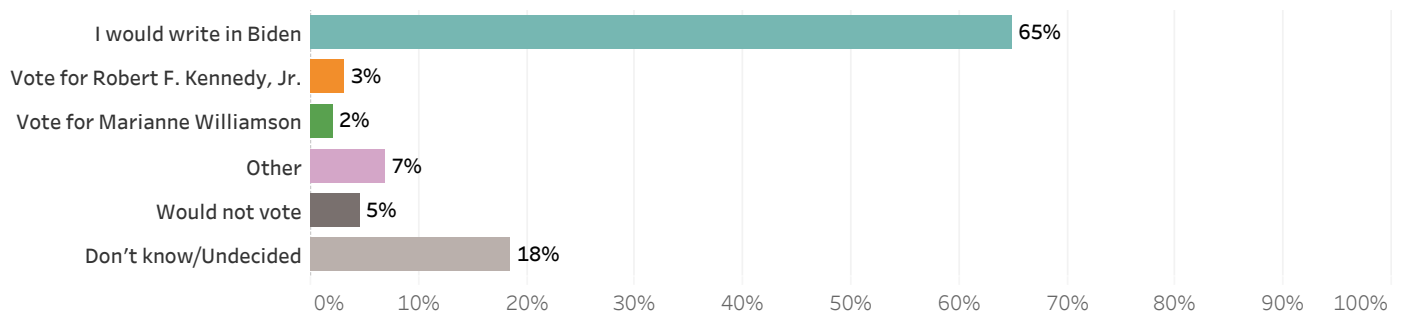
When asked which potential candidate is their second choice, 10% of likely New Hampshire Democratic primary voters choose Biden, 10% choose Williamson, 4% select Kennedy, 27% mention someone else, 11% say they have no second choice, and 37% are unsure. Among Biden supporters, 11% say Williamson is their second choice, 9% say they have no second choice, 33% mention someone else, and 42% are unsure. More than half (56%) of Williamson supporters say that Biden is their second choice while a plurality (35%) of Kennedy supporters say they have no second choice.

Biden supporters (N=520) were asked what they would do if Biden's name did not appear on the 2024 Democratic Presidential Primary ballot. Nearly two-thirds (65%) say that they would write in Biden, 3% would vote for Kennedy, 2% would vote for Williamson, 7% would vote for someone else, 5% would not vote, and 18% are unsure what they would do.

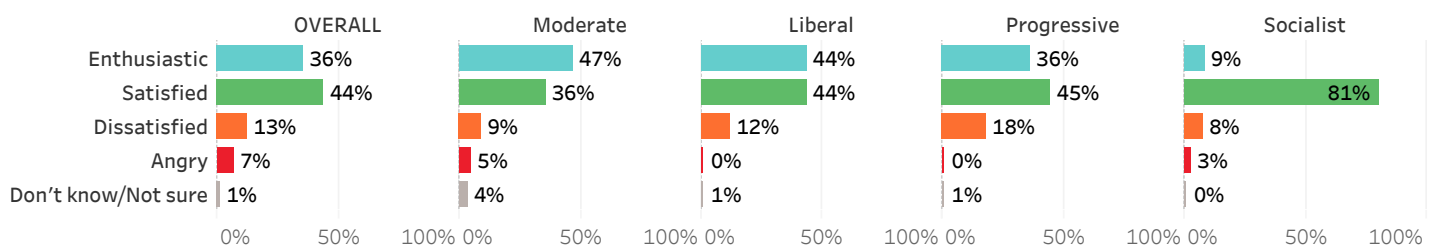
Decision on DEM 2024 Presidential Candidate if Biden Not on the Ballot - Among Biden Primary Supporters - July 2023



Feelings About Democratic Candidates

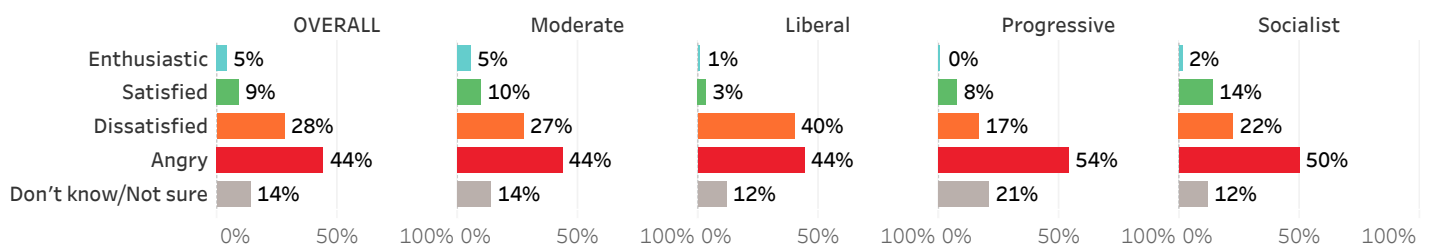
Despite strong support from Democrats, there is little enthusiasm for Biden. Only 36% of likely 2024 New Hampshire Democratic primary voters say they would be enthusiastic if Biden were the 2024 Democratic presidential nominee, 44% would be satisfied, 13% would be dissatisfied, and 7% would be angry. Moderates and liberals are most likely to say they would be enthusiastic but only 9% of socialists say they would be enthusiastic.

Feelings if 2024 DEM Presidential Nominee is Biden - Among Likely DEM Primary Voters - By Ideology - July 2023



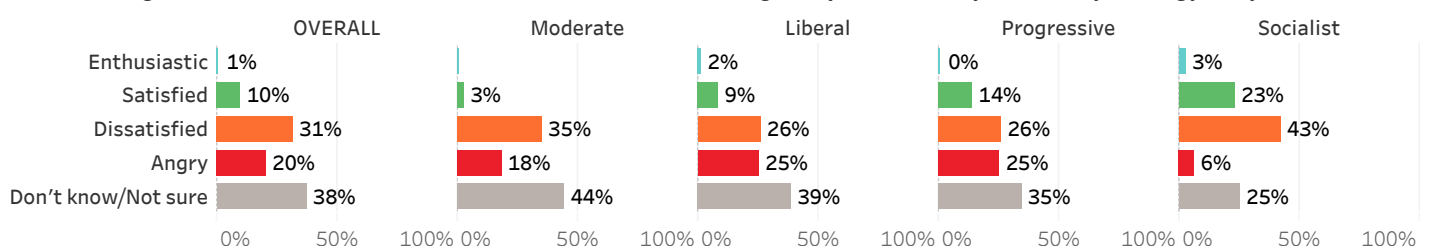
Only 5% of likely 2024 New Hampshire Democratic primary voters say they would be enthusiastic if Kennedy were the 2024 Democratic presidential nominee, 9% would be satisfied, 28% would be dissatisfied, and 44% would be angry. Most Democratic primary voters of all ideologies say they would be angry or dissatisfied with this outcome.

Feelings if 2024 DEM Presidential Nominee is Kennedy - Among Likely DEM Primary Voters - By Ideology - July 2023



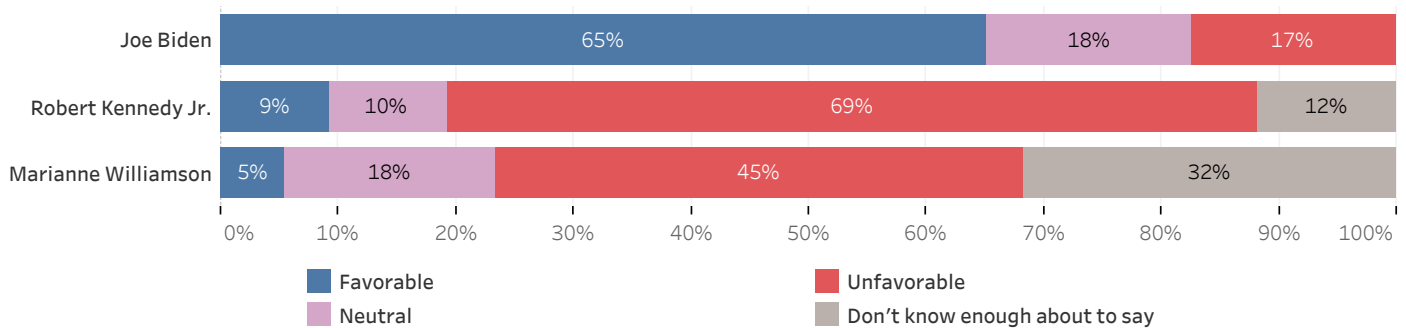
Only 1% of likely 2024 New Hampshire Democratic primary voters say they would be enthusiastic if Williamson were the 2024 Democratic presidential nominee, 10% would be satisfied, 31% would be dissatisfied, 20% would be angry, and 38% are unsure how they would feel. Socialists are by far most likely to say they would be satisfied or enthusiastic with this outcome.

Feelings if 2024 DEM Presidential Nominee is Williamson - Among Likely DEM Primary Voters - By Ideology - July 2023

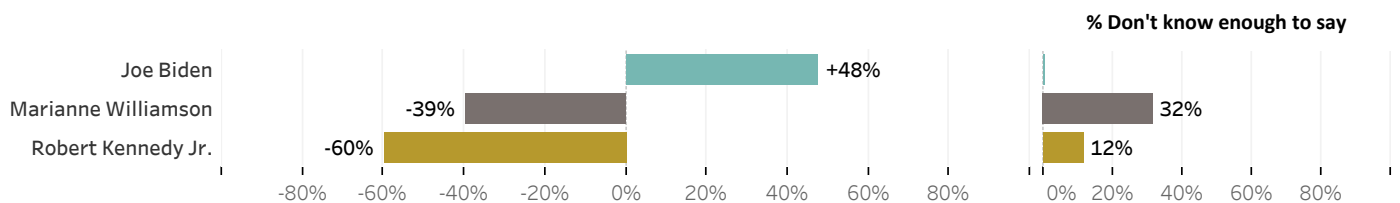


Sixty-five percent of likely 2024 Democratic New Hampshire presidential primary voters have a favorable opinion of Biden, 18% have a neutral opinion of him, and 17% have an unfavorable opinion of him. Biden's net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion) is +48, up from +31 in April. Biden's two opponents are unpopular among likely Democratic primary voters: only 5% have a favorable opinion of Williamson, 18% have a neutral opinion, 45% have an unfavorable opinion, and 32% don't know enough about her to say while Kennedy is even more unpopular with a net favorability rating of -60.

Net Favorability - Potential 2024 Democratic Candidates - Among Likely DEM 2024 Primary Voters - July 2023



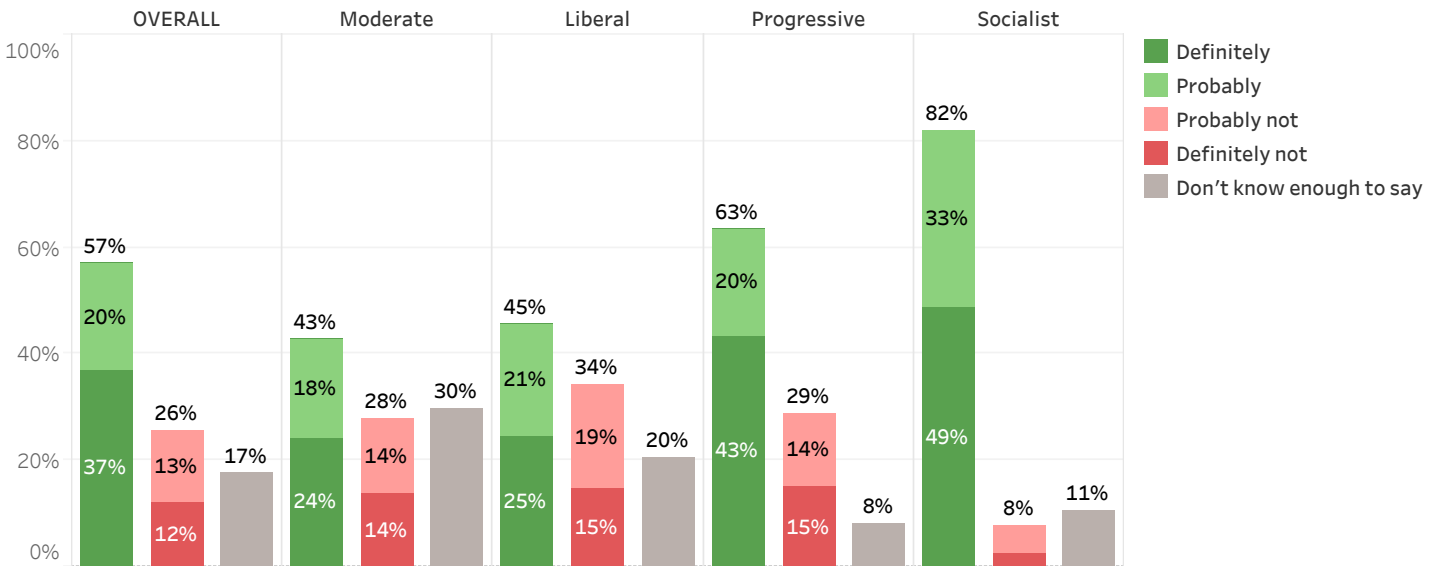
Respondents were asked what one word they would use to describe Biden, Kennedy, and Williamson. Respondents most often use the words "old," "steady," "competent," "experienced," "honest," and "leader" to describe Biden, they most often use the words "crazy," "dangerous," "insane," "conspiracy," and "unknown" to describe Kennedy, and they most often use the words "unknown," "crazy," "unqualified," "who?," and "kooky" to describe Williamson.

One Word to Describe Biden, Kennedy, and Williamson - Among Likely DEM Primary Voters - July 2023



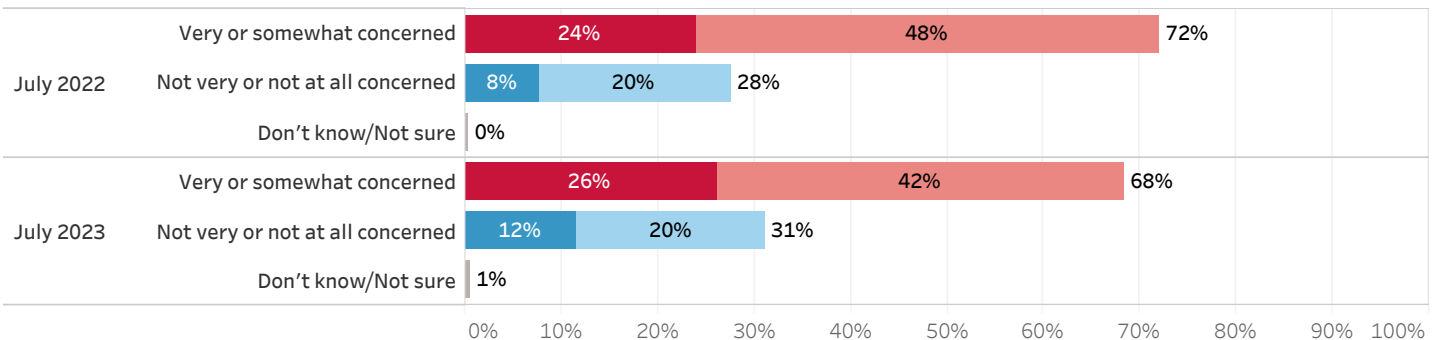
The Democratic National Committee (DNC) has announced that they will hold no primary debates before the Democratic presidential primary election. However, more than half (57%) of likely 2024 Democratic primary voters in New Hampshire think debates definitely (37%) or probably (20%) should be held before the primaries are held, 26% think there probably (13%) or definitely (12%) should not be debates, and 17% are unsure. Socialists (82%) and progressives (63%) are most likely to believe there definitely or probably should be primary debates.

Should Debates Be Held Before 2024 DEM Presidential Primaries - Among Likely DEM Primary Voters - By Ideology - July 2023



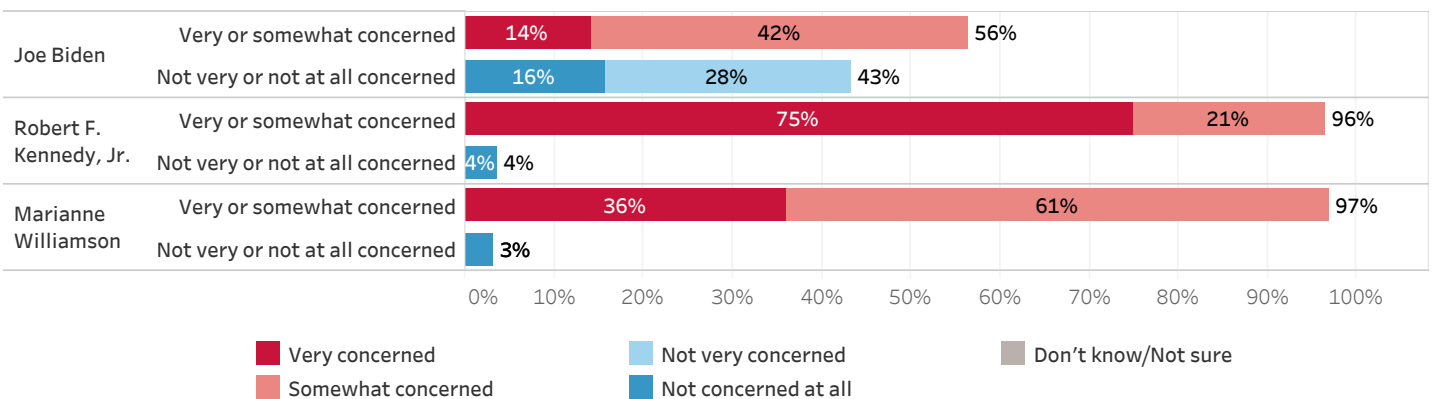
President Biden is the oldest president to ever seek reelection. More than two-thirds (68%) of likely 2024 Democratic primary voters say they are very (26%) or somewhat (42%) concerned about Biden's age while 31% say they are not very concerned (20%) or not concerned at all (12%). A similar percentage of likely primary voters said they were very or somewhat concerned about Biden's age in July 2022.

More than half (56%) of Biden supporters say that they are very or somewhat concerned about his age while nearly all Williamson (97%) and Kennedy (96%) supporters are very or somewhat concerned.

Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Two thousand and twenty-eight (2,028) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between July 13 and July 17, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.2 percent. Included in the sample were 743 likely 2024 Democratic Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 3.6 percent). These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the July 2023 Granite State Poll is 25%. The design effect for the survey is 2.8%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 8,000 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
