#### GRANITE STATERS THINK TRUMP WILL BE CONVICTED OF A CRIME BUT FEW THINK HE WILL GO TO PRISON

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DURHAM, NH - More than six in ten New Hampshire residents believe that former President Donald Trump will be convicted in at least one of the cases currently being brought against him. However, less than one-quarter expect Trump will spend one or more days in prison. Majorities of state residents feel that Trump committed a crime in each of the four cases for which he has been indicted. Most Granite Staters also believe that Hunter Biden has done something illegal and that he is receiving favorable treatment because he is Joe Biden's son.

#### **Trump Investigations**

Former President Donald Trump was recently indicted in a case concerning whether he illegally interfered with the 2020 presidential election in Georgia and over the past four months has been indicted in three other cases. Fifty-eight percent think that Trump definitely (46%) or probably (11%) committed a crime in a case alleging Trump illegally mishandled classified documents, (40%) believe he probably (19%) or definitely (21%) did not commit a crime in this case, and 2% are unsure. Similar majorities believe that Trump definitely or probably committed a crime in the cases alleging Trump tried to overturn the results of the 2020 election and aided the January 6th riot in Washington D.C. (57%), illegally interfered with the 2020 presidential election in Georgia (56%), and in the case related to alleged "hush money" payments to adult movie actress Stormy Daniels late in his 2016 presidential campaign (55%). The percentage of Granite State residents who think Trump committed a crime in each of these cases is essentially unchanged since April.

Overall, 63% of Granite Staters believe that Trump has committed a crime in at least one of the four investigations. Almost all respondents say they have heard a lot or some about each of these cases.


#### **Believe Trump Committed a Crime in Following Cases**


Nearly all Democrats and majorities of Independents believe that Trump definitely or probably committed a crime in three of these cases, while 15% or less of Republicans believe Trump definitely or probably committed a crime in each case. More than 99% of Democrats and 67% of Independents believe Trump committed a crime in at least one of these cases while only 24% of Republicans agree. The percentage of Independents who believe Trump has committed at least one crime (67%) has increased since April (50%).






Granite Staters increasingly believe that Trump will be convicted as a result of these cases: 54% believe he is very (24%) or somewhat (30%) likely to be convicted in the case alleging interference in the 2020 election in Georgia, 53% think he is likely to be convicted in the case alleging mishandling of classified documents, 52% think he is likely to be convicted in the case alleging interference in the 2020 election and aid to the January 6th riot, and 46% believe he will be convicted in the case involving "hush money" payments in the 2016 election campaign. New Hampshire residents are more likely to think Trump will be convicted in each of these cases than they were in April.

#### Likelihood Trump Will Be Convicted in Following Cases




Overall, 61% of Granite Staters believe that Trump will be convicted as a result of at least one of these investigations, up from 51% who felt that way in April. Seventy-one percent of Independents, up from only 38% in April, believe that Trump will be convicted of at least one crime as a result of these cases. Thirty-nine percent of Republicans think Trump will be convicted of at least one crime, up from 22% in April, while 78% of Democrats expect Trump to be convicted of at least one crime, unchanged since April. *Joe Rogan* (+17 percentage points) and conservative radio (+15) listeners are more likely than in April to believe Trump will be convicted of at least one crime.

Believe Trump Will Be Convicted in at Least One Current Case - Change from April 2023 to August 2023 - by Selected Demographics




Overall, 47% of New Hampshire residents believe Trump committed at least one crime in these cases and will be convicted in at least one case. Sixteen percent believe Trump committed a crime in at least one case but will not be convicted in any of them, 14% believe he did not commit a crime in any of these cases but will be wrongfully convicted in at least one of them, and 24% think Trump did not commit a crime in any of these cases and will not be convicted in any of them. Most Democrats (78%) and a majority of Independents (56%) think Trump committed at least one crime and will be convicted as a result of at least one case, while a plurality of Republicans (48%) think Trump did not commit a crime in any of the cases and will not be convicted as a result of any of them.

#### **Combined Opinion on Trump Indictments**




Only 24% of New Hampshire residents believe that Trump is very (9%) or somewhat (15%) likely to spend at least one day in prison. More than two-thirds (69%) think it is not very likely (31%) or not at all likely (38%) that this will happen while 7% are unsure. A majority (54%) of those who think Trump will be convicted of at least one crime (N=701) believe he is not very likely (36%) or not likely at all (19%) to spend at least one day in prison.

Nearly two-thirds (63%) of Granite Staters believe that Joe Biden won the 2020 presidential election, 22% think that Donald Trump won the 2020 election, and 15% are unsure. Nearly all (>99%) of those who voted for Biden believe that he won the election. Forty-nine percent of those who voted for Trump claim that he won the election while only 19% think Biden won and 32% are unsure. Most (79%) who voted for another candidate or did not vote in 2020 believe that Biden won the election.

#### **Hunter Biden Investigation**


The House Oversight and Accountability Committee has been conducting an investigation into Hunter Biden's former business dealings. Only 42% of Granite Staters say they have heard a lot about this investigation, 49% have heard some about it, 9% have heard not very much, and less than 1% have heard nothing at all about it.

Based on what they have heard about the investigation, nearly two-thirds (65%) of Granite Staters believe that Hunter Biden has done something illegal, 22% believe he has done something unethical but not illegal, 1% think he has done nothing wrong, and 12% are unsure. Only 30% of Democrats think that Hunter Biden has done something illegal while more than three-quarters of Independents (78%) and nearly all Republicans (96%) think he has done something illegal.

#### Belief About What Hunter Biden Did - by Party ID

Sixty-three percent of Granite Staters think that Hunter Biden is definitely (46%) or probably (17%) receiving favorable treatment from U.S. prosecutors because he is Joe Biden's son. Only 31% think that Hunter Biden is probably not (16%) or definitely not (15%) receiving favorable treatment while 6% are unsure. Nearly all (97%) Republicans and more than three-quarters (76%) of Independents believe that Hunter Biden is receiving favorable treatment but only 26% of Democrats agree.

#### **Granite State Poll Methodology**

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand, one hundred and fifty-six (1,156) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between August 17 and August 21, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.9 percent. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the August 2023 Granite State Poll is 28%. The design effect for the survey is 2.9%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,250 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
