MAINERS FORESEE AT LEAST ONE TRUMP CONVICTION BUT FEW THINK HE WILL GO TO PRISON



DURHAM, NH - More than six in ten Maine residents believe that former President Donald Trump will be convicted in at least one of the cases currently being brought against him, up from just over half who expected this in April. However, only one in five expect Trump will spend one or more days in prison. Majorities of state residents feel that Trump committed a crime in each of the four cases for which he has been indicted. A majority of Mainers believe that Hunter Biden has done something illegal and that he is receiving favorable treatment because he is Joe Biden's son.

Trump Investigations

Former President Donald Trump was recently indicted in a case concerning illegal interference with the 2020 presidential election in Georgia and over the past four months, has been indicted in three other cases. Sixty percent think that Trump definitely (46%) or probably (14%) committed a crime in a case concerning the mishandling of classified documents, 37% believe he probably (15%) or definitely (22%) did not commit a crime in this case, and 3% are unsure. Similar majorities believe that Trump definitely or probably committed a crime in the cases involving "hush money" payments to adult movie actress Stormy Daniels late in his 2016 presidential campaign (59%), that he tried to overturn the results of the 2020 election and aided the January 6th riot in Washington D.C. (58%), and that he illegally interfered with the 2020 presidential election in Georgia (58%).


Overall, nearly two-thirds (64%) of Mainers believe that Trump has committed a crime in at least one of the four investigations, up slightly from 60% in April. Almost all respondents say they have heard a lot or some about each of these cases.


Nearly all Democrats and majorities of Independents believe that Trump definitely or probably committed a crime in each of these cases, while less than 20% of Republicans believe Trump definitely or probably committed a crime. More than 99% of Democrats, 65% of Independents, and 26% of Republicans believe Trump committed a crime in at least one of these cases. Independents (+12 percentage points) and Republicans (+9) are more likely than in April to believe Trump has committed at least one crime.




Believe Trump Definitely or Probably Committed a Crime in Following Cases - By Party ID - August 2023

Just over half (53%) of Mainers believe Trump is very (19%) or somewhat (33%) likely to be convicted in the case alleging interference in the 2020 election and aid to the January 6th riot, while about half (49%) think he is likely to be convicted in the case alleging interference in the 2020 election in Georgia. Pluralities believe Trump is not very or not at all likely to be convicted in the cases alleging he made "hush money" payments in the 2016 election campaign (49%) and the case alleging he mishandled classified documents (49%). Maine residents are more likely than in April to believe Trump is likely to be convicted in the case alleging interference in the 2020 election and aid to the January 6th riot (+15 percentage points) and the case alleging interference in the 2020 election in Georgia (+12).

Likelihood Trump Will Be Convicted in Following Cases




Overall, 62% of Mainers believe that Trump will be convicted as a result of at least one of these investigations, up from 53% who felt that way in April. Most Democrats (91%) believe Trump will be convicted as a result of at least one of these cases but only 43% of Independents and 38% of Republicans agree. All three groups are more likely than in April to believe that Trump will be convicted in at least one case.




Believe Trump Will Be Convicted in at Least One Current Case - Change from April 2023 to August 2023 - by Selected Demographics

Overall, 52% of Maine residents believe Trump committed at least one crime in these cases and will be convicted as a result of at least one of these cases. Twelve percent believe Trump committed a crime in at least one case but will not be convicted in any of them, 10% believe he did not commit a crime in any of these cases but will be wrongfully convicted in at least one of them, and 25% think Trump did not commit a crime in any of these cases and will not be convicted in any of them. Most Democrats (91%) think Trump committed at least one crime and will be convicted in at least one case, while a majority of Republicans (53%) think Trump did not commit a crime in any of the cases and will not be convicted as a result of any of them. Independents are split, with 33% believing Trump has committed at least one crime but will not be convicted in at least one case, while 31% think Trump has committed a crime and will be convicted.




Combined Opinion on Trump Indictments

Only 20% of Maine residents believe that Trump is very (7%) or somewhat (13%) likely to spend at least one day in prison as a result of the current cases against him. More than two-thirds (69%) think it is not very likely (32%) or not at all likely (37%) that this will happen while 11% are unsure. Among those who think Trump will be convicted of at least one crime (N=334), only 30% believe he is very (11%) or somewhat (19%) likely to go to prison as a result.

Six in ten (61%) Mainers believe that Joe Biden won the 2020 presidential election, 26% think that Donald Trump won the 2020 election, and 12% are unsure. Nearly all (99%) of those who voted for Biden believe that he won the election. Fifty-nine percent of those who voted for Trump claim that he won the election while only 20% think Biden won and 21% are unsure.




Who Believe Won 2020 Presidential Election - By 2020 Vote

Hunter Biden Investigation


The House Oversight and Accountability Committee has been conducting an investigation into Hunter Biden's former business dealings. Only 41% of Mainers say they have heard a lot about this investigation, 38% have heard some about it, 16% have heard not very much, and 5% have heard nothing at all about it.

Based on what they have heard about the investigation, 52% of Mainers believe that Hunter Biden has done something illegal, 24% believe he has done something unethical but not illegal, 1% think he has done nothing wrong, and 23% are unsure. Only 18% of Democrats think that Hunter Biden has done something illegal while 62% of Independents and most Republicans (89%) think he has done something illegal.

A majority (58%) of Mainers think that Hunter Biden is definitely (44%) or probably (14%) receiving favorable treatment from U.S. prosecutors because he is Joe Biden's son. Thirty-five percent think that Hunter Biden is probably not (23%) or definitely not (11%) receiving favorable treatment while 7% are unsure. Nearly all Republicans (94%) and a majority of Independents (55%) believe that Hunter Biden is receiving favorable treatment but only 26% of Democrats agree.

Pine Tree State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Pine Tree State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Five hundred fifty-five (555) Pine Tree State Panel members completed the survey online between August 17 and August 21, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 4.2 percent. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the August 2023 Pine Tree State Poll is 21%. The design effect for the survey is 2.5%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the ME Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Maine.

The Pine Tree State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of Maine residents. Approximately 2,750 Maine adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
