#### MAJORITY IN NH FEEL SUMMERS ARE WARMER THAN THEY USED TO BE, HUMAN-CAUSED CLIMATE CHANGE HAPPENING NOW

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
DURHAM, NH - More than half of New Hampshire residents feel that summers are warmer than two decades ago and two-thirds say they have avoided doing outdoor activities at least one day this summer due to the heat. Seven in eight Granite Staters believe climate change is happening now and the majority believe it is caused primarily by human activity. Young people and Democrats are particularly likely to believe climate change is caused primarily by people and to be worried about its effects.

#### **Summer Weather**

More than half (55%) of New Hampshire residents feel that summers in the state are much (32%) or somewhat (23%) warmer than they were twenty years ago. Just under one-third (32%) think that summers are about the same as they were twenty years ago, 7% think summers are somewhat (7%) or much (<1%) cooler now, and 6% are unsure.

Democrats and Independents, those under the age of thirty-five, those who have completed a postgraduate degree, MSNBC viewers, and NHPR listeners are particularly likely to say that the summers in New Hampshire are warmer than they were twenty years ago, while Republicans, those with a high school degree or less education, conservative radio and Joe Rogan listeners, and Fox News viewers are less likely to say that recent New Hampshire summers have been warmer.

#### Feel That Summers in State are Warmer or Cooler than 20 Years Ago




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Two-thirds (66%) of New Hampshire residents say they have avoided outdoor activities due to excessive outdoor heat on at least one day so far this summer; 27% have done this on 1-5 days, 19% have done this on 6-10 days, 13% have done this on 11-20 days, and 7% have avoided outdoor activities more than 20 days so far this summer.

Women and Seacoast residents are particularly likely to report having avoided outdoor activities due to excessive outdoor heat on at least one day.





Most New Hampshire residents (89%) say that they have some form of air conditioning in their home while 11% do not. Most respondents of all income levels and those who rent or own their home say that they have some form of air conditioning.

#### Have Air Conditioning in Home - by Household Income




#### **Climate Change**

When asked about their overall beliefs about climate change, 62% of Granite Staters believe that climate change is happening now, caused mainly by human activities, 25% believe climate change is happening now, but is caused mainly by natural forces, 9% believe climate change is not happening now, and 3% are unsure.


There is a significant partisan difference in beliefs about climate change. Nearly all Democrats (97%) and a majority of Independents (63%) believe that climate change is happening now and is caused mainly by human activities. More than three-quarters of Republicans believe climate change is happening now, but a majority (51%) think it is caused mainly by natural forces. Those under the age of thirty-five, those with a college degree or more education, and Seacoast residents are particularly likely to believe that climate change is happening now, caused mainly by human activities.

### Closest Opinion on Cause of Climate Change - by Party ID




More than two-thirds (68%) of New Hampshire residents say that they are very (47%) or somewhat (21%) concerned about the current effects of climate change on the world, 32% are not very (14%) or not at all (18%) concerned, and 1% are unsure. Granite Staters are more likely to be very concerned about the effects of climate change in the future: 47% are very concerned about the current effects while 55% are very concerned about the effects in twenty years and 62% are very concerned about the effects in fifty years. Young people and Democrats are particularly likely to be concerned.

#### **Concern About Effects of Climate Change on World**




Granite Staters are slightly less concerned about the current effects of climate change on their hometown or city: 54% say that they are very (30%) or somewhat (24%) concerned about the current effects of climate change on the town or city, 46% are not very (23%) or not at all (23%) concerned, and less than 1% are unsure. Respondents are more concerned about the effects of climate change on their town or city in the future: nearly two-thirds (65%) are concerned about the effects in twenty years while 60% are concerned about the effects in fifty years.

Overall, more than half (54%) of New Hampshire residents are concerned about the current effect of climate change on both the world and their home town or city, 15% are concerned about the current effect on the world but not their home town or city, 1% are concerned about the effects on their home town or city but not the world, and 31% are not concerned about the effects of climate change on the world or their home town or city.

#### **Granite State Poll Methodology**

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand, one hundred and fifty-six (1,156) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between August 17 and August 21, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.9 percent. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the August 2023 Granite State Poll is 28%. The design effect for the survey is 2.9%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire.

The Granite State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,250 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
