NEW HAMPSHIRE DISAPPROVES OF BIDEN IMPEACHMENT INQUIRY, FEW EXPECT HOUSE TO IMPEACH BIDEN

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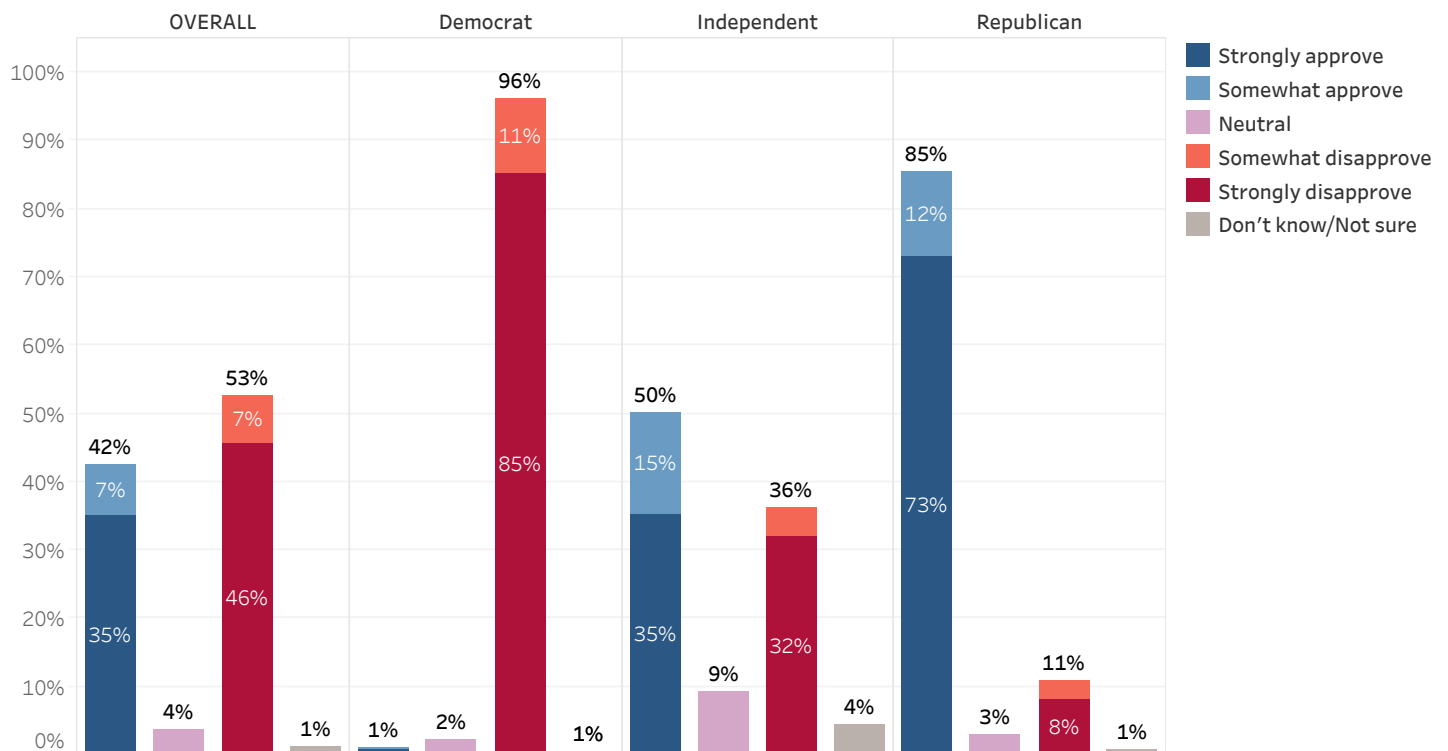
DURHAM, NH - A small majority of New Hampshire residents disapprove of former Speaker Kevin McCarthy's recent decision to launch an impeachment inquiry into President Joe Biden about his actions related to Hunter Biden's foreign business activities. Only four in ten Granite Staters think that Biden's actions in this matter are impeachable. Few state residents think it is likely that Biden will be impeached by the House of Representatives or convicted by the Senate as a result of this investigation. Republicans are far more likely than Democrats and Independents to think Biden has committed impeachable offenses or will be impeached by the House. Biden's job approval rating remains low, only 44% approve of the job he is doing as president.

Biden Impeachment Inquiry

On September 12, former Speaker of the House of Representatives Kevin McCarthy announced an impeachment inquiry into President Joe Biden. McCarthy has alleged that Biden lied about knowledge of his son's business dealings and that Biden family members received millions of dollars in payments dating back to Biden's time as Vice President. Most (85%) say they have heard a lot (40%) or some (45%) about this.

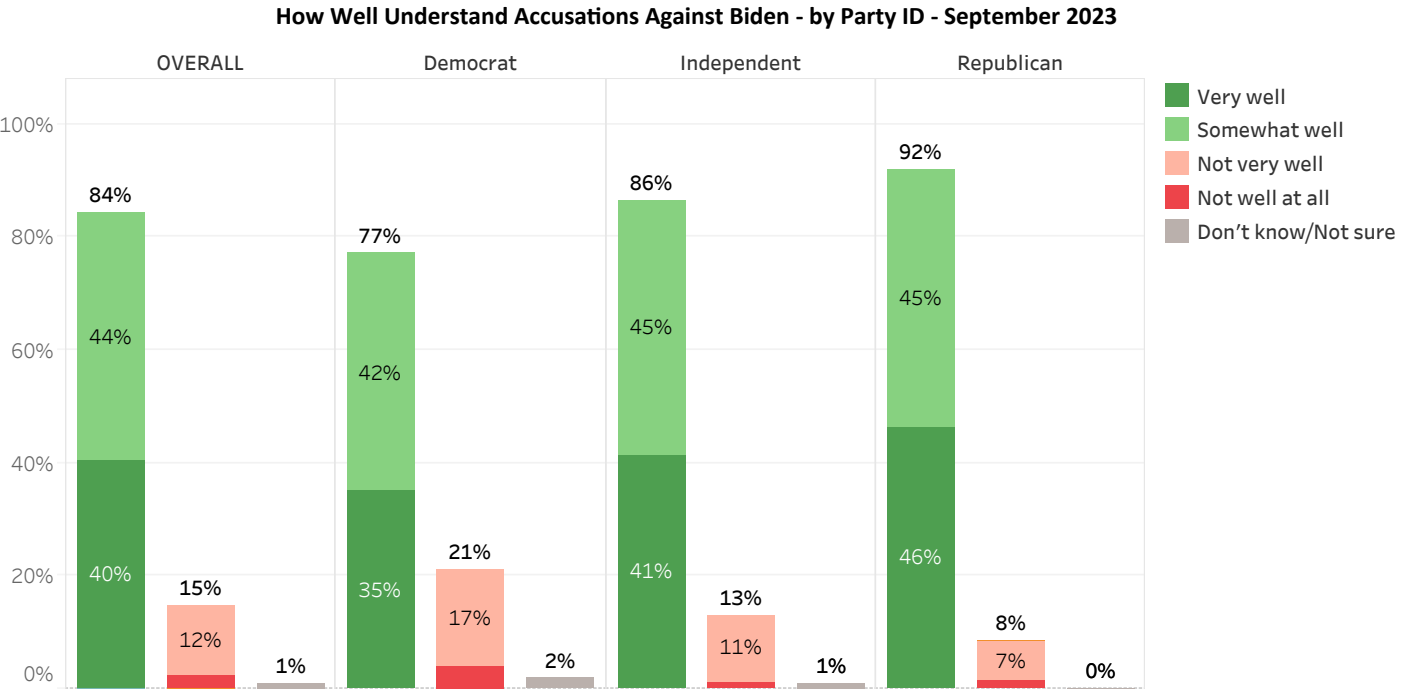
A majority (53%) of New Hampshire residents say that they strongly (46%) or somewhat (7%) disapprove of McCarthy's decision to launch an impeachment inquiry into Biden; 42% strongly (35%) or somewhat (7%) approve of McCarthy's decision, 4% are neutral, and less than 1% are unsure. Nearly all Democrats (96%) disapprove of McCarthy's decision but a majority of Independents (50%) and most Republicans (85%) approve.

Approve or Disapprove of Biden Impeachment Inquiry - by Party ID - September 2023



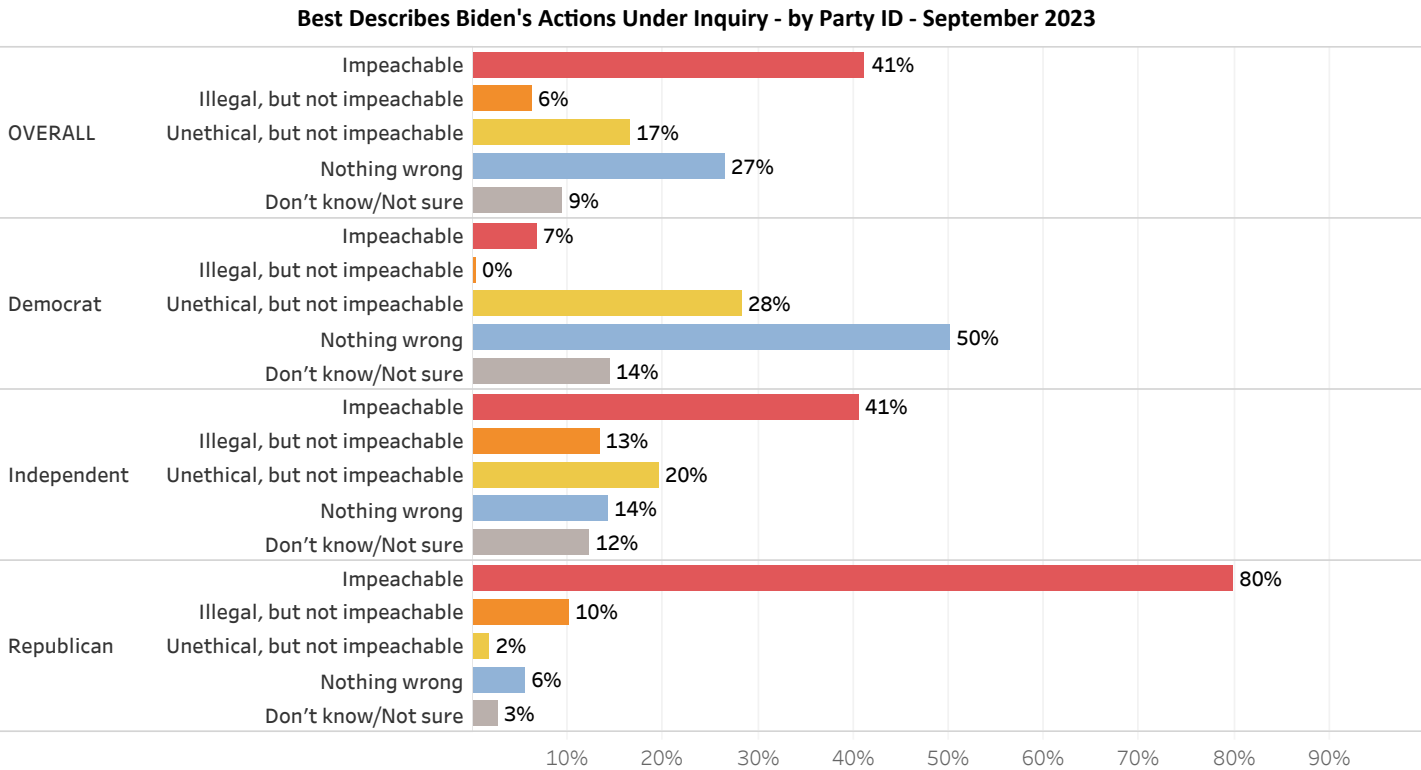

The accusations made against Biden in this matter are quite well known to Granite Staters; 44% say they understand the accusations being made against Biden very well, while 44% say they understand them somewhat well, only 15% say they understand the allegations against Biden not very well (12%) or not well at all (3%) and 1% are unsure. Republicans (92%) are more likely than Independents (86%) and Democrats (77%) to say they understand the allegations against Biden very or somewhat well.



Based on what they have heard about this investigation, 41% of New Hampshire residents believe that Biden's actions in this inquiry were impeachable offenses, 6% think Biden did something illegal but not impeachable, 17% think he did something unethical but not impeachable, 27% think he did nothing wrong, and 9% are unsure.

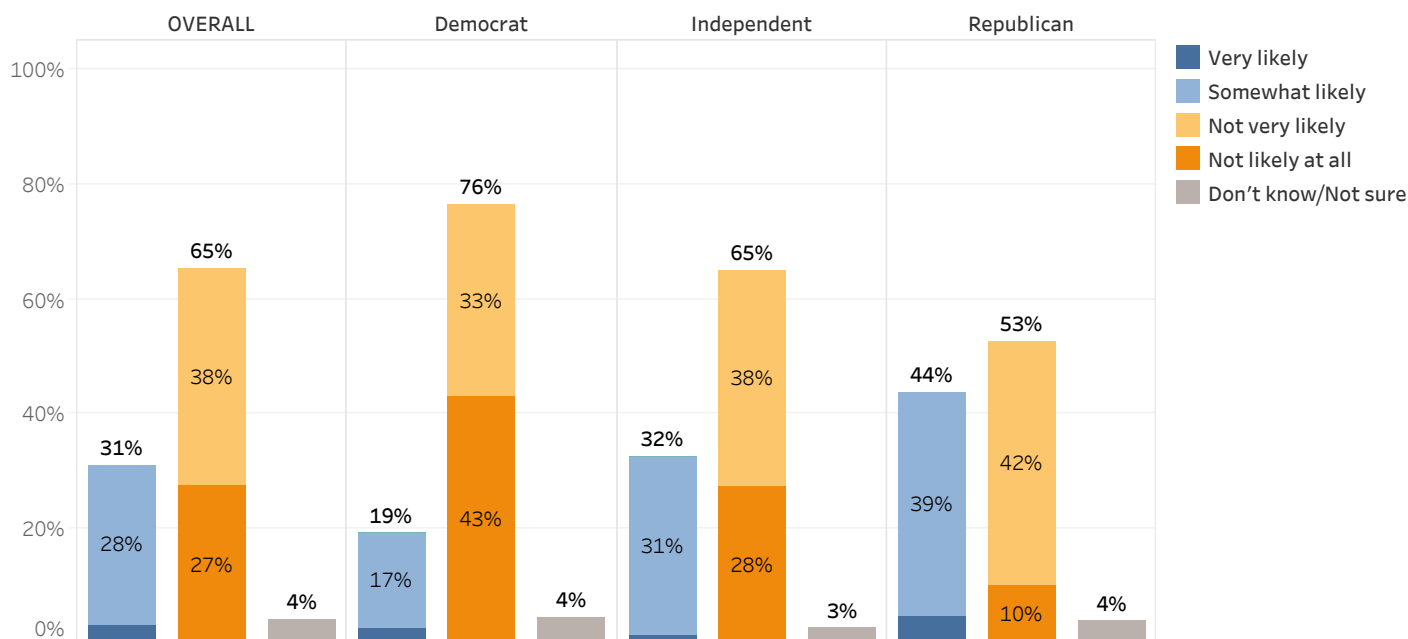
Most Democrats (64%) believe Biden did nothing wrong (50%) or are unsure (14%). By contrast, four in five (80%) Republicans believe Biden's actions are impeachable and only 6% think Biden has done nothing wrong.



Despite their personal feelings about whether Biden’s actions call for impeachment, only 31% of New Hampshire residents think it is very (3%) or somewhat (28%) likely that Biden will be impeached by the U.S. House of Representatives; two-thirds (65%) think it is not very (38%) or not at all (27%) likely that Biden will be impeached while 4% are unsure. Three-quarters (76%) of Democrats think Biden is unlikely to be impeached but 44% of Republicans think Biden is very or somewhat likely to be impeached.

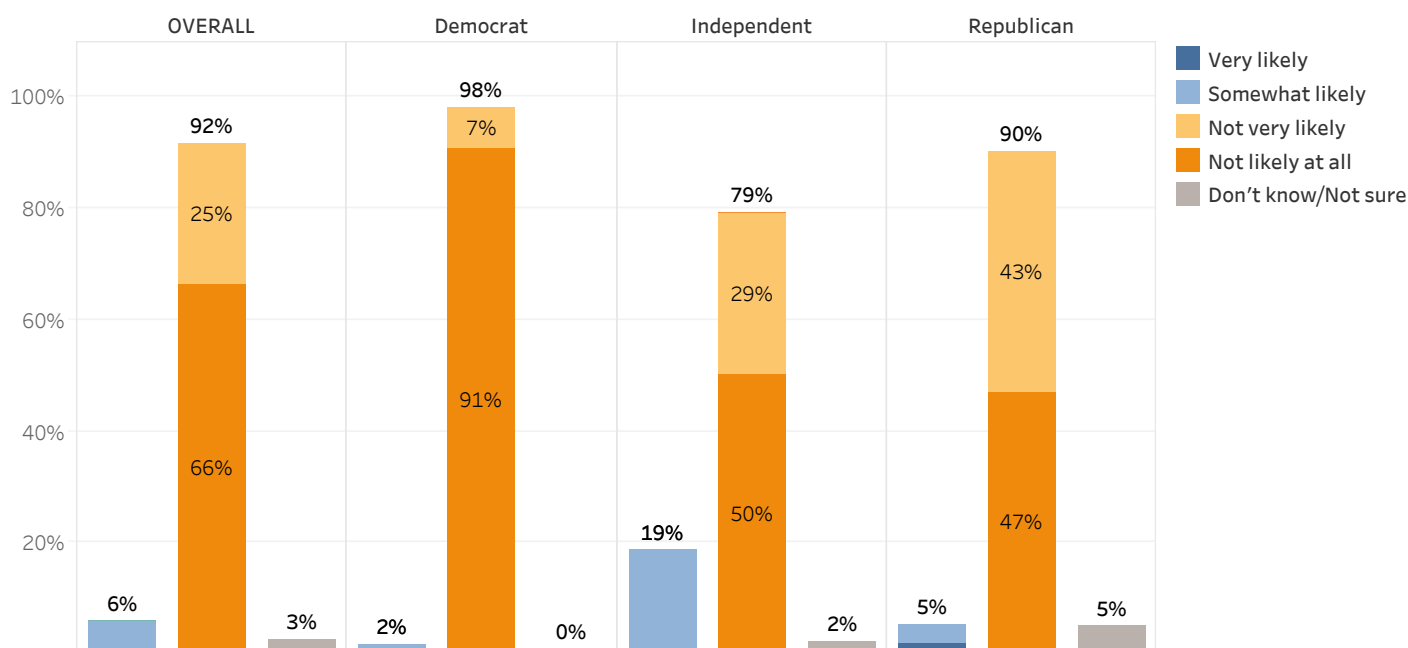
Among those who think Biden has committed impeachable actions (N=402), just over half (52%) think it is very or somewhat likely that Biden will be impeached by the House while 44% think he will not be impeached. Among those who do not think Biden has committed impeachable actions (N=481), only 17% think it is very or somewhat likely that Biden will be impeached.

Even fewer Granite Staters think the investigation of Biden will lead to his removal from office by the U.S. Senate. Only 6% think it is very (1%) or somewhat (5%) likely that Biden will be convicted by the Senate and removed from office; 92% think it is not very (25%) or not at all (66%) likely that Biden will be convicted and removed while 3% are unsure. Most Democrats (91%) say that it is not likely at all that Biden will be convicted and removed from office while only 50% of Independents and 47% of Republicans feel that way.

Likelihood Biden is Convicted by U.S. Senate As Result of Investigation - by Party ID - September 2023

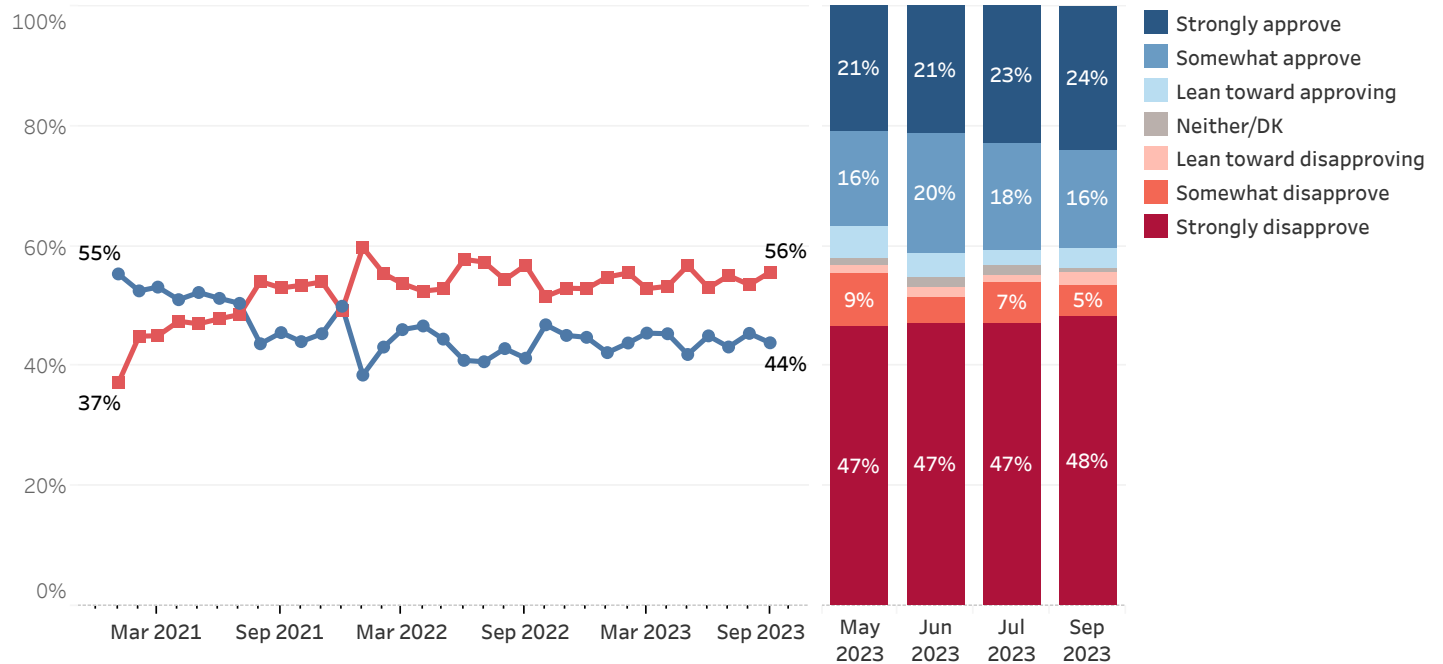


Presidential Approval

Biden continues to be hampered by low job approval ratings. A majority (56%) disapprove of Biden's handling of his job as president while 44% approve. Biden's net approval rating among Granite Staters (-12) has remained unchanged over the past year.

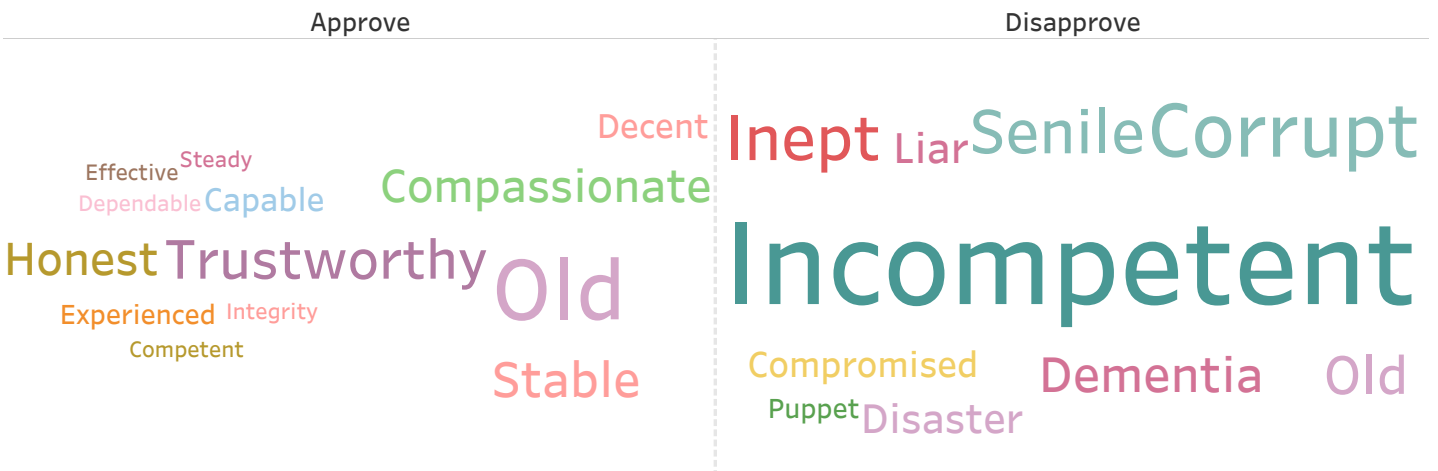
Eighty-six percent of Democrats approve of Biden's performance as president but only 23% of Independents and 7% of Republicans approve. Former President Trump had a similar net approval rating (-11) among Granite Staters in August 2019.

When asked what one word they would use to describe Biden, those who approve of his job performance most often use the words "old," "trustworthy," "stable," "compassionate," and "honest." Those who disapprove of Biden's performance most often use the words "incompetent," "corrupt," "inept," "senile," and "old."

Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Nine hundred and ninety-eight (998) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between September 28 and October 2, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.1 percent. In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the September 2023 Granite State Poll is 33%. The design effect for the survey is 2.9%.

The Granite State Panel is a probability-based web panel of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 6,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
