MAJORITY IN MAINE PLAN TO VOTE NO ON QUESTION 3, YES ON QUESTION 4; UNCERTAINTY REIGNS OVER QUESTIONS 5-8

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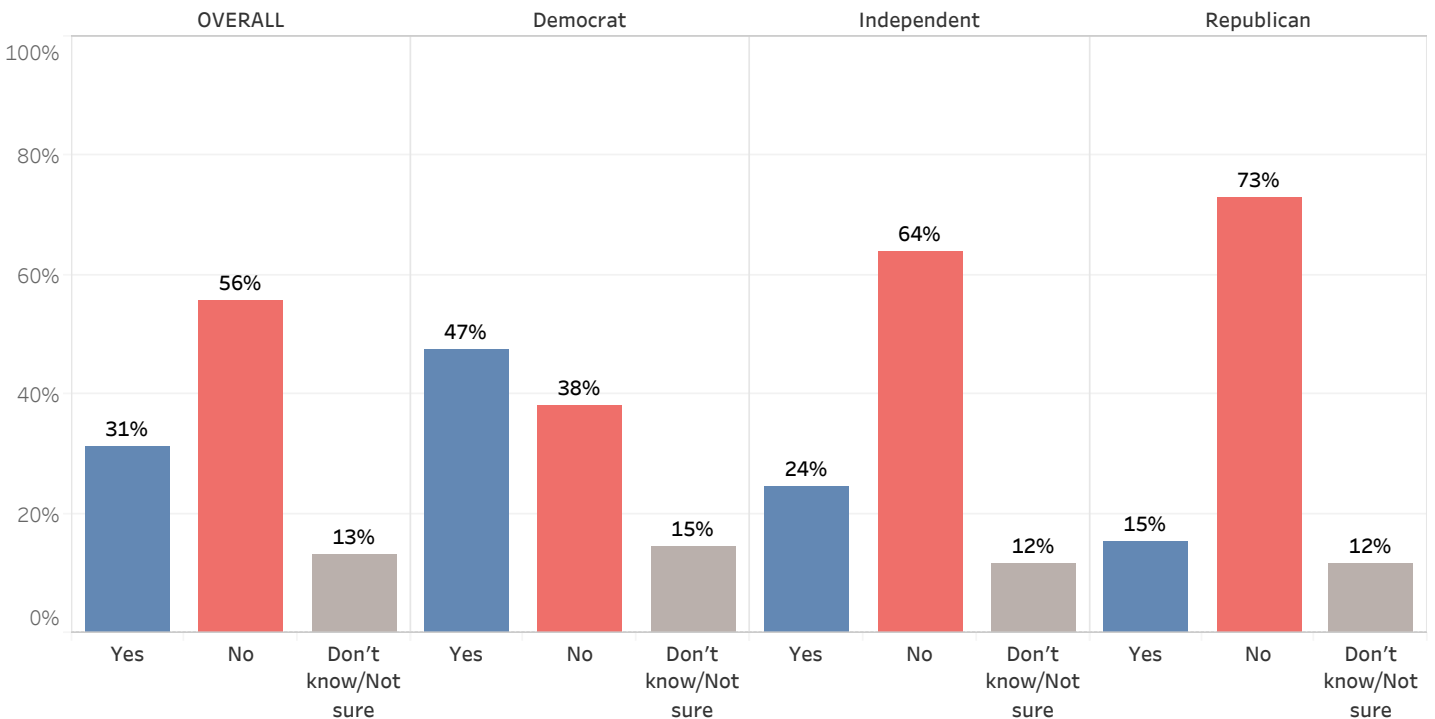
DURHAM, NH - With only a few weeks remaining before Maine's 2023 Referendum election, Mainers appear set to reject Question 3, which proposes to create a publicly-owned utility, the Pine Tree Power Company. Majorities support Question 4 on automotive right to repair and Question 2, which concerns campaign finance and corruption. A smaller majority support Question 1, a measure some argue is designed to make Question 3 difficult to implement if it were to pass. Few Mainers say they have heard much or have a solid understanding of Questions 5 through 8, with many indicating that they are unsure how they will vote on these questions.

2023 Maine Referendum Election

The upcoming 2023 Referendum election includes eight ballot questions, but perhaps the highest profile is Question 3, described as "an act to create the 'Pine Tree Power Company,' a nonprofit, customer-owned utility." Nine in ten (91%) Mainers say they have heard a lot (73%) or some (18%) about this, up from 77% in August, and 78% say they understand the question very or somewhat well, up from 55% who said they understood it this well in August. Janet Mills, the Democratic Governor of Maine, has announced her opposition to Question 3.

Among those who say they plan to vote in Maine's 2023 Referendum election (N=795), 31% plan to vote "yes" on Question 3, 56% plan to vote "no," and 13% are unsure. Among Democrats, 47% plan to vote yes, 38% plan to vote no, and 15% are unsure. By contrast, majorities of Independents (64%) and Republicans (73%) plan to vote no on Question 3. Self-described socialists (55%) and liberals (53%) and those who have completed postgraduate work (43%) are most likely to say they will vote yes, while self-described libertarians (6%), Northern Maine residents (19%), and those with a high school education or less (22%) are least likely to vote yes.

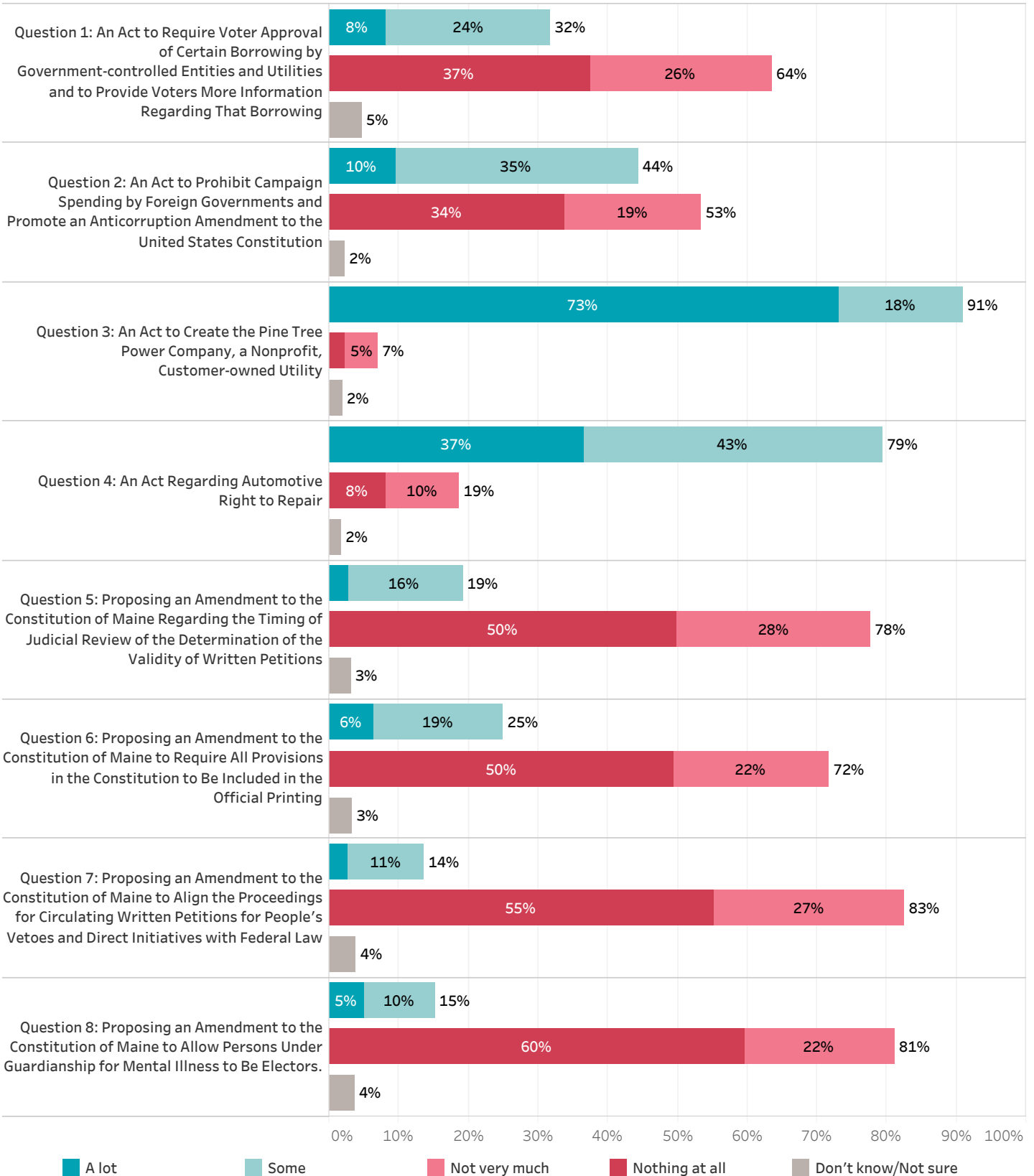
How Plan to Vote: Question 3 - By Party ID - October 2023

After Question 3, Mainers have heard the most about Question 4, a measure described as "an act regarding automotive right to repair": 37% have heard a lot about Question 4, 43% have heard some about it, 10% have heard not very much, and 8% have heard nothing at all. Less than half of Mainers have heard a lot or some about Question 2 (44%) or Question 1 (32%), while only a quarter or less have heard a lot or some about Question 6 (25%), Question 5 (19%), Question 8 (15%), and Question 7 (14%).

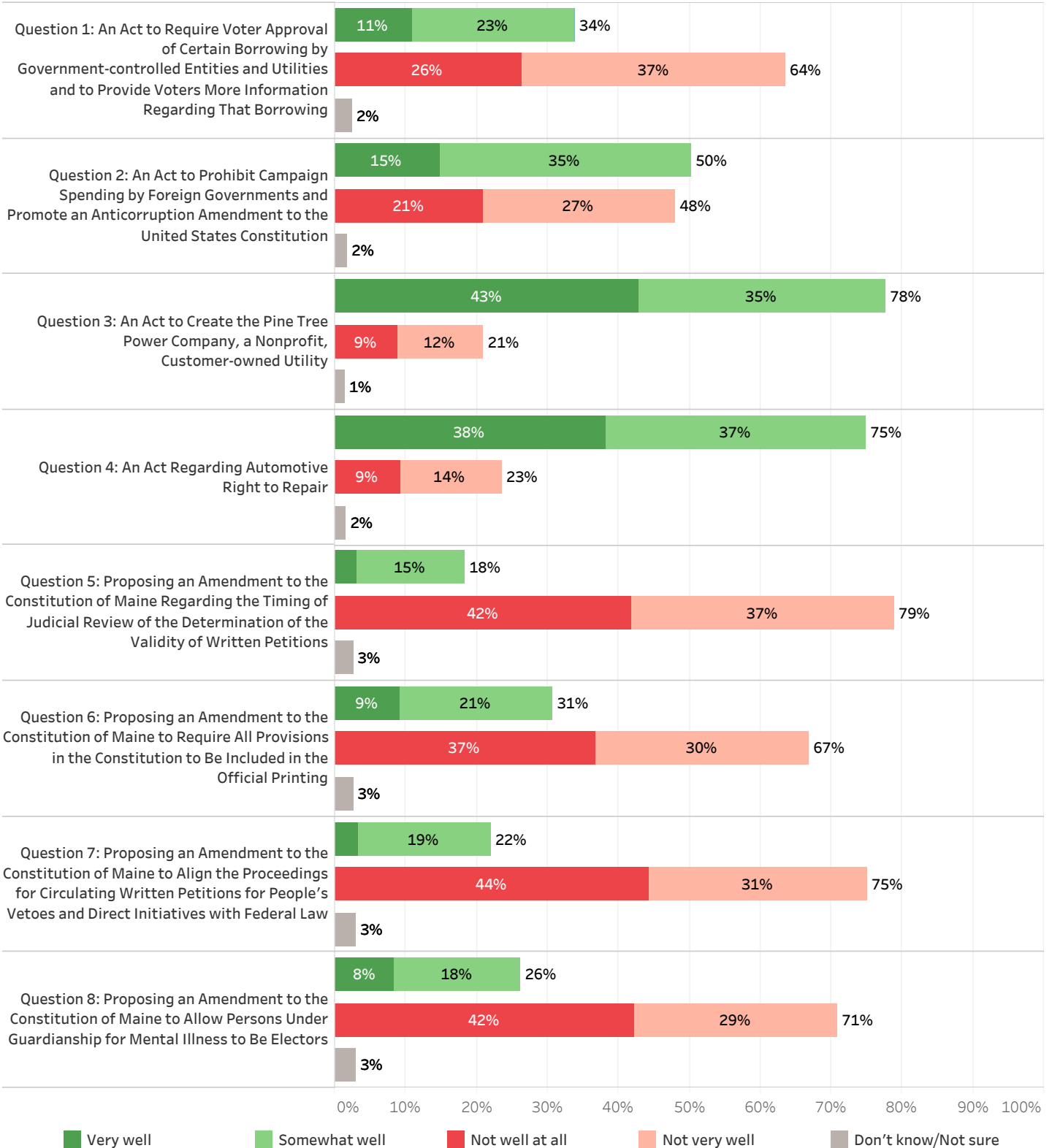
How Much Heard or Seen About 2023 Referendum Questions - October 2023



About three-quarters of Mainers say that they understand Question 3 (78%) and Question 4 (75%) very or somewhat well, while 50% say they understand Question 2 very or somewhat well and 34% understand Question 1 very or somewhat well. Few say that they understand Question 6 (31%), Question 8 (26%), Question 7 (22%), or Question 5 (18%) very or somewhat well.

Mainers' understanding of several of these questions has increased since August, with Question 4 (+33 percentage points) and Question 3 (+23) seeing the largest increases in the percentage of respondents who say they understand these questions very or somewhat well.

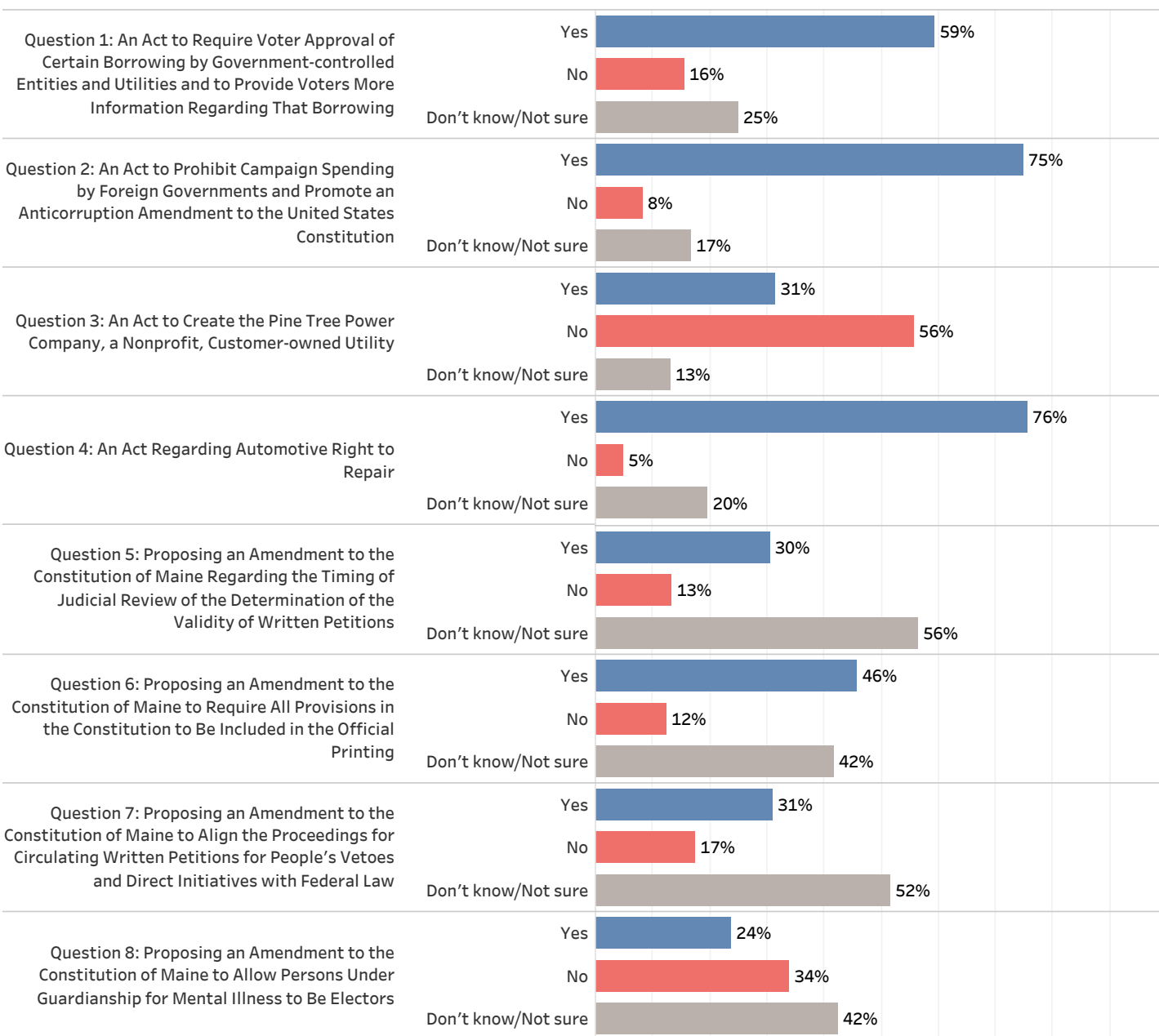
How Well Understand 2023 Referendum Questions - October 2023



Among those who say they plan to vote in November (N=724), a large majority (76%) plan to vote yes on Question 4, a measure described as "an act regarding automotive right to repair," while only 5% plan to vote no and 20% are unsure. A similar percentage (75%) say they will vote yes on Question 2, described as "an act to prohibit campaign spending by foreign governments and promote an anticorruption amendment to the United States Constitution," while only 8% plan to vote no and 17% are unsure. A majority (59%) also plan to vote yes on Question 1, described as "an act to require voter approval of certain borrowing by government-controlled entities and utilities and to provide voters more information regarding that borrowing," while 16% plan to vote no and 25% are unsure.

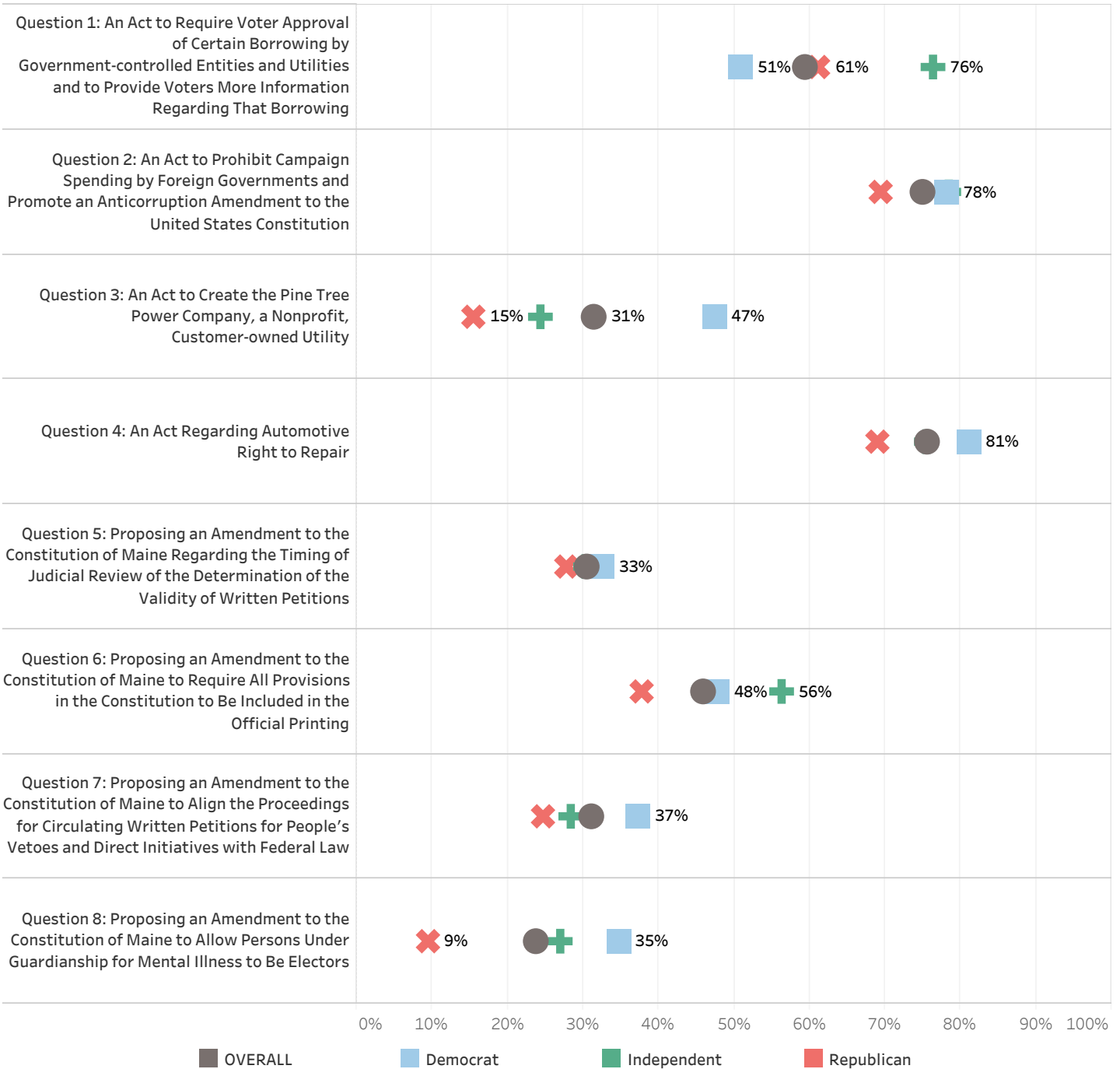
By contrast, likely voters show no preferences regarding Questions 5-8, questions about which respondents have heard little and generally do not understand well. A plurality (46%) plan to vote yes on Question 6, described as "proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Maine to require all provisions in the Constitution to be included in the official printing," while 12% plan to vote no and 42% are unsure. A majority (56%) are unsure how they will vote on Question 5, described as "proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Maine regarding the timing of judicial review of the determination of the validity of written petitions," and 52% are unsure how they will vote on Question 7, described as "proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Maine to align the proceedings for circulating written petitions for people's vetoes and direct initiatives with federal law." Mainers are divided on Question 8, described as "proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Maine to allow persons under guardianship for mental illness to be electors": 24% plan to vote yes on this question, 34% plan to vote no, and a plurality (42%) are unsure.

Independents are more likely to plan on voting yes on Question 1. However, there are no significant partisan differences on how likely voters intend to vote on Question 2, Question 4, Question 5, Question 6, and Question 7.

Pine Tree State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Pine Tree State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Seven hundred ninety-five (795) Pine Tree State Panel members completed the survey online between October 19 and October 23, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.5 percent. In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the October 2023 Pine Tree State Poll is 30%. The design effect for the survey is 2.2%.

The Pine Tree State Panel is a probability-based web panel of Maine residents. Approximately 2,750 Maine adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau as well as party registration levels provided by the ME Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Maine. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
