GRANITE STATERS DIVIDED ON ISRAELI ACTION IN GAZA; RIGHT & FAR-LEFT DISAPPROVE OF BIDEN'S HANDLING OF CONFLICT

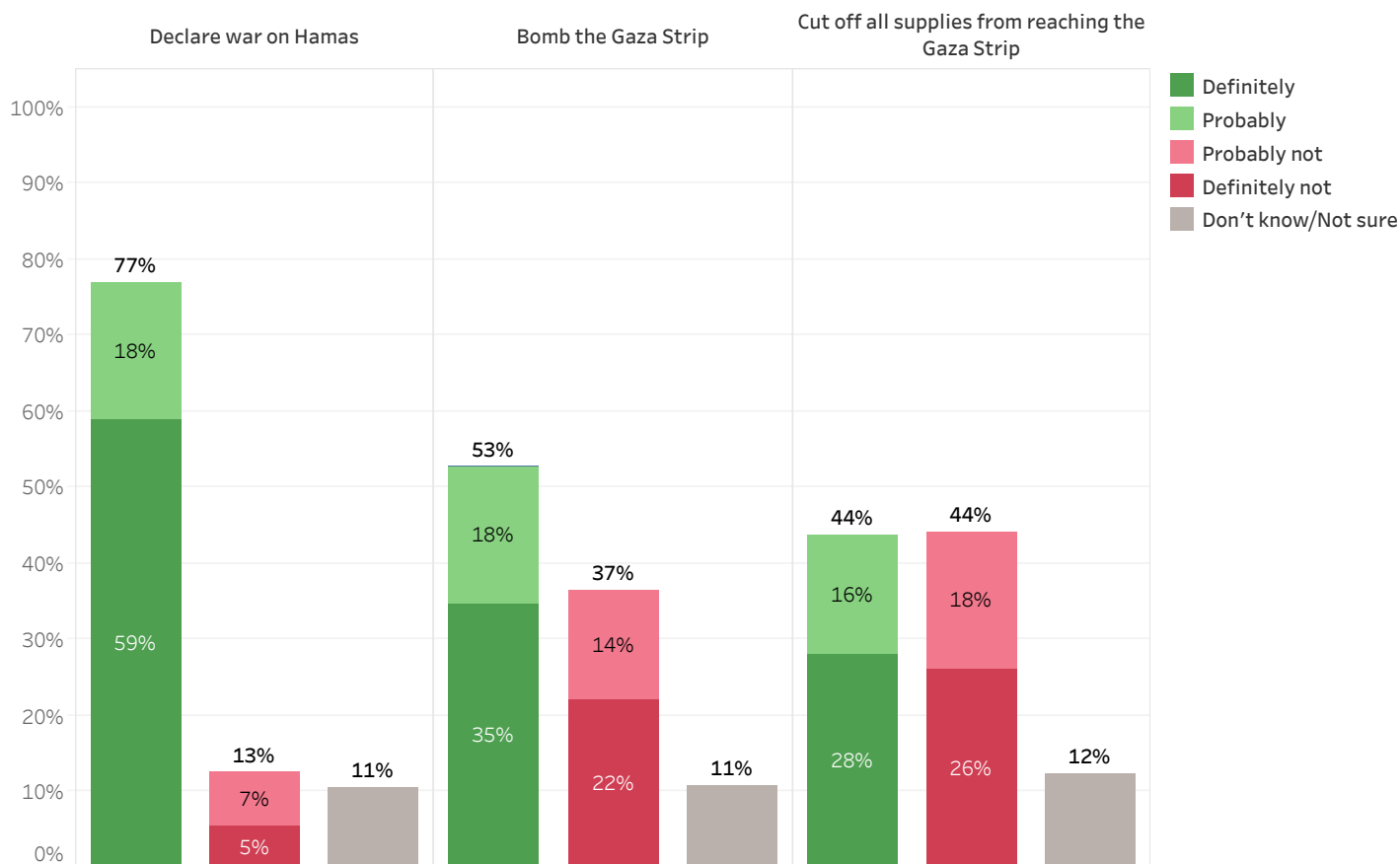
DURHAM, NH - Most New Hampshire residents think Israel was justified declaring war on Hamas following its attack on October 7th, but Granite Staters are divided over Israel's actions in the Gaza Strip. Half of state residents support a two-state solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and a majority want the U.S. to act as a neutral peacemaker in the peace process. New Hampshire residents are split over President Biden's handling of the crisis.

Israel-Hamas Conflict

On October 7th, Hamas launched an attack on Israel, reportedly killing more than 1,400 Israelis, mostly civilians. More than three-quarters (77%) of Granite Staters say that Israel's decision to declare war on Hamas in response to this attack was definitely (59%) or probably (18%) justified, 13% think it was probably (7%) or definitely (5%) not justified, and 11% are unsure.

A smaller majority of New Hampshire residents (53%) think that Israel's decision to bomb the Gaza Strip in response to the attack was definitely or probably justified. Granite Staters are divided over Israel's decision to cut off all supplies from reaching the Gaza Strip; 44% believe this decision was definitely or probably justified and 44% feel it was probably or definitely not justified.

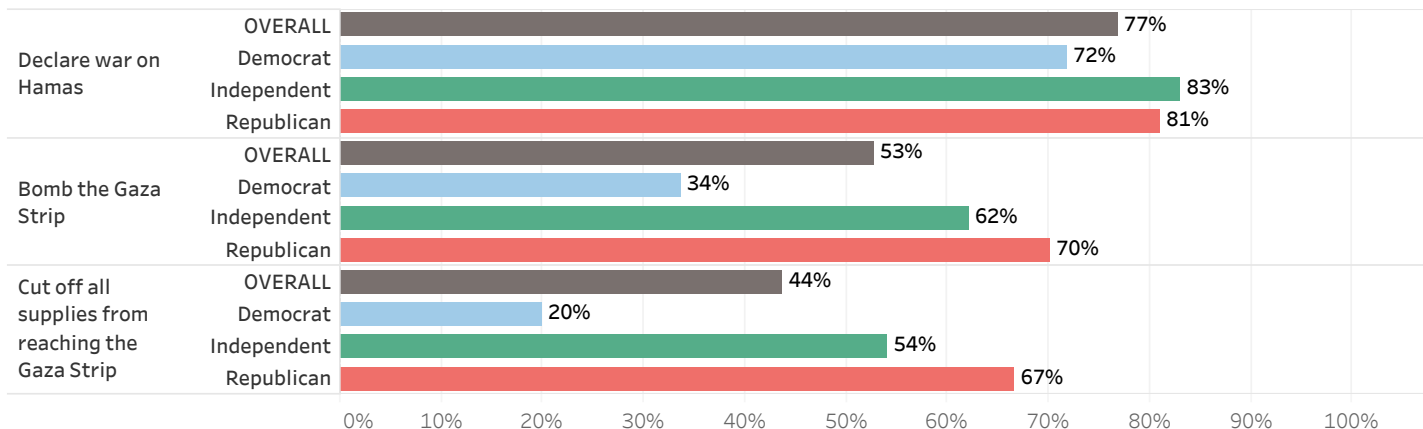
Believe Actions by Israel Definitely or Probably Justified as Response to Hamas 10/7 Attack - October 2023

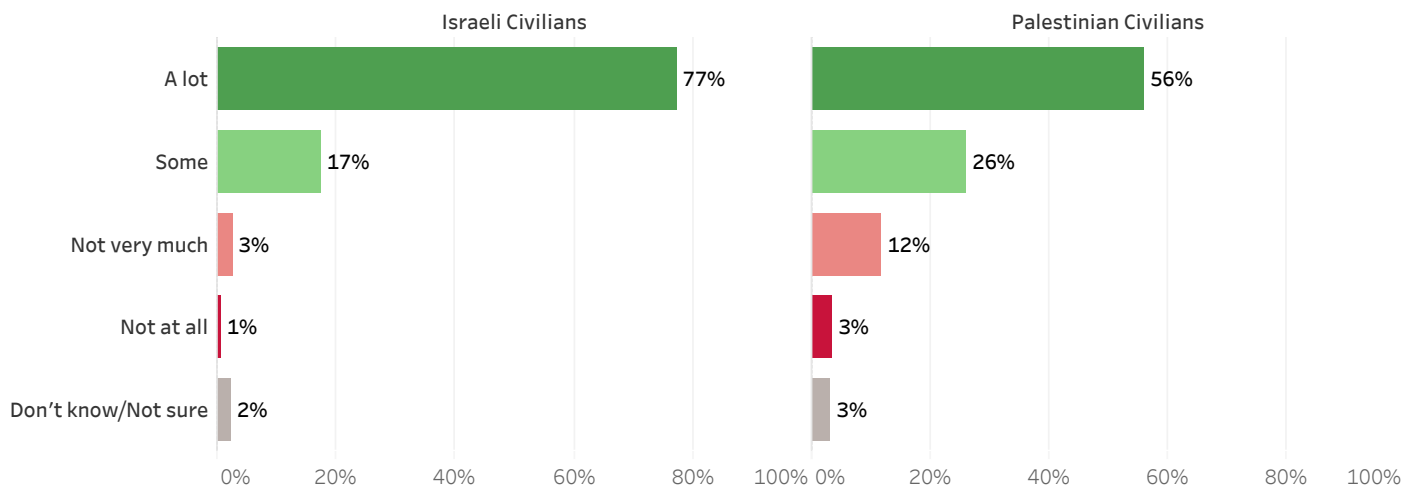
There is bipartisan agreement that Israel was justified in declaring war on Hamas in response to the 10/7 attack. However, while majorities of Republicans and Independents also believe Israel was justified in bombing and cutting off supplies to the Gaza Strip, relatively few Democrats agree.

Believe Actions by Israel Definitely or Probably Justified as Response to Hamas 10/7 Attack - by Party ID - October 2023



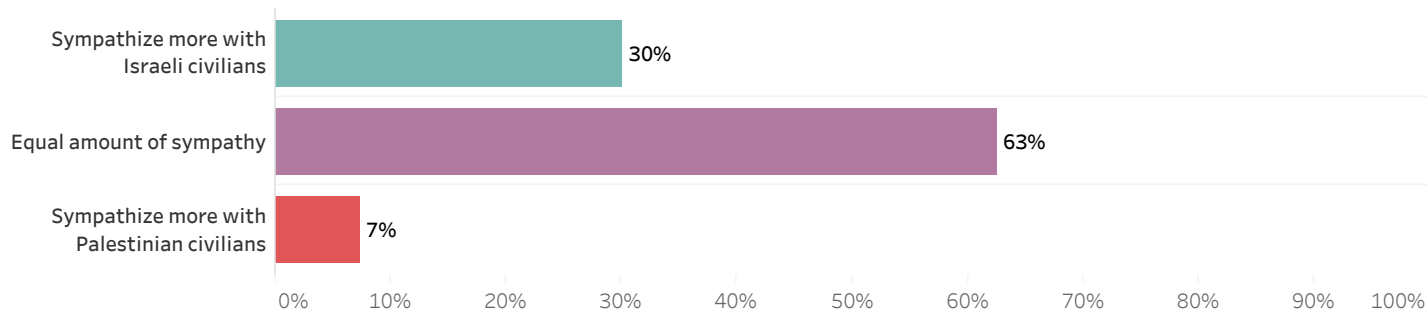
Seventy-seven percent of New Hampshire residents say that they feel a lot of sympathy for Israeli civilians, 17% feel some sympathy, 3% feel not very much sympathy, 1% do not feel any sympathy at all, and 2% are unsure. A small majority (56%) say that they feel a lot of sympathy for Palestinian civilians, 26% feel some sympathy, 12% feel not very much sympathy, 3% do not feel any sympathy at all, and 3% are unsure.

Based on these responses, 30% of Granite Staters say that they have greater sympathy for Israeli civilians than Palestinian civilians, 7% have greater sympathy for Palestinian civilians than Israeli civilians, and 63% have about the same amount of sympathy for both groups. A majority (56%) of self-described conservatives say that they have greater sympathy for Israeli civilians while more than a quarter (27%) of self-described socialists have greater sympathy for Palestinian civilians than for Israeli civilians.

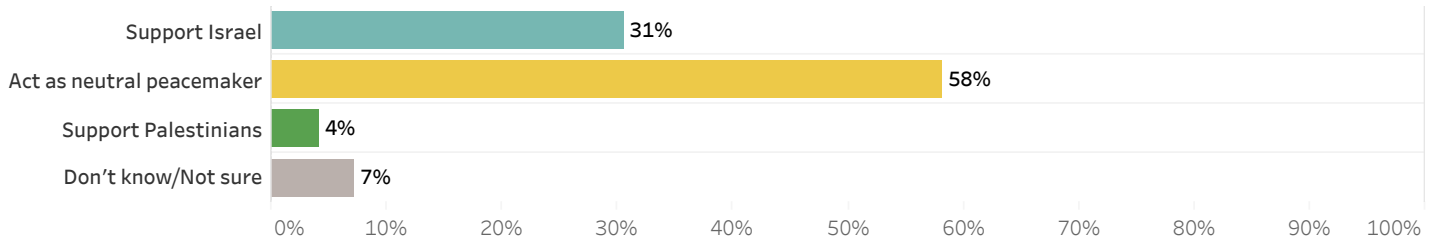
Sympathize with Israeli or Palestinian Citizens More - October 2023



Middle-East Peace Process

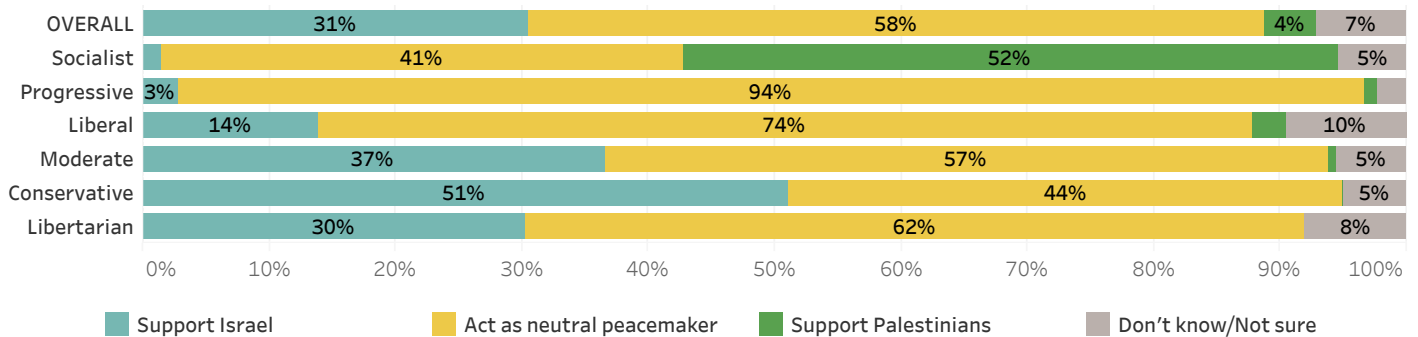
When asked what role they feel the United States should play in the peace process between Israel and the Palestinian territories, 31% of New Hampshire residents feel the United States should support Israel in these negotiations, 58% feel the U.S. should act as a neutral peacemaker, 4% think the U.S. should support the Palestinians, and 7% are unsure.

Desired U.S. Role in Israeli-Palestinian Peace Process - October 2023



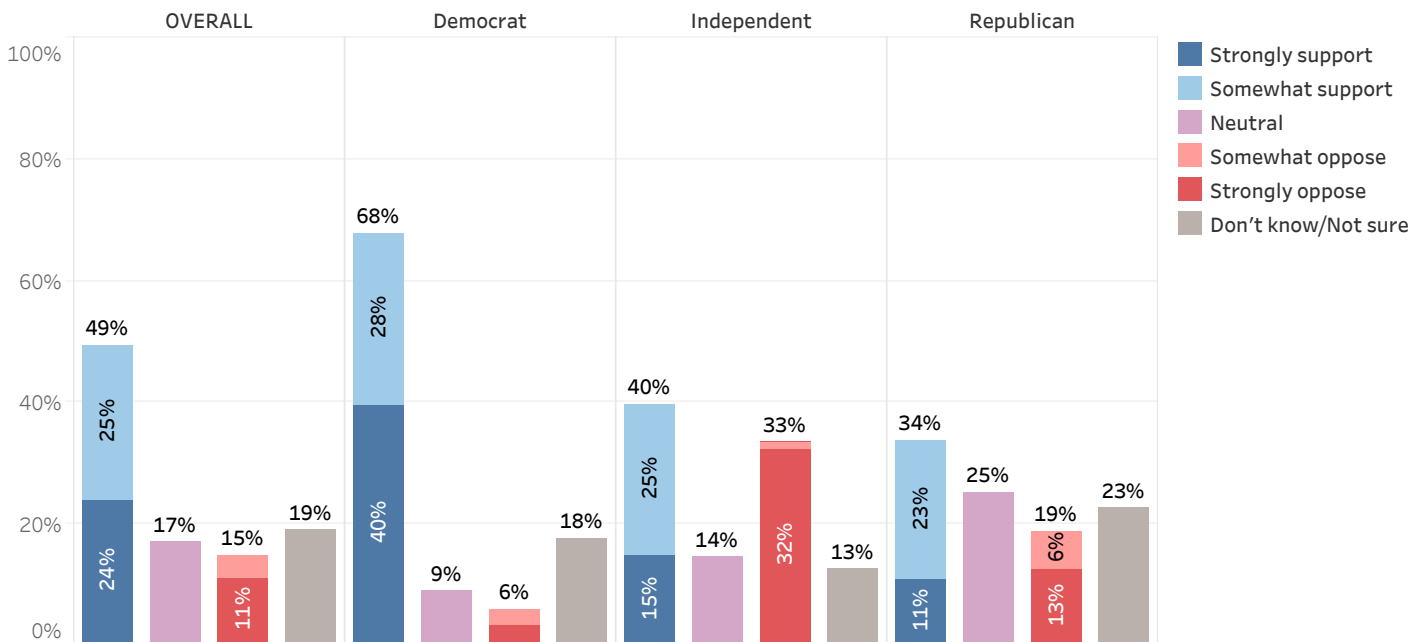
Most self-described progressives (94%) and liberals (74%) and smaller majorities of libertarians (62%) and moderates (57%) want the U.S. to act as a neutral peacemaker in an Israeli-Palestinian peace processes, while a slim majority of conservatives (51%) want the U.S. to support Israel and a majority of socialists (52%) want the U.S. to support the Palestinians.

Current U.S. policy calls for a "two-state" solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, resulting in separate Israeli and Palestinian states with borders similar to the pre-1967 borders. Half (49%) of Granite Staters strongly (24%) or somewhat (25%) support this, 15% are somewhat (4%) or strongly (11%) opposed, 17% are neutral, and 19% are unsure. More than two-thirds (68%) of Democrats support a "two-state" solution but only 40% of Independents and 34% of Republicans agree.

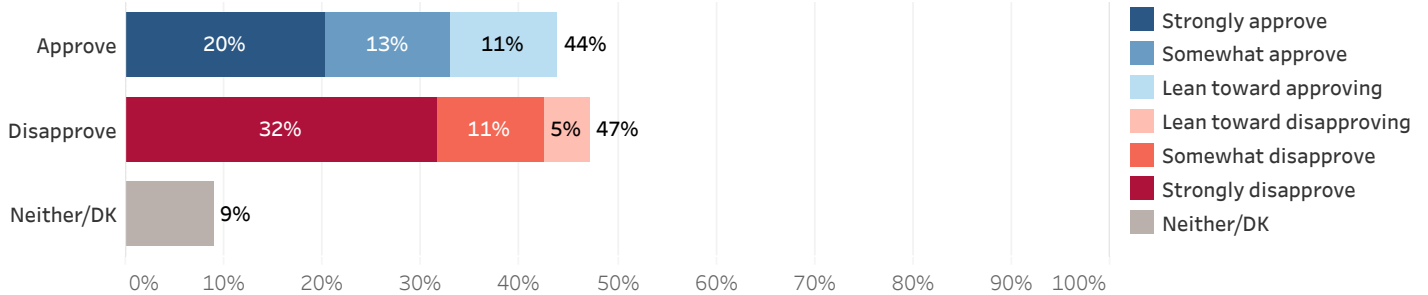
Support Two-State Solution to Israeli-Palestinian Conflict - by Party ID - October 2023



U.S. Foreign Policy

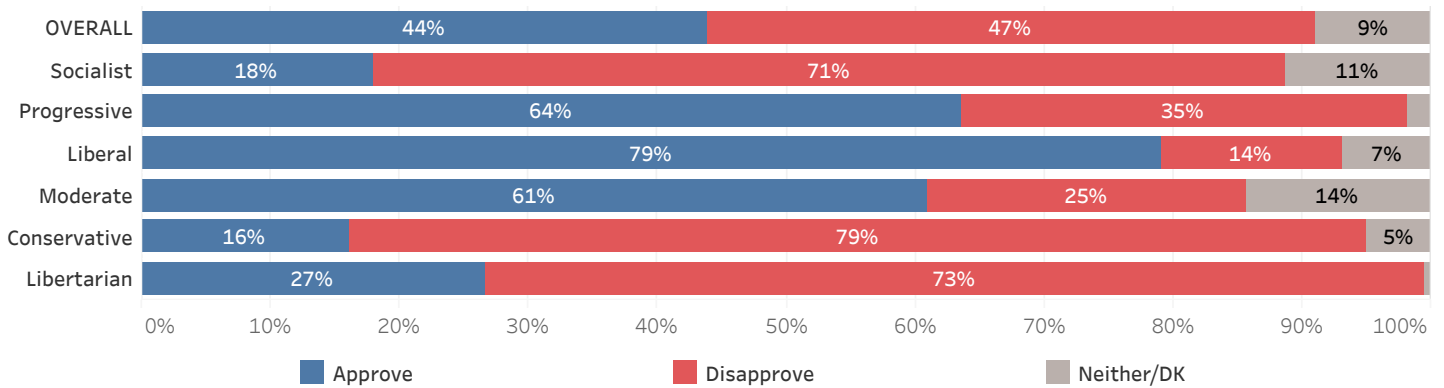
President Joe Biden has affirmed American support for Israel following the attack on October 7th, visited the country to demonstrate American support, and proposed a new aid package for Israel, among other actions. Overall, Granite Staters are divided in their opinions of Biden's handling of American policy on the Israeli-Hamas conflict, with 44% approving of his handling and 47% disapproving.

Biden enjoys majority approval for his handling of the Israeli-Hamas conflict among self-described liberals (79%), progressives (64%), and moderates (61%), but only 27% of libertarians, 18% of socialists, and 16% of conservatives approve.

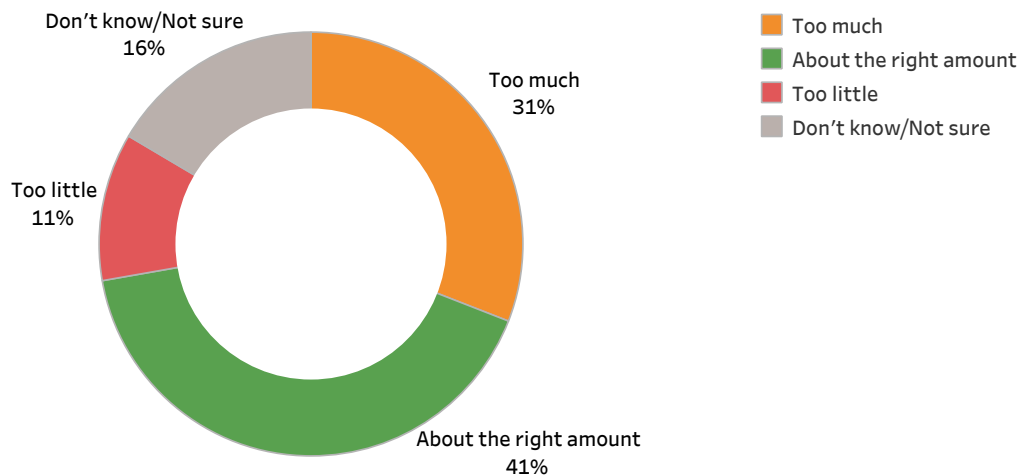
Approval of President Biden's Handling of Israel-Hamas Conflict - by Ideology - October 2023



When asked whether they feel the United States generally supports Israel too much or not enough, 31% of New Hampshire residents think the U.S. supports Israel too much, 41% think the U.S. supports Israel about the right amount, 11% think the U.S. supports Israel too little, and 16% are unsure.

Among left-leaning Granite Staters, majorities of self-described socialists (83%) and progressives (66%) feel the United States generally supports Israel too much, while half (49%) of liberals think the U.S. supports Israel about the right amount. Nearly a quarter (24%) of self-described conservatives think the U.S. supports Israel too little.

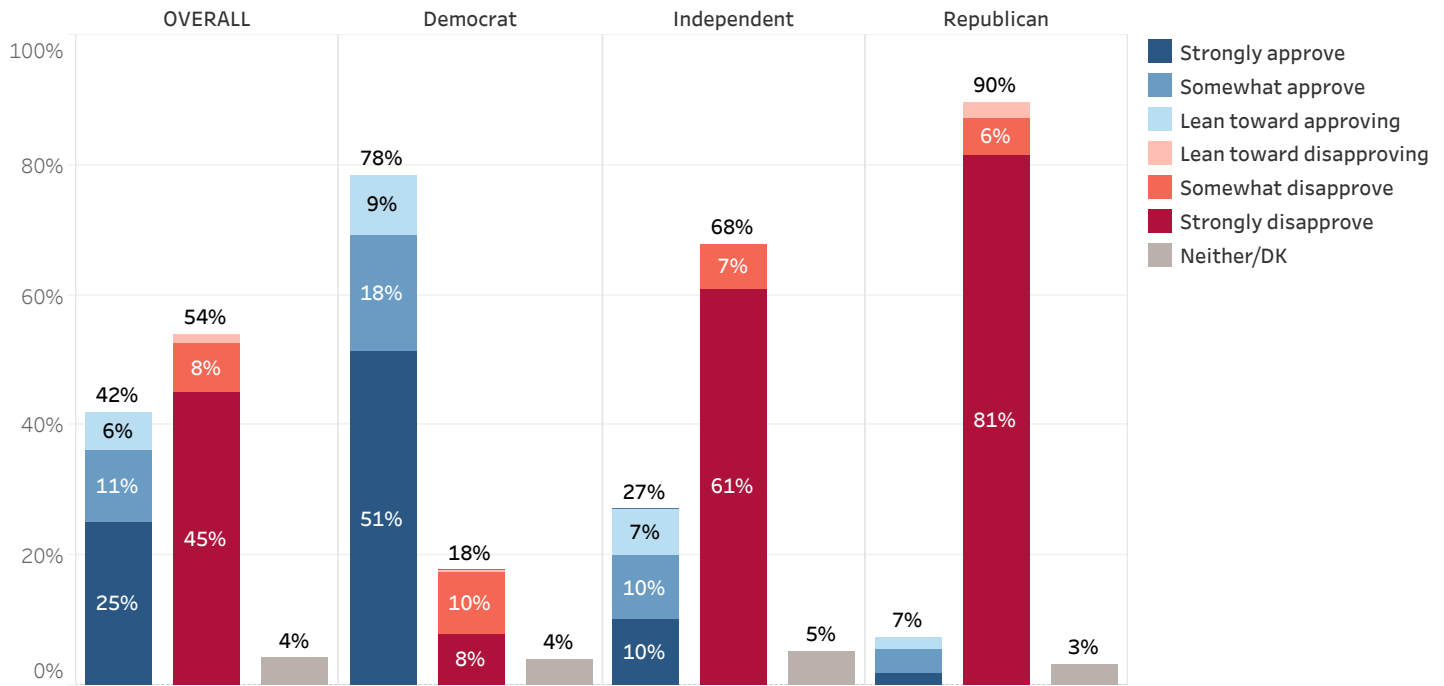
U.S. Support Israel Too Much or Not Enough - October 2023



Overall, 42% of Granite Staters approve of Biden's handling of foreign affairs, 54% disapprove, and 4% are unsure. More than three-quarters (78%) of Democrats approve of Biden's handling of foreign affairs but only 27% of Independents and 7% of Republicans feel that way.

Among those who approve of Biden's handling of the Israel-Hamas conflict, 84% approve of Biden's overall handling of foreign affairs while 15% disapprove. Among those who disapprove of Biden's handling of the Israel-Hamas conflict, 7% approve of Biden's overall handling of foreign affairs while 92% disapprove.

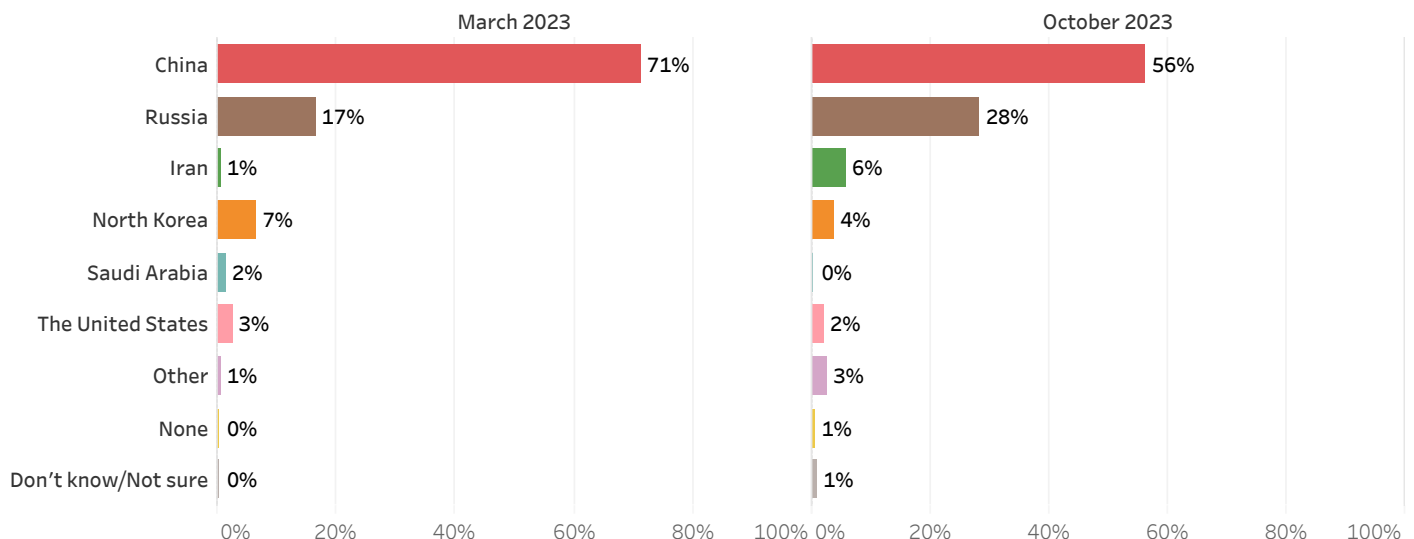
Approval of President Biden's Handling of Foreign Affairs - October 2023



When asked which foreign country they feel is the greatest threat to the United States, 56% of New Hampshire residents mention China, 28% mention Russia, 6% mention Iran, 4% mention North Korea, and less than 1% mention Saudi Arabia. Two percent mention the United States itself, while 3% mention another country. Granite Staters are less likely to mention China than they were in March while they are more likely to mention Russia and slightly more likely to mention Iran.

About three-quarters of Republicans (75%) and Independents (74%) feel that China is the greatest foreign threat to the United States but a majority of Democrats (53%) say that Russia is the greatest threat to the U.S.

Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand, one hundred, and thirty (1,130) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between October 19 and October 23, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.9 percent. In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the October 2023 Granite State Poll is 32%. The design effect for the survey is 2.1%.

The Granite State Panel is a probability-based web panel of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 6,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
