#### TRUMP & BIDEN LEAD COMFORTABLY IN VERMONT PRIMARY RACES; MAJORITY AGREE WITH BALLOT EXCLUSION OF TRUMP IN ME

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
DURHAM, NH - More than half of likely Republican primary voters in Vermont support former President Donald Trump and most of his supporters say that they have definitely decided to vote for him. Trump is followed distantly by former U.N. Ambassador Nikki Haley and former New Jersey Governor Chris Christie. On the Democratic side, which most likely primary voters plan to participate in, three-quarters support President Joe Biden while Minnesota Representative Dean Phillips and author Marianne Williamson garner very little support. Six in ten Vermonters agree with the decision to disqualify Trump from the primary ballot in Maine.

#### 2024 Republican Presidential Primary

Vermont has no party registration and allows voters to choose the primary in which they would like to participate. Currently, among those who say they plan to vote in the primary on March 5, 46% plan to vote in the Democratic primary, 28% plan to vote in the Republican primary, and 25% are unsure.


In the Republican primary, former President Donald Trump holds a wide lead with 47% of the vote, followed distantly by former UN Ambassador Nikki Haley (19%). Less than 10% support former New Jersey Governor Chris Christie (9%), Florida Governor Ron DeSantis (3%), or entrepreneur Vivek Ramaswamy (2%). Compared to April 2023, Haley (+17 percentage points) has seen her support increase while DeSantis (-29) has seen his support decline considerably.

#### First Choice GOP 2024 Presidential Candidate



Nearly half (48%) of likely 2024 Republican primary voters say they have definitely decided who they will vote for, 33% say they are currently leaning towards someone, and 17% say they are still trying to decide. Nearly two-thirds (65%) of Trump supporters say they have definitely decided to support him.


#### Definitely Decided on 2024 GOP Presidential Primary Nominee Choice - January 2024



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
When asked which candidate is their second choice, 25% of likely Vermont Republican primary voters choose Ramaswamy, followed by Christie (18%), DeSantis (15%), Haley (10%), and Trump (8%). Nine percent say that they don't have a second choice while 5% are unsure.

Among those who support Trump, 44% say Ramaswamy is their second choice and 19% choose DeSantis. Among Haley supporters, 55% say that Christie is their second choice, while 21% choose DeSantis.




Trump is by far the most personally popular candidate among likely 2024 Republican Vermont presidential primary voters. Fifty-seven percent of likely Republican primary voters have a favorable opinion of Trump, 37% have an unfavorable opinion of him, and 6% are neutral. Trump's net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion) is +20, down from +51 in April 2023. Likely Republican primary voters have a mostly neutral opinion of Ramaswamy (+0), DeSantis (-4), and Haley (-9), while they have a negative opinion of Christie (-48). DeSantis, Haley, and Trump have seen their net favorability among likely Republican primary voters fall significantly since April 2023.

Favorability - Potential 2024 Republican Candidates - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - January 2024








#### **Trump Election Disqualification**


In recent months, legal challenges have been made to disqualify Donald Trump from being able to run for president, citing the 14th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution. However, only 28% of Vermont residents say that they understand the 14th Amendment very well regarding whether a person is eligible to run for president of the United States while another 46% say they understand it somewhat well

Recently, Maine Secretary of State Shenna Bellows ruled that Donald Trump is ineligible to run in the state's presidential primary, citing the 14th Amendment. Six in ten (59%) Vermont residents strongly (50%) or somewhat (10%) support Bellows' decision, 29% strongly (24%) or somewhat (5%) oppose it, 2% are neutral, and 9% are unsure. Eighty-four percent of Democrats and 59% of Independents support Bellows' decision but three-quarters (76%) of Republicans oppose it.




Support or Oppose Decision to Disqualify Trump from Maine Primary Ballot - by Party ID - January 2024

Twenty-six percent of Vermont residents believe that partisan politics factored a lot in the decision to disqualify Trump from the Maine primary ballot, 20% think partisan politics factored in some, 17% think it factored in not very much, 23% think it factored in not at all, and 14% are unsure. Among those who support the decision to disqualify Trump (N=536), six in ten (61%) think that partisan politics factored not very much or not at all into the decision. Among those who oppose the decision to disqualify Trump (N=264), 93% think partisan politics factored in a lot or some.




Two-thirds (66%) of Vermont residents feel that Trump bears a great deal of responsibility for what happened at the U.S. Capitol on January 6th, 2021, 8% think he bears a good amount of responsibility, 8% think he bears not very much responsibility, and 16% think he bears no responsibility at all. Nearly all (>99%) Democrats and 68% of Independents feel Trump bears a great deal or a good amount of responsibility but only 22% of Republicans feel that way.




#### 2024 Democratic Presidential Primary

President Joe Biden holds a dominant lead in the 2024 Democratic Presidential Primary in Vermont. Three-quarters (76%) of Vermonters who plan to vote in the Democratic primary support Biden, 4% support Marianne Williamson, 3% support Dean Phillips, 10% support another candidate, and 7% are unsure. Support for Biden is highest among self-described liberals while support for Williamson is highest among socialists and support for Phillips is highest among moderates. Biden also does notably worse among those aged 18 to 34 than among older voters in Vermont.



First Choice DEM 2024 Presidential Candidate - January 2024


More than half (59%) of likely 2024 Democratic primary voters say they have definitely decided who they will vote for, while 19% say they are leaning toward someone and 17% are still trying to decide. A majority (66%) of Biden supporters say they have definitely decided while 44% of Phillips supporters and 30% of Williamson supporters say they have definitely decided.

Sixty-six percent of likely 2024 Democratic New Hampshire presidential primary voters have a favorable opinion of Biden, 19% have a neutral opinion of him, and 13% have an unfavorable opinion of him. Biden's net favorability rating among likely Democratic primary voters is +53. Biden is less personally popular among those under the age of 50 and self-described socialists and progressives.

Biden's two opponents are unpopular or unknown among likely Democratic primary voters: only 6% have a favorable opinion of Phillips, 14% have a neutral opinion, 19% have an unfavorable opinion, and 61% don't know enough about Phillips to have an opinion. Only 5% have a favorable opinion of Williamson, 9% are neutral, 39% have an unfavorable opinion, and 47% don't know enough to have an opinion.




Favorability - 2024 Democratic Candidates - Among Likely DEM 2024 Primary Voters - January 2024

#### **Presidential Approval**

A majority (54%) of Vermonters approve of Biden's handling of his job as president, 46% disapprove, and 2% are unsure. Biden's net approval rating (the percentage who approve of his handling his job as president minus the percent who disapprove) is +8, Biden's lowest net approval rating since July 2022 (+3).

Eighty-one percent of Democrats approve of Biden's performance as president but only 29% of Independents and 5% of Republicans approve. The proportion of Democrats who approve of Biden's performance (81%) has declined since October 2023 (92%).



#### **Green Mountain State Poll Methodology**

These findings are based on the latest Green Mountain State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Nine hundred four (904) Green Mountain State Panel members completed the survey online between January 4 and January 8, 2024. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.3 percent. Included in the sample were 242 likely 2024 Republican Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 6.3 percent) and 393 likely 2024 Democratic Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 4.9 percent). There were 219 unweighted likely Republican Primary voters and 455 unweighted likely Democratic Primary voters. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the January 2023 Green Mountain State Poll is 34%. The design effect for the survey is 2.2%.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as to 2020 election results in Vermont.

The Green Mountain State Panel is part of an effort by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center to investigate new ways of gathering and understanding the opinion of Vermont residents. Approximately 3,000 Vermont adults have been recruited from randomly-selected landline and cell phone numbers to participate in the panel. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
