BIDEN COMFORTABLE IN NH DEM PRIMARY DESPITE ANGER FROM YOUNG VOTERS

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
DURHAM, NH - President Joe Biden is heading to victory as a write-in candidate in New Hampshire. Aspiring contenders Minnesota Representative Dean Phillips and author Marianne Williamson remain unknown and unpopular in the state. However, Biden fares poorly among self-described socialists and those under thirty-five, many of whom say they would be angry if Biden becomes the nominee. A sign of trouble for November is that less than half of Democratic primary voters think Biden is the party's best hope to win the general election, although there is no consensus about an alternative candidate.

2024 Democratic Presidential Primary

The New Hampshire Democratic primary will take place on Tuesday, despite rule changes by the Democratic National Committee (DNC) to move South Carolina ahead of New Hampshire. As a result, President Joe Biden did not put his name on the ballot and the DNC has stripped the state of its delegates to the Democratic National Convention, even going so far as to declare the contest "meaningless." However, several New Hampshire Democrats have launched a write-in campaign for Biden.

With only days remaining, Biden continues to hold a large lead over his Democratic challengers. Sixty-three percent of likely Democratic primary voters say that they plan to write in Biden's name on their ballot, 10% plan to vote for Minnesota Representative Dean Phillips, 9% will vote for author Marianne Williamson, 11% named some candidate, and 6% are still unsure. Support for Biden is slightly lower than in early January (69%) while Williamson and Phillips have seen no movement at all despite spending significant time in the state. Support for Biden is lowest among self-described socialists (22%) and those aged 18 to 34 (35%).


First Choice DEM 2024 Presidential Candidate - Likely DEM Primary Voters


Some analysts have predicted low turnout in the Democratic primary since the primary is not sanctioned, Biden is not campaigning in New Hampshire, and there is a competitive Republican primary which will draw more undeclared voters. Currently, among the undeclared voters who plan to vote in a primary, 60% say they will vote in the Republican primary while 38% plan to vote in the Democratic primary. In addition, among those who voted in the 2020 Democratic primary (N=1,034), only 67% say they plan to vote in the Republican primary, and 13% are unlikely to vote in either primary.

Voting Plan for 2024 Primary Elections - Among 2020 DEM Primary Voters - January 19, 2024




Nine in ten (91%) likely 2024 Democratic primary voters say that they are aware that President Biden will not appear on the 2024 New Hampshire Democratic Primary ballot, while only 8% were not previously aware of this fact. The percentage who were previously aware of this (91%) has increased since November (77%). Those aged 18-34 (84%) are less likely to have been previously aware that Biden will not be on the ballot than older voters.

Three-quarters (76%) of likely 2024 Democratic primary voters say they have definitely decided who they will vote for, up from 66% in November, while 17% say they are leaning toward someone and only 7% are still trying to decide. Almost all Biden supporters (92%) say they have definitely decided while 43% of Phillips supporters and only 11% of Williamson supporters say they have definitely decided.


Definitely Decided on 2024 DEM Presidential Primary Nominee Choice - Likely DEM Primary Voters - January 19, 2024



Only 31% percent of likely Democratic primary voters say they will be enthusiastic if Biden is the Democratic nominee, 39% will be satisfied, 13% will be dissatisfied, and 13% will be angry. Forty-three percent say they will be dissatisfied (31%) or angry (12%) if Phillips is the Democratic nominee, while more than half (58%) would be dissatisfied (39%) or angry (19%) if Williamson is the nominee.


Among Biden supporters, 47% say they would be enthusiastic if he were the nominee while 49% would be satisfied.

Support for Biden is not consistent among Democratic voters: 44% of self-described moderates and 40% of liberals say they would be enthusiastic if Biden is the 2024 nominee but only 25% of progressives and 9% of socialists are enthusiastic. Similarly, 56% of those aged 65 and older and 45% of those aged 50 to 64 are enthusiastic about Biden as the nominee but only 23% of those aged 35 to 49 and 6% of those aged 18 to 34 would be enthusiastic. Forty-four percent of self-described socialists and 29% of those aged 18 to 34 say they would be angry if Biden were the nominee, up from only 7% of socialists and 4% of those aged 18 to 34 who felt that way in November.

Sixty percent of likely 2024 Democratic New Hampshire presidential primary voters have a favorable opinion of Biden, 20% have a neutral opinion of him, and 20% have an unfavorable opinion of him. Biden's net favorability rating among likely Democratic primary voters is +40, down from +51 in early January. Biden's two opponents are far less popular among likely Democratic primary voters: only 14% have a favorable opinion of Phillips, 27% have a neutral opinion, 28% have an unfavorable opinion, and 31% don't know enough about him to say. Only 7% have a favorable opinion of Williamson, 23% are neutral, 43% have an unfavorable opinion, and 26% don't know enough to have an opinion.


Net Favorability - 2024 Democratic Candidates - Among Likely DEM 2024 Primary Voters



Assessment of Biden


Seven in ten (71%) likely Democratic primary voters believe that Biden has helped the country in his time as president, 16% think he has done more to hurt the country, and 11% think he has not made much of a difference. Almost all of Biden supporters (93%) believe he has done more to help the country but only 33% of those who support another candidate in the primary feel that way. Among all Granite Staters, only 36% think Biden has done more to help the country during his time as president so far while 51% feel he has done more to hurt the country and 12% think he has not made much of a difference.

Biden Helped or Hurt Country as President - January 19, 2024




Only 46% of likely Democratic primary voters think that the Democratic Party has a better chance of winning with Joe Biden as the party's nominee, down from 54% in November. Thirty-nine percent think the Democratic Party would have a better chance with someone else as the nominee and 15% are unsure. Only 15% of self-described socialists and 23% of those aged 18 to 34 think Biden is the Democratic Party's best option to win.

Better Chance for Democratic Party to Win General Election with Biden or Other Candidate - Likely DEM Primary Voters




Despite the fact that only 39% of likely Democratic primary voters think the Democratic Party has a better chance of winning the general election with a nominee other than Biden, those who believe this do not have a clear alternative: 28% say Phillips is the candidate that gives Democrats a better chance to win in November, 7% mention Vermont Senator Bernie Sanders, and 6% say California Governor Gavin Newsom. Twenty-four percent mention other candidates while 10% are unsure.



Assessment of the Country

The Biden campaign has been focused on painting Donald Trump as a threat to democracy and this message has resonated with New Hampshire Democrats. Eighty percent of likely 2024 Democratic primary voters believe that American democracy is under attack, 16% feel that American democracy is being tested but is not under attack, and only 2% feel that American democracy is not in danger.


Status of American Democracy - Likely DEM Primary Voters - January 19, 2024



Granite Staters overall are somewhat less concerned about the status of American democracy: 72% of state residents believe that American democracy is under attack, 21% feel that American democracy is being tested but is not under attack, and 4% feel that American democracy is not in danger.

Self-identified Democrats (78%) are more likely than Republicans (69%) and Independents (58%) to believe that American democracy is under attack.

CNN New Hampshire Primary Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest CNN New Hampshire Primary Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Two thousand, three hundred and forty-eight (2,348) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between January 16 and January 19, 2024. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.0 percent. Included in the sample were 775 likely 2024 Democratic Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 3.5 percent). There were 838 unweighted likely Democratic Primary voters. In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for this CNN New Hampshire Primary Poll is 38%. The design effect for the survey is 2.1%.

The Granite State Panel is a probability-based web panel of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 7,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents. The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
