BIDEN COMFORTABLY LEADS TRUMP IN RHODE ISLAND DESPITE LOW JOB APPROVAL

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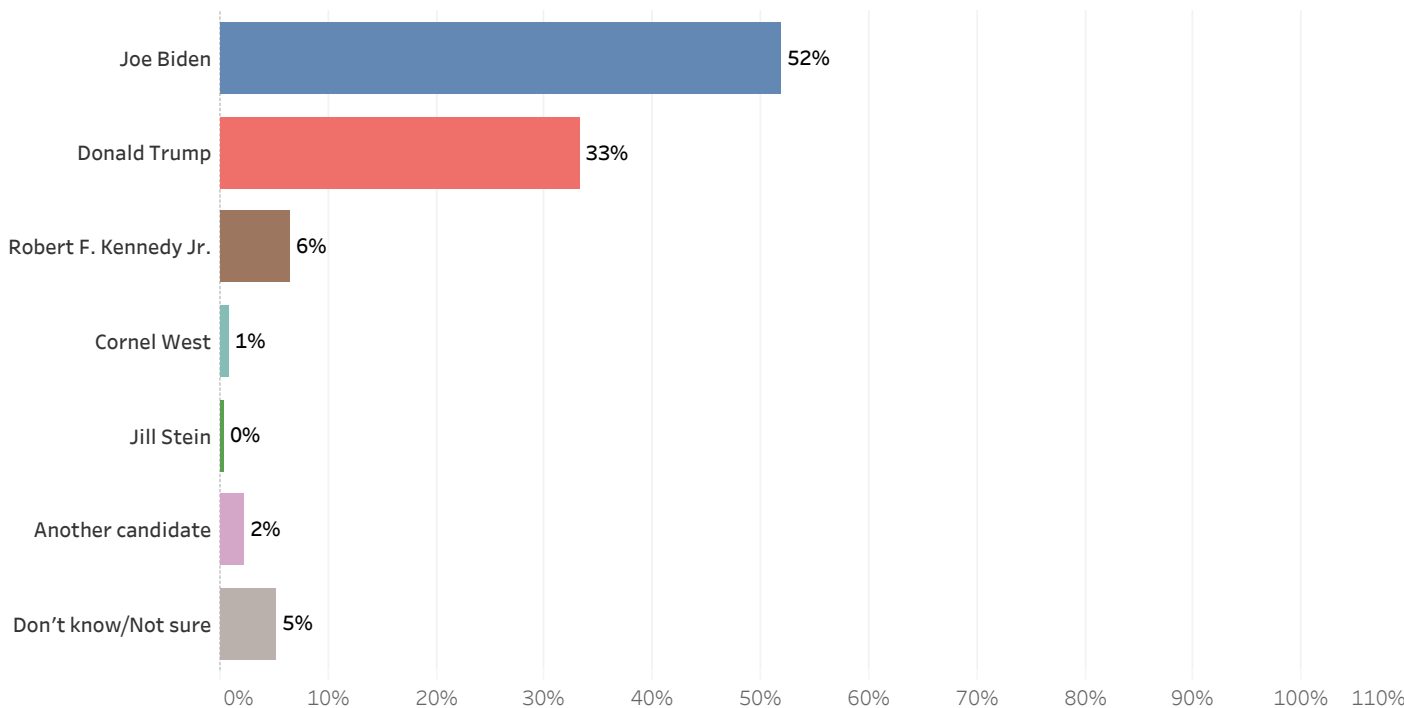
DURHAM, NH - More than half of likely voters in Rhode Island plan to vote for President Joe Biden in the 2024 presidential election. However, a majority of Rhode Islanders disapprove of Biden's performance as president, many citing his handling of immigration as a reason they disapprove. Donald Trump is an unpopular figure in Rhode Island and nearly-two thirds believe Trump is guilty in his "hush money" case. Rhode Islanders generally support protestors on campuses carrying out strikes or walkouts but think it is unacceptable to put up tents, occupy buildings, or state that Israel has no right to exist.

2024 Presidential Race

More than half (52%) of likely general election voters in Rhode Island say that if the election were held today, they would vote for Biden, 33% would vote for Trump, 6% would vote for Independent Robert F. Kennedy Jr., 1% would vote for Independent Cornel West, less than 1% would vote for Green Party candidate Jill Stein, 2% would vote for another candidate, and 5% are unsure. If they could vote only for Biden or Trump, 60% say that they would vote for Biden and 40% would vote for Trump. Overall, 82% say that they have definitely decided who they will vote for, 14% say they are leaning toward someone, and 5% are still trying to decide. Ninety-two percent of Biden supporters and 85% of Trump supporters say they have definitely decided but only 12% of supporters of other candidates have definitely decided.

Almost all self-described conservatives (95%) support Trump, similarly, 93% of liberals and 91% of progressives support Biden. Kennedy draws his support from self-described socialists (18%) and libertarians (13%). Trump holds a small lead among those aged 35 to 49 but Biden holds clear leads among all other age groups. More than two-thirds (68%) of women in Rhode Island support Biden but only 34% of men support him.

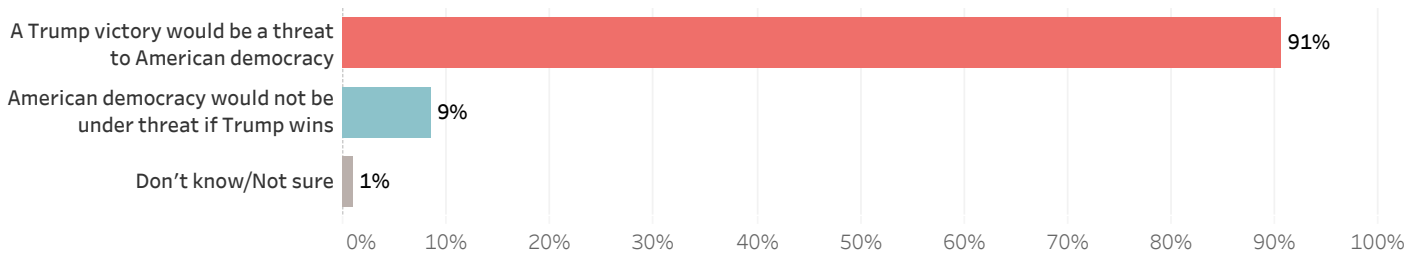
2024 Presidential General Election Matchup - May 2024

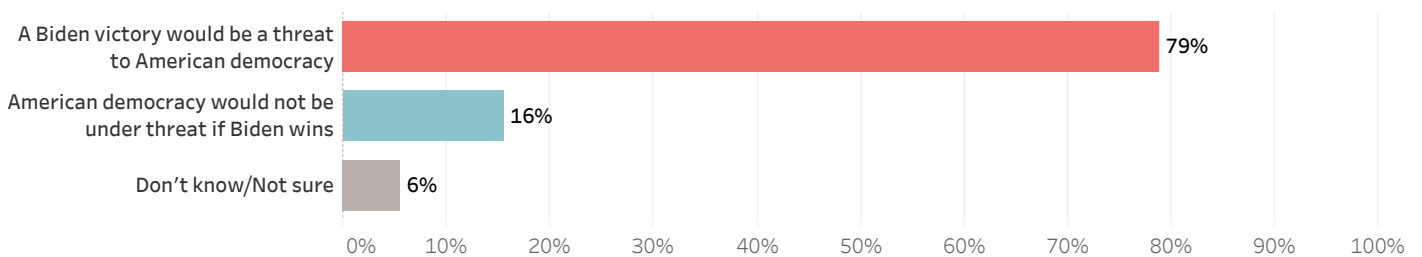
President Biden has been focusing his campaign on the idea that Trump is a threat to democracy. Among those who do not support Trump (N=332), 91% believe a Trump victory would be a threat to American democracy while only 9% feel American democracy would not be under threat if Trump wins.

Effect on American Democracy if Trump Wins - Among Non-Trump Supporters - May 2024



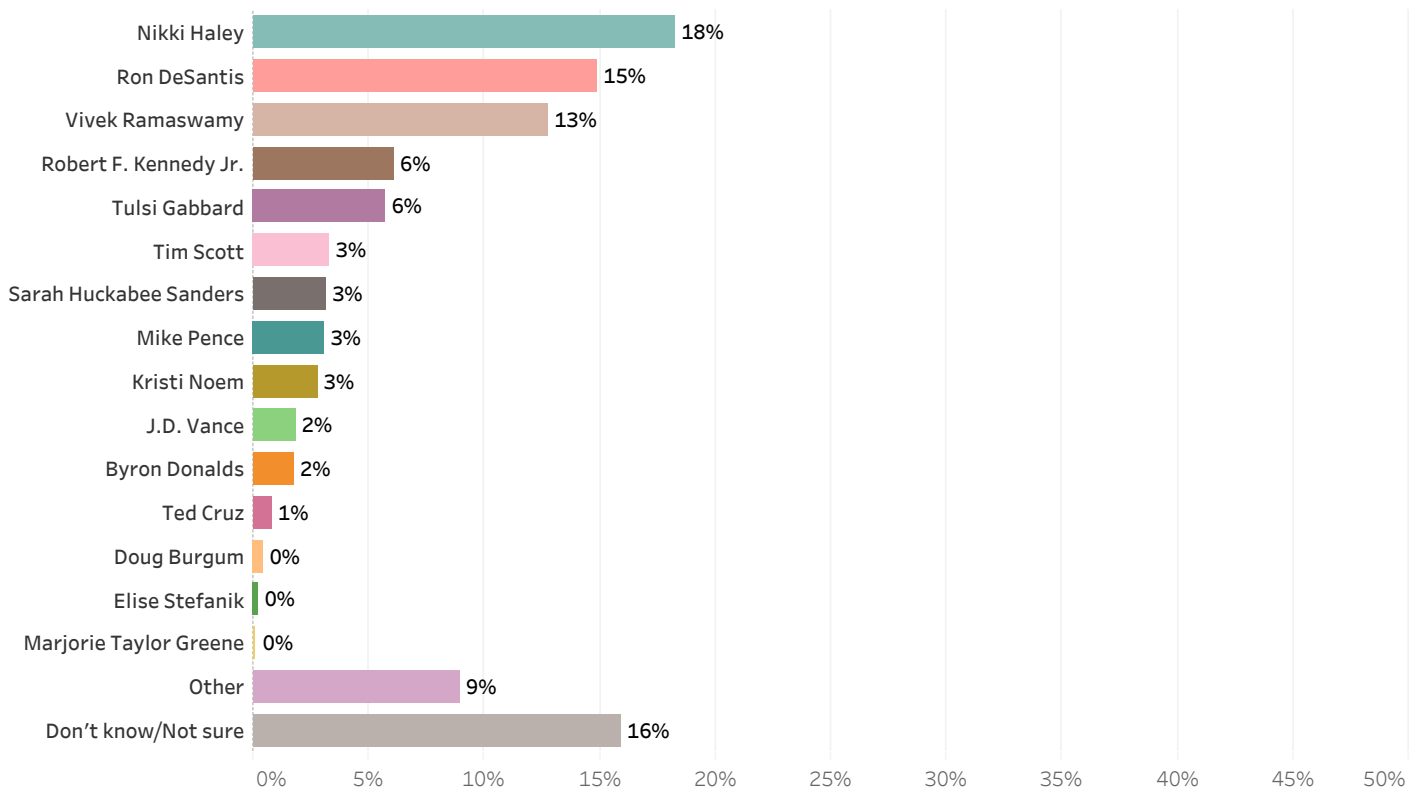
But opponents of Biden are similarly concerned about the threat of a Biden victory. Among those who do not support Biden (N=232), 79% believe a Biden victory would be a threat to American democracy while 16% feel American democracy would not be under threat if Biden wins.

Those who do not support Biden were asked who they would like to see Trump choose as his vice-presidential nominee, but there is no clear favorite. Respondents were most likely to mention former U.N. Ambassador Nikki Haley (18%), Florida Governor Ron DeSantis (15%), entrepreneur Vivek Ramaswamy (13%), Independent presidential candidate Robert F. Kennedy Jr. (6%), and former Hawaii Congresswoman Tulsi Gabbard (6%).

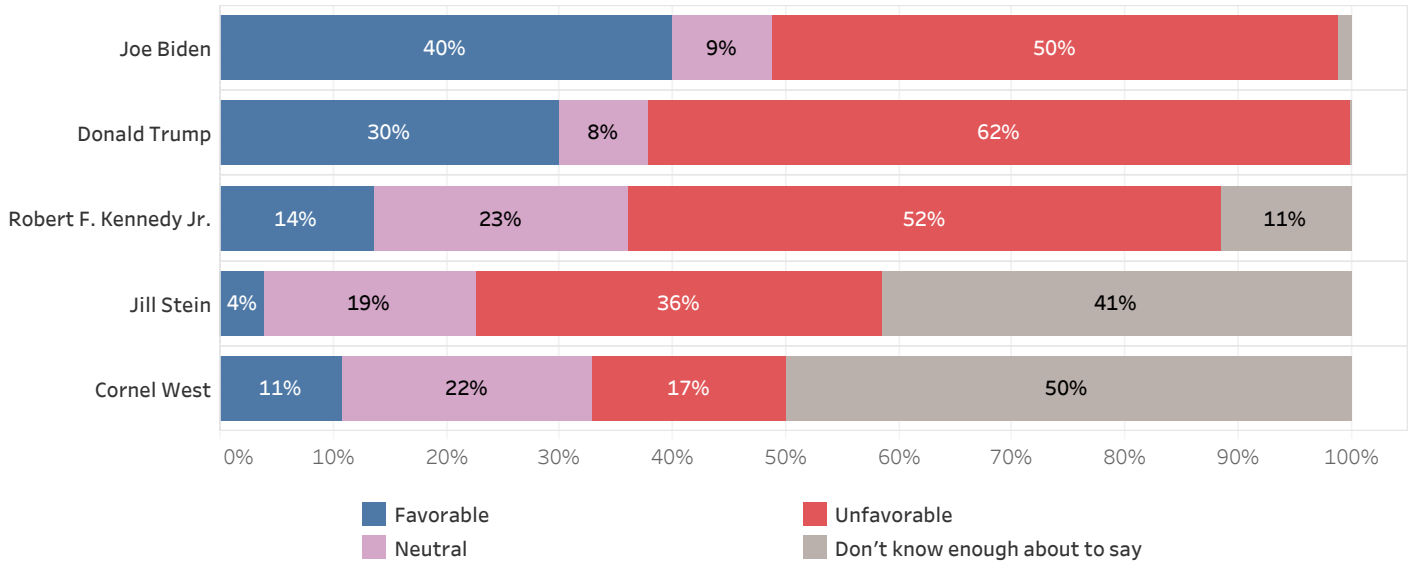
Preferred Trump Vice Presidential Nominee - Among Non-Biden Supporters - May 2024



Forty percent of Rhode Islanders have a favorable opinion of Joe Biden, 9% are neutral, and 50% have an unfavorable view of him, yielding a net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion of him minus the percentage who have an unfavorable opinion) of -10. Trump is less popular, as only 30% have a favorable opinion of him, 8% are neutral, and 62% have an unfavorable opinion, yielding a net favorability rating of -32.

Only 14% have a favorable opinion of Kennedy, 23% are neutral, and 52% have an unfavorable view of him, yielding a net favorability rating of -39. Pluralities don't know enough to have an opinion about Stein (41%) and West (50%).

2024 Presidential Candidates Favorability - May 2024

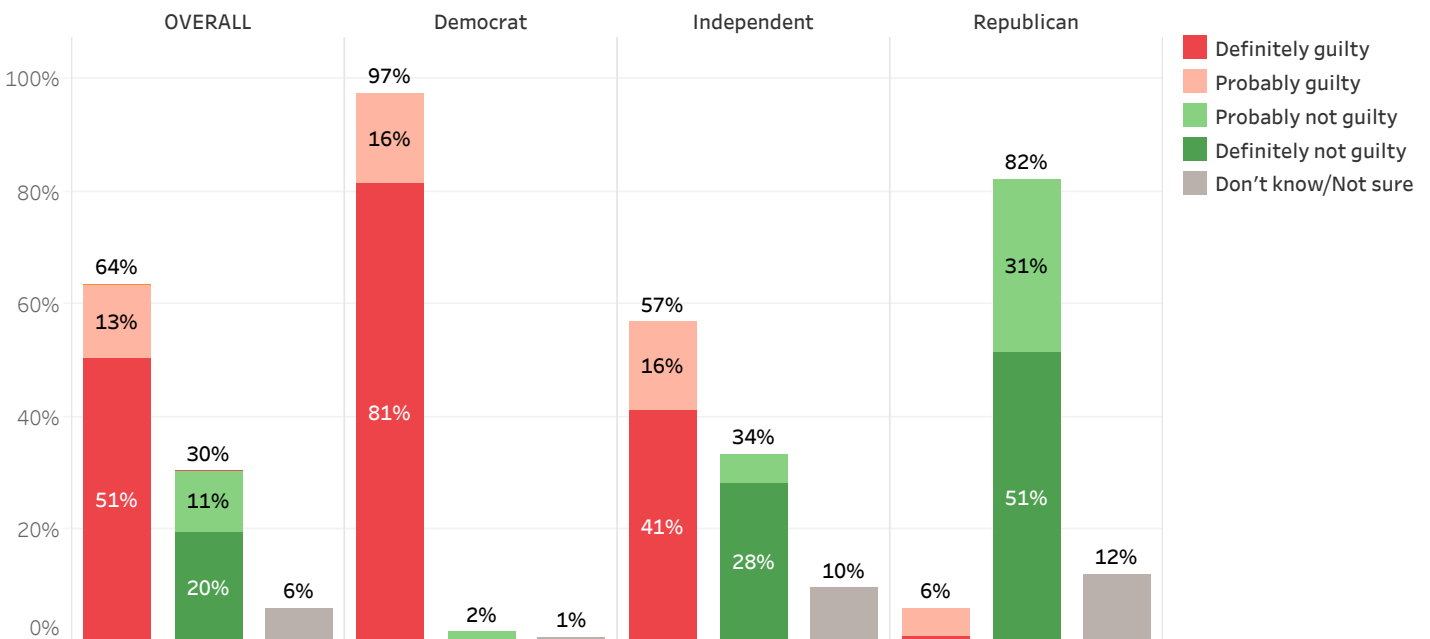


Trump NY "Hush Money" Case

Trump is currently on trial in New York for allegedly falsifying business records to pay "hush money" to Stormy Daniels in the run-up to the 2016 election. Forty-seven percent of Rhode Island residents say that they have heard a lot about this case, 37% have heard some about it, and 16% have heard not very much or nothing at all about it.

Nearly two-thirds (64%) of Rhode Islanders think Trump is definitely (51%) or probably (13%) guilty, 30% believe he is definitely not (20%) or probably not (11%) guilty, and 6% are unsure. Nearly all Democrats (97%) and a majority of Independents (57%) believe Trump is guilty but only 6% of Republicans agree.

Believe Trump is Guilty or Innocent in NY "Hush Money" Case - by Party ID - May 2024

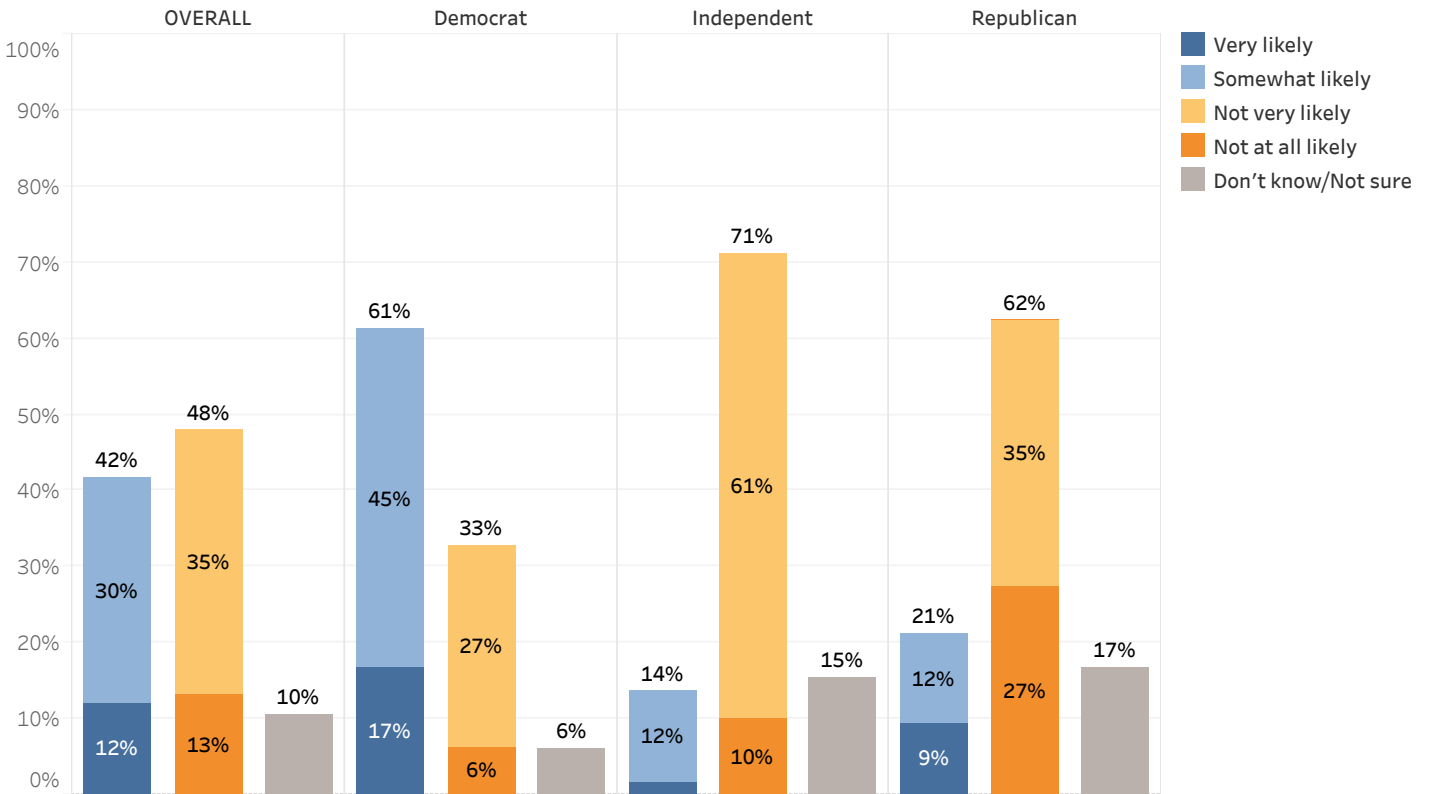


Rhode Island residents are less certain that Trump will be convicted in this case: 12% think Trump is very likely to be convicted, 30% think this is somewhat likely, 35% think it is not very likely, 13% think it is not at all likely, and 10% are unsure. A majority of Democrats (61%) believe Trump is very or somewhat likely to be convicted but only 21% of Republicans and 14% of Independents feel that way.

Overall, 33% feel Trump is guilty and will be convicted, 24% feel he is guilty but will not be convicted, 6% feel he is not guilty but will be convicted, and 17% feel he is not guilty and will not be convicted.

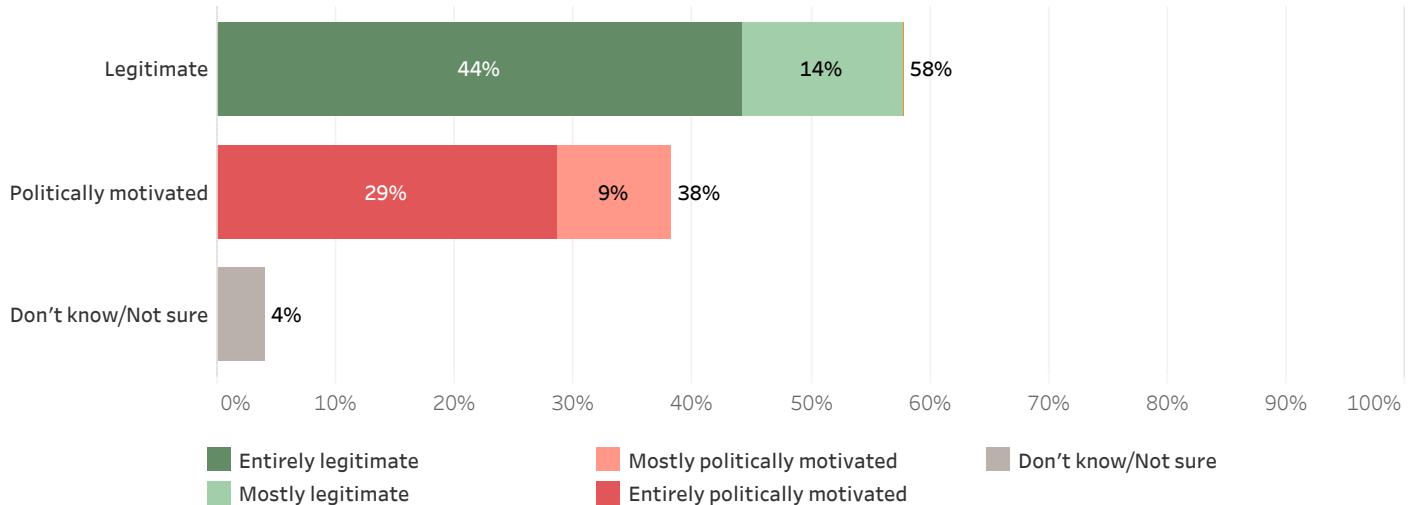
If Trump were to be convicted in this case, 19% of Rhode Islanders say that this would make them more likely to vote for Trump in 2024, 53% say that it would make no difference, and 26% say that it would make them less likely to vote for him.

A majority (58%) of Rhode Island residents believe the decision to prosecute Trump was entirely (44%) or mostly (14%) legitimate, 38% think it was entirely (29%) or mostly (9%) politically motivated, and 4% are unsure. Nearly all Democrats (93%) feel the decision was entirely or mostly legitimate but 95% of Republicans think it was entirely or mostly politically motivated.

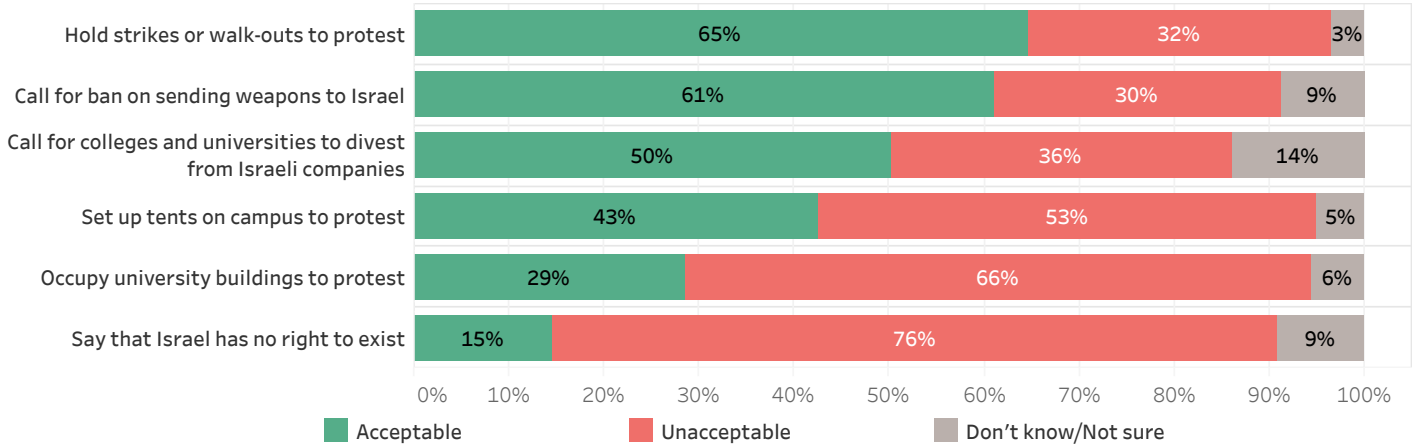
Believe Decision to Prosecute Trump in NY "Hush Money" Case Legitimate or Politically-Motivated - May 2024



Campus Protests Concerning War in Gaza

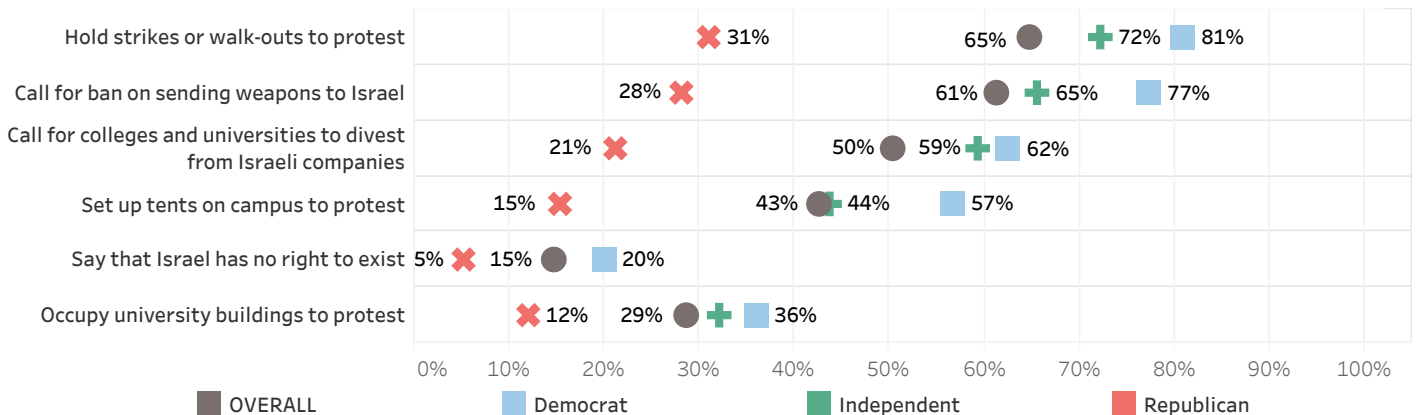
Students at college and university campuses throughout the country have protested Israeli conduct in the current war in Gaza as well as American policy surrounding the conflict. Most Rhode Island residents (65%) think it is acceptable for protestors to hold strikes or walk-outs but majorities think it is unacceptable to set up tents on campus (53%) or to occupy university buildings (66%). In terms of policies they are advocating, 61% think it is acceptable for protestors to call for a ban on sending weapons to Israel and half (50%) think it is acceptable to call for colleges to divest from Israeli companies. However, 76% think it is unacceptable for protestors to say that Israel has no right to exist.

Consider Following Actions by Campus Protestors to be Acceptable or Unacceptable - May 2024



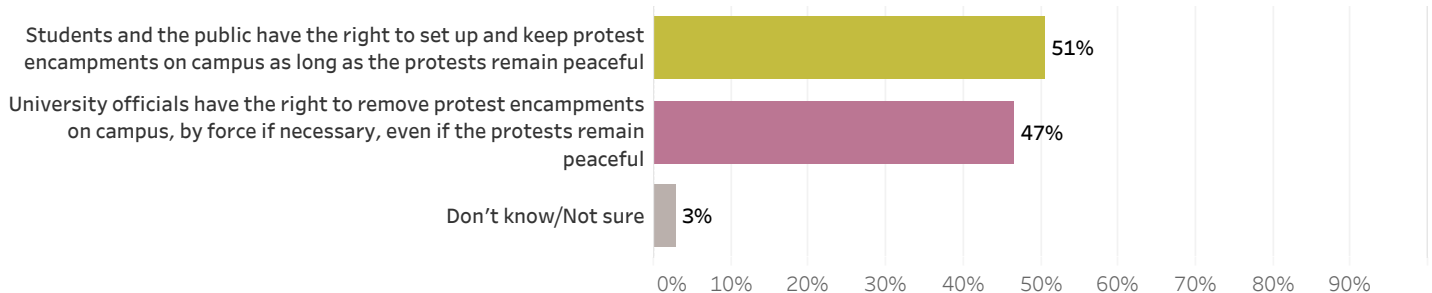
Democrats are significantly more likely than Republicans and Independents to think it is acceptable for campus protestors to hold strikes or walkouts, set up tents on campus, call for a ban on sending weapons to Israel, and call for college and universities to divest from Israeli companies.

Fifty-one percent of Rhode Island residents think students and the public have the right to set up and keep protest encampments on campus as long as the protests remain peaceful while 47% believe university officials have the right to remove protest encampments on campus, by force if necessary, even if the protests remain peaceful. Sixty-eight percent of Democrats believe protest encampments should be allowed as long as they are peaceful but only 20% of Republicans agree.

Comes Closest to Opinion on Tent Protests on College Campuses - May 2024

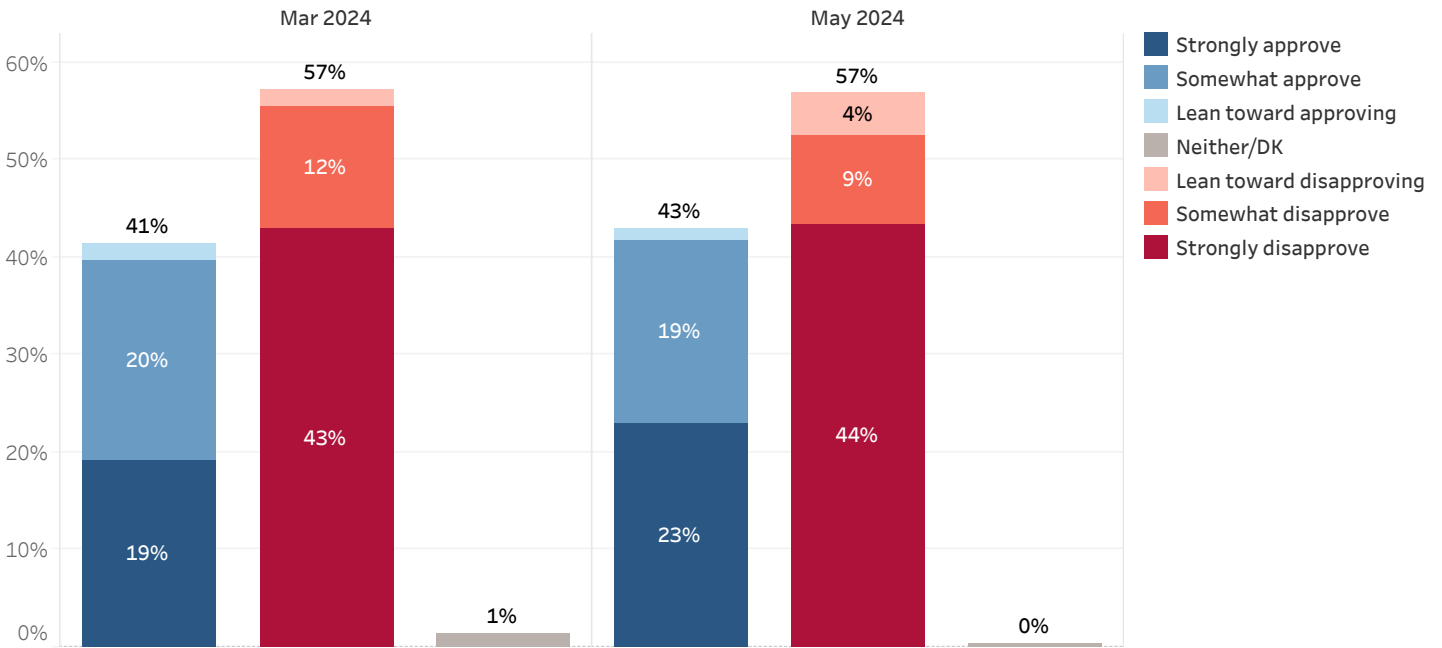


Presidential Approval

Forty-three percent of Rhode Island residents approve of Biden's handling of his job as president, 57% disapprove, and less than 1% are unsure. Biden's net approval rating (the percentage who approve of his handling his job as president minus the percent who disapprove) is -14, largely unchanged compared to March (-16).

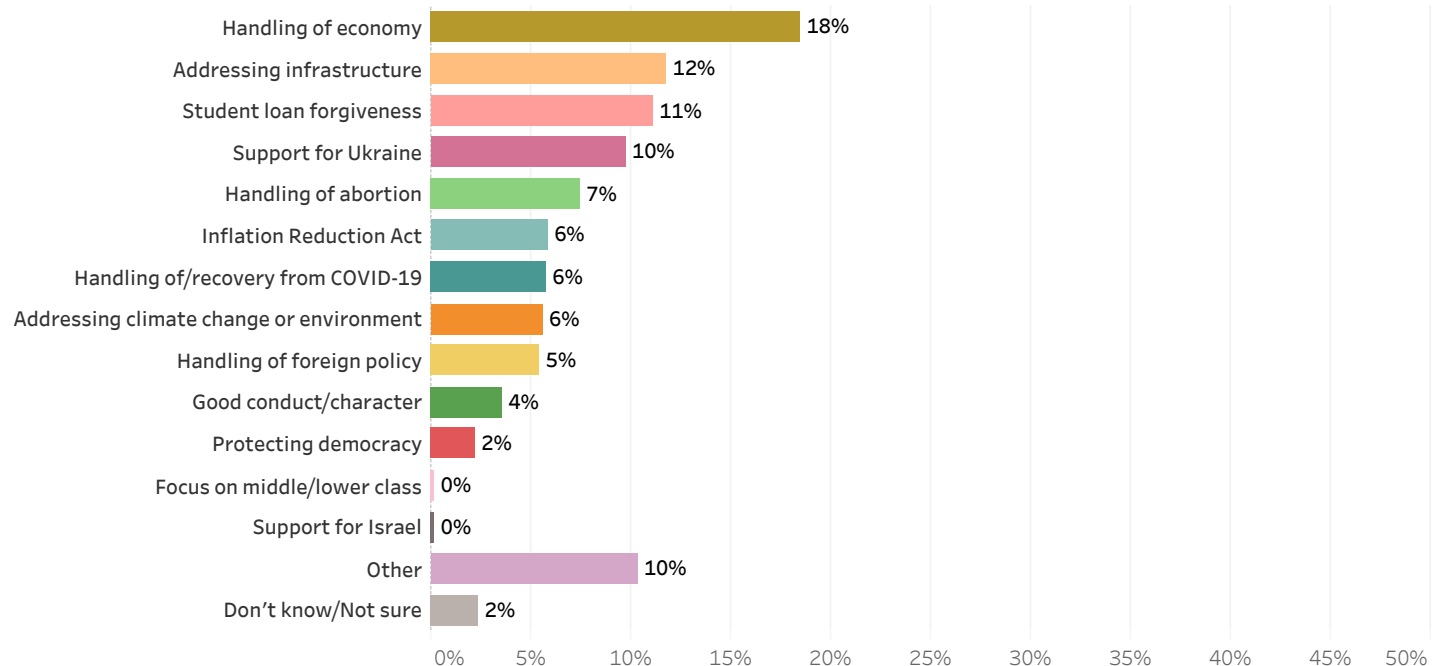
Seventy-five percent of Democrats, approve of Biden's performance as president, up from 69% in March. However, very few Independents (13%) and Republicans (1%) approve of Biden's performance as president.

Approval of President Biden's Job Performance



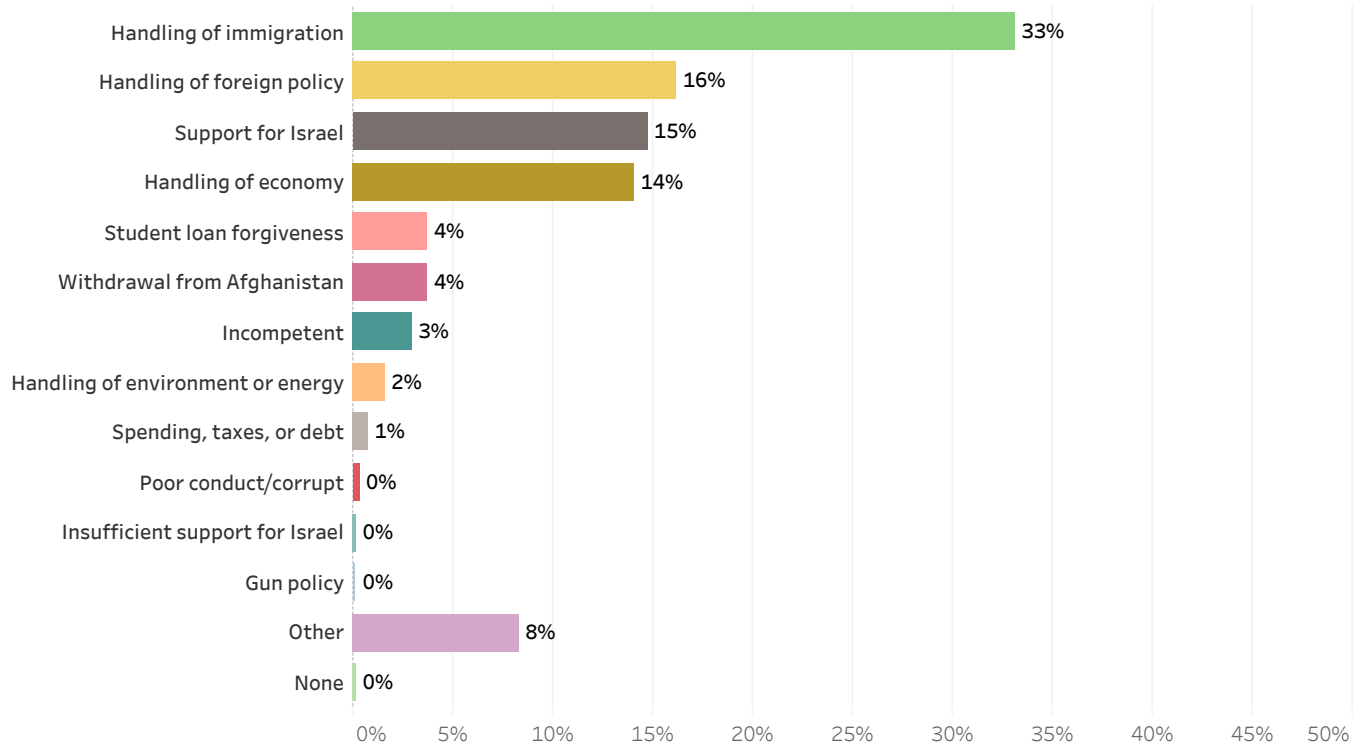
Those who approve of Biden's performance most often mention his handling of the economy (18%), addressing infrastructure (12%), student loan forgiveness (11%), and support for Ukraine (10%) as the most important decisions Biden has made that makes them approve of his job performance, followed by his handling of abortion (7%), the Inflation Reduction Act (6%), his handling of or recovery from COVID-19 (6%), addressing climate change or the environment (6%), and his handling of foreign policy (5%).

Those who disapprove of Biden's performance most often mention Biden's handling of immigration (33%) as the most important decision Biden has made that makes them disapprove of Biden's job performance, followed by Biden's handling of foreign policy (16%), his support for Israel (15%), and handling of the economy (14%).

Ocean State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Ocean State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Six hundred twenty-seven (627) Ocean State Panel members completed the survey online between May 16 and May 20, 2024. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.9 percent. Included in the sample were 538 likely 2024 general election voters (margin of sampling error +/- 4.2%). In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response.

These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the May 2024 Ocean State Poll is 33%. The design effect for the survey is 2.2%.

The Ocean State Panel is a probability-based web panel of Rhode Island residents. Approximately 2,000 Rhode Island adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the RI Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Rhode Island. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
