Durham, N.H. – Join the University of New Hampshire Marine Docents this summer for a day cruise aboard the university's research vessel, the *R/V Gulf Challenger*. Learn about the history of New Hampshire's seacoast aboard the Isles of Shoals Discovery Cruise. The Shoals Cruise includes a visit to Appledore Island and a tour of the Shoals Marine Lab.
