HALF OF VERMONTERS FEEL PRISON IS APPROPRIATE PUNISHMENT FOR TRUMP IN "HUSH MONEY" CASE


DURHAM, NH - Half of Vermont residents think sentencing Donald Trump to prison is an appropriate punishment in his New York "hush money" case but few expect this to occur. Residents are divided on other potential punishments such as house arrest, community service, parole, or a small fine. Nearly half of Vermont Republicans think any punishment is inappropriate. Bipartisan majorities support President Biden's executive action concerning illegal immigration.

Trump NY "Hush Money" Case

Donald Trump was convicted in New York for falsifying business records concerning "hush money" payments to Stormy Daniels in the run-up to the 2016 presidential election. Trump has not yet been sentenced.


Fifty-five percent of Vermonters think a large fine is an appropriate punishment for Trump, 51% think prison, 40% think house arrest, 35% think community service, 34% think parole, and 17% think a small fine are appropriate punishments.

0% 10% 20% 30% 40% 50% 60% 70% 80% 90% 100% Nearly three-quarters of Democrats (73%) think a prison sentence is an appropriate punishment but only 34% of Independents and 10% of Republicans agree. Majorities of Democrats also think a large fine (70%) and house arrest (57%) are appropriate punishments for Trump. More than half of Independents think a large fine (53%) is appropriate but less than half think other punishments are appropriate. Among Republicans, 43% do not think any punishment is appropriate while only 16% of Independents and less than 1% of




While half of Vermont residents think a prison sentence is an appropriate sentence for Trump, only 12% think it is very (2%) or somewhat (10%) likely that Trump will be sent to prison, 80% think this is not very likely (43%) or not at all likely (37%) to happen, and 8% are unsure. Republicans (21%) are more likely than Democrats (10%) and Independents (8%) to think it is likely Trump will be sent to prison.

Overall, 6% of Vermonters think Trump being sentenced to prison is appropriate and think it is likely to happen, 43% think prison is appropriate but is unlikely, 6% think prison is inappropriate but is likely, and 28% think prison is inappropriate and is unlikely.

Trump has said he will appeal the verdict in this case. Vermont residents are divided in their predictions of whether his appeals will be successful. Forty-two percent think it is very (19%) or somewhat (23%) likely that Trump's appeals will be successful, 43% think this is not very likely (25%) or not at all likely (18%), and 14% are unsure. A majority of Democrats (62%) think it is not very likely or not at all likely that Trump's appeals will be successful but most Republicans (83%) think this is very or somewhat likely. Independents are divided: 37% think it is likely that Trump's appeals will be successful, 32% think they are unlikely to be successful, and 32% are unsure.




Perceived Likelihood Trump Will Successfully Appeal Conviction in Hush Money Case - by Party ID - June 2024

Immigration


Earlier this month, President Biden issued an executive order to largely close the U.S.-Mexico border to asylum seekers when authorities have determined that the border is "overwhelmed." Thirty percent of Vermont residents have heard a lot about this, 42% have heard some, 16% have not heard very much, and 9% have heard nothing at all. Republicans are more likely than Independents and Democrats to have heard a lot or some about this.

Among those who have heard something about the new asylum policy (N=747), 61% strongly (35%) or somewhat (26%) support Biden's executive order, 13% are neutral, 22% strongly (14%) or somewhat (8%) oppose it, and 4% are unsure. Two-thirds (66%) of Republicans and more than half of Democrats (59%) and Independents (58%) support the order.

Overall, 59% of Vermonters approve of Biden's handling of his job as president, 37% disapprove, and 4% are unsure. Biden's net approval rating (the percentage who approve of his handling his job as president minus the percent who disapprove) is +21, little change since April (+17). Ninety percent of Democrats approve of Biden's performance as president but only 38% of Independents and 2% of Republicans approve.

Green Mountain State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Green Mountain State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Eight hundred thirty-eight (838) Green Mountain State Panel members completed the survey online between June 13 and June 17, 2024. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.4 percent. In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for the June 2024 Green Mountain State Poll is 36%. The design effect for the survey is 2.3%.

The Green Mountain State Panel is a probability-based web panel of Vermont residents. Approximately 2,500 Vermont adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as to 2020 election results in Vermont. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.

How Much Heard About Biden 2024 Immigration Executive Order
