#### HARRIS AHEAD IN MAINE, CD2 TOO-CLOSE-TO-CALL

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
DURHAM, NH - Vice President Kamala Harris has increased her lead over former President Donald Trump in Maine and the race is tied in Maine's 2nd Congressional District. Nearly half of likely voters in the state expect Harris to win. Harris is more personally popular than Trump and is rated more highly on several personal attributes, particularly physical and mental fitness and temperament. The Democratic vice-presidential nominee, Minnesota Governor Tim Walz, is generally popular in Maine and most Harris supporters are enthusiastic about his selection. President Joe Biden's job performance remains unchanged as half of Mainers believe he has been below average or one of the worst U.S. presidents.

#### 2024 Presidential Race

If the presidential election were held today, 55% of Maine likely voters say that they would vote for Harris, 38% would vote for Trump, 2% would vote for Independent Robert F. Kennedy Jr., 1% each would vote for Green Party candidate Jill Stein or for Libertarian candidate Chase Oliver, less than 1% would vote for any other candidate, and 2% are undecided. Harris garners 62% of the vote in Maine's 1st Congressional District compared to only 33% of support for Trump. However, the race is close in Maine's 2nd Congressional District, where 49% say they plan to vote for Harris and 44% plan to vote for Trump.

If they could only vote for Harris or Trump, 58% of likely voters say that they would vote for Harris and 41% say they would vote for Trump. Shortly after President Biden's withdrawal in July, Harris was supported by 48% of Mainers while 40% supported Trump. Harris enjoys overwhelming support from self-described liberals (92%), progressives (90%), and socialists (86%) in Maine, along with support from more than two-thirds (69%) of moderates. Trump has the support of 92% of conservatives and most libertarians (76%). Harris holds very large leads among women (65% to 27%) and those with college degrees (68% to 26%) while Trump leads among men (51% to 43%) and the two are closely matched among those without a college degree, with 48% supporting Harris and 45% supporting Trump.


#### 2024 Presidential General Election Matchup - Harris, Trump, et al

When asked who they believe is most likely to win the presidential election, 51% select Harris, 37% think Trump will win, and 11% are unsure. Eighty-four percent of Harris supporters think that she is most likely to win while about the same proportion of Trump supporters (83%) think he is most likely to win.


Who Believe is Most Likely to Win 2024 Presidential Race - by Candidate Supported - August 2024



Six in ten Maine residents (60%) are very (28%) or somewhat (32%) confident that there will be a peaceful transfer of power after the upcoming presidential election. Thirty-seven percent are not very confident (24%) or not at all confident (13%) that there will be a peaceful transfer of power and 3% are unsure.


Among those who think Trump will win (N=352), 72% are very or somewhat confident that a peaceful transfer of power will occur after the election while those who believe Harris will win (N=478) are less likely to be confident (58%) that a peaceful transfer will occur.

Confidence Peaceful Transfer of Power Will Occur After Next Election - August 2024 - By Anticipated Winner of Election




Turning to the personal favorability of the candidates, 50% of Mainers have a favorable opinion of Harris, 43% have an unfavorable opinion of her, and 6% are neutral. Harris' net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion), is +7. Harris is extremely popular among Democrats (+88) but is extremely unpopular among Republicans (-93) while Independents are neutral (+1).

Thirty-five percent of Mainers have a favorable opinion of Trump, 60% have an unfavorable opinion, and 4% are neutral, yielding a net favorability rating of -25. Trump is quite popular among Republicans (+75) but is unpopular among Independents (-47) and extremely unpopular among Democrats (-99). Only 5% of Mainers say that they have an unfavorable opinion of both Harris and Trump.



Two-thirds (67%) of Mainers rate Harris' physical and mental fitness as very good (43%) or good (24%), 18% rate her physical and mental fitness as fair, and 13% rate her physical and mental fitness as poor (5%) or very poor (8%). Smaller majorities of state residents rate Harris' temperament (54%) and communication skills (55%) as very good or good, while less than half rate her honesty and integrity (49%), decision-making (48%), policy positions on major issues (47%), and ability to understand the problems facing people like them (44%) as very good or good. Mainers rate Harris considerably more highly on physical and mental fitness and communication skills than they did Biden in February.


Mainers are less positive about Trump when asked to rate his personal characteristics. Respondents are most likely to rate Trump's policy positions on major issues (39%), decision-making (39%), and physical and mental fitness (38%) as very good or good, but Mainers rate Harris more highly on each attribute and less than one-quarter rate Trump's temperament as very good or good (23%).



#### 2024 Running Mates


Harris' choice of Minnesota Governor Tim Walz as her running mate is widely popular among her voters in Maine. Among Harris supporters (N=529), 59% say that they are enthusiastic about Walz's selection, 29% are satisfied, 3% are dissatisfied, none are angry, and 10% are unsure. Majorities of progressive (72%), liberal (59%), socialist (57%), and moderate (54%) Harris supporters describe themselves as enthusiastic about selecting Walz as her running mate.

Feelings on Walz's Selection as Trump's Running Mate - Among Harris Supporters - August 2024




Overall, 46% of Mainers have a favorable opinion of Walz, 33% have an unfavorable opinion of him, 12% are neutral, and 9% don't know enough about him to say. Walz's net favorability rating is +13.

Favorability - Tim Walz




Trump named Ohio Senator J.D. Vance as his running mate in July but Trump supporters are much less enthusiastic about Vance than Harris supporters are of Walz. Among Trump supporters (N=373), 37% say they are enthusiastic about Vance's selection, 47% are satisfied, 8% are dissatisfied, less than 1% are angry, and 7% are unsure. Responses to this question are largely similar to those provided in July.

Only 30% of Mainers overall have a favorable opinion of Vance, 57% have an unfavorable opinion of him, 10% are neutral, and 4% don't know enough about him to say. Vance's net favorability rating is -27.


Favorability - J.D. Vance



#### **Assessment of Biden**


Among all Mainers, a slight majority (52%) disapprove of Biden's handling of his job as president while 48% approve. Biden's net approval rating (-3) has remained largely stable in Maine in 2024.

Ninety-two percent of Maine Democrats approve of Biden's performance as president but only 22% of Independents and 4% of Republicans approve.



Thirty-one percent of Maine residents feel that overall Biden has been one of the best presidents (10%) or above average (21%), 19% say that Biden has been an average president, and 49% believe Biden has been below average (9%) or one the worst presidents (40%). Among Democrats, 62% feel that Biden is one of the best presidents or above average but 62% of Independents and the vast majority of Republicans (95%) believe Biden is below average or one of the worst presidents.

#### Pine Tree State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Pine Tree State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Eight hundred twenty-one (821) Pine Tree State Panel members completed the survey online. The response rate for panel respondents to the August 2024 Pine Tree State Poll is 40%. In addition, 178 Maine residents completed the survey after receiving an invitation via text message to complete the survey online. Overall, 999 individuals completed the survey between August 15 and August 19, 2024. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.1 percent. Included in the sample were 951 likely general election voters (margin of sampling error +/- 3.2 percent). In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The design effect for the survey is 2.2%.

The Pine Tree State Panel is a probability-based web panel of Maine residents. Approximately 2,500 Maine adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the ME Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Maine. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
