NH RESIDENTS REMAIN POSITIVE ON SUNUNU'S PERFORMANCE AS GOVERNOR


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DURHAM, NH - A majority approve of retiring incumbent Governor Chris Sununu's job performance. Four in ten residents, and more than two-thirds of Republicans, believe he has been above average or one of New Hampshire's best governors. Sununu's handling of COVID-19 and taxes are most often cited by his supporters as positive decisions while his handling of abortion and support for former President Donald Trump are most often mentioned as poor decisions by Sununu's detractors.


Governor Sununu

Currently, 58% of New Hampshire residents approve of Governor Sununu's job performance, 38% disapprove, and 3% neither approve nor disapprove or don't know. Sununu's net approval rating is +20, its highest point since November 2023 (+22). Eighty-seven percent of Republicans and 78% of Independents approve of Sununu's performance as governor but only 24% of Democrats approve.




Forty-one percent of New Hampshire residents feel that overall Sununu has been one of the state's best governors (15%) or above average (26%), 31% say that Sununu has been an average governor, and 21% believe Sununu has been below average (16%) or one the worst governors (5%). Sixty-eight percent of Republicans and 49% of Independents feel that Sununu is one of the best governors or above average but only 15% of Democrats feel that way.

Those who approve of Sununu's performance as governor (N=962) most often mention his handling of COVID-19 (17%) and taxes (13%) as the most important decisions he has made that makes them approve of his job performance, followed by his handling of education (6%), LGBTQ issues (6%), and the budget or finances (5%).



Those who disapprove of Sununu's performance as governor (N=712) most often mention his handling of abortion (20%), his supporting Trump (17%), his handling of education (13%), his handling of drug policy (12%), and his handling of LGBTQ issues (12%).



Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. One thousand, seven hundred and eighty-nine (1,789) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online. The response rate for panel respondents to the August 2024 Granite State Poll is 34%. In addition, 351 New Hampshire residents completed the survey after receiving an invitation via text message to complete the survey online. Overall, 2,140 individuals completed the survey between August 15 and August 19, 2024. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.1 percent. In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The design effect for the survey is 2.1%.

The Granite State Panel is a probability-based web panel of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 8,000 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
