## NEAR UNANIMOUS SUPPORT FOR HARRIS AMONG NH DEMOCRATS FUELS WIDER LEAD OVER TRUMP

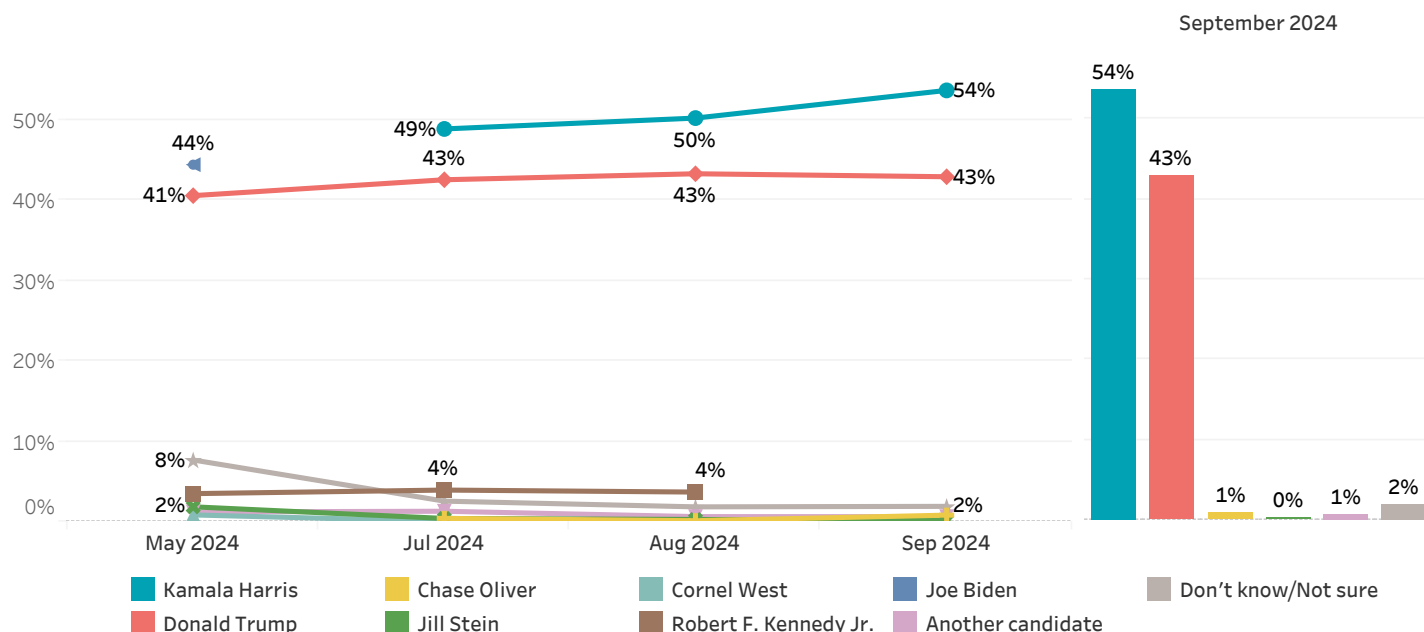
DURHAM, NH - Vice President Kamala Harris' lead over former President Donald Trump in New Hampshire has increased since August and state residents increasingly think Harris will win the upcoming election. Those who watched the September debate between Harris and Trump rate Harris' performance better than Trump's. Trump supporters are more hesitant than Harris supporters to express their support for Trump in public or to talk about it with people they know. About half of Granite Staters consider voter fraud to be a serious problem in the country and a majority of Republicans believe fraudulent mail in or absentee ballots, non-citizens voting, and people voting using the name of someone else occurs frequently. State residents are far less likely to consider voter fraud to be a serious issue in New Hampshire.

### 2024 Presidential Race

Vice President Harris has increased her lead over former President Trump in New Hampshire. If the election were held today, 54% of likely voters in the state say that they would vote for Harris, 43% would vote for Trump, 1% would vote for Libertarian candidate Chase Oliver, less than 1% would vote for Green Party candidate Jill Stein, 1% would vote for another candidate, and 2% don't know or are unsure. Harris held a six percentage point lead in July and a seven point lead in August. Ninety-five percent of Harris supporters and 94% of Trump supporters say they have definitely decided whom to support.

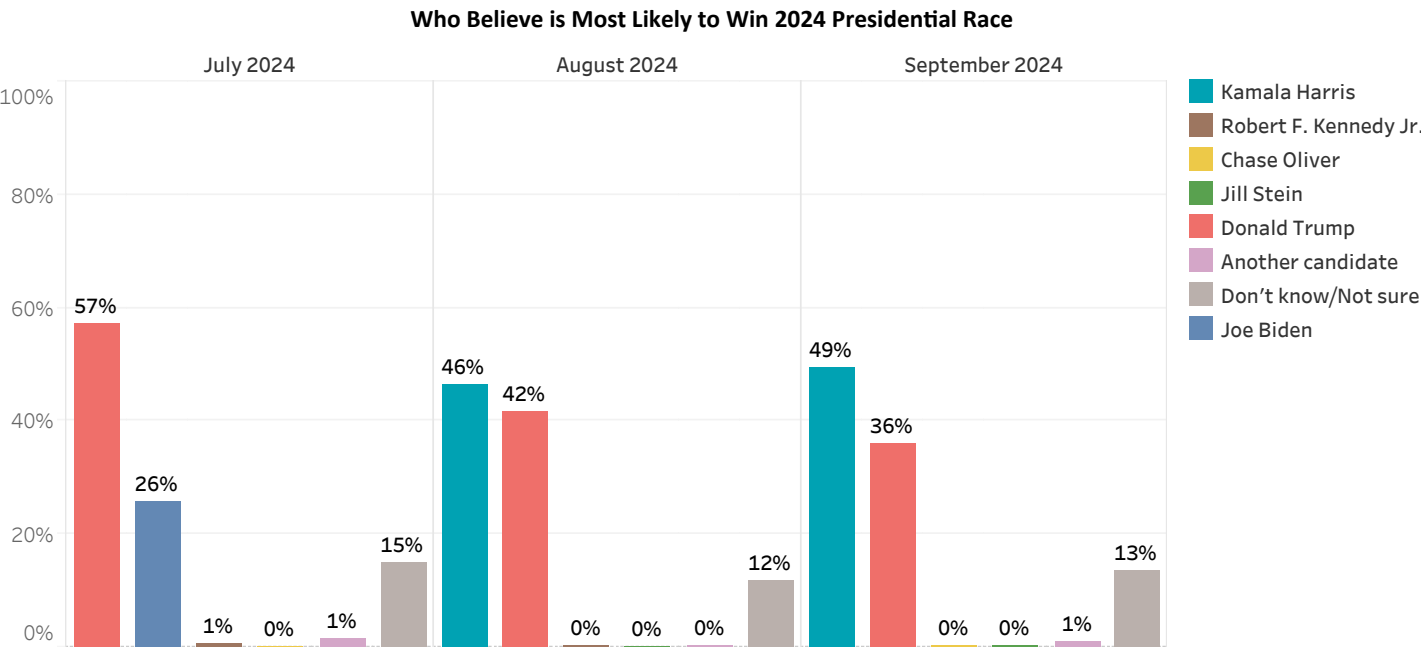
Harris's increased lead is largely due to consolidating support among Democrats and left-leaning voters. Nearly all New Hampshire Democrats (98%), self-described progressives (>99%), liberals (99%), and socialists (99%) support Harris, each slightly higher than in August, while 64% of moderates support Harris, up from 59% in August. Trump enjoys the support of 88% of Republicans, 92% of self-described conservatives, and 79% of libertarians, but garners only 31% of the moderate vote, unchanged since August. Harris holds wide leads among women with a college degree (+48 percentage points) and men with a college degree (+27). Trump holds a smaller lead among men without a college degree (+17) while women without a college degree are split evenly between the two candidates.

### 2024 Presidential General Election Matchup

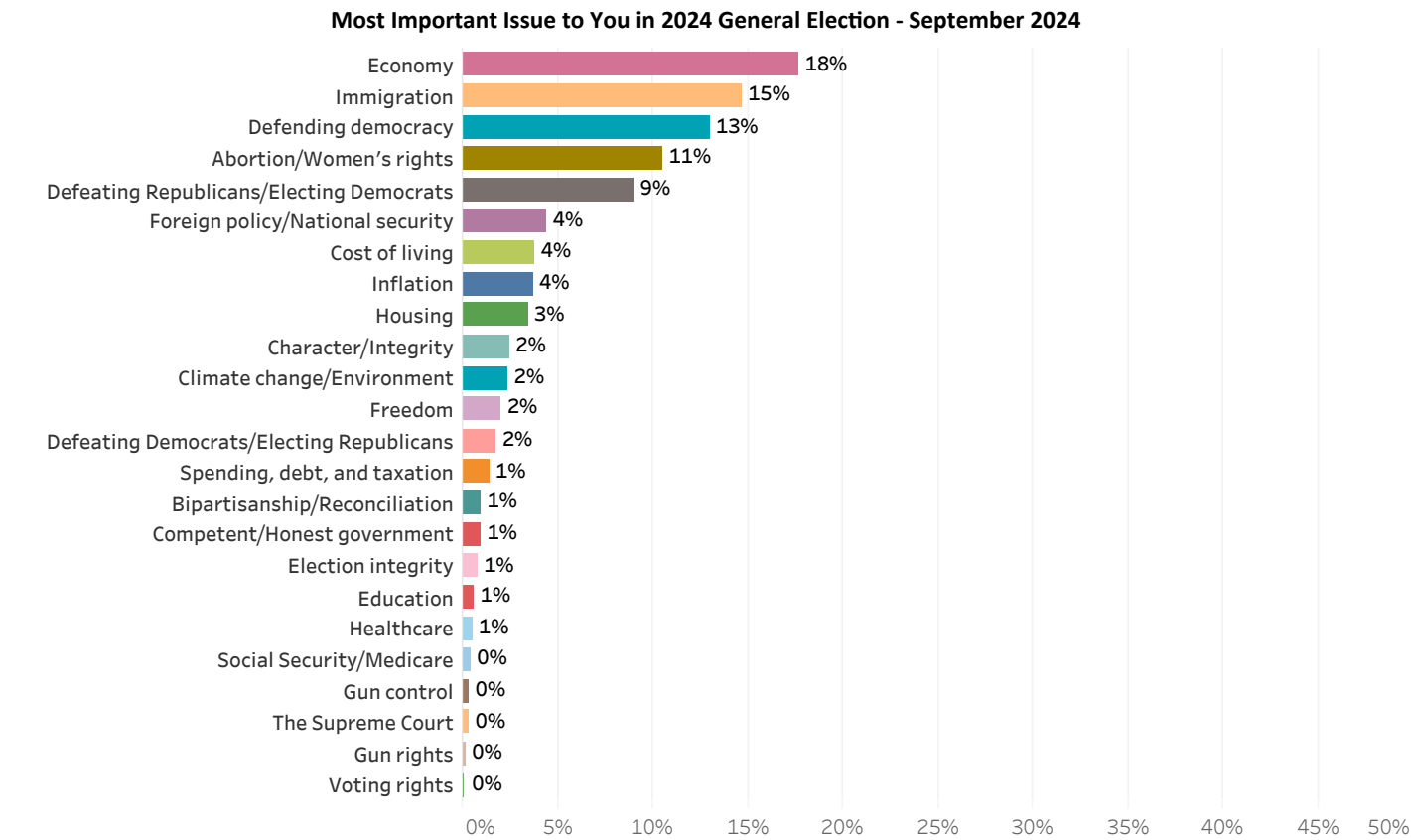

When asked who they believe is most likely to win the presidential election, 49% name Harris, 36% think Trump will win, and 13% are unsure. In August, 46% thought Harris would win while 42% felt Trump would win. Eighty-four percent of Harris supporters think she is most likely to win, unchanged since August, while 78% of Trump supporters think he is most likely to win.

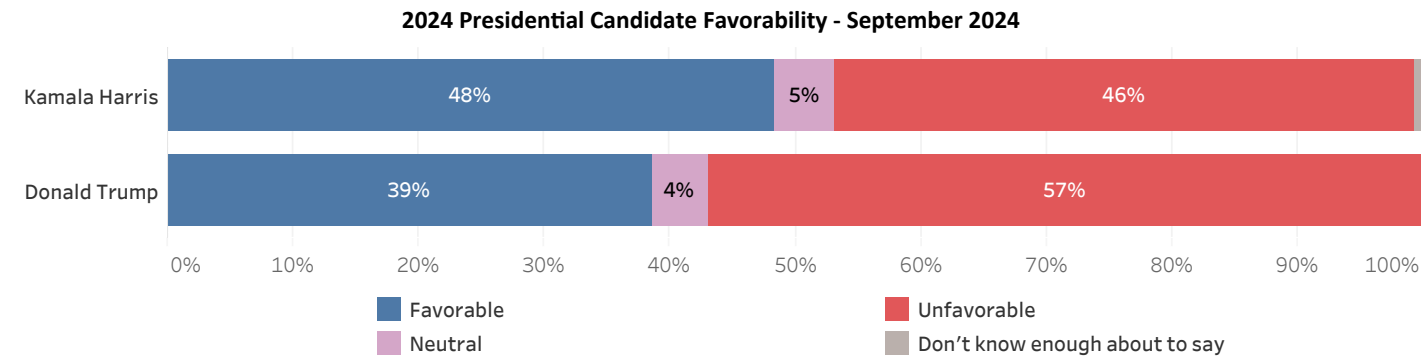


There are significant partisan differences about issues in the election. Among all likely voters, 18% say the economy is the most important issue to them, 15% cite immigration, 13% mention defending democracy, 11% cite abortion or women's rights, and 9% mention defeating Republicans or electing Democrats. Fewer likely voters mention foreign policy or national security (4%), the cost of living (4%), inflation (4%), or housing (3%). More than half of Democrats say that defending democracy, abortion or women's rights, or defeating Republicans or electing Democrats are the most important issue to them, while more than half of Independents and Republicans cite the economy or immigration as the most important issues.



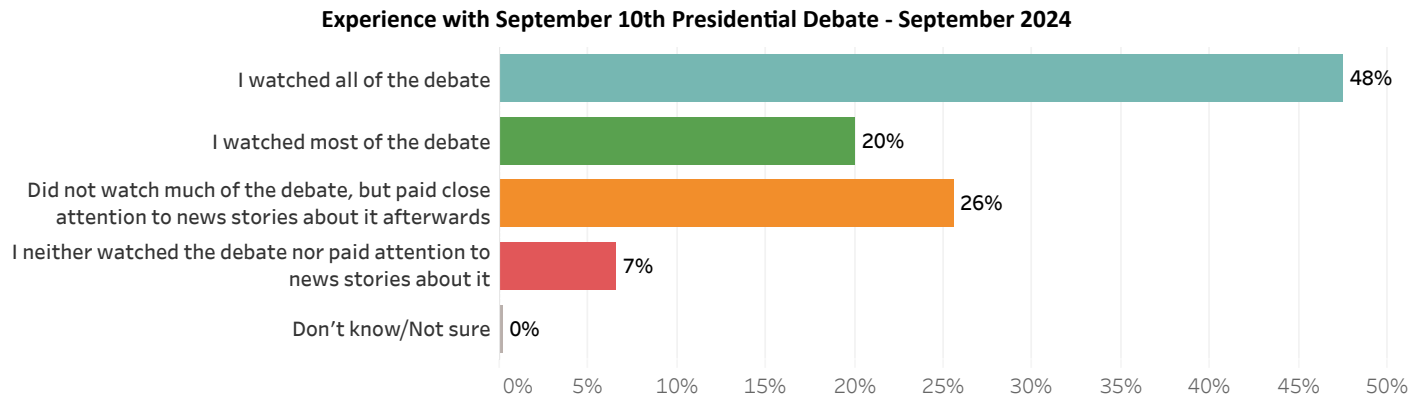
Turning to the personal favorability of the candidates, 48% of Granite Staters have a favorable opinion of Harris, 46% have an unfavorable opinion of her, 5% are neutral, and 1% don't know enough about her to say. Harris' net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion), is +2, up from -4 in August and -37 in May. Harris' net favorability rating among Democrats is +90, up from (+85) in August, while her net favorability rating is -29 among Independents and -84 among Republicans.

Thirty-nine percent of Granite Staters have a favorable opinion of Trump, 57% have an unfavorable opinion, and 4% are neutral, yielding a net favorability rating of -18. Only 4% of Granite Staters say that they have an unfavorable opinion of both Harris and Trump.



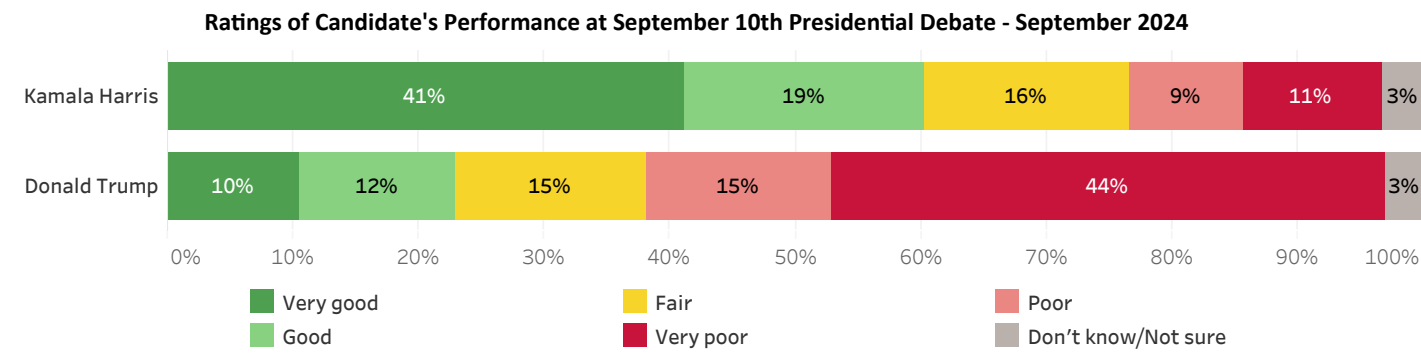
**September Presidential Debate**

Harris and Trump met in a debate on September 10th. Nearly half (48%) of likely voters in New Hampshire say that they watched all of the debate, 20% say that they watched most of the debate, 25% say that they did not watch most of the debate, but paid close attention to news stories about it afterwards, and 7% neither watched the debate nor paid attention to news stories about it.



Among those who watched all or most of the debate or paid close attention to news stories about it afterwards (N=1,575), 60% rate Harris' performance in the debate as very good (41%) or good (19%), 16% rate it as fair, 9% rate her performance as poor, and 11% rate her performance as very poor (9%) or very poor (11%). Nearly all Harris supporters (97%) rate her performance as very good or good.

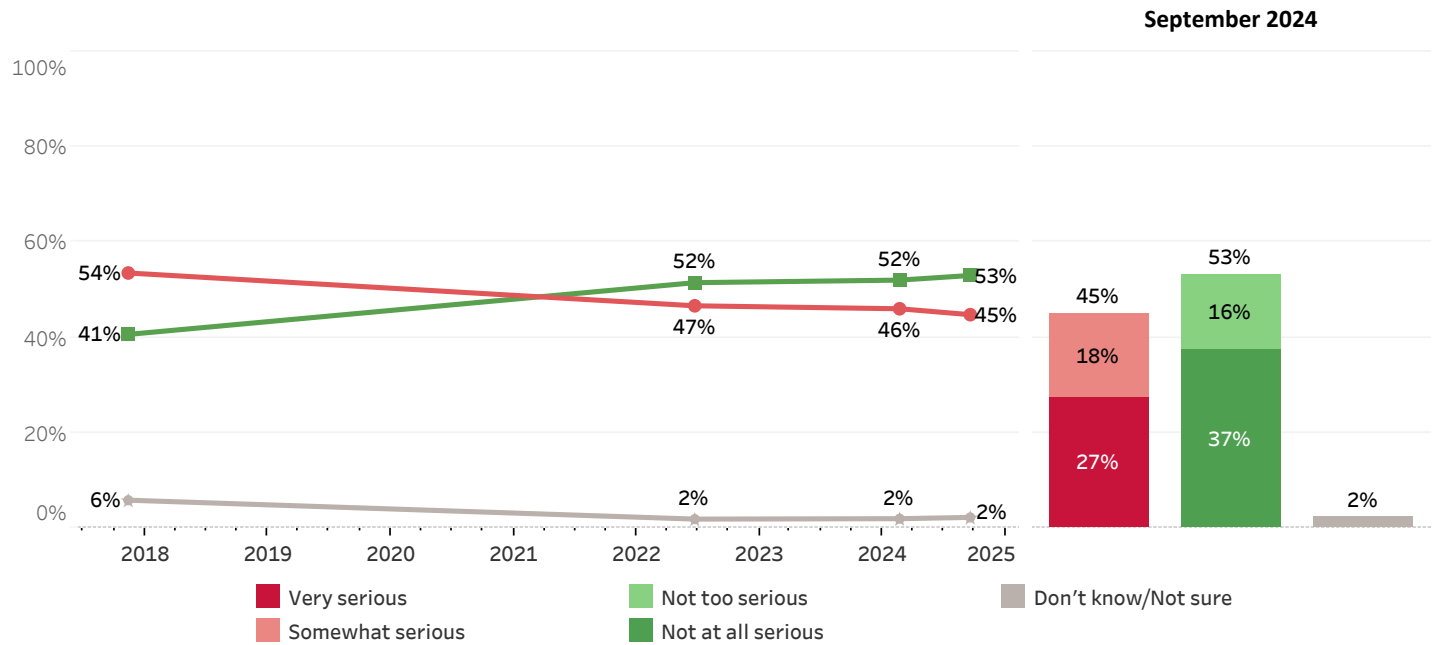
By contrast, only 23% of those who watched all or most of the debate or paid close attention to news stories about it afterwards rate Trump's performance as very good (10%) or good (12%), 15% rate it as fair, and 59% rate his performance as poor (15%) or very poor (44%). Among Trump supporters, only 55% rate his performance as very good or good.



## Election Integrity

Concerns about election integrity have been central to the 2016 and 2020 elections and remain so in 2024. Forty-five percent of New Hampshire residents believe that voter fraud is a very (27%) or somewhat (18%) serious problem in the United States, 53% think it is not too serious (16%) or not at all serious (37%), and 2% are unsure. Feelings about voter fraud in the country are largely unchanged since November 2022. Most Republicans (85%) and just under half of Independents (47%) believe that voter fraud is a very or somewhat serious problem in the country but only 7% of Democrats agree.

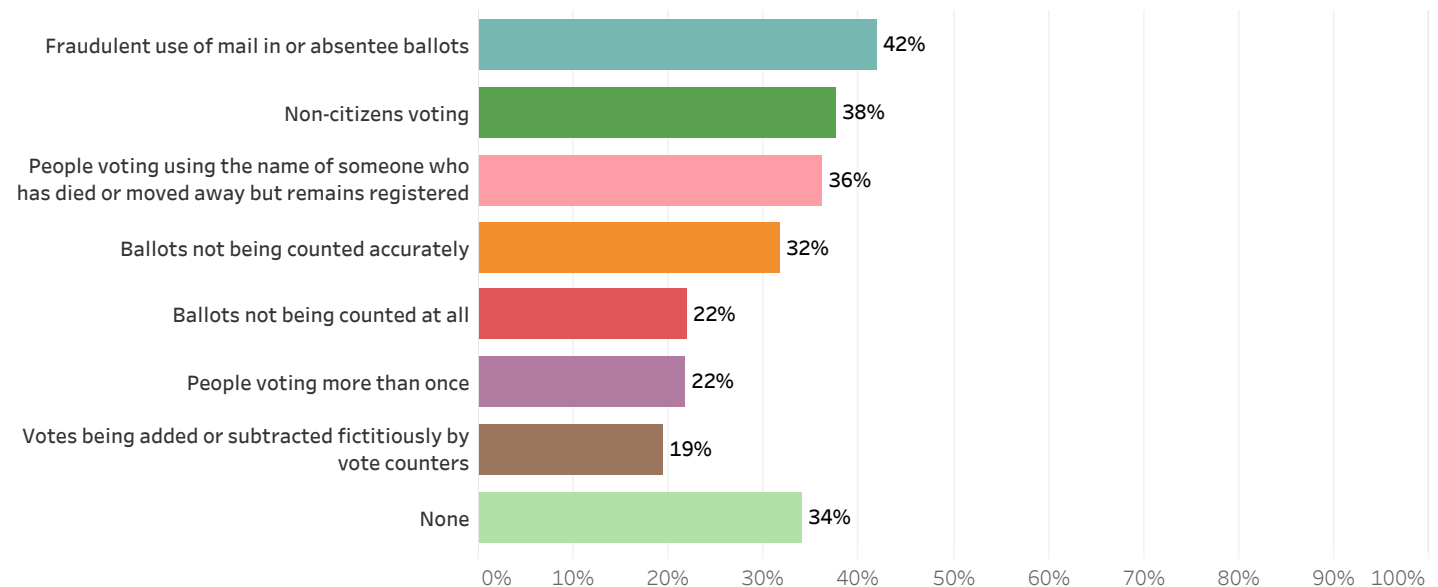
### Seriousness of Voter Fraud in United States



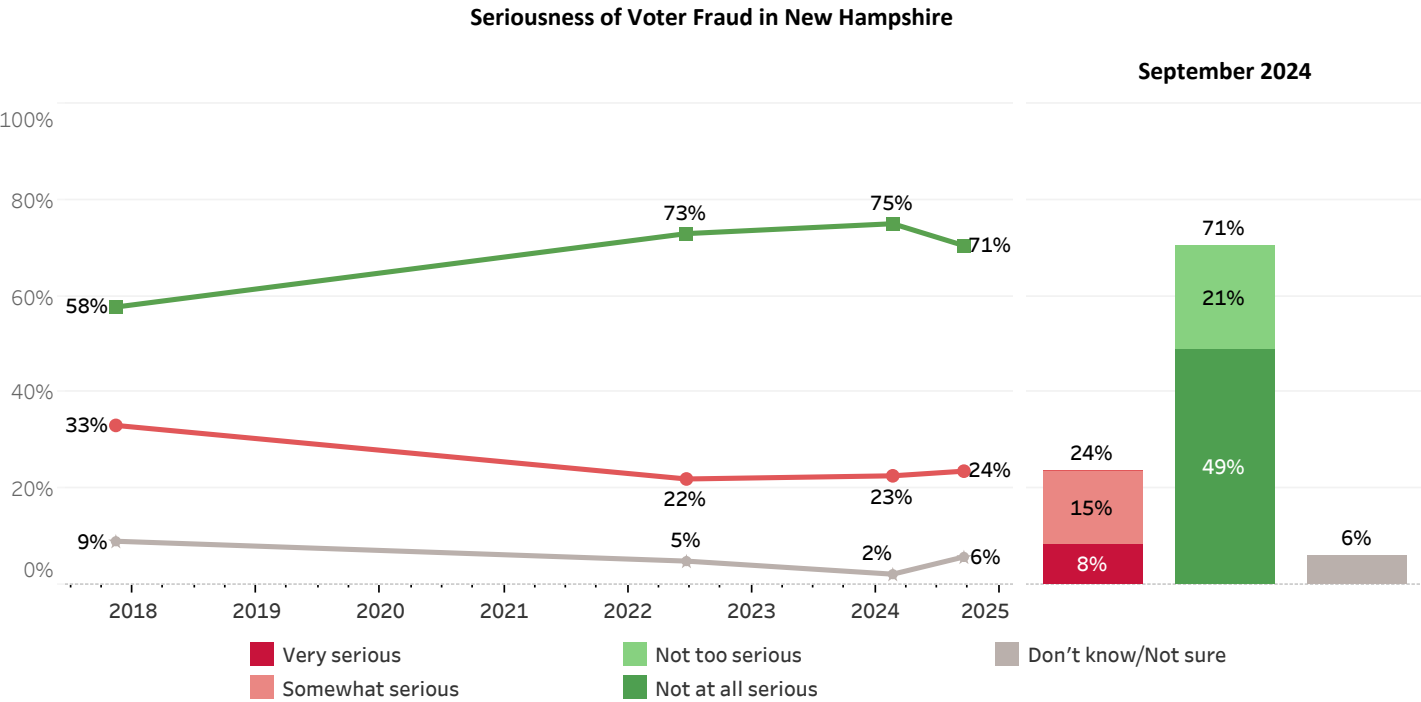
Forty-two percent of New Hampshire residents believe that fraudulent use of mail in or absentee ballots occurs frequently in the country, 38% believe that non-citizens frequently vote, 36% believe people frequently vote using the name of someone who has died or moved away but remains registered, 32% believe ballots are frequently not counted accurately, 22% believe ballots are frequently not counted at all, 22% believe people frequently vote more than once, and 19% believe votes are frequently added or subtracted fictitiously by vote counters. Thirty-four percent believe that none of these things happen frequently in the United States.

Most Republicans believe that fraudulent use of mail in or absentee ballots (77%), non-citizens voting (71%), and people voting using the name of someone else (60%) occurs frequently in the country. By contrast, very few Democrats believe these things happen frequently.

### Forms of Voter Fraud Believe Occur Frequently in United States - September 2024

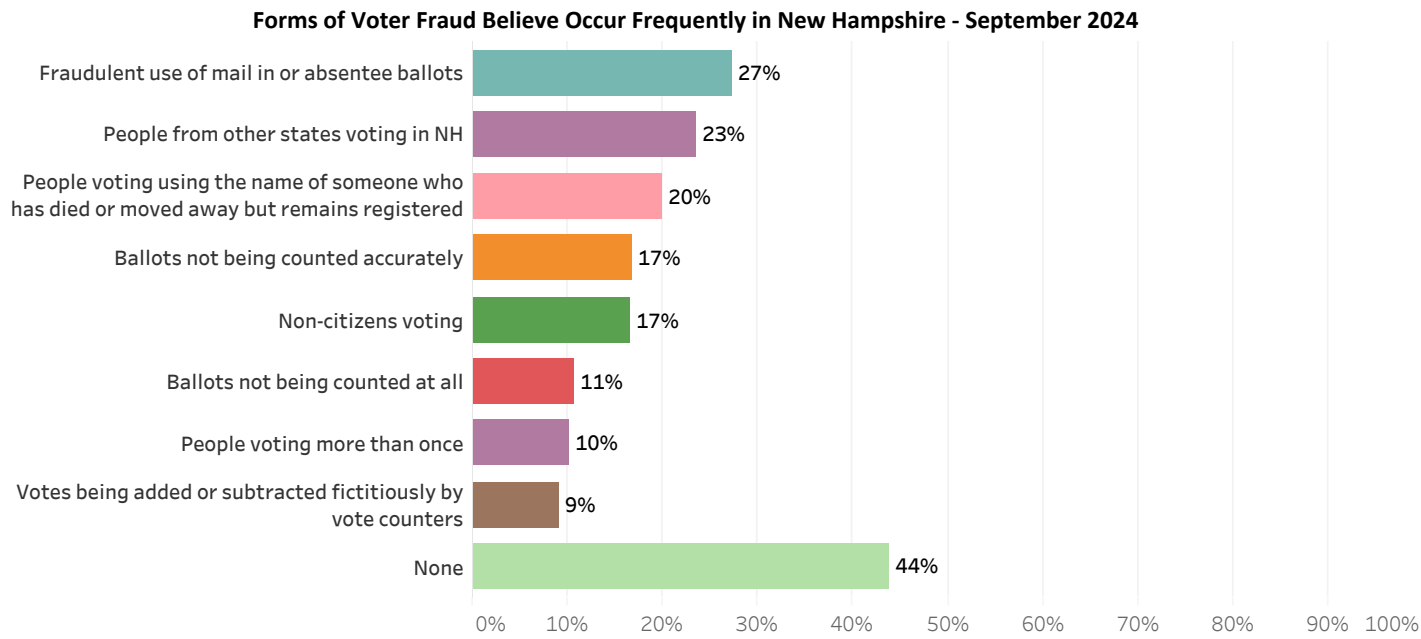


Granite Staters are less likely to consider voter fraud to be a serious problem in New Hampshire: only 24% believe that voter fraud is a very (8%) or somewhat (15%) serious problem in New Hampshire, 71% think it is not too serious (21%) or not at all serious (49%), and 6% are unsure. Perceptions of voter fraud in the state are largely unchanged since November 2022. Nearly half of Republicans (46%) believe that voter fraud is a very or somewhat serious problem in New Hampshire but only 24% of Independents and 3% of Democrats agree.



Twenty-seven percent of New Hampshire residents believe that fraudulent use of mail or absentee ballots occurs frequently in New Hampshire, 23% believe the people from other states frequently vote in New Hampshire, 20% believe people frequently vote using the name of someone who has died or moved away but remains registered, 17% believe ballots are frequently not counted accurately, 17% believe non-citizens frequently vote, 11% believe ballots are frequently not counted at all, 10% believe that people frequently vote more than once, and 9% believe that votes are frequently added or subtracted fictitiously by voter counters. Forty-four percent believe that none of these things happen frequently in New Hampshire.

More than one-third of Republicans believe that fraudulent use of mail in or absentee ballots (53%) and people from other states voting in New Hampshire (41%) occurs frequently in the state. By contrast, among Democrats less than one in ten believe these things happen frequently.

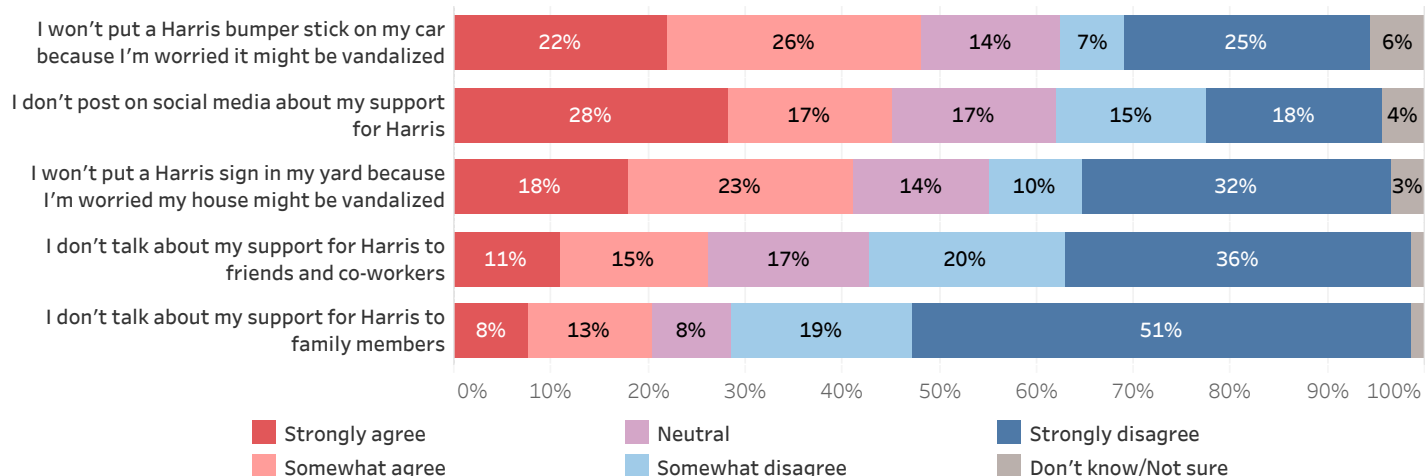


## Reluctance to Express Political Support

Many voters are hesitant to express their support for their preferred candidate. Nearly half of Harris supporters (48%) strongly (22%) or somewhat (26%) agree that they won't put a Harris bumper sticker on their car because they're worried it might be vandalized, 14% are neutral on this question, 7% are unsure how they feel. Forty-five percent agree that they don't post on social media about their support for Harris, and 41% agree that they won't put a Harris sign in their yard because they are worried their house might be vandalized. Fewer Harris supporters agree that they don't talk about their support for Harris to friends and co-workers (26%) or don't talk about their support for Harris to family members (20%).

Among Harris supporters, self-described conservatives, and those who voted for Trump in 2020 are considerably more likely to say that they do not post on social media about their support for Harris and do not talk to their family, friends, or co-workers about their support for Harris.

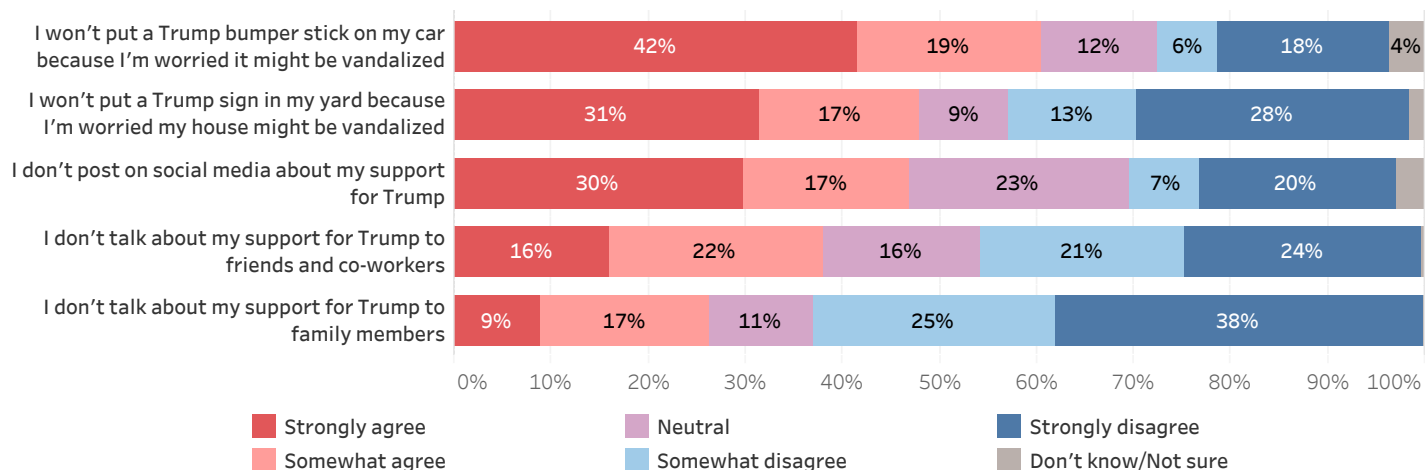
### Concerns Held by Some Harris Supporters - Among Harris Supporters - September 2024



Trump's voters are even more reluctant to express their support. Six in ten Trump supporters (62%) strongly (42%) or somewhat (19%) agree that they won't put a Trump bumper sticker on their car because they're worried it might be vandalized, 12% are neutral on this question, 24% somewhat (6%) or strongly (18%) disagree, and 4% are unsure how they feel. Nearly half agree that they won't put a Trump sign in their yard because they are worried their house might be vandalized (48%) or that they don't post on social media about their support for Trump (47%). Thirty-eight percent agree that they don't talk about their support for Trump to friends and coworkers while 27% do not talk about their support for Trump to family members. Trump supporters in 2024 are less likely than were 2020 Trump voters to say that they won't put a sign on their yard due to fears of vandalism or that they don't talk about their support for Trump with family members.

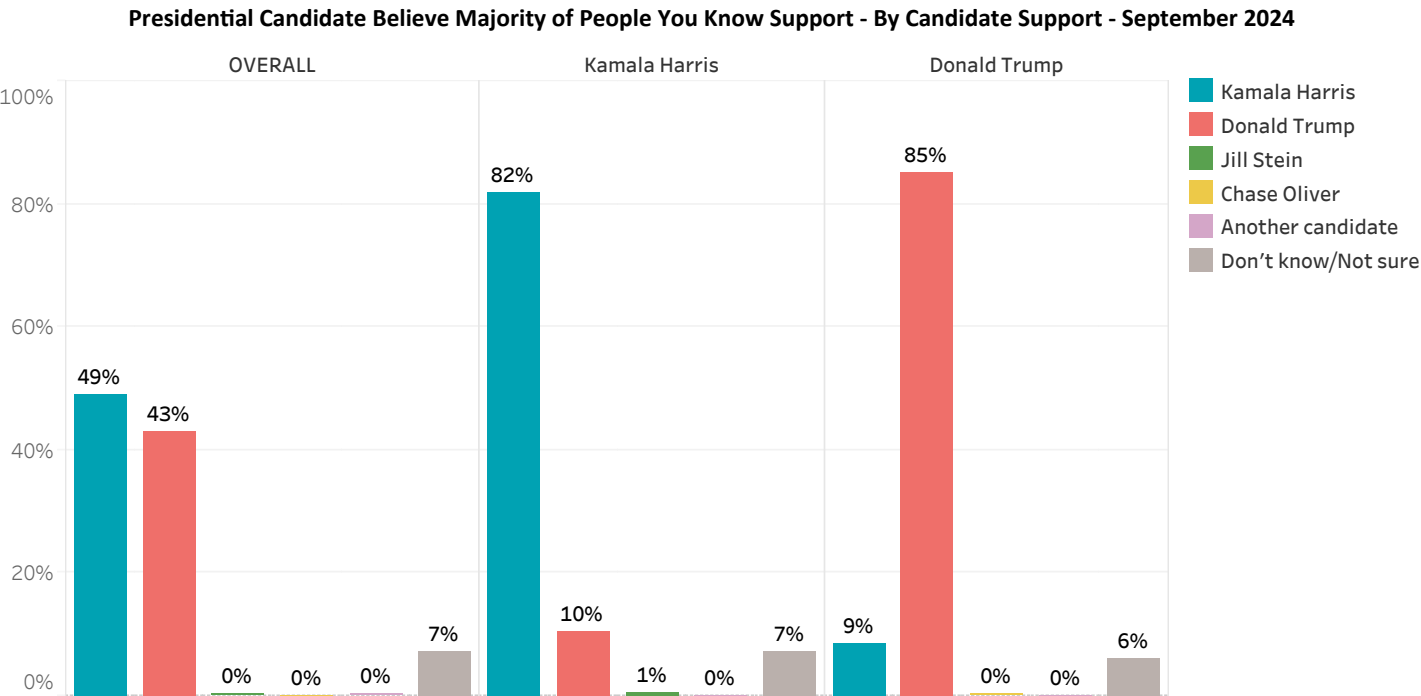
Among Trump supporters, self-described libertarians are more likely to say they will not publicly display their support for Trump through yard signs, bumper stickers, or posts on social media. Those aged 65 and older are more likely than others to say that they don't talk about their support for Trump with family members.

Half (49%) of likely New Hampshire voters say the majority of people they know support Harris, 43% say the majority of the people they know support Trump, less than 1% say the majority support Stein, Oliver, or another candidate, and 7% are unsure.

Among Harris supporters, 82% say that the majority of people they know also support Harris while 10% believe a majority of the people they know support Trump. Among Trump supporters, 85% say that the majority of the people they know support Trump while 9% believe a majority of the people they know support Harris.



## Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Overall, 1,803 individuals completed the survey between September 12 and September 16, 2024. One thousand, four hundred and ninety-one (1,491) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online. The response rate for panel respondents to the September 2024 Granite State Poll is 34%. In addition, 312 New Hampshire residents completed the survey after receiving an invitation via text message to complete the survey online. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.3 percent. Included in the sample were 1,695 likely general election voters (margin of sampling error +/- 2.4 percent). In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The design effect for the survey is 2.1%.

The Granite State Panel is a probability-based web panel of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 8,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
