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## HARRIS ENJOYS HIGH MARKS ON DEBATE, COMMANDING LEAD AMONG MASSACHUSETTS VOTERS

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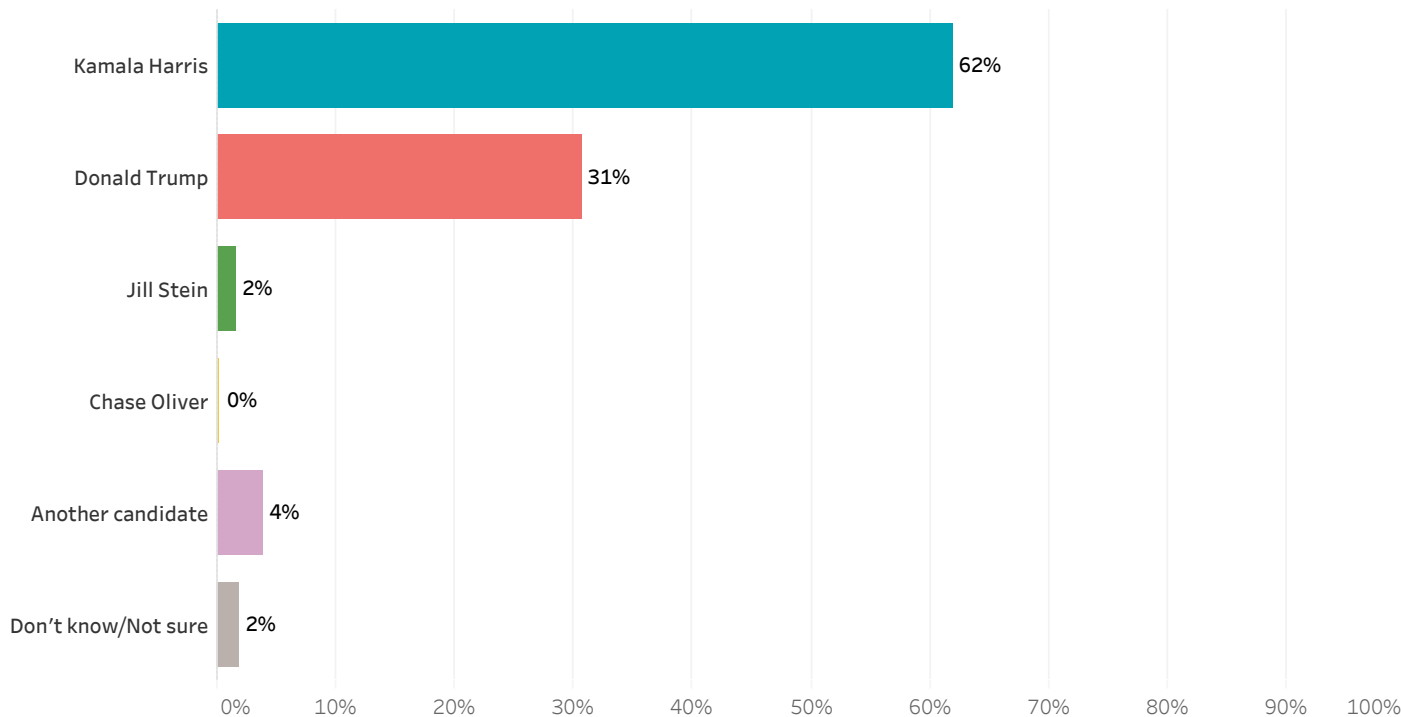
DURHAM, NH - Vice President Kamala Harris leads former President Donald Trump by a large margin in Massachusetts and a majority expect her to be elected president in November. Bay Staters think Harris performed much better than Trump during the recent presidential debate. Many Trump supporters, particularly women, say that they avoid expressing their support for Trump in public or private. More than one-third of Bay Staters consider voter fraud to be a serious problem in the country and a majority of Republicans believe that several forms of voter fraud occur frequently. State residents are less likely to consider voter fraud a serious issue in Massachusetts.

### 2024 Presidential Race

Vice President Harris holds a commanding over former President Trump in Massachusetts. If the election were held today, 62% of likely voters in the state say that they would vote for Harris, 31% would vote for Trump, 2% would vote for Green Party candidate Jill Stein, less than 1% would vote for Libertarian candidate Chase Oliver, 4% would vote for another candidate, and 2% don't know or are unsure. Ninety-five percent of Harris supporters and 88% of Trump supporters say they have definitely decided whom to support.

Harris's enjoys near unanimous support from self-described progressives (99%) and liberals (98%) and most self-described socialists (75%) and moderates (67%). Trump enjoys the support of most conservatives (86%) but garners only 35% support among libertarians. Harris holds very large leads among women with a college degree (+70 percentage points) and men with a college degree (+68). Trump holds a smaller lead among men without a college degree (+16) while the two candidates are effectively tied among women without a college degree.

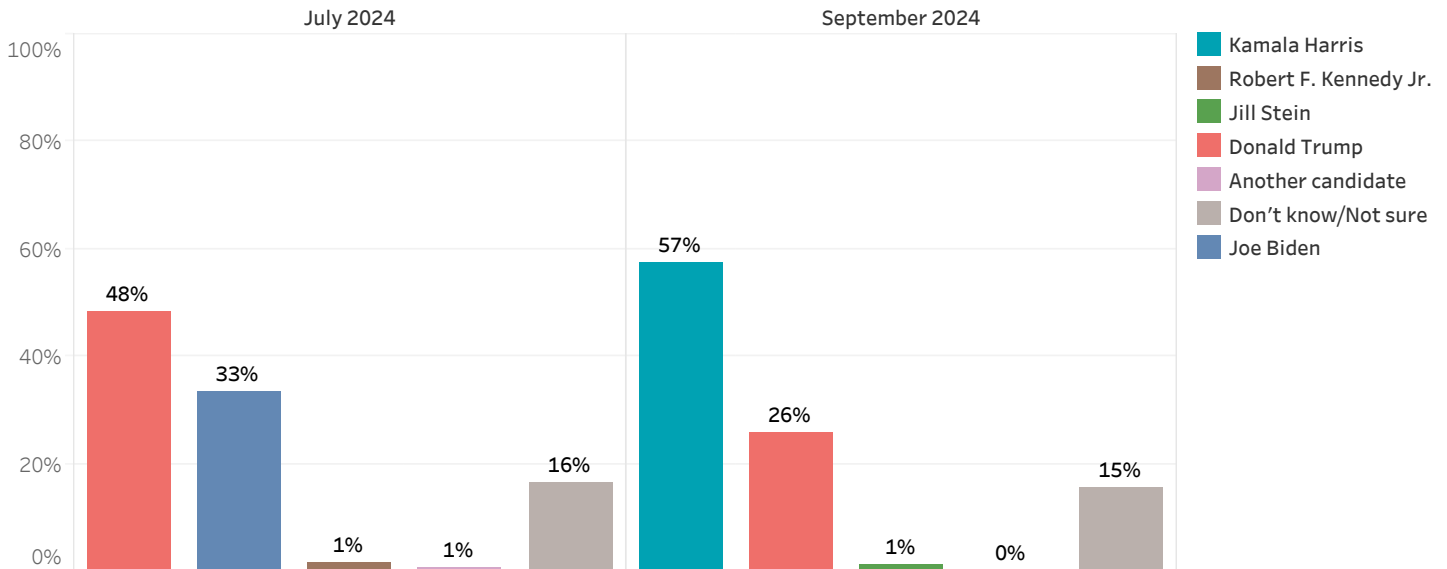
2024 Presidential General Election Matchup - Harris, Trump, et al - September 2024

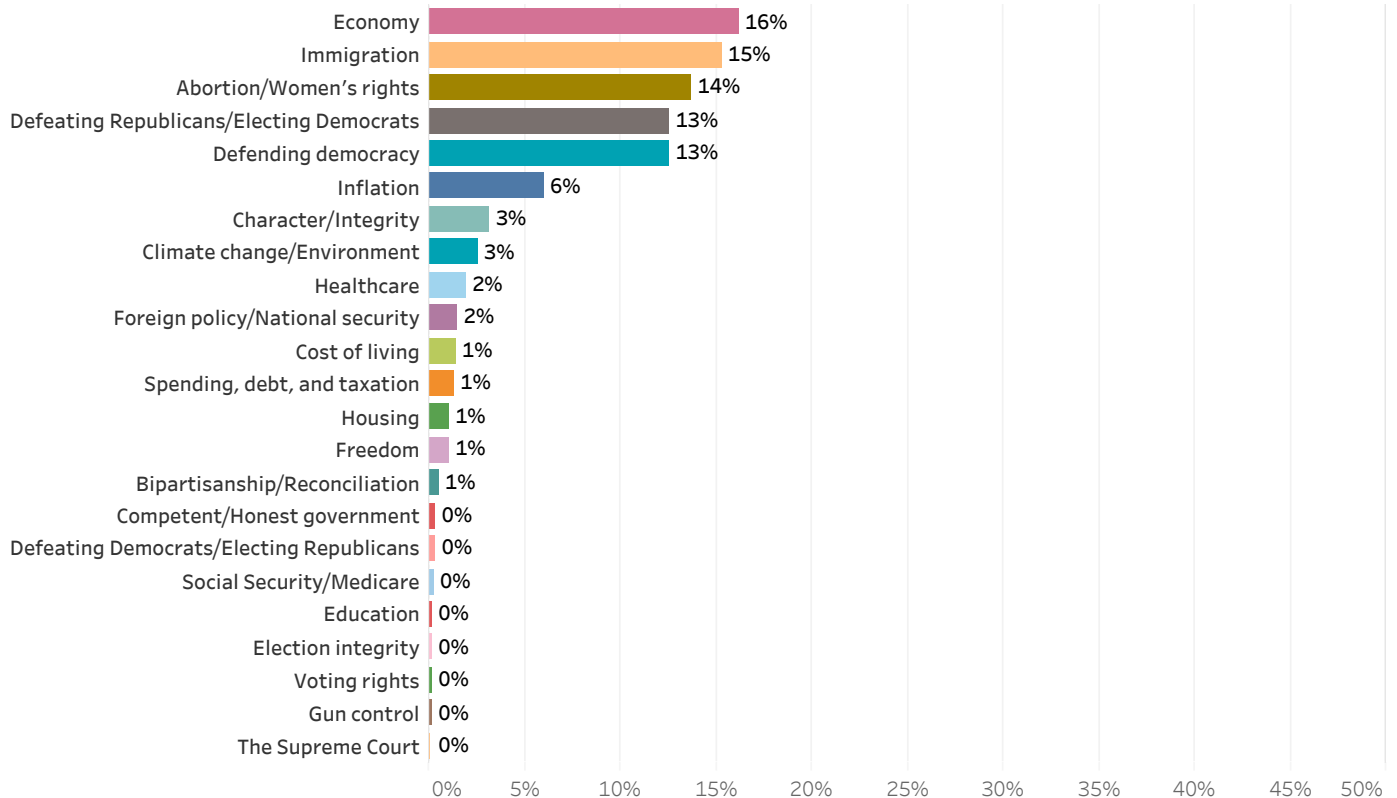
When asked who they believe is most likely to win the presidential election, 57% name Harris, 26% think Trump will win, and 15% are unsure. Before President Joe Biden's withdrawal from the race in July, 33% thought it was most likely that Biden would win the presidential election while 48% felt Trump was most likely to win. Seventy-seven percent of Harris supporters think that she is most likely to win, while 71% of Trump supporters think he is most likely to win, down from 79% in July.

When asked to name the most important issue to them in the upcoming general election, likely voters cite the economy (16%), immigration (15%), abortion or women's rights (14%), defeating Republicans or electing Democrats (13%), and defending democracy (13%). Fewer likely voters mention inflation (6%), the character or integrity of the candidates (3%), climate change or the environment (3%), healthcare (2%), or foreign policy or national security (2%). Democrats most often mention abortion/women's rights, defending democracy, defeating Republicans or electing Democrats, and the economy, while two-thirds of Republicans cite immigration or the economy as their most important issue.

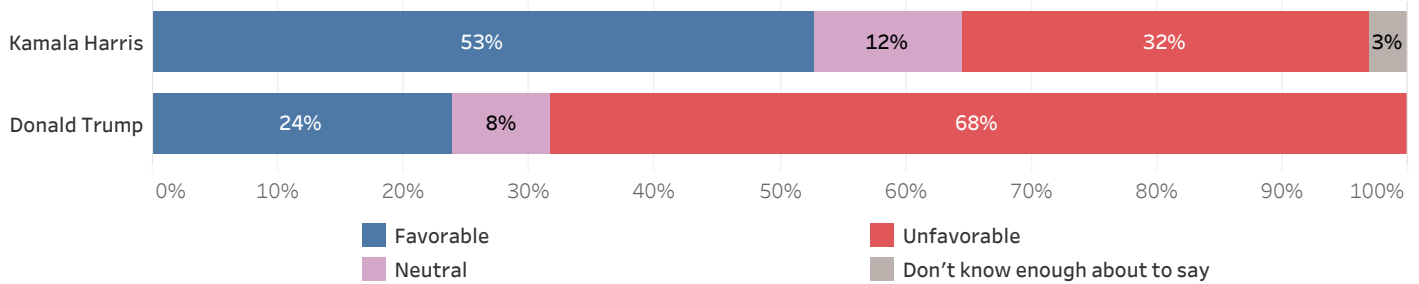
### Most Important Issue to You in 2024 General Election - September 2024



Turning to the personal favorability of the candidates, 53% of Bay Staters have a favorable opinion of Harris, 32% have an unfavorable opinion of her, 12% are neutral, and 3% don't know enough about her to say. Harris' net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion), is +20. Harris is very popular among Democrats (+83) but is very unpopular among Republicans (-86) while Independents are largely neutral (+8).

Only 24% percent of Bay Staters have a favorable opinion of Trump, 68% have an unfavorable opinion, and 8% are neutral, yielding a net favorability rating of -44, very slightly down from -40 in May. Seven percent of Bay Staters say that they have an unfavorable opinion of both Harris and Trump.

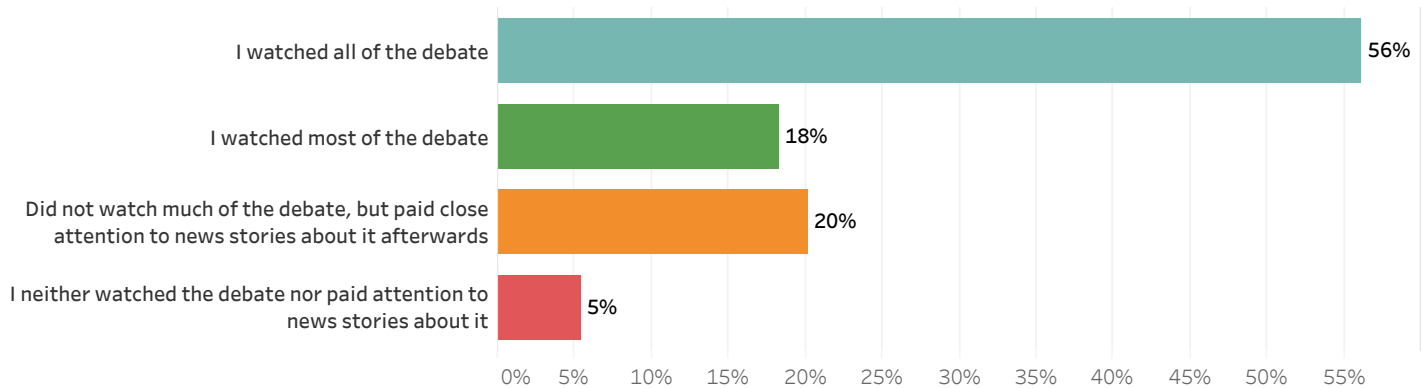
### 2024 Presidential Candidate Favorability - September 2024



### September Presidential Debate

Harris and Trump met for a debate on September 10th. More than half (56%) of likely voters in Massachusetts say that they watched all of the debate, 18% say that they watched most of the debate, 20% say that they did not watch much of the debate but paid close attention to news stories about it afterwards, and 5% neither watched the debate nor paid attention to news stories about it.

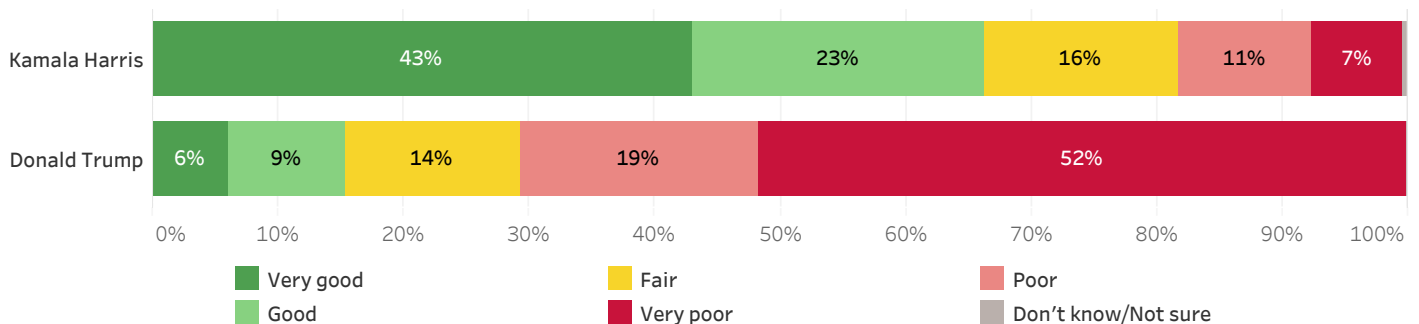
### Experience with September 10th Presidential Debate - September 2024



Among those who watched all or most of the debate or paid close attention to news stories about it afterwards (N=531), 66% rate Harris' performance in the debate as very good (43%) or good (23%), 16% rate it as fair, and 18% rate her performance as poor (11%) or very poor (7%). The vast majority of Harris supporters (93%) rate her performance as very good or good.

By contrast, only 15% rate Trump's performance in the debate as very good (6%) or good (9%), 14% rate it as fair, and 71% rate his performance as poor (19%) or very poor (52%). Among Trump supporters, only 47% rate his performance as very good or good.

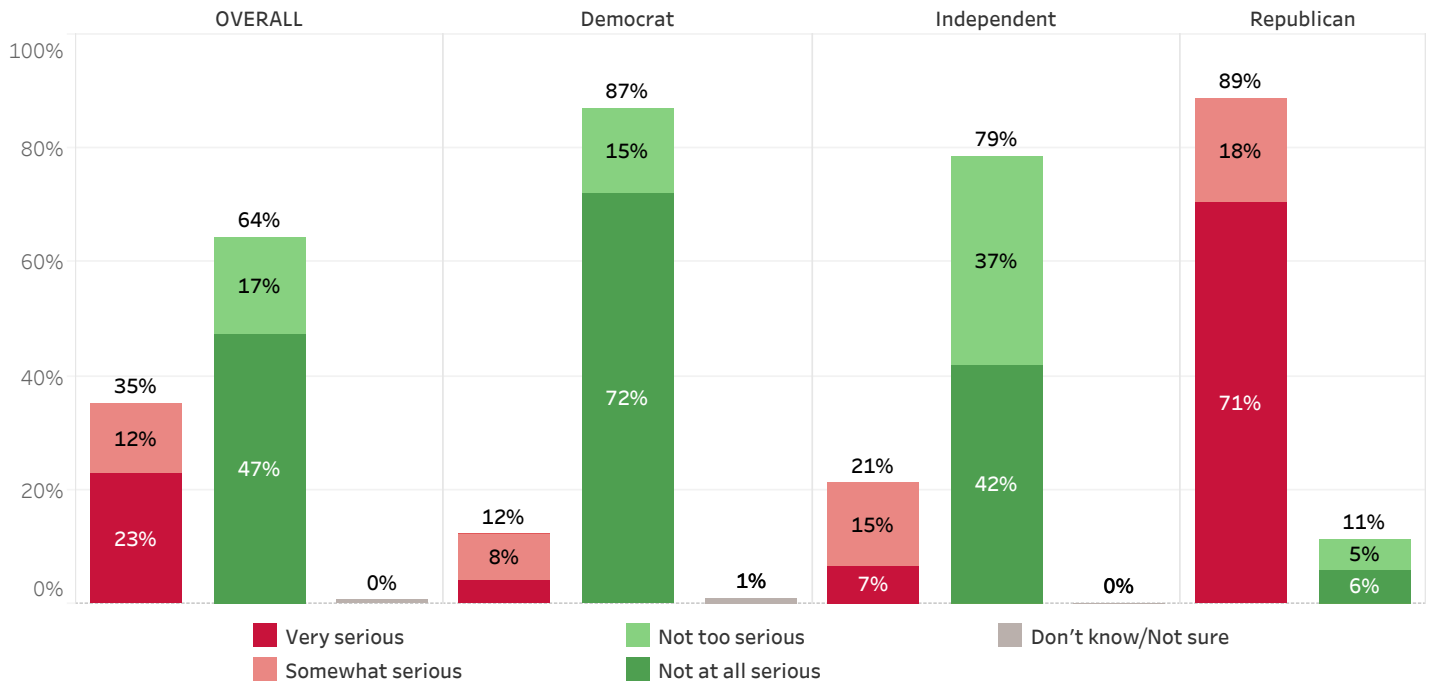
### Ratings of Candidate's Performance at September 10th Presidential Debate - September 2024



## Election Integrity

Thirty-five percent of Massachusetts residents believe that voter fraud is a very (23%) or somewhat (12%) serious problem in the United States, 64% think it is not too serious (17%) or not at all serious (47%), and less than 1% are unsure. Most Republicans (89%) believe that voter fraud is a very or somewhat serious problem in the country but only 21% of Independents and 12% of Democrats agree.

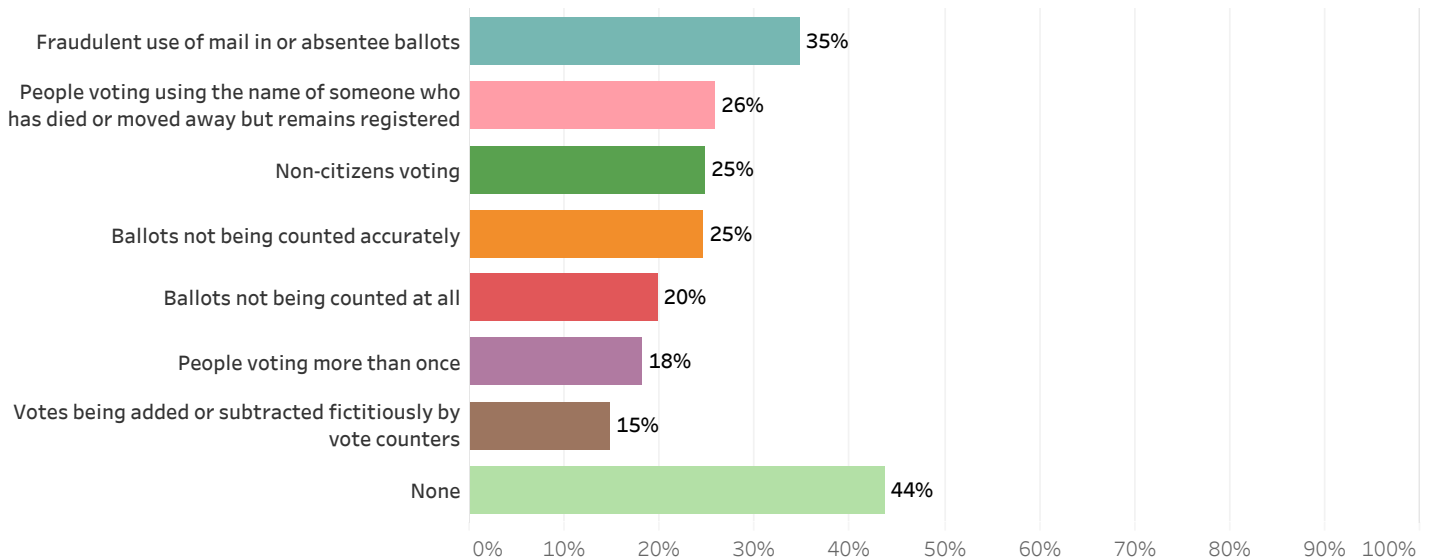
**Seriousness of Voter Fraud in United States - By Party ID - September 2024**



Thirty-five percent of Massachusetts residents believe that fraudulent use of mail in or absentee ballots occurs frequently in the country as a whole, 26% believe people frequently vote using the name of someone who has died or moved away but remains registered, 25% each believe that non-citizens frequently vote and that ballots are frequently not counted accurately, 20% believe ballots are frequently not counted at all, 18% believe people frequently vote more than once, and 15% believe votes are frequently added or subtracted fictitiously by vote counters. Forty-four percent believe that none of these things happen frequently in the United States.

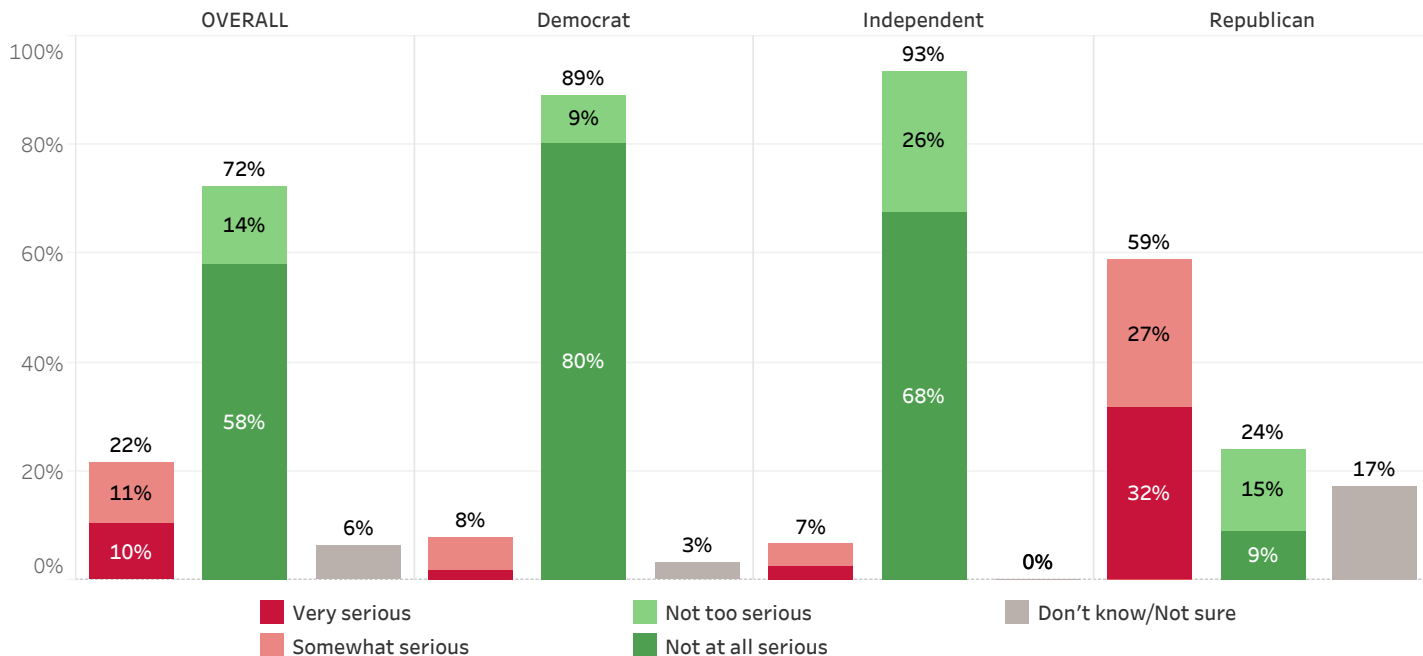
A majority of Republicans believe that fraudulent use of mail in or absentee ballots (84%), non-citizens voting (75%), people voting using the name of someone else (64%), ballots not being counted accurately (56%), and ballots not being counted at all (53%) occurs frequently in the country. Independents and Democrats are considerably less likely to believe that these things happen frequently.

Bay Staters are less likely to consider voter fraud to be a serious problem in Massachusetts: 22% believe that voter fraud is a very (10%) or somewhat (11%) serious problem in Massachusetts, 72% think it is not too serious (14%) or not at all serious (58%), and 6% are unsure. More than half of Republicans (59%) believe that voter fraud is a very or somewhat serious problem in Massachusetts but only 8% of Democrats and 7% of Independents agree.

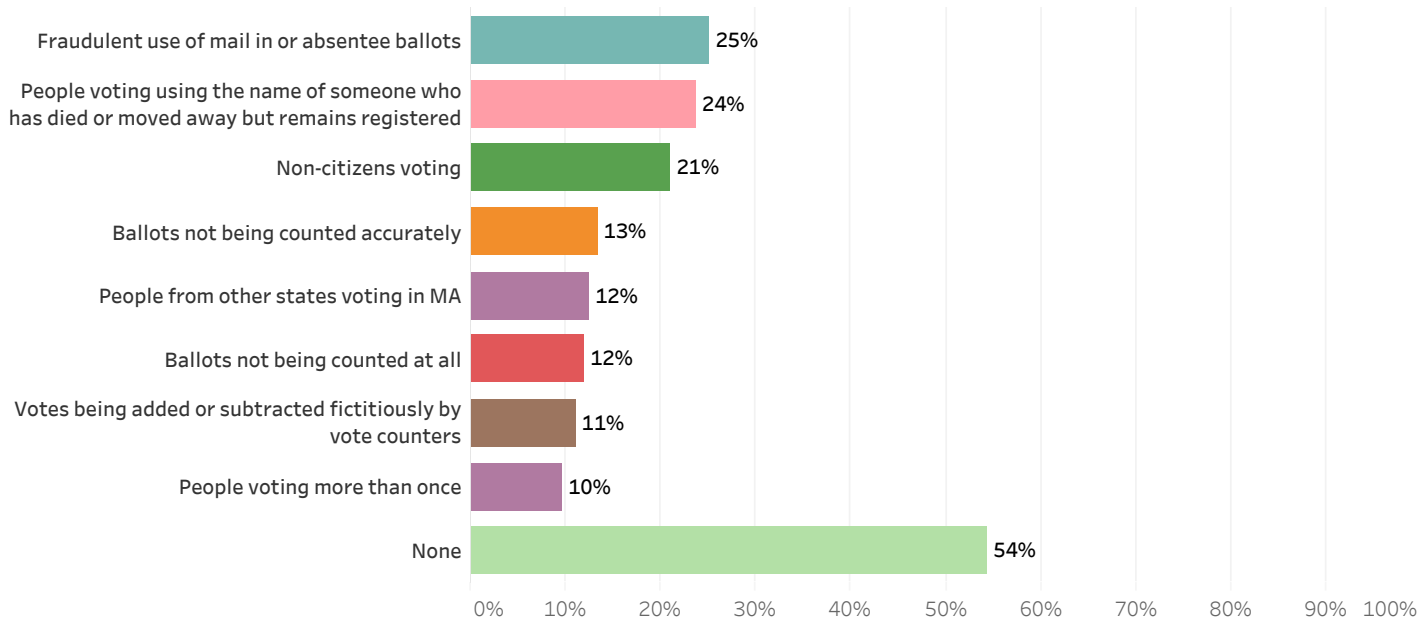
**Seriousness of Voter Fraud in Massachusetts - By Party ID - September 2024**



Twenty-five percent of Massachusetts residents believe that fraudulent use of mail or absentee ballots occurs frequently in Massachusetts, 24% believe people frequently vote using the name of someone who has died or moved away but remains registered, and 20% believe non-citizens frequently vote. Fewer state residents believe that ballots are frequently not counted accurately (13%), that people from other states frequently vote in Massachusetts (12%), that ballots are frequently not counted at all (12%), that votes are frequently added or subtracted fictitiously by voter counters (11%), or that people frequently vote more than once (10%). Fifty-four percent believe that none of these things happen frequently in Massachusetts.

More than one-third of Republicans believe that fraudulent use of mail in or absentee ballots (58%), people voting using the name of someone else (47%), and non-citizens voting (47%) occurs frequently in the state.

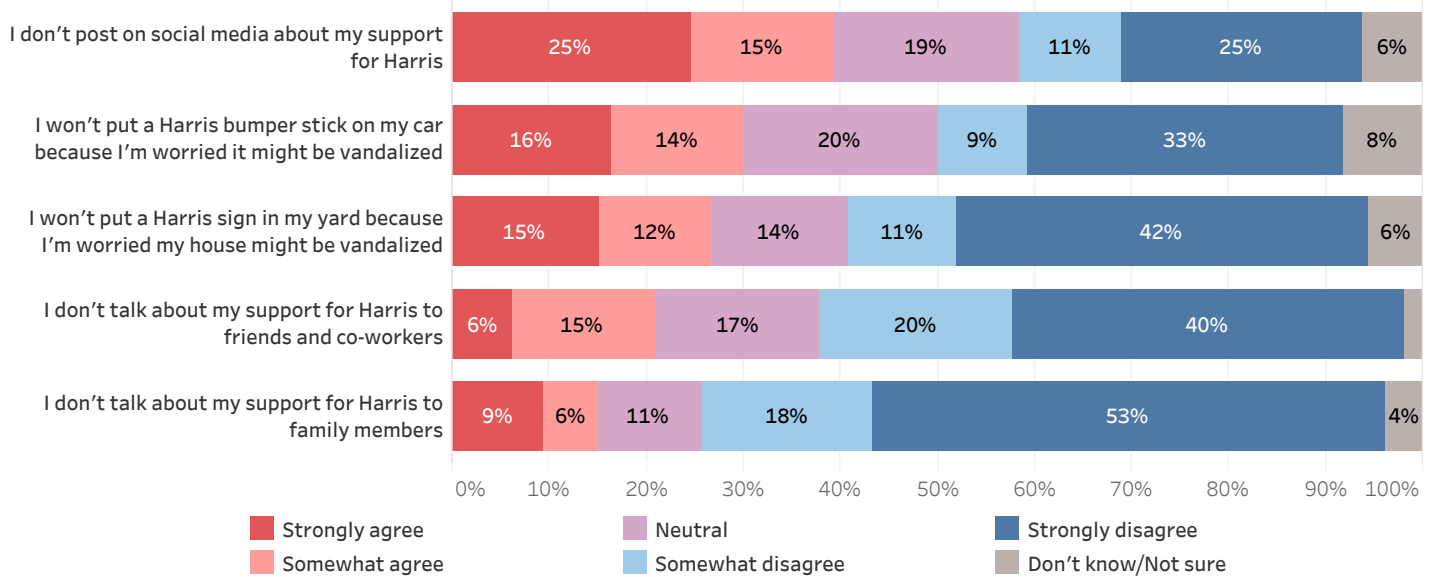
**Forms of Voter Fraud Believe Occur Frequently in Massachusetts - September 2024**



### Reluctance to Express Political Support

Four in ten Harris supporters (39%) strongly (25%) or somewhat (15%) agree that they don't post on social media about their support for Harris, 19% are neutral on this question, 36% somewhat (11%) or strongly (25%) disagree, and 6% are unsure how they feel. Three in ten (30%) agree that they won't put a Harris bumper sticker on their car because they are worried it might be vandalized, 27% say that they won't put a Harris sign in their yard because they are worried their house might be vandalized, 21% don't talk about their support for Harris to friends and co-workers, and 15% don't talk about their support for Harris to family members.

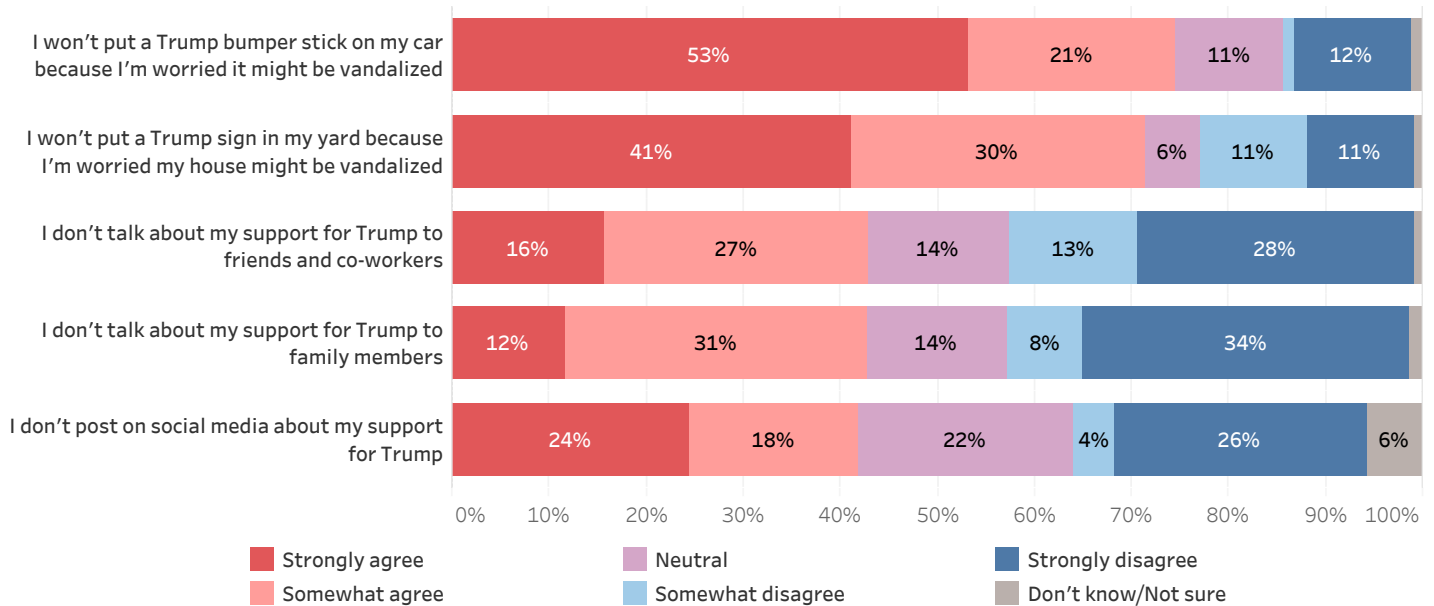
#### Concerns Held by Some Harris Supporters - Among Harris Supporters - September 2024



Trump supporters are much less likely to publicly support Trump. Three-quarters of Trump supporters (75%) strongly (53%) or somewhat (21%) agree that they won't put a Trump bumper sticker on their car because they're worried it might be vandalized, 11% are neutral on this question, 13% somewhat (1%) or strongly (12%) disagree, and 1% are unsure how they feel. Seventy-one percent agree that they won't put a Trump sign in their yard because they are worried their house might be vandalized while fewer Trump supporters say that they don't talk about their support for Trump with friends and co-workers (43%) or with family members (43%) or don't post on social media about their support for Trump (42%).

Among Trump supporters, women are a good deal more likely to say that they will not post on social media about their support for Trump and not talk about their support for Trump with friends, coworkers, or family.

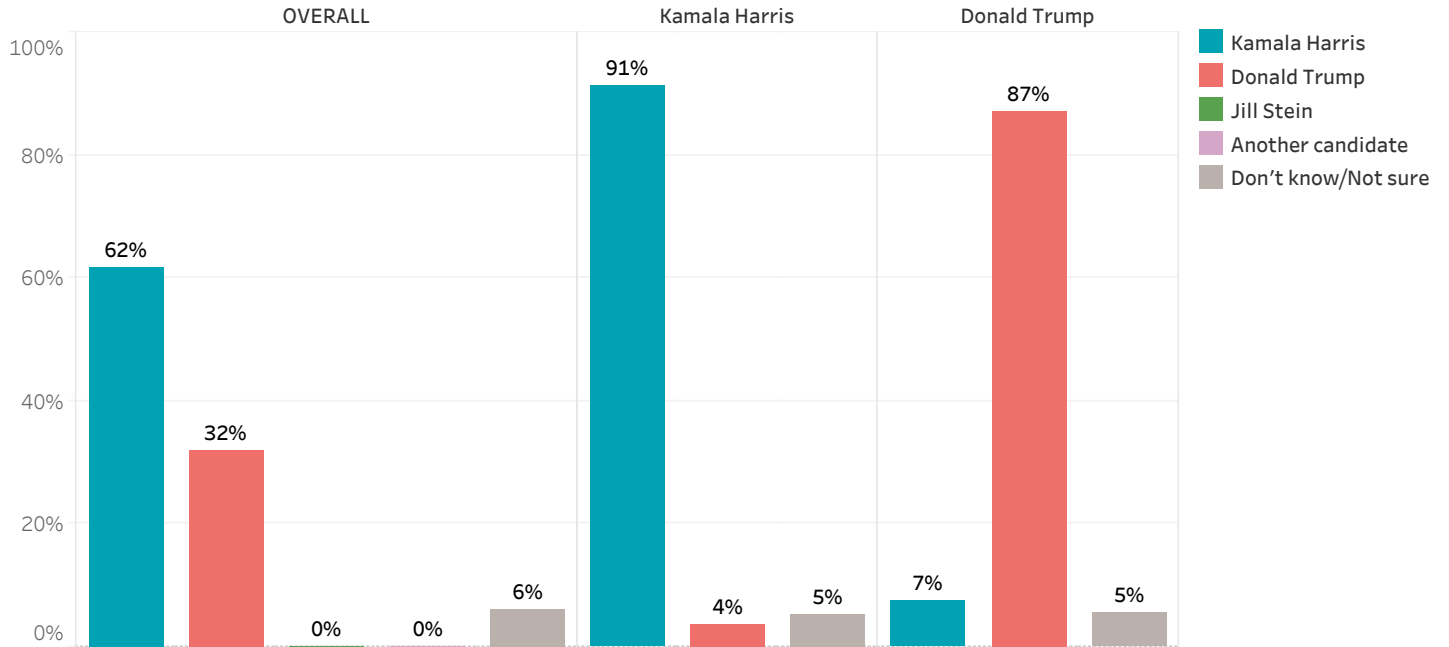
#### Concerns Held by Some Trump Supporters - Among Trump Supporters - September 2024



Sixty-two percent of likely Massachusetts voters say that the majority of people they know support Harris, 32% say the majority of the people they know support Trump, less than 1% say the majority support Stein or another candidate, and 6% are unsure.

There is strong evidence of social “sorting” among Massachusetts residents. Among Harris supporters, 91% say the majority of people they know also support Harris while only 4% believe a majority of the people they know support Trump. Among Trump supporters, 87% say the majority of the people they know support Trump while 7% believe a majority of the people they know support Harris.

## Bay State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Bay State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Overall, 596 individuals completed the survey between September 12 and September 16, 2024. Four hundred eighty-two (482) Bay State Panel members completed the survey online. The response rate for panel respondents to the September 2024 Bay State Poll is 31%. In addition, 114 Massachusetts residents completed the survey after receiving an invitation via text message to complete the survey online. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 4.0 percent. Included in the sample were 564 likely general election voters (margin of sampling error +/- 4.1 percent). In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The design effect for the survey is 2.3%.

The Bay State Panel is a probability-based web panel of Massachusetts residents. Approximately 1,750 Massachusetts adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the MA Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Massachusetts. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
