

HARRIS LEADS TRUMP IN RHODE ISLAND BUT VOTERS UNSURE WHO WILL WIN PRESIDENCY

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
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DURHAM, NH - Vice President Kamala Harris continues to enjoy a double-digit lead over former President Donald Trump in Rhode Island as the campaign comes to a close. However, Harris supporters and Rhode Islanders generally are less likely than in September to believe Harris will win the national election and become president. Harris has only middling favorability among Rhode Islanders but Trump is quite unpopular in the state. Concerns about the upcoming election are commonplace, as more than four in five say they are concerned about individuals trying to interfere with the electoral process and political leaders attempting to illegally seize power.

2024 Presidential Race

With the 2024 General Election only days away, Vice President Harris continues to have a comfortable lead over former President Trump in Rhode Island. Among likely voters, 54% say that they will vote for Harris or have already voted for her while 40% say they will vote or have voted for Trump. Few say they will vote or have voted for Party Party nominee Robert "Robby" Wells (2%), Green Party nominee Jill Stein (1%), Independent Robert F. Kennedy Jr. (1%), Socialism and Liberation nominee Claudia De La Cruz (1%), Libertarian nominee Chase Oliver (<1%), or another candidate (1%), while 1% are undecided. Harris' lead over Trump (+14 percentage points) is slightly lower than in September (+20). Nearly all Trump (98%) and Harris (97%) supporters say they have definitely decided whom to support or have already voted.


Harris enjoys the support of most self-described liberals (95%), socialists (80%), progressives (77%), and moderates (61%) in the state, while most conservatives (96%) and libertarians (88%) support Trump. Men and women differ dramatically in their preferences in this race: among women, 66% support Harris while only 31% support Trump, while among men 52% support Trump and 40% support Harris.



2024 Presidential General Election Matchup



Among Harris voters (N=377), 61% say that their vote is more for Harris than it is against Trump, while 37% say that their vote is more against Trump than for Harris. Majorities of moderates (64%), progressives (63%), and liberals (60%) say that their vote is more for Harris than against Trump but a majority of socialists (54%) say that their vote is more against Trump than for Harris.




Vote More for Harris or Against Trump - Among Harris Supporters - November 2024

Among Trump voters (N=278), 80% say that their vote is more for Trump than it is against Harris, while 20% say that their vote is more against Harris than for Trump.



Vote More for Trump or Against Harris - Among Trump Supporters - November 2024


When asked who they believe is most likely to win the presidential election, 45% name Harris, 41% name Trump, and 13% are unsure. In September, 55% thought Harris would win while only 35% felt Trump would win. Seventy-two percent of Harris supporters think she is most likely to win, down from 85% in September, while 86% of Trump supporters think he is most likely to win, up from 81% in August.



Who Believe is Most Likely to Win 2024 Presidential Race


Turning to the personal favorability of the candidates, 48% of likely voters in Rhode Island have a favorable opinion of Harris, 45% have an unfavorable opinion of her, and 7% are neutral. Harris' net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion), is +3. Harris' net favorability rating among Democrats is +75, while her net favorability rating is -67 among Independents and -96 among Republicans. Harris' running mate, Minnesota Governor Tim Walz, is viewed favorably by 49% of likely voters, 39% have an unfavorable opinion, and 11% are neutral, yielding a net favorability rating of +10.

Thirty-two percent of Rhode Island residents have a favorable opinion of Trump, 58% have an unfavorable opinion, and 9% are neutral, yielding a net favorability rating of -26. Trump's net favorability rating among Republicans is +77, while his net favorability rating is -6 among Independents and -87 among Democrats. Likely voters have a similar opinion of Trump's running mate, Ohio Senator J.D. Vance: 33% have a favorable opinion of Vance, 53% have an unfavorable opinion, and 9% are neutral.




2024 Presidential & Vice-Presidential Candidates Favorability - November 2024

Respondents were asked what one word they would use to describe Harris and Trump. The most often mentioned words for each candidate among Harris and Trump supporters may be found below.




Election Integrity

Eighty-nine percent of likely voters feel very (60%) or somewhat (29%) confident that their vote in the upcoming general election will be accurately counted. Eleven percent say they are not very confident (10%) or not at all confident (1%) that their vote will be counted accurately while less than 1% are unsure. The vast majority of Democrats (98%) and Independents (92%) are very or somewhat confident that their vote will be accurately counted but only 69% of Republicans feel that way.

Eighty-four percent of Rhode Island residents say they are very (54%) or somewhat (30%) concerned that people will try to interfere with the election process using illegal or violent methods, 10% are not very concerned about this happening, and 6% are not concerned at all. Most Rhode Islanders are also very or somewhat concerned that in the next year political leaders will use illegal or violent methods to gain or hold onto power (82%) or that in the next year political leaders they support will be violently attacked because of their political beliefs or affiliation (77%). There is less concern about potential violence perpetrated on respondents themselves or people they know: 47% are very (20%) or somewhat (27%) concerned that in the next year they or someone they know will be violently attacked because of their political beliefs or affiliation while 53% are not very (31%) or not at all concerned (22%) about this happening.





election process using illegal or violent methods


Political leaders will use illegal or violent methods to gain or hold onto power

Ocean State State Election Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Ocean State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Overall, 754 individuals completed the survey between October 29 and November 2, 2024. Six hundred fifty-nine (659) Ocean State Panel members completed the survey online. The response rate for panel respondents to this November 2024 Ocean State Election Poll is 35%. In addition, 95 Rhode Island residents completed the survey after receiving an invitation via text message to complete the survey online. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.6 percent. Included in the sample were 708 likely general election voters (margin of sampling error +/- 3.7 percent). In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The design effect for the survey is 2.0%.

The Ocean State Panel is a probability-based web panel of Rhode Island residents. Approximately 2,100 Rhode Island adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau as well as party registration levels provided by the RI Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Rhode Island. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
