#### MASS VOTERS SUPPORT AUDIT OF LEGISLATURE & TRANSPORTATION UNIONS, SPLIT ON TIPPING REFORM & REMOVING MCAS


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DURHAM, NH - Clear majorities of likely voters in Massachusetts support ballot measures which would authorize an audit of the state legislature and provide for unionizing transportation drivers while a plurality support greater access to psychedelic substances. Voters are split on repealing the requirement that high school students pass the MCAS exam to graduate and increasing the wage of tipped employees. Incumbent Democratic Senator Elizabeth Warren holds a comfortable lead over Republican nominee John Deaton in the U.S. Senate race and most voters in the state expect Warren to win.

#### 2024 Massachusetts Senate Election

Incumbent Democrat Elizabeth Warren is on track to win a third term in the U.S. Senate. Sixty percent of likely voters say they will vote or have already voted for Warren while 37% say they will vote or have voted for Republican nominee John Deaton and 3% are undecided. Ninety-six percent of Democrats support Warren while 95% of Republicans support Deaton. Among Independents, 51% support Warren, 43% support Deaton, and 6% are undecided. Nearly all Warren supporters (98%) and 91% of Deaton supporters say they have definitely decided whom to support or have already voted.


Warren enjoys the support of nearly all socialists (>99%), progressives (99%), and liberals (99%), along with a majority of moderates (56%), while Deaton has those support of nearly all conservatives (97%) and libertarians (94%). Deaton does best among men aged 18-34, leading with 56% of the vote compared to 44% for Warren, but Warren has her largest lead among women aged 18-34, garnering 92% of the vote compared to only 8% for Deaton.


Most likely voters believe that Warren (84%) will win the election for the U.S. Senate, only 12% believe Deaton will win, and 4% are unsure. Nearly all (>99%) Warren supporters think she is most likely to win while only 32% of Deaton supporters think he is most likely to win.



# Who Believe is Most Likely to Win 2024 Massachusetts Senate Race - by Sen. Candidate Supported - November 2024

Nearly half (48%) of likely voters have a favorable opinion of Warren, 37% have an unfavorable opinion of her, 14% are neutral, and 1% don't know enough about her to say, yielding a net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion) of +11. Warren is very popular among Democrats (+76) but is very unpopular among Republicans (-91) while Independents are largely neutral (-7).

Voters are split on Deaton, with many being unfamiliar with him. Twenty-four percent of likely voters have a favorable opinion of Deaton, 21% have an unfavorable opinion of him, 23% are neutral, and 32% don't know enough about him to say, yielding a net favorability rating of +3. Deaton is popular among Republicans (+63) but is unpopular among Democrats (-35) while Independents are largely neutral (+9).

#### 2024 Ballot Questions

Massachusetts voters will vote on the following ballot questions in the 2024 general election:

Question 1 - Authorize the state auditor to audit the state legislature, and remove some existing regulations regarding the auditing process

Question 2 - Repeal the requirement that students must achieve a certain competency level on the Massachusetts Comprehensive Assessment System (MCAS) exam to graduate high school


Question 3 - Provide for unionizing and collective bargaining for transportation network drivers

Question 4 - Regulate access to psychedelic substances

Question 5 - Gradually increase the wage of tipped employees until it meets the state minimum wage in 2029 and still permit tipping in addition to the minimum wage


Eighty-one percent of likely voters have heard a lot (42%) or some (39%) about Question 5 and 82% say that they understand this question very or somewhat well. A similar percentage have heard a lot or some about Question 2 (81%) and 88% say that they understand this question.

Likely voters in Massachusetts are less familiar with the other measures on the ballot. Just over half have heard a lot of some about Question 3 (58%), Question 4 (57%), and Question 1 (51%). While fewer likely voters have heard about these measures, most say they understand each very or somewhat well.




#### How Much Heard About 2024 Ballot Questions - November 2024






Nearly two-thirds (65%) of likely Massachusetts voters say they will vote "yes" on Question 1 (auditing of state legislature), only 19% say they will vote "no" and 15% are undecided, while 55% say they will vote yes on Question 3 (unionizing of transportation drivers). Likely voters are somewhat supportive of Question 4 (greater access to psychedelic substances): 48% plan to vote for it, 36% plan to vote against it, and 16% are undecided, while voters are closely divided on Question 2 (removing MCAS requirement for graduation), on which 49% plan to vote "yes" and 43% plan to vote "no", and on Question 5 (increase minimum wage of tipped employees), on which 41% plan to vote "yes" and 45% plan to vote "no."

Support for Question 1 is bipartisan, but Massachusetts voters disagree considerably on the other questions, with Democrats generally more supportive. More than three-quarters (78%) of Democrats say they will vote "yes" on Question 3, but only 36% of Independents and 30% of Republicans agree. Similarly, nearly two-thirds of Democrats say they will vote yes on Questions 2 (65%) and 4 (63%) but fewer Independents and far fewer Republicans plan to vote yes on these questions.

#### **Bay State Election Poll Methodology**

These findings are based on the latest Bay State Election Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Overall, 764 individuals completed the survey between October 29 and November 2, 2024. Five hundred and ninety (590) Bay State Panel members completed the survey online. The response rate for panel respondents to this November 2024 Bay State Election Poll is 37%. In addition, 174 Massachusetts residents completed the survey after receiving an invitation via text message to complete the survey online. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 3.5 percent. Included in the sample were 744 likely general election voters (margin of sampling error +/- 3.6 percent). In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The design effect for the survey is 2.4%.

The Bay State Panel is a probability-based web panel of Massachusetts residents. Approximately 2,000 Massachusetts adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau as well as party registration levels provided by the Massachusetts Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Massachusetts. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
