HARRIS MAINTAINS WIDE LEAD OVER TRUMP IN VERMONT, FEARS OF POLITICAL VIOLENCE WIDESPREAD

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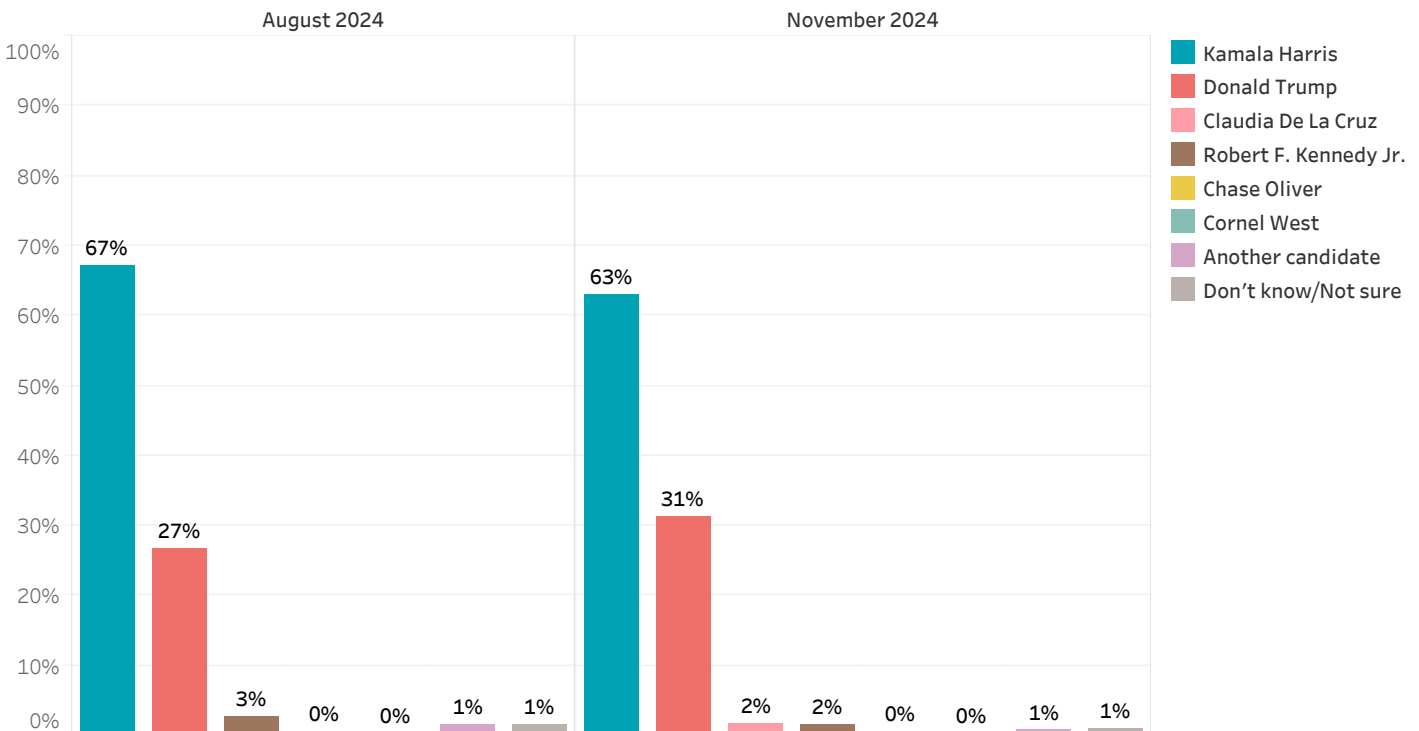
DURHAM, NH - Vice President Kamala Harris holds a substantial lead over former President Donald Trump in Vermont and half of likely voters expect Harris to win the presidency. Most Vermonters are confident their vote will be accurately counted, but most voters are also concerned about attempts by people in the near future to subvert the electoral process or political leaders illegally or violently trying to seize power.

2024 Presidential Race

With the 2024 General Election only days away, Vice President Harris is well ahead of former President Trump in Vermont. Among likely voters, 63% say that they will vote or have already voted for Harris while 31% say they will vote or have voted for Trump. Few say they will vote or have voted for Socialism and Liberation Party nominee Claudia De La Cruz (2%), Independent Robert F. Kennedy Jr. (2%), Libertarian nominee Chase Oliver (<1%), Independent Cornel West (<1%), or another candidate (1%), while 1% are unsure. Harris' lead over Trump (+32 percentage points) has declined somewhat since September (+40) but remains sizable. Nearly all Harris supporters (99%) and Trump supporters (>99%) say they have definitely decided whom to support or have already voted.

Harris enjoys the support of more than three-quarters (76%) of likely voters in Vermont aged 65 and older. Almost all self-described liberals (99%) and progressives (93%) and most socialists (77%) and moderates (72%) support Harris while most conservatives (91%) and libertarians (78%) support Trump. Women with a college degree (80%) and men with a college degree (72%) overwhelmingly support Harris, along with two-thirds of women without a college degree (66%), while Trump garners the support of just over half (51%) of men without a college degree.

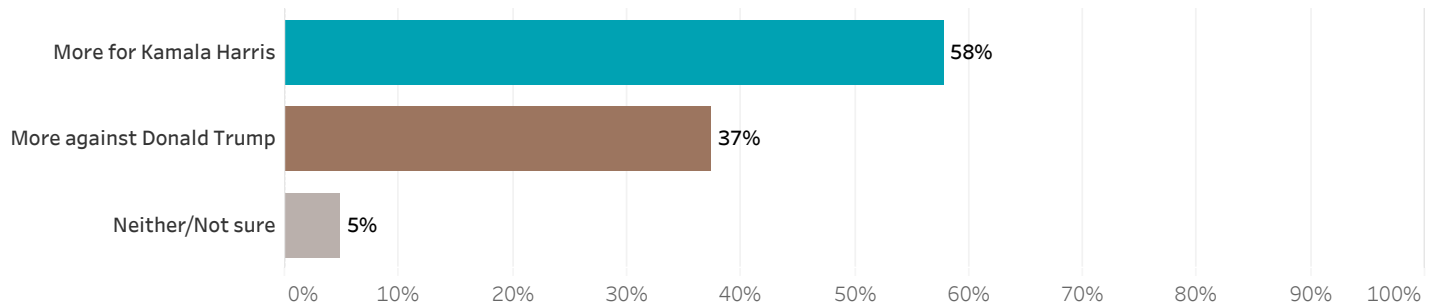
2024 Presidential General Election Matchup

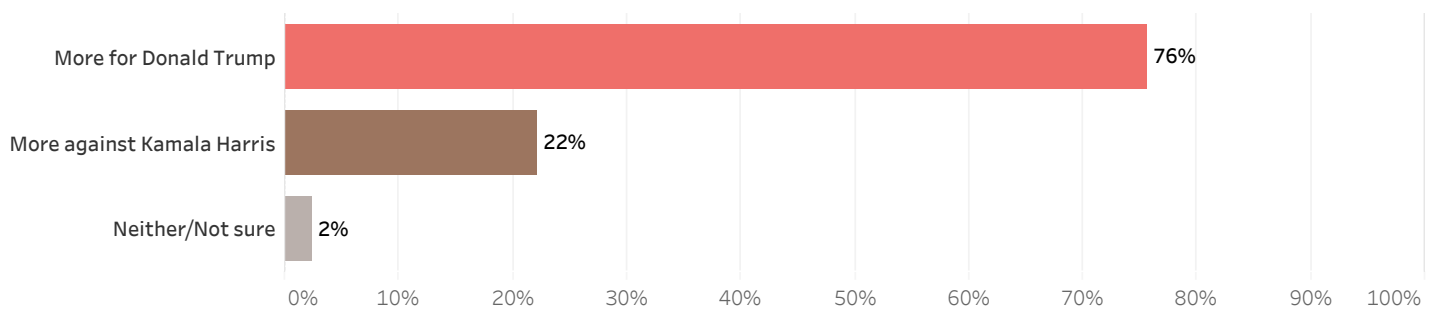
Among Harris voters (N=730), 58% say their vote is more for Harris than it is against Trump, while 37% say their vote is more against Trump than for Harris. Seventy percent of liberals say their vote is more for Harris than against Trump while 57% of progressives, 54% of moderates, and 47% of socialists say that is the case.

Vote More for Harris or Against Trump - Among Harris Supporters - November 2024



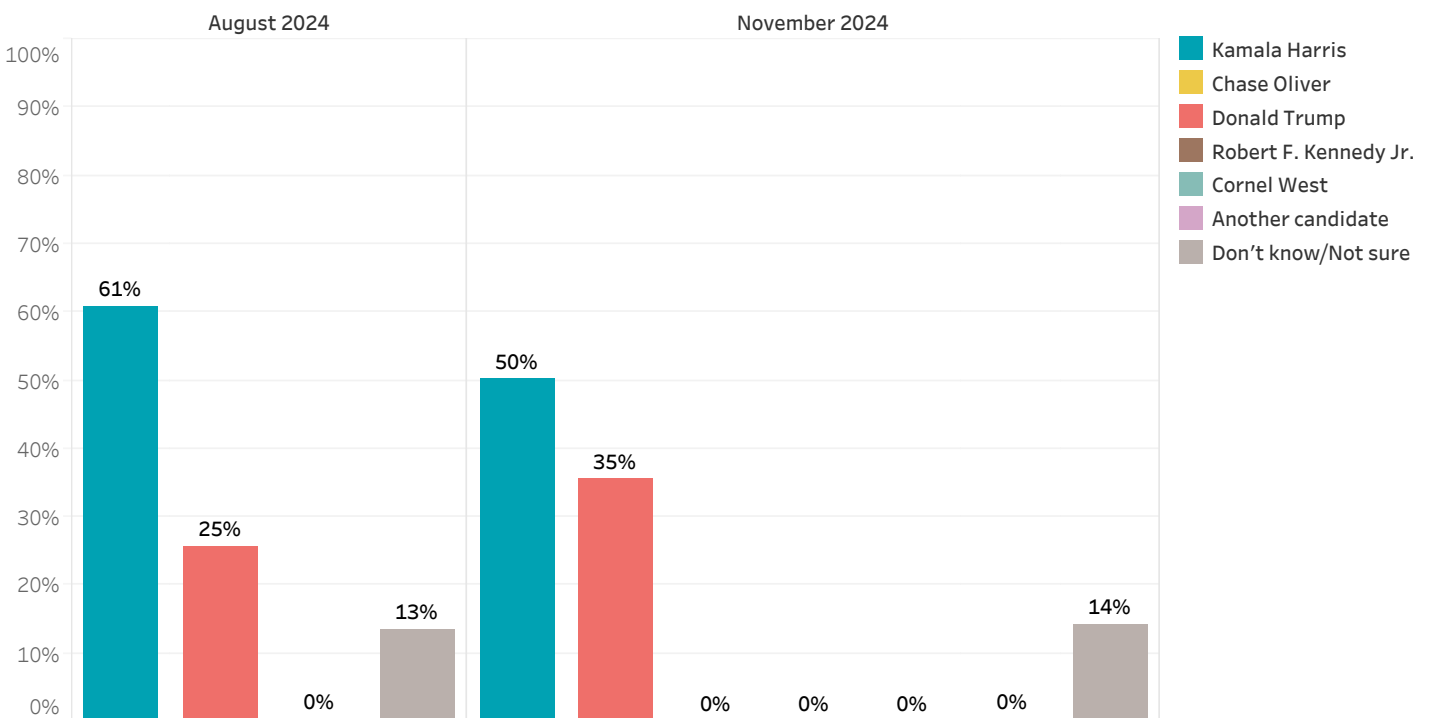
Among Trump voters (N=363), 76% say their vote is more for Trump than it is against Harris, while 22% say their vote is more against Harris than for Trump.

When asked who they believe is most likely to win the presidential election, 50% name Harris, 35% think Trump will win, and 14% are unsure. In August, 61% thought Harris would win while 25% felt Trump would win. Seventy-three percent of Harris supporters think she is most likely to win, down from 84% in September, while 87% of Trump supporters think he is most likely to win, up from 81% in September.

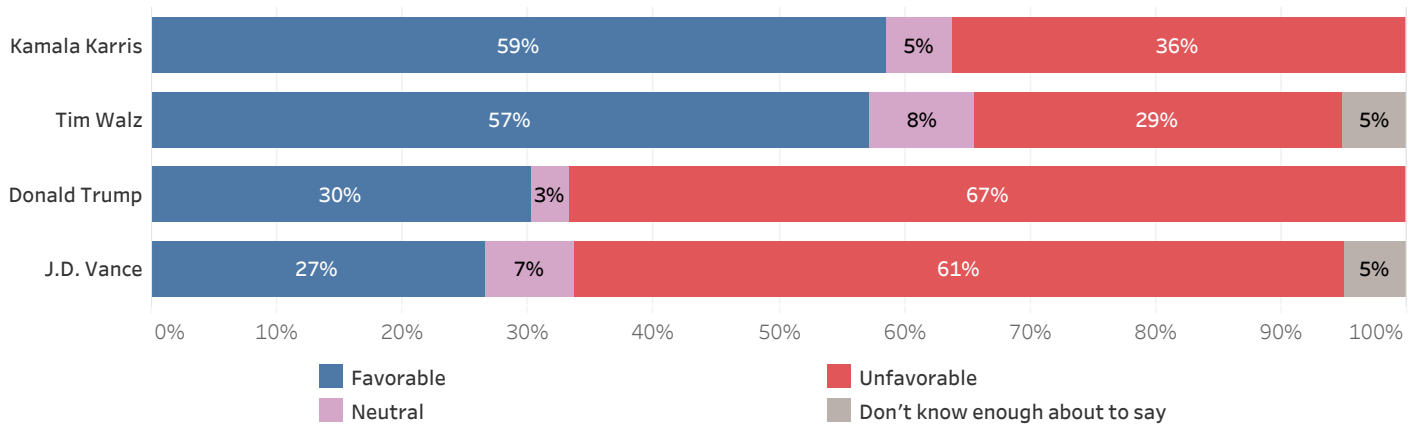
Who Believe is Most Likely to Win 2024 Presidential Race



Turning to the personal favorability of the candidates, 59% of likely voters in Vermont have a favorable opinion of Harris, 36% have an unfavorable opinion of her, and 5% are neutral. Harris' net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion), is +23. Harris' net favorability rating among Democrats is +92, while her net favorability rating is -15 among Independents and -88 among Republicans. Harris' running mate, Tim Walz, is viewed favorably by 57% of likely voters, 29% have an unfavorable opinion, 8% are neutral, and 5% don't know enough about him to say, yielding a net favorability rating of +28.

Thirty percent of Vermonters have a favorable opinion of Trump, 67% have an unfavorable opinion, and 3% are neutral, yielding a net favorability rating of -37. Trump's net favorability rating among Republicans is +72, while his net favorability rating is -42 among Independents and -99 among Democrats. Likely voters have a similar opinion of Trump's running mate J.D. Vance: only 27% have a favorable opinion of Vance, 61% have an unfavorable opinion, and 5% are neutral.

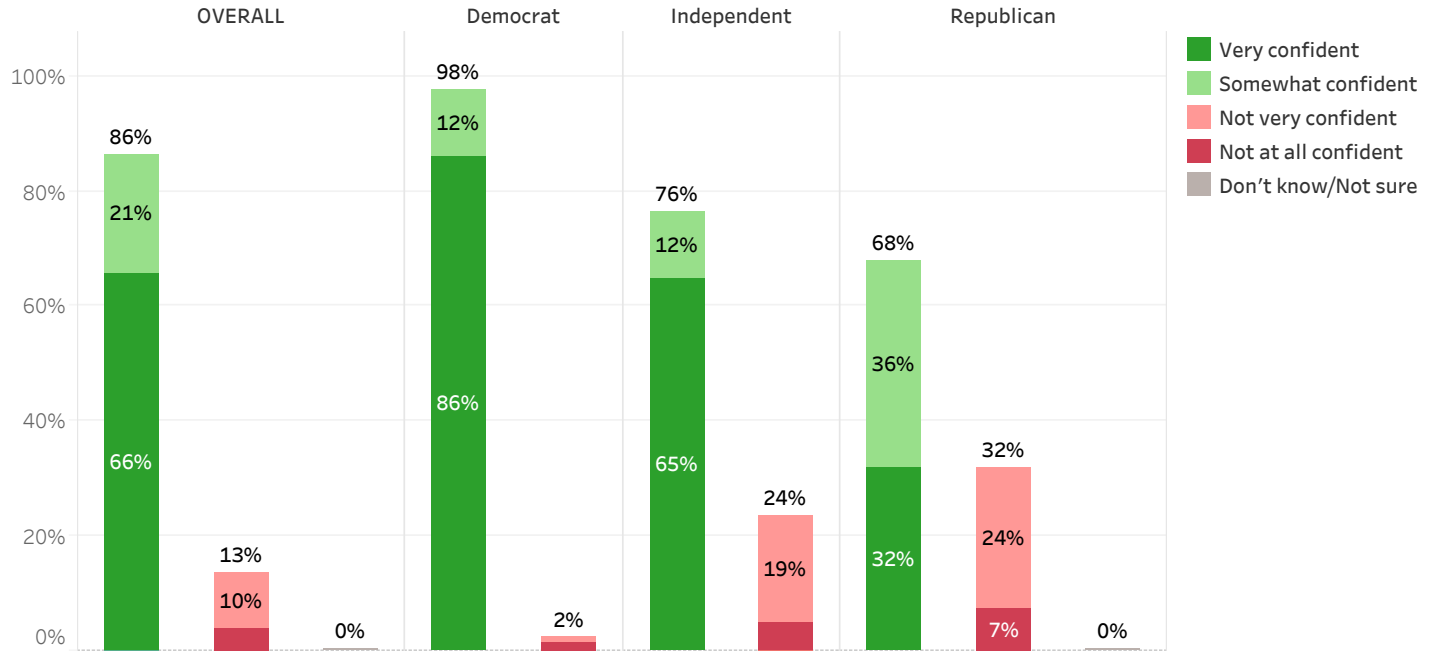

Election Integrity

Eighty-six percent of likely voters feel very (66%) or somewhat (21%) confident that their vote in the upcoming general election will be accurately counted. Thirteen percent say they are not very confident (10%) or not at all confident (4%) that their vote will be counted accurately while less than 1% are unsure. Nearly all self-identified Democrats (98%) are very or somewhat confident that their vote will be accurately counted but only 76% of Independents and 68% of Republicans feel that way.

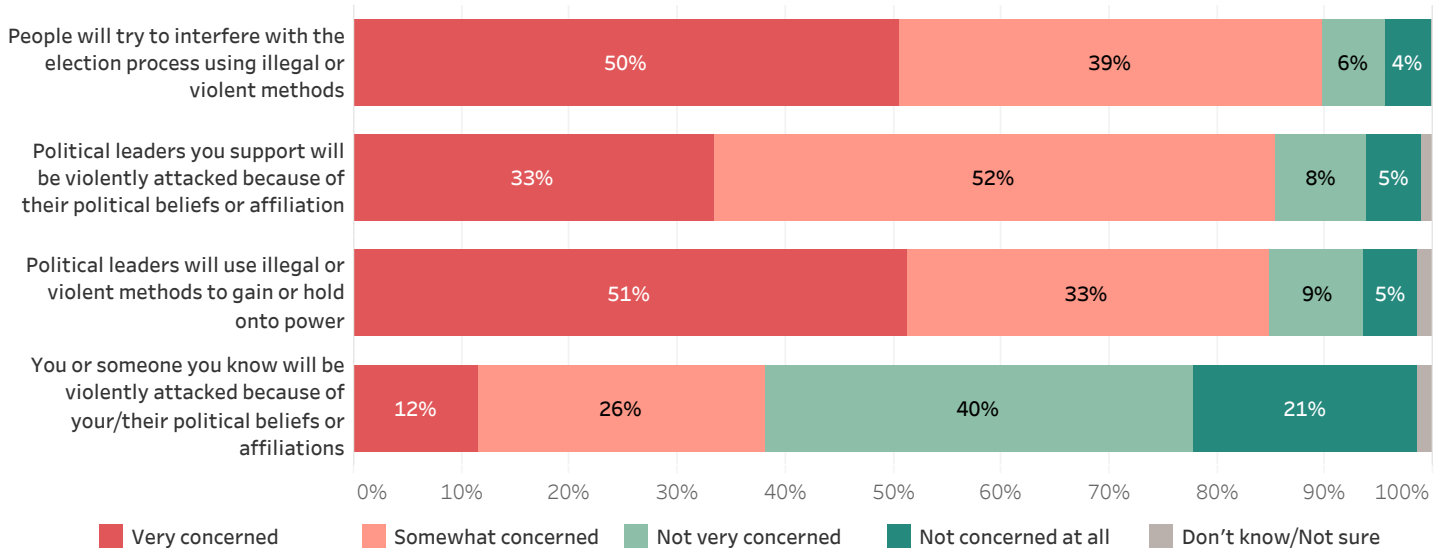
Confidence General Election Vote Will be Accurately Counted - by Party ID - November 2024



Political Violence

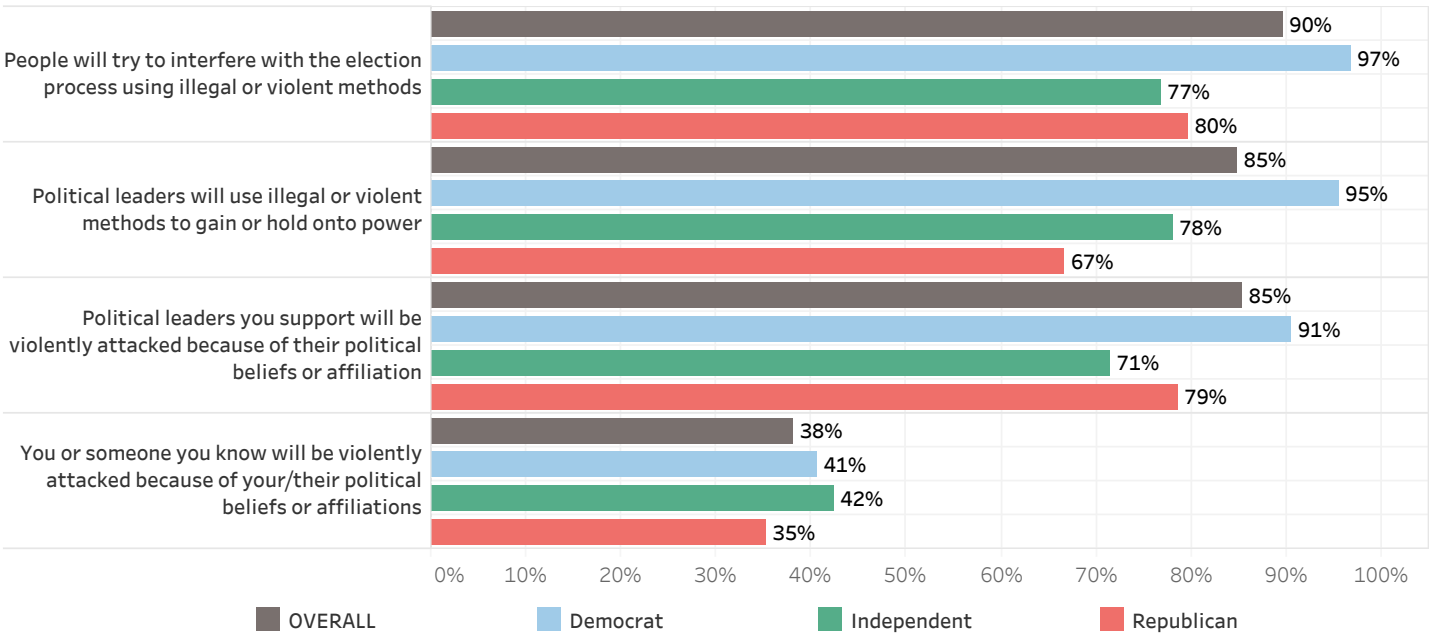
Ninety percent of Vermont residents say they are very (50%) or somewhat (39%) concerned that in the next year, people will try to interfere with the election process using illegal or violent methods, 6% are not very concerned about this happening, and 4% are not concerned at all. Most Vermonters are also very or somewhat concerned that in the next year, political leaders they support will be violently attacked because of their political beliefs or affiliation (85%) or political leaders will use illegal or violent methods to gain or hold onto power (85%). There is considerably less concern about potential violence perpetrated on respondents themselves or people they know: only 38% are very (12%) or somewhat (26%) concerned that in the next year they or someone they know will be violently attacked because of their political beliefs or affiliation while 61% are not very (40%) or not at all concerned (21%) about this happening.

Democrats are more likely than Republicans and Independents to be worried that in the next year people will illegally or violently try to interfere with the election process, political leaders will illegally and violently try to seize power, or political leaders they support will be violently attacked. All three groups are far less concerned about themselves or someone they know personally being attacked due to politics.

Green Mountain State Election Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Green Mountain State Election Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Overall, 1,191 individuals completed the survey between October 29 and November 2, 2024. Nine hundred and ninety-two (992) Green Mountain State Panel members completed the survey online. The response rate for panel respondents to this November 2024 Green Mountain State Election Poll is 43%. In addition, 199 Vermont residents completed the survey after receiving an invitation via text message to complete the survey online. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.8 percent. Included in the sample were 1,167 likely general election voters (margin of sampling error +/- 2.9 percent). In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The design effect for the survey is 2.2%.

The Green Mountain State Panel is a probability-based web panel of Vermont residents. Approximately 2,700 Vermont adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau and to 2020 election results in Vermont. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
