### HARRIS LEADS STATEWIDE IN MAINE BUT TRUMP HAS SMALL LEAD IN CD2

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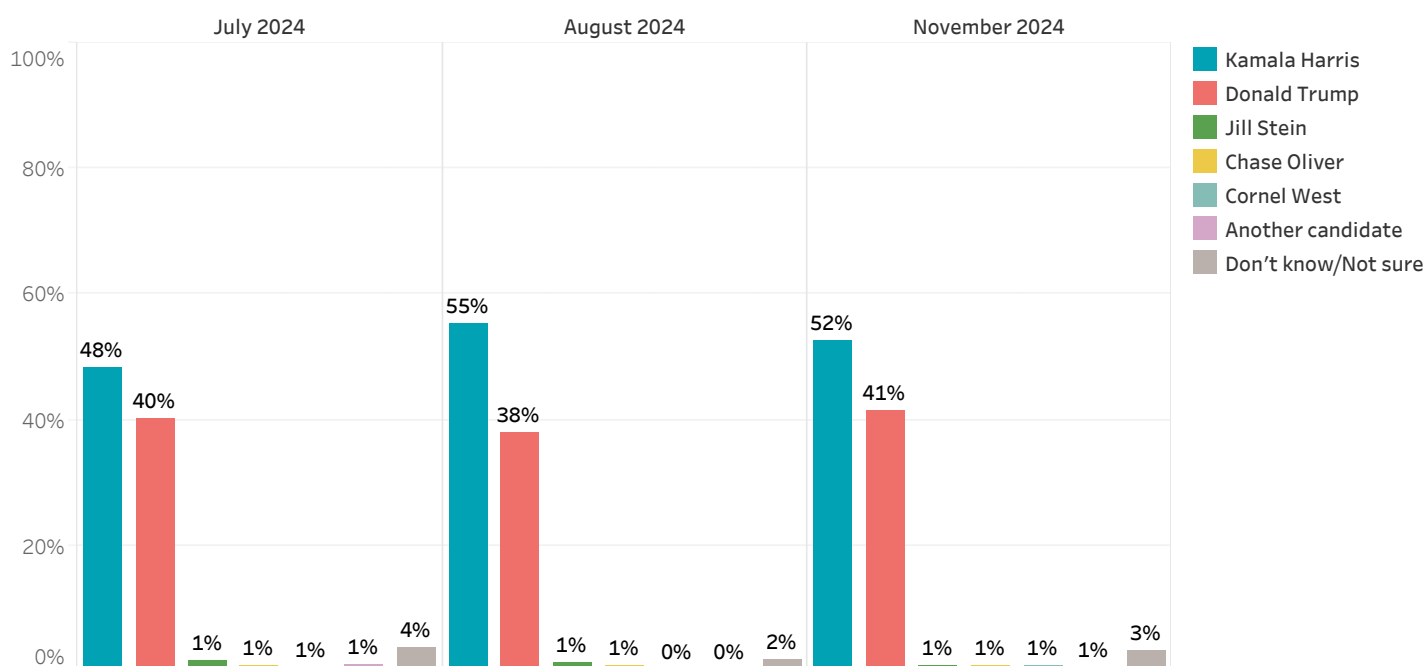
DURHAM, NH - Vice President Kamala Harris leads former President Donald Trump in Maine but Trump holds a slim lead in Maine's 2nd Congressional District, the winner of which receives one electoral vote under Maine's system of apportioning electoral votes. Mainers are evenly divided about who will win the national election. Most Mainers are confident their vote will be accurately counted, but Republicans are less likely than Democrats to feel this way. Mainers are concerned about attempts by people to subvert the electoral process or that political leaders will illegally or violently try to seize power, but relatively few are concerned that they or someone they know might be attacked due to their political beliefs.

### 2024 Presidential Race

With the 2024 General Election only days away, Vice President Harris holds a double-digit lead over former President Trump in Maine. Among likely voters, 52% say that they will vote for or have already voted for Harris while 41% say they will vote or have voted for Trump. Few say they will vote or have voted for Green Party nominee Jill Stein (1%), Libertarian nominee Chase Oliver (1%), Independent Cornel West (1%), or another candidate (1%), while 3% are undecided. Harris' lead over Trump (+11 percentage points) has declined slightly since August (+17) but is larger than her lead in July (+8). Nearly all Harris supporters (99%) and Trump supporters (99%) say they have definitely decided whom to support or have already voted.

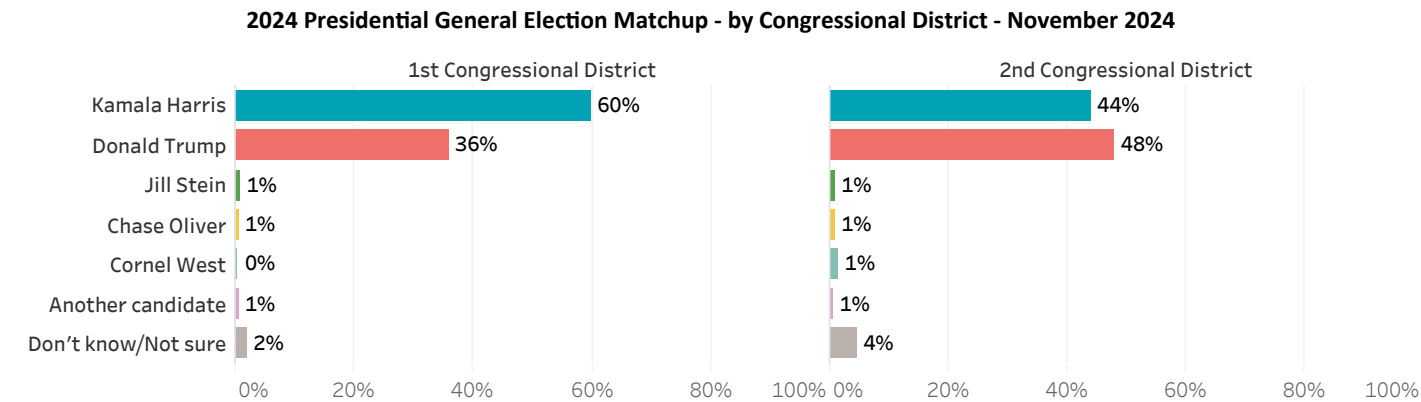
Harris enjoys the support of nearly all self-described liberals (97%) and progressives (92%), along with most socialists (72%) and moderates (66%). Nearly all conservatives (97%) support Trump, along with 69% of libertarians. Harris holds a commanding lead among women with a college degree (+46 percentage points) and a large lead among men with a college degree (+24). By contrast, Harris leads by only 3 percentage points among women without a college degree and Trump holds a lead of 13 percentage points among men without a college degree.

### 2024 Presidential General Election Matchup

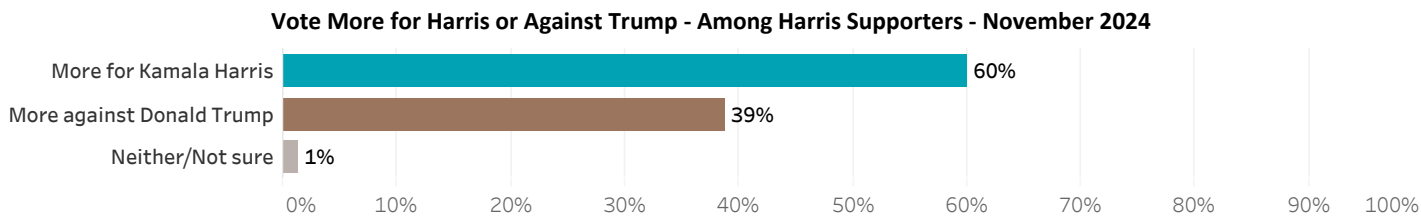


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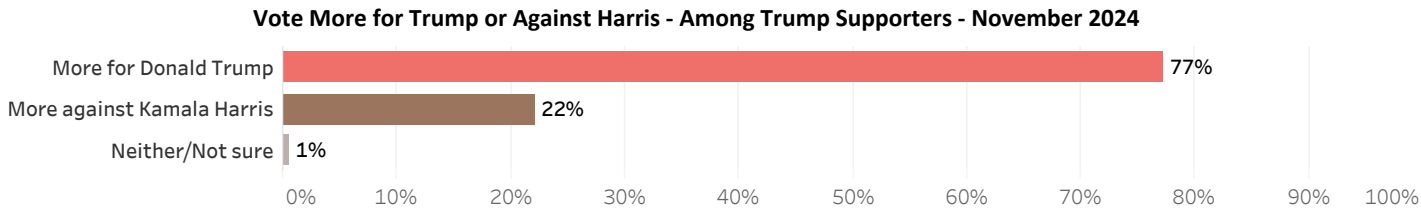
Maine apportions one electoral vote to the winner of each of its two congressional districts, in addition to two electoral votes awarded to the statewide winner. There has been considerable attention given to Maine's 2nd Congressional District, which Trump won by 10 percentage points in 2016 and by 7 percentage points in 2020. Among likely voters, 48% in CD2 say that they will vote for or have already voted for Trump while 44% say they will vote or have voted for Harris. In Maine's 1st Congressional District, Harris holds a commanding lead with 60% of the vote compared to only 36% for Trump.



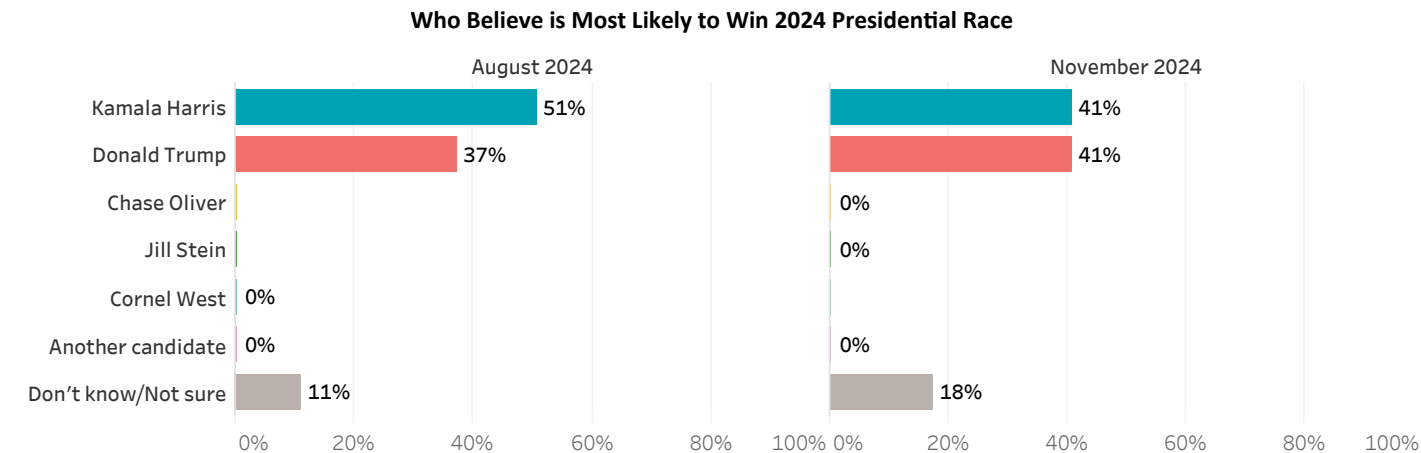
Among Harris voters (N=774), 60% say their vote is more for Harris than it is against Trump, while 39% say their vote is more against Trump than for Harris. Majorities of liberals (74%) and progressives (62%) say their vote is more for Harris than against Trump but a majority of socialists (59%) say their vote is more against Trump than for Harris.



Among Trump voters (N=611), 77% say their vote is more for Trump than it is against Harris, while 22% say their vote is more against Harris than for Trump. Most libertarians (85%) and conservatives (82%) say their vote is more for Trump than against Harris.

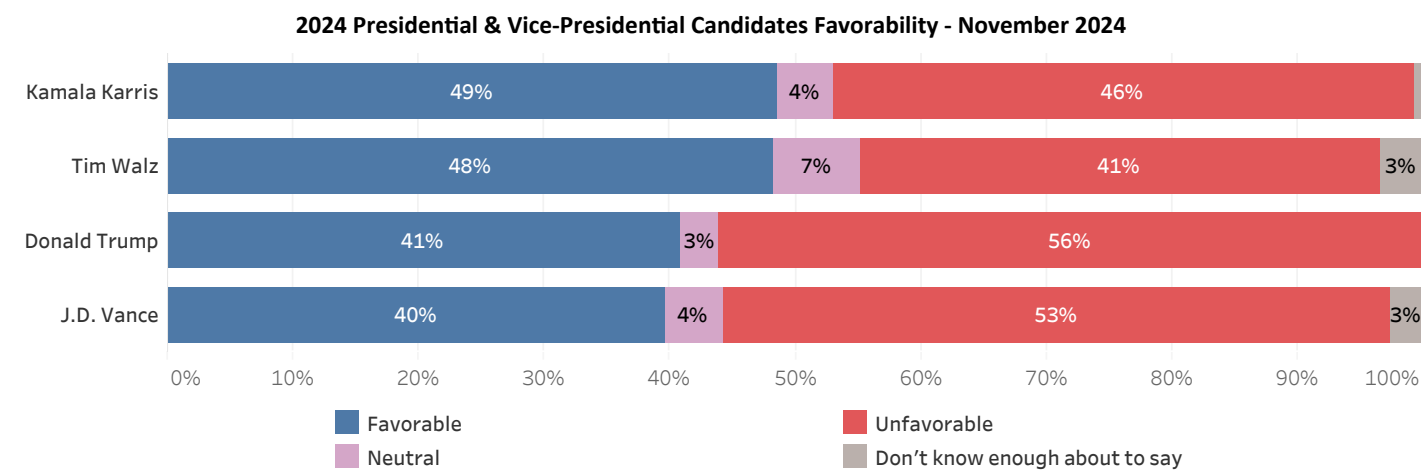


When asked who they believe is most likely to win the presidential election, 41% name Trump, 41% name Harris, and 18% are unsure. In August, 51% thought Harris would win while 37% believed Trump would win. Seventy-one percent of Harris supporters think she will win, down from 84% in August, while 85% of Trump supporters think he will win, largely unchanged since August (83%).



Turning to the personal favorability of the candidates, 49% of likely voters in Maine have a favorable opinion of Harris, 46% have an unfavorable opinion of her, and 4% are neutral. Harris' net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion), is +3. Harris' net favorability rating among Democrats is +86, while her net favorability rating is -7 among Independents and -92 among Republicans. Harris' running mate, Tim Walz, is viewed favorably by 48% of likely voters, 41% have an unfavorable opinion, and 7% are neutral, yielding a net favorability rating of +7.

Forty-one percent of Mainers have a favorable opinion of Trump, 56% have an unfavorable opinion, and 3% are neutral, yielding a net favorability rating of -15. Trump's net favorability rating among Republicans is +84, while his net favorability rating is -36 among Independents and -98 among Democrats. Likely voters have a similar opinion of Trump's running mate J.D. Vance: 40% have a favorable opinion of him, 53% have an unfavorable opinion, and 4% are neutral.

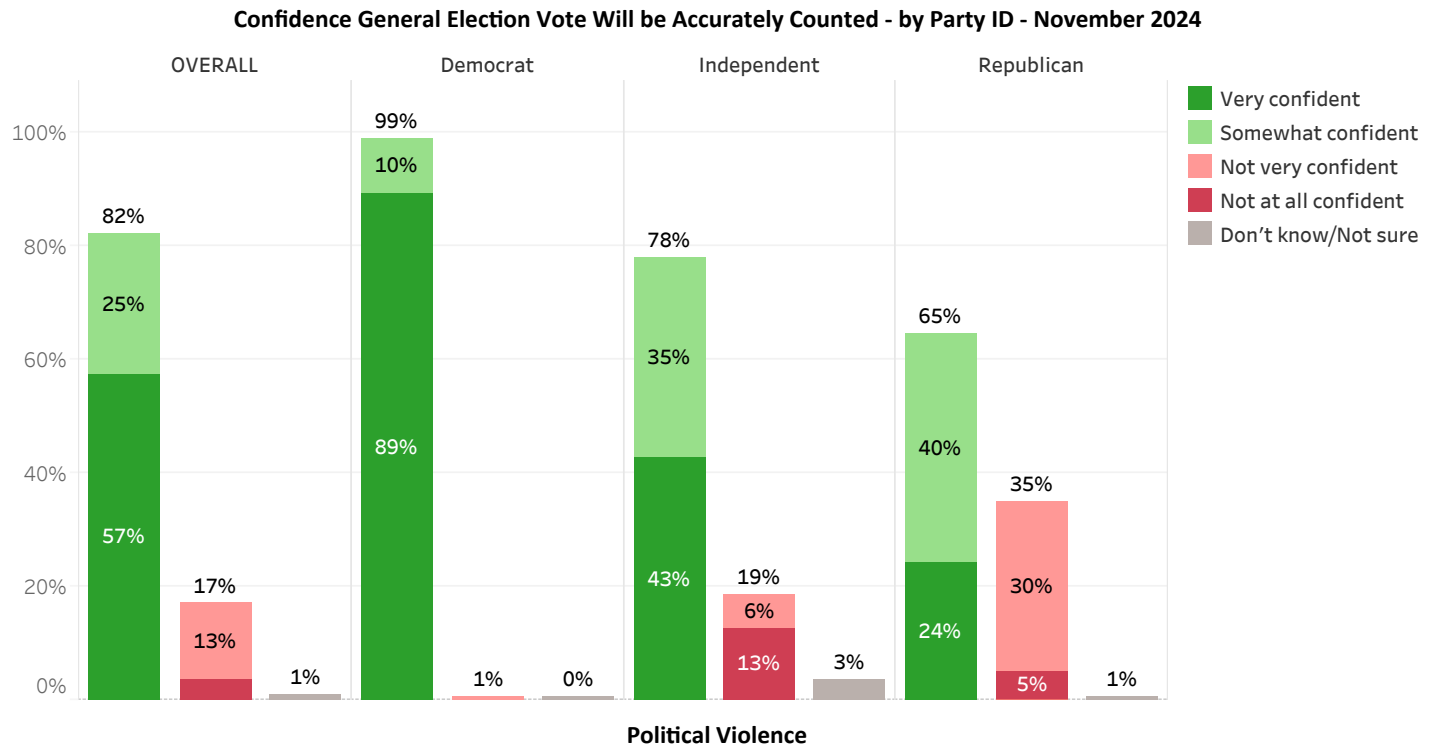


Respondents were asked what one word they would use to describe Harris and Trump. The most often mentioned words for each candidate among Harris and Trump supporters may be found below.



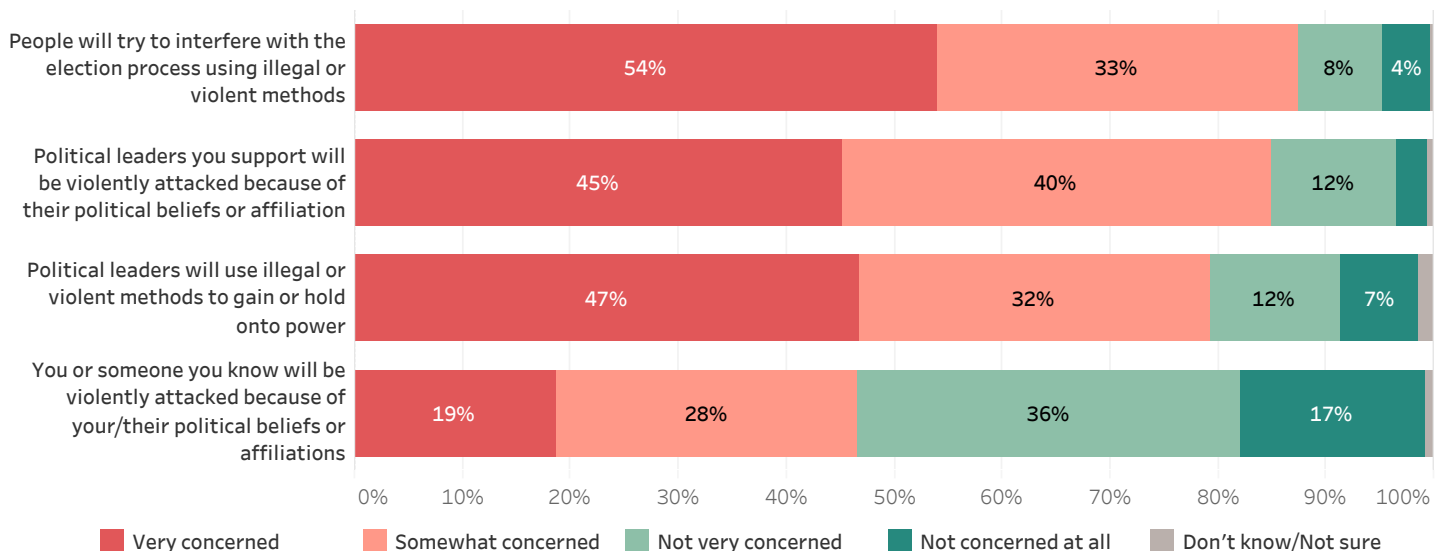
## Election Integrity

Eighty-two percent of likely voters are very (57%) or somewhat (25%) confident their vote will be accurately counted, 17% are not very confident (13%) or not at all confident (4%) their vote will be counted accurately and 1% are unsure. Nearly all self-identified Democrats (99%) are very or somewhat confident their vote will be accurately counted but only 78% of Independents and 65% of Republicans feel that way.

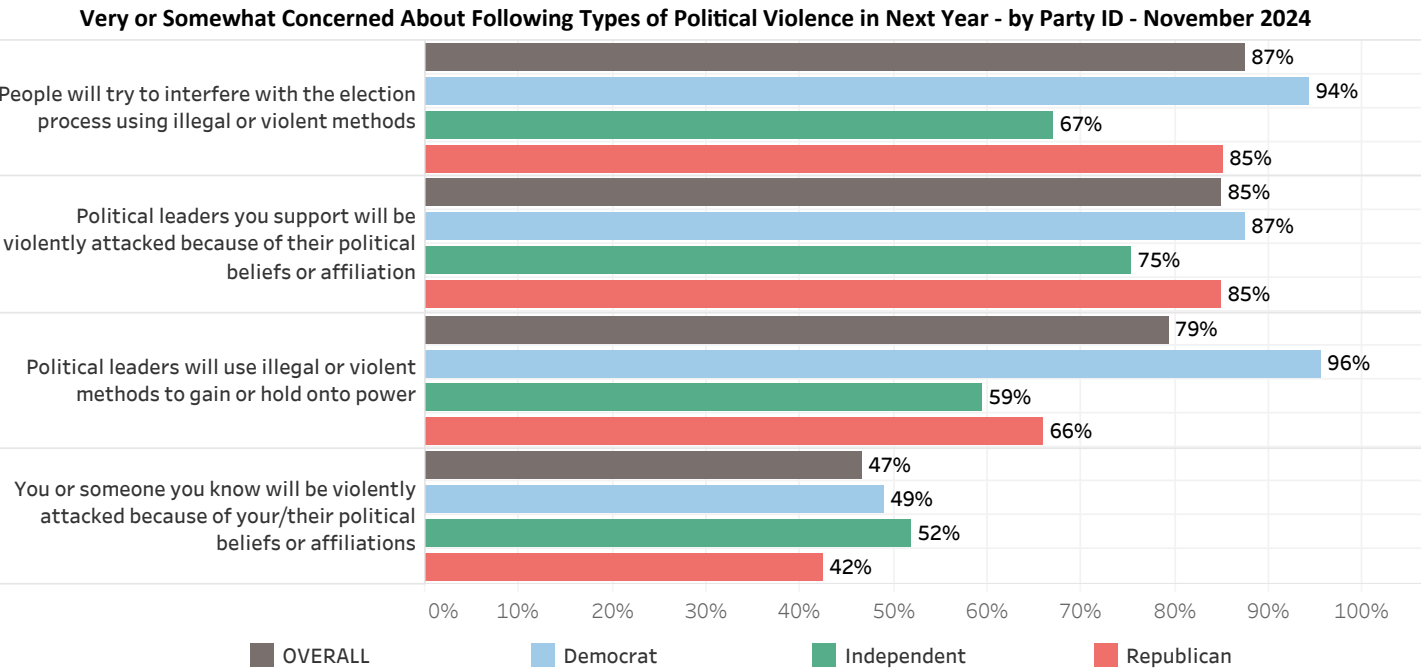


Eighty-seven percent of Maine residents say they are very (54%) or somewhat (33%) concerned that in the next year, people will try to interfere with the election process using illegal or violent methods, 8% are not very concerned about this happening, and 4% are not concerned at all. Most Mainers are also very or somewhat concerned that political leaders they support will be violently attacked because of their political beliefs or affiliation (85%) or that in the next year, political leaders will use illegal or violent methods to gain or hold power (79%). There is less concern about potential violence perpetrated on respondents themselves or people they know: 47% are very (19%) or somewhat (28%) concerned that in the next year they or someone they know will be violently attacked because of their political beliefs or affiliation while 53% are not very (36%) or not at all concerned (17%) about this happening.

Independents are less likely than Democrats or Republicans to be concerned about people trying to interfere with the election process. Democrats are more likely than Republicans and Independents to be worried that in the next year, political leaders will illegally or violently try to seize power.



## Pine Tree State Election Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Pine Tree State Election Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Overall, 1,552 individuals completed the survey between October 29 and November 2, 2024. Nine hundred and seventy-seven (977) Pine Tree State Panel members completed the survey online. The response rate for panel respondents to this November 2024 Pine Tree State Election Poll is 46%. In addition, 575 Maine residents completed the survey after receiving an invitation via text message to complete the survey online. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.5 percent. Included in the sample were 1,485 likely general election voters (margin of sampling error +/- 2.4 percent), 801 of whom reside in Maine's 1st Congressional District (MOE +/- 3.5 percent) and 683 reside in Maine's 2nd Congressional District (MOE +/- 3.7 percent). In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The design effect for the survey is 2.0%.

The Pine Tree State Panel is a probability-based web panel of Maine residents. Approximately 2,600 Maine adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau as well as party registration levels provided by the Maine Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in Maine. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
