## HARRIS' LEAD OVER TRUMP NARROWS IN NH; LIKELY VOTERS SPLIT ON EXPECTED WINNER NATIONALLY

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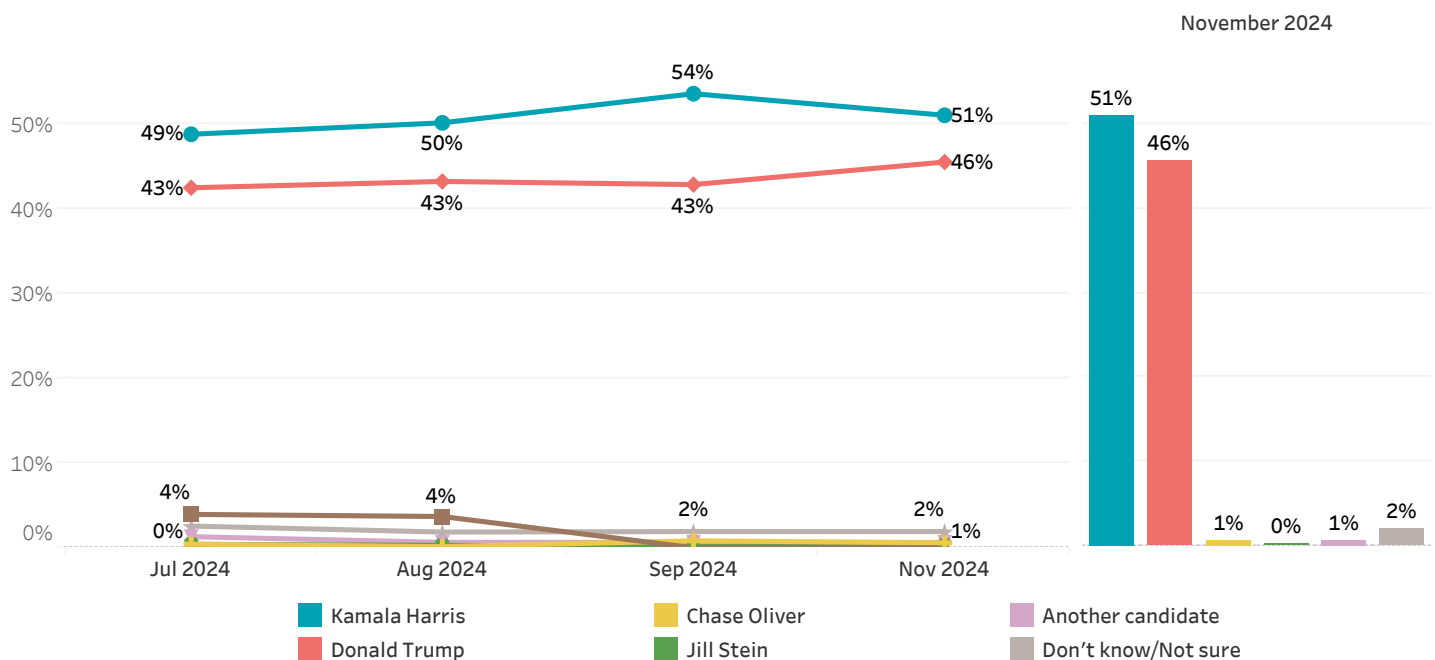
DURHAM, NH - Vice President Kamala Harris continues to hold a lead over former President Donald Trump in New Hampshire as the campaign comes to an end, but her advantage has shrunk since September. Voters are evenly split when asked which candidate they expect to become president, a change since September when a plurality expected Harris to win. Harris and her running mate, Minnesota Governor Tim Walz, are more popular among likely New Hampshire voters than Trump and his running mate, Ohio Senator J.D. Vance. There is widespread anxiety in the state about political violence, as more than four in five likely voters express concerns about violent election interference, attacks on political figures, and political leaders trying to seize power.

### 2024 Presidential Race

With the 2024 General Election only days away, Vice President Harris leads former President Trump in New Hampshire. Among likely voters, 51% say that they will vote for Harris or have already voted for her while 46% say they will vote or have voted for Trump. Very few say they will vote for or have voted for Libertarian nominee Chase Oliver (1%), Green Party nominee Jill Stein (<1%), or another candidate (1%), while 2% are undecided. Harris' lead over Trump (+5 percentage points) has declined since September (+11) but is similar to the leads Harris held over Trump in August (+7) and July (+6). Ninety-eight percent of Harris supporters and 96% of Trump supporters say they have definitely decided whom to support or have already voted.

Harris has lost ground among voters 65 and older since September, with 52% supporting her, down from 61% in September. Harris continues to enjoy overwhelming support among self-described progressives (98%) and liberals (94%) and a majority of support from socialists (74%) and moderates (65%) while Trump has the support of nearly all conservatives (94%) and most libertarians (85%). Harris holds wide leads among women with a college degree (+43 percentage points) and men with a college degree (+19). Trump holds a similar lead among men without a college degree (+20) while women without a college degree are split.

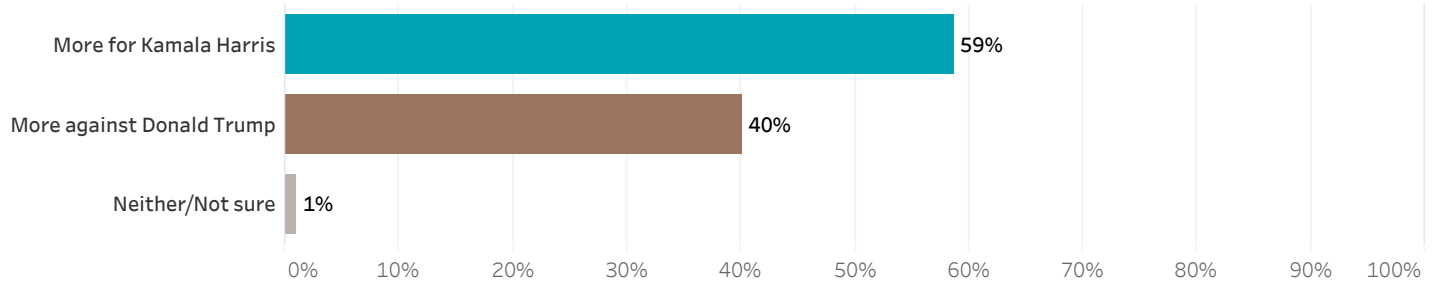
### 2024 Presidential General Election Matchup

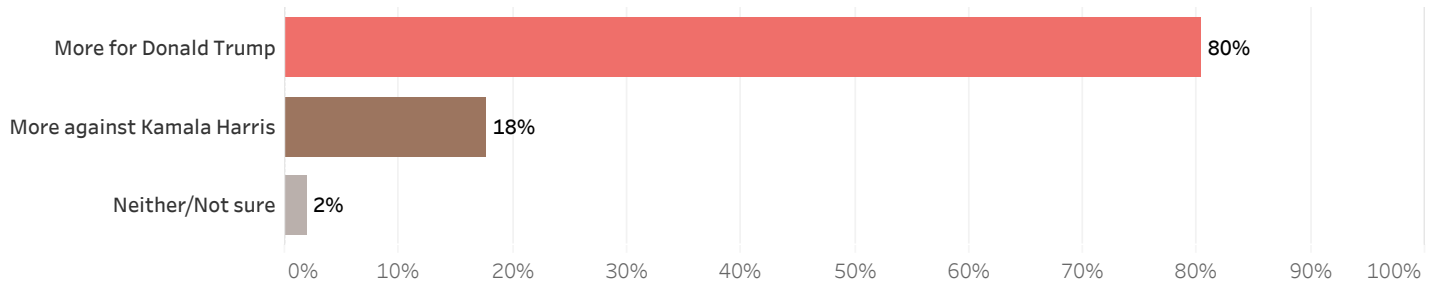
Among Harris supporters (N=1,419), 59% say that their vote is more for Harris than it is against Trump, while 40% say that their vote is more against Trump than for Harris. Majorities of self-described progressives (68%), liberals (63%), and moderates (53%) say that their vote is more for Harris than against Trump but two-thirds (67%) of socialists say that their vote is more against Trump than for Harris.

**Vote More for Harris or Against Trump - Among Harris Supporters - November 2024**



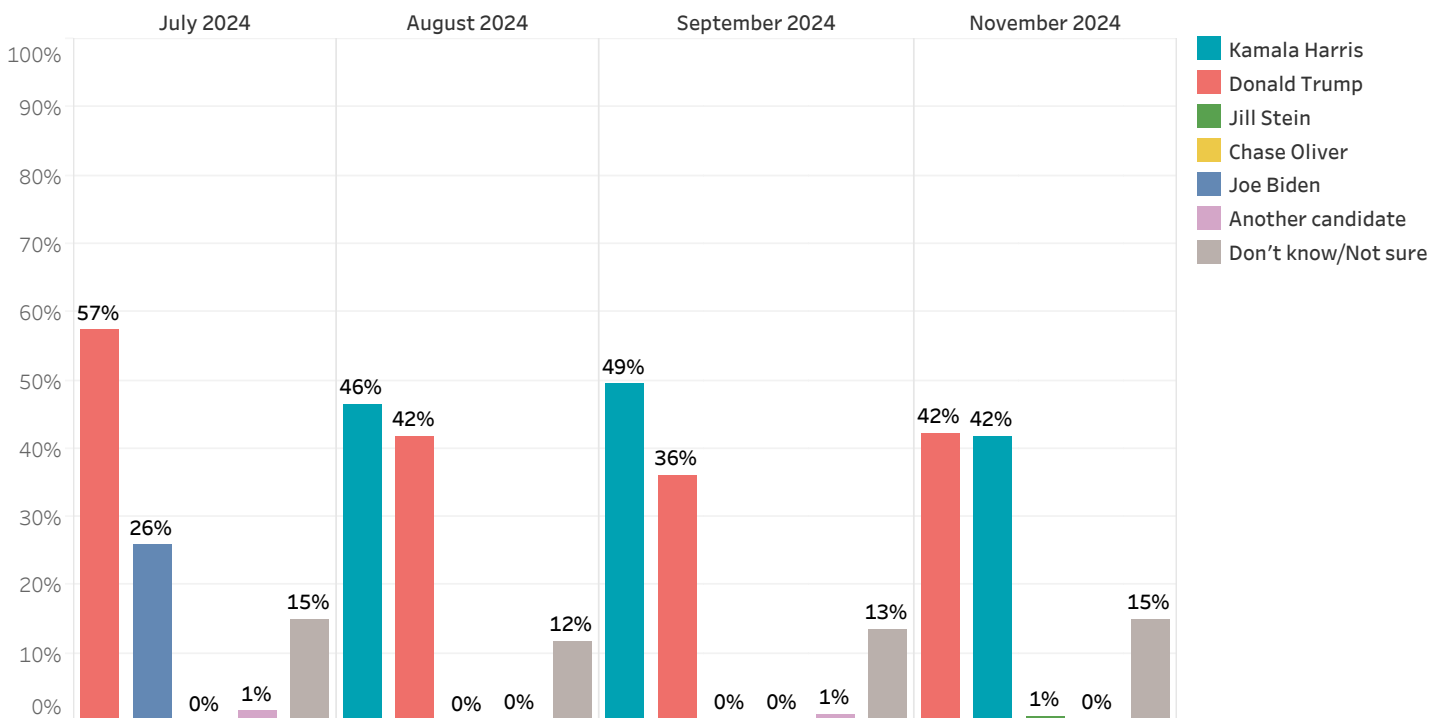
Among Trump supporters (N=1,271), 80% say that their vote is more for Trump than it is against Harris, while 18% say that their vote is more against Harris than for Trump. Almost all conservatives (91%) and smaller majorities of libertarians (64%) and moderates (57%) say that their vote is more for Trump than against Harris.

New Hampshire voters are split over which candidate is most likely to win the election, 42% think Trump will win, 42% think Harris will win, and 15% are unsure. In September, 49% thought Harris would win and only 36% thought Trump would win. Seventy-five percent of Harris supporters think she is most likely to win, down from 83% in September, while 84% of Trump supporters think he is most likely to win, up slightly since September (78%).

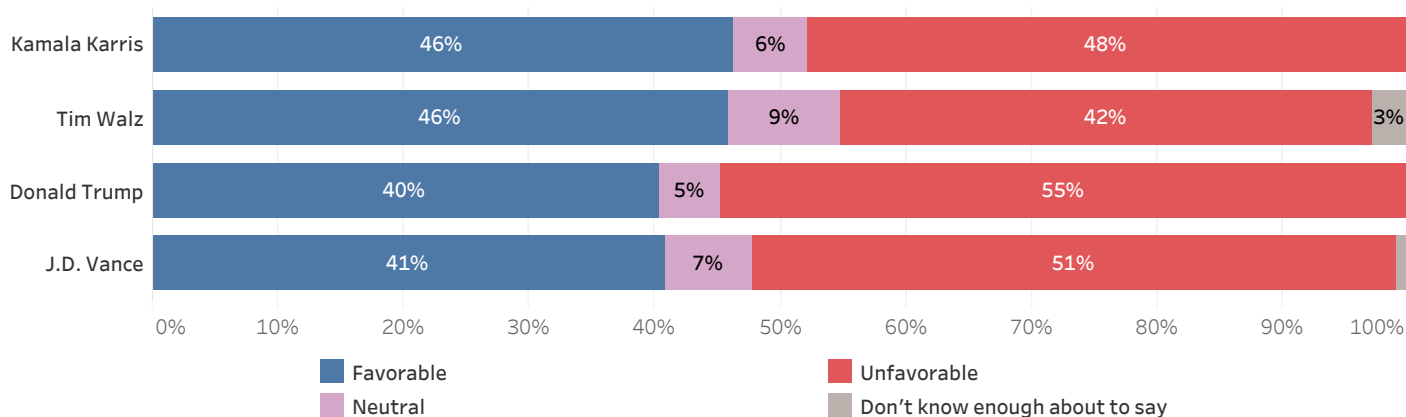
**Who Believe is Most Likely to Win 2024 Presidential Race**



Turning to the personal favorability of the candidates, 46% of New Hampshire likely voters have a favorable opinion of Harris, 48% have an unfavorable opinion of her, and 6% are neutral. Harris' net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion), is -2. Harris' net favorability rating among Democrats is +87, while her net favorability rating is -19 among Independents and -86 among Republicans. Harris' running mate, Tim Walz, is viewed favorably by 46% of likely voters, 42% have an unfavorable opinion, 9% are neutral, and 3% don't know enough about him to say, yielding a net favorability rating of +4.

Forty percent of Granite Staters have a favorable opinion of Trump, 55% have an unfavorable opinion, and 5% are neutral, yielding a net favorability rating of -14. Trump's net favorability rating among Republicans is +71, while his net favorability rating is -31 among Independents and -95 among Democrats. Likely voters have a similar opinion of Trump's running mate J.D. Vance: 41% have a favorable opinion of him, 51% have an unfavorable opinion, and 7% are neutral.

One Word to Describe Kamala Harris - by Candidate Supported - November 2024



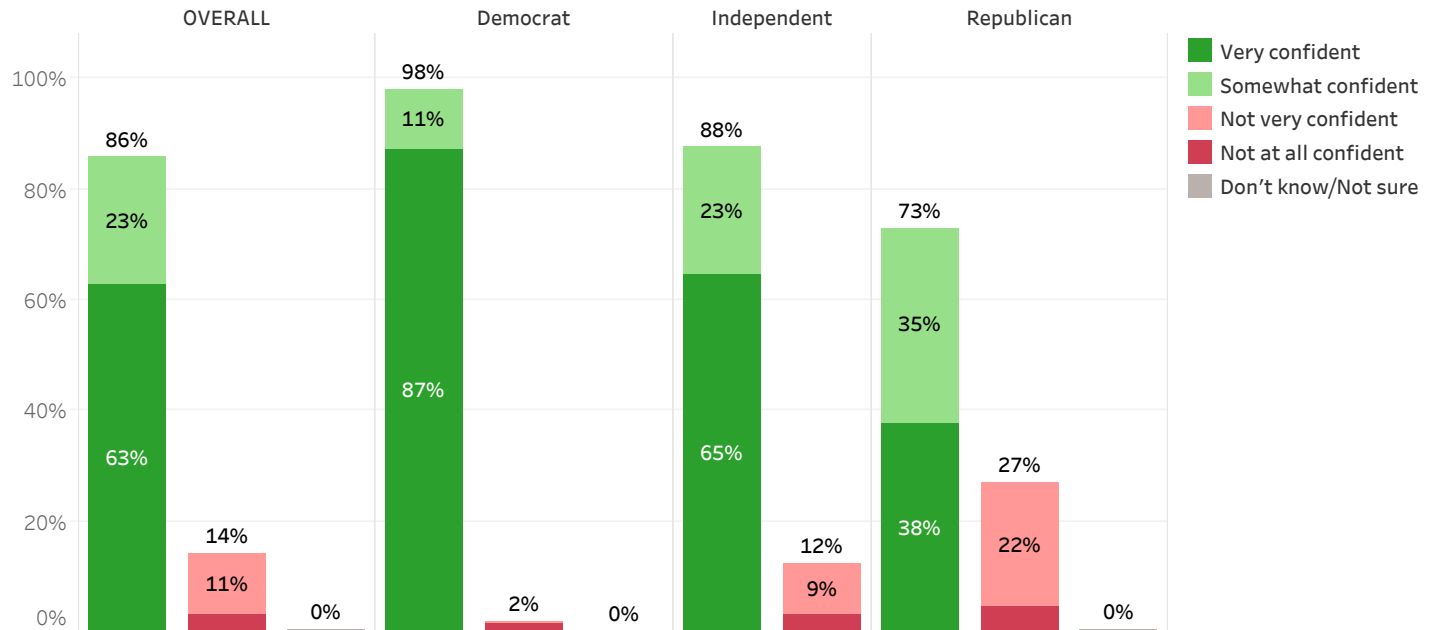
One Word to Describe Donald Trump - by Candidate Supported - November 2024



## Election Integrity

Eighty-six percent of likely voters are very (63%) or somewhat (23%) confident their vote in the upcoming general election will be accurately counted. Fourteen percent say they are not very confident (11%) or not at all confident (3%) their vote will be counted accurately while less than 1% are unsure. Likely voters are slightly less confident their vote will be accurately counted than likely voters were in November 2020. Nearly all self-identified Democrats (98%) and 88% of Independents are very or somewhat confident their vote will be accurately counted but only 73% of Republicans feel that way, down from 90% in November 2020.

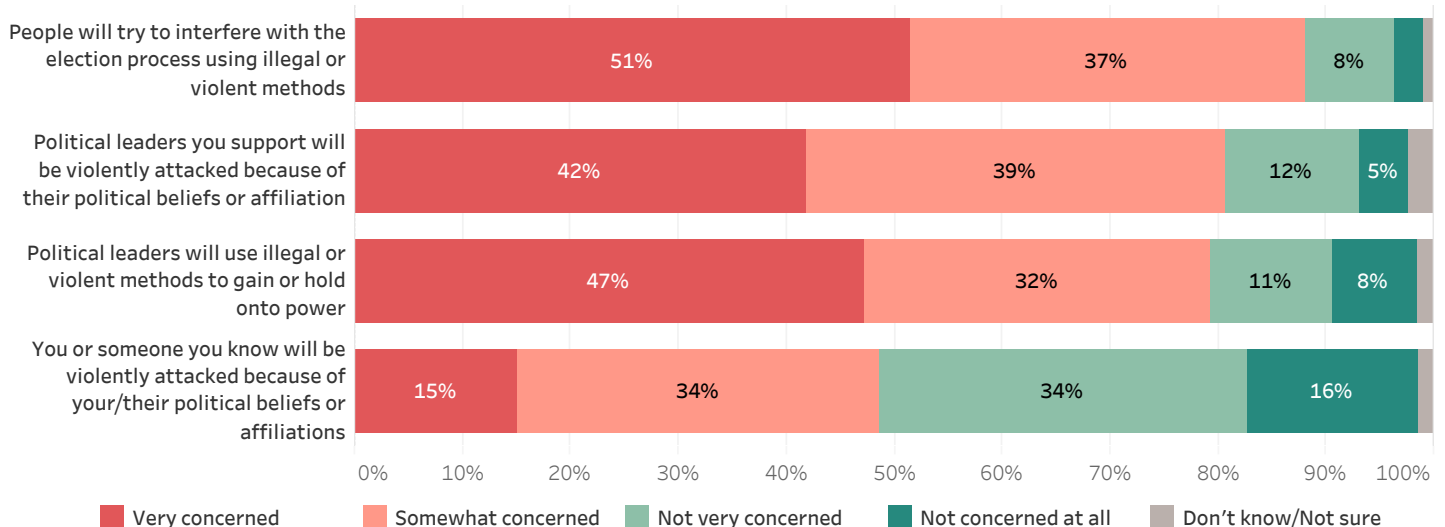
**Confidence General Election Vote Will be Accurately Counted - by Party ID - November 2024**



## Political Violence

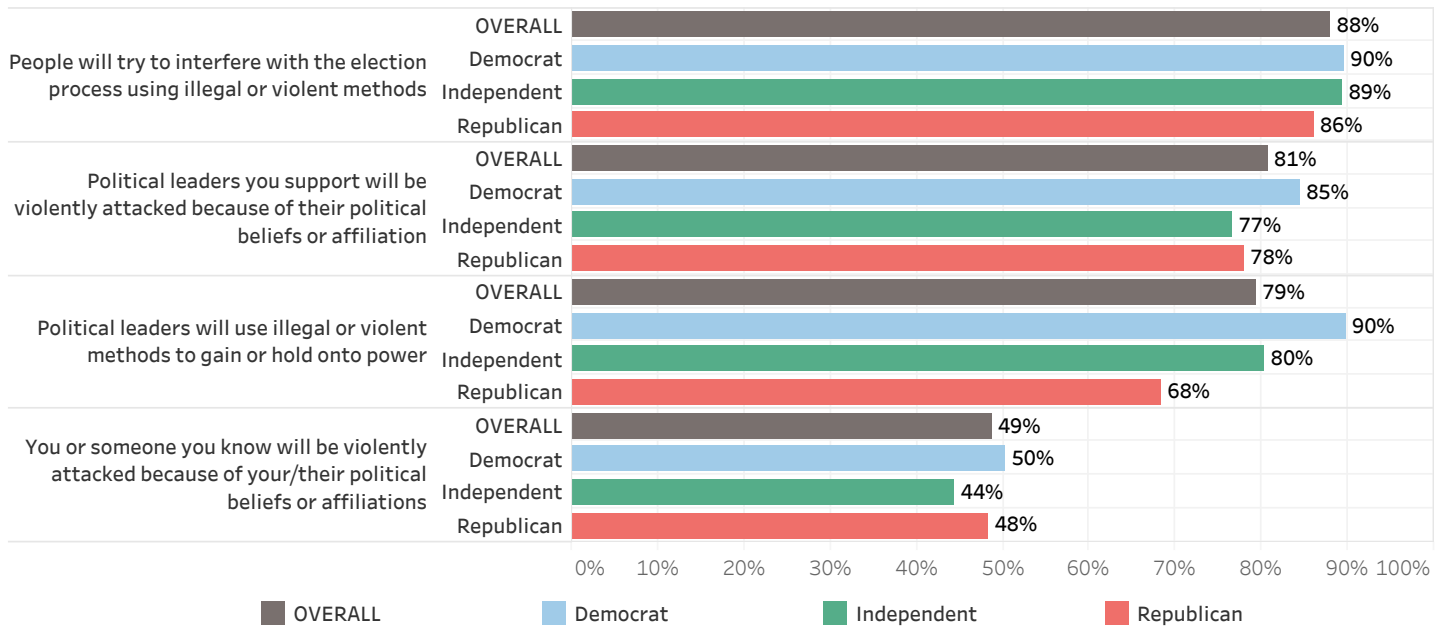
Eighty-eight percent of New Hampshire residents say they are very (51%) or somewhat (37%) concerned that in the next year people will try to interfere with the election process using illegal or violent methods, 8% are not very concerned about this happening, 3% are not concerned at all, and 1% are unsure. Most Granite Staters are also very or somewhat concerned that in the next year, that political leaders they support will be violently attacked because of their political beliefs or affiliation (81%) or that political leaders will use illegal or violent methods to gain or hold onto power (79%). There is less concern about potential violence perpetrated on respondents themselves or people they know: 49% are very (15%) or somewhat (34%) concerned that in the next year they or someone they know will be violently attacked because of their political beliefs or affiliation while half (50%) are not very (34%) or not at all concerned (16%) about this happening. Responses to these questions are largely similar to those provided in July.

Democrats are more likely than Republicans and Independents to be worried that in the next year, political leaders will use illegal or violent methods to gain or hold onto power and are slightly more concerned that political leaders they support will be violently attacked because of their political beliefs or affiliation.

## Granite State Election Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest Granite State Election Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Overall, 2,887 individuals completed the survey between October 29 and November 2, 2024. Two thousand, one hundred and six (2,106) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online. The response rate for panel respondents to this November 2024 Granite State Election Poll is 38%. In addition, 781 New Hampshire residents completed the survey after receiving an invitation via text message to complete the survey online. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 1.8 percent. Included in the sample were 2,814 likely general election voters (margin of sampling error +/- 1.9 percent). In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The design effect for the survey is 2.2%.

The Granite State Panel is a probability-based web panel of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 8,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
