They're also sharing how their experience at UNH helped prepare them for their future endeavors.



“We knew alums were accomplishing great things out in their professional lives, and we wanted a place to share those successes,” says Bridget Finnegan, creative director, who worked with UNH's social media manager Jason Boucher on the Tales concept.

The Alumni Tales webpage also allows the broader community to share in the Wildcat pride that alumni carry with them months and years after earning their diplomas.

“UNH is where I came alive academically and socially. From Day One ... I learned to be an active participant in my educational journey. I wanted to study things I was personally interested in and passionate about. I’m fortunate to now be in a place where I can be my authentic self at work and be surrounded by similarly minded people,” wrote Tony Berry ’01, who says he is “living the dream” working in HR at Burton Snowboards. Others credited specific faculty members, departments and internship experiences with helping them find their “right fit,” professionally.
