We have communicated with all of the faculty and staff leading UNH programs currently abroad to reassure them that we are monitoring the developing situation closely.

The University of New Hampshire has 107 students enrolled in summer programs. We have not heard from any students that their travel plans have been impacted. Our six-week Cambridge Summer Program has 48 attendees and runs through August 18.

We will continue to monitor the situation in the UK and make sure our students have the latest information about travel from the State Department and the Department of Homeland Security.
