Responsibilities:

- Support learning activities and help maintain an energetic and enthusiastic learning environment as directed by the programs' lead facilitators;
- Develop understanding of program curriculum and document, review, and develop curriculum artifacts;
- Coordinate and assist with student arrival and departure;
- Manage onsite equipment, tools, materials and other instructional logistics as needed or requested by lead facilitators and lab staff;
- Support planning and preparation of school year program activities, configuration and maintenance of learning spaces, and organization and maintenance of learning materials and supplies;
- Collect, organize, and analyze participant data;
- Attend required training and orientation sessions;

- Excellent time management, organizational and communication skills;
- Familiarity and enjoyment working with youth in an informal or formal setting;
