They have also created a new two-credit [Career Boot Camp](#) class teaching resume-writing and offering mock interviews.

- [Handshake](#) is a job and career board like Indeed but specifically for college students with up to five years of experience.
- [Wildcat Connections](#) is specifically for UNH students and alumni, like a more intimate LinkedIn where students can make industry connections with alumni.

Some options being considered include adding parents to Wildcat Connections, reaching out to parents about having their companies offer internships and on-campus recruiting and creating a calendar for parents that can help facilitate a dialogue and set expectations with your students.
