UNH Manchester's 12:1 student-to-faculty ratio allows for a more intimate learning environment, giving students have a better chance to get to know their professors and classmates.

"With the small class sizes, you don't just feel like a number," said [biological sciences](#) grad Nathan Domingues '16. "Your professors know your name, and you get to know the people in your class much better. It is just a better overall learning experience."
