DURHAM, N.H. – Chris Forhan, an award-winning poet and graduate of the University of New Hampshire, will read from his work Thursday, April 14, 2005, from 5:30-6:30 p.m. in UNH's Hamilton Smith Hall, room 214. His reading is free and open to the public.

Forhan earned his master's at UNH. His first book, *Forgive Us Our Happiness*, won the Bakeless Prize and his second, *The Actual Moon, the Actual Stars*, is the winner of the 2004 Samuel French Poetry Prize. Forhan's poetry has won a Pushcart Prize and appeared in *Poetry*, *Ploughshares*, *New England Review*, *Parnasses* and other magazines.

Forhan teaches at Auburn University and in the Warren Wilson MFA program.
