Open to any youth ages 18 or under, this people’s choice-style contest will be voted on by the public. The entry receiving the most votes during the fair by noon on Sunday will earn special recognition and will be the “Poster Potato” for next year’s contest.

Details:

- No pre-registration required.
- One entry per youth.
- Each entry should have a creative name.
- Entries may include more than one potato.
- All entries should be prepared in advance and should be brought to the fair ready for display.
- Any entry deemed inappropriate may be disqualified at the discretion of the 4-H manager. (Keep it fun and clean!)
- All entries are due at the 4-H Exhibit Hall on Tuesday, August 1st between 4-8 pm. Alternative drop-off arrangements can be made by calling the 4-H Office at 603-352-4550.
- Entries may be picked up during Exhibit Hall clean-up on Sunday, Aug 6th after 4:00 pm. All entries not picked up will be composted.
- Entries should be built to withstand the August heat, humidity, and wind. Don’t cut your potato friend!
