COVID-19 New Hampshire City and Town Annual Reports Collection Final Report, February 3, 2023

The New Hampshire City and Town Annual Reports Collection is used widely throughout the state and beyond, and is a valuable source of historical data on the fiscal management and vital statistics of New Hampshire's municipalities. With the funding provided we successfully completed the goals of this project by making accessible all known annual reports from the University of New Hampshire Library (UNH Library) and New Hampshire State Library (NHSL) collections. This project adds to the collection previously developed and internally funded by The UNH Library and more than doubled the size of the combined projects. The combined collections are in the UNH Scholars Repository and current use statistics can be found in the collection dashboards, linked below.

Project Outcomes

In this project a total of **20,606** volumes were added to the collection, including **18,879** volumes that were scanned and **1,727** volumes retrieved from city/town websites. The total scanned volumes include **1,189** annual reports of New Hampshire's 10 counties, added to the scope of this project with permission of the New Hampshire State Library Assistant Library Director because their content complements that found in the city and town reports. The number of volumes retrieved from each location was as follows:

New Hampshire State Library: 11,685

University of New Hampshire Library: 7,194

City/town websites: 1,727

At the beginning of the project 20 of 234 New Hampshire's cities/towns were not represented in the digital collections. All towns are now represented. Content for an additional eight village precincts and two extinct towns was also added.

A list of volumes added by location can be found on pages 3-6 of this report. The combined collections contain **35,491** volumes as of this report.

Methods:

A list of all previously digitized reports was generated and used to create a list of potentially missing volumes. This list was checked against the holdings of first the UNH Library and then NHSL, and the matching volumes were retrieved, checked for condition, packed, and shipped via ground carrier to the Internet Archives scanning center at the Boston Public Library. Once scanning was completed, the resulting digital volumes were quality checked, described in a metadata records, and uploaded to the repository. Physical volumes were shipped back to UNH, inventoried, and returned to their respective home collections. Newer reports, typically those produced in the past decade, were retrieved from and city/town websites, described, and uploaded.

We overestimated hourly and travel costs and redirected the extra funds toward shipping and scanning services; this change was within 10% of the total budget. Our original estimate of volumes to scan (14,720) was slightly low because the NHSL had earlier volumes in their collection than anticipated.

The UNH Library contributed an additional \$6,257.30 to cover shipping and scanning services to complete the final shipment of reports, covering approximately 600 volumes. This was invoiced directly to the UNH Library.
