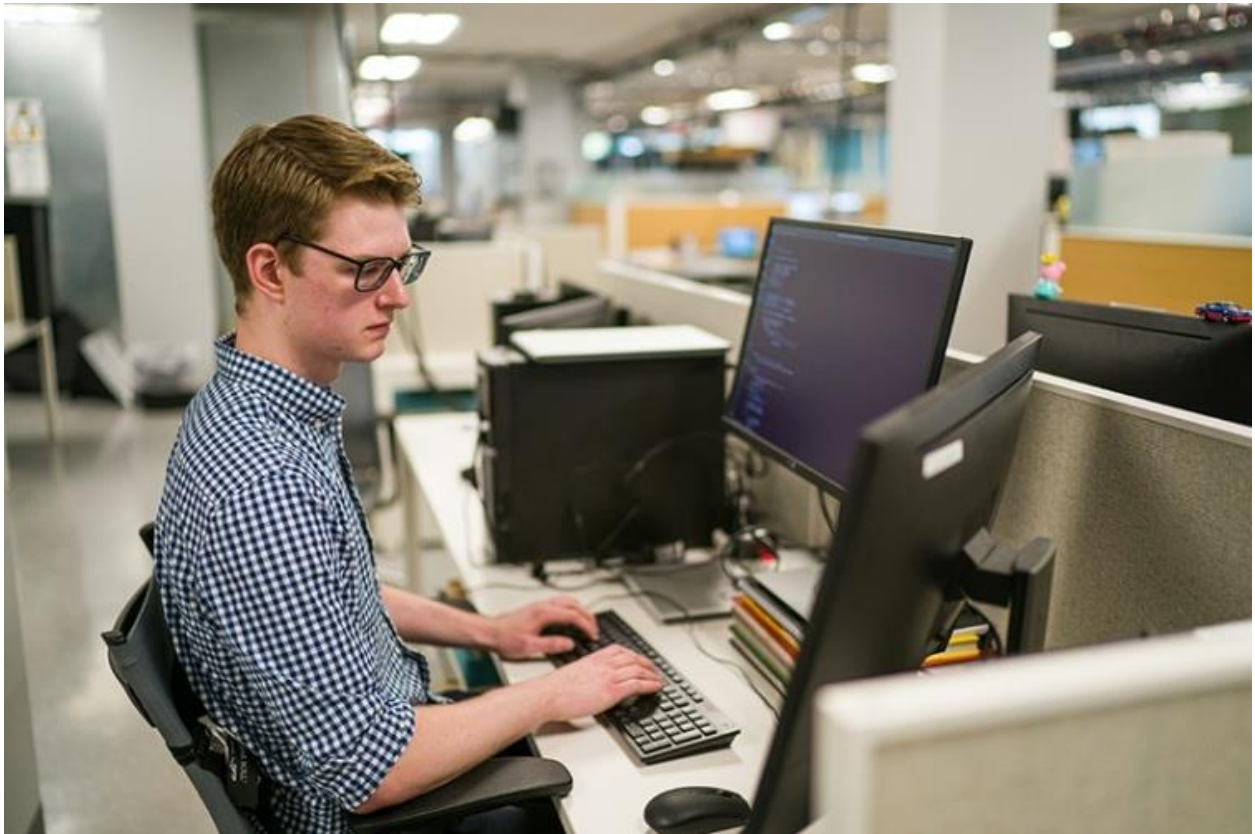


UNH Hosts National Cyber Security Awareness Month Virtual Events

October is National Cybersecurity Awareness Month (NCSAM). In recognition, the University System of New Hampshire will host a series of virtual events to expand awareness around different aspects of the cybersecurity landscape.

This year's events include a panel of UNH Manchester Cybersecurity Policy and Risk Management program graduates discussing their capstone projects, presentations by faculty members on a range of cybersecurity topics, and a talk by one of UNH Durham's librarians about privacy risks to student activists and the role librarians play in protecting student privacy to support that activism.
