DURHAM, N.H. -- The University of New Hampshire will welcome alumni and friends back to campus for Homecoming weekend on Oct. 5-7 with a parade, receptions, music and a variety of athletic events.

The weekend will kick off on Friday, Oct. 5, with the Blue and White parade at 6 p.m., followed by a pep rally, band concert and fireworks at Cowell Stadium at 7 p.m. A sale of UNH logo clothing and gift items will be held at the Alumni Center from 2 to 6 p.m.

At 10 p.m., a Comedy Concert will be held at Lundholm Gymnasium, featuring stand-up comedian and actor Jay Mohr. Mohr made his TV debut playing the dimwitted Dorfman on "Camp Wilder" (ABC, 1992). He first gained national attention in 1993 as a cast member on "Saturday Night Live," and played the role of the former-protege-turned-nemesis agent (of Tom Cruise) in the critically acclaimed movie "Jerry Maguire" (1996). He also played Jennifer Aniston's pretend fiancé in the romantic comedy "Picture Perfect" (1997) and the war-hero son in the comedy spoof "Mafia" (1998).
