

UNH Offers Three New Study Abroad Programs in Europe

DURHAM, N.H. -- The University of New Hampshire is offering students three new study abroad programs in France, Germany and Scotland.

Developed with the University of Delaware, the new spring semester program in Paris offers French language and literature courses, as well as courses in political science, art history and history, which will be taught in English.

Rosenheim, Germany is the site for a three-week, two-course intensive language summer study program. It has been developed in conjunction with Mary Washington College, and is the equivalent of German 501 offered at the UNH campus.

UNH's College of Engineering and Physical Sciences is offering a new exchange program at Heriot-Watt University in Edinburgh, Scotland.
