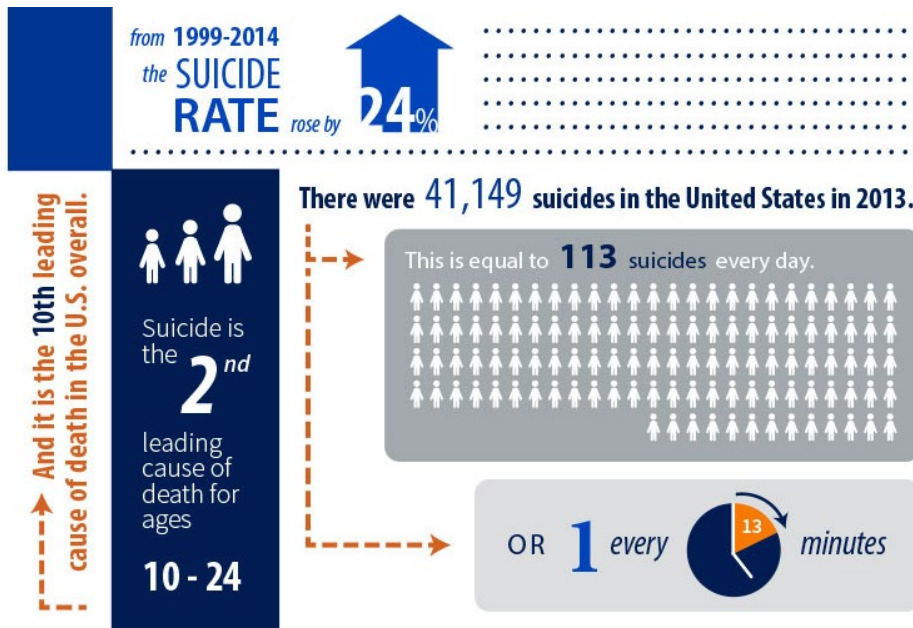

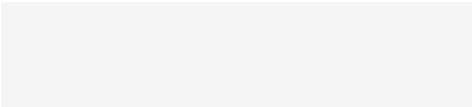
Do You Know Kognito?
