An executive recruitment firm has been hired to partner with the University System of New Hampshire to conduct the search for the successor to UNH President Mark W. Huddleston, who is retiring at the end of June 2018. The presidential [search committee](#) appointed by the University System of New Hampshire Board of Trustees announced today the selection of [Isaacson, Miller](#), a Boston-based firm that conducts more than 200 searches nationally and internationally each year.

The firm was selected unanimously by the USNH search committee, which reviewed 13 proposals and interviewed three
