He is currently the chair of the ACS Committee on Committees and treasurer of the Northeast Region Board. He has previously served as chair of both the Local Section Activities Committee and the Membership Affairs Committee.

Jones also has organized numerous symposia, chaired two Northeast Regional Meetings and served as program chair for national meetings of the Division of Chemical Education three times. In 2010, he was recognized as an ACS Fellow. In 2015, he received the E. Anne Nalley Award for Service to the ACS in the Northeast Region.

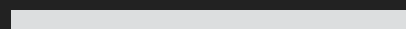

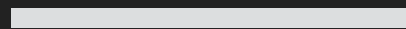
