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New Hampshire Small Business Development Center Joins Celebration of National "SBDC Day" March 22

The first pilot Small Business Development Centers started in 1979, and the SBDC was founded in New Hampshire in 1984, under Governor John H. Sununu. NH SBDC has provided business advising services to more than 26,000 entrepreneurs and online and in-person educational content to over 65,000 individuals since that time.

America's SBDC Network - the nation's largest business assistance network - helps aspiring and emerging small business owners achieve the American dream of entrepreneurship. With nearly 1,000 locations across the country, SBDCs provide local businesses and entrepreneurs with the resources needed to succeed.

In 2016, New Hampshire's SBDC provided 6,330 hours of business advising to 698 clients, helping them to raise a record \$30 million in capital infusion and \$22.4 million in increased revenue, create 173 new jobs and retain 33 jobs, and win \$100,000 in cash and in-kind support through business plan competitions.
