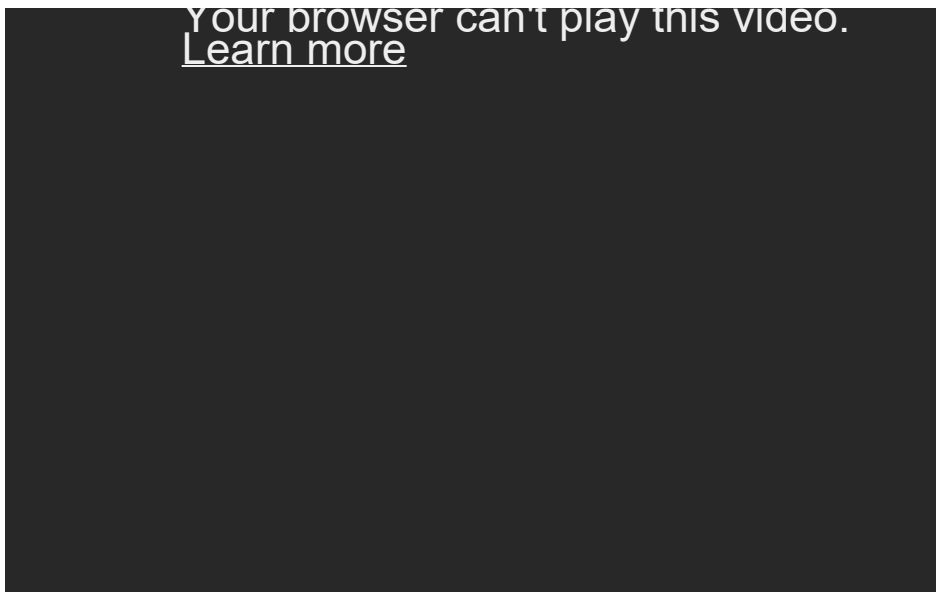


Celebrating the Class of 2022

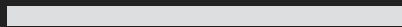

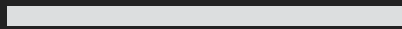
