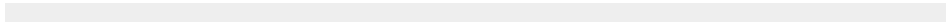
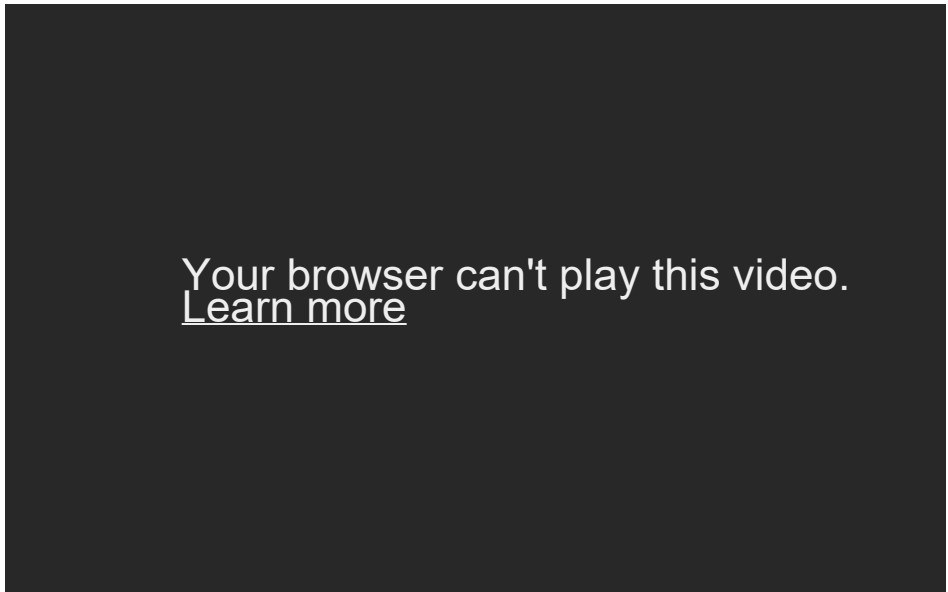

Matt DiBiase '22 pursues passion in research project

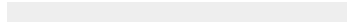
