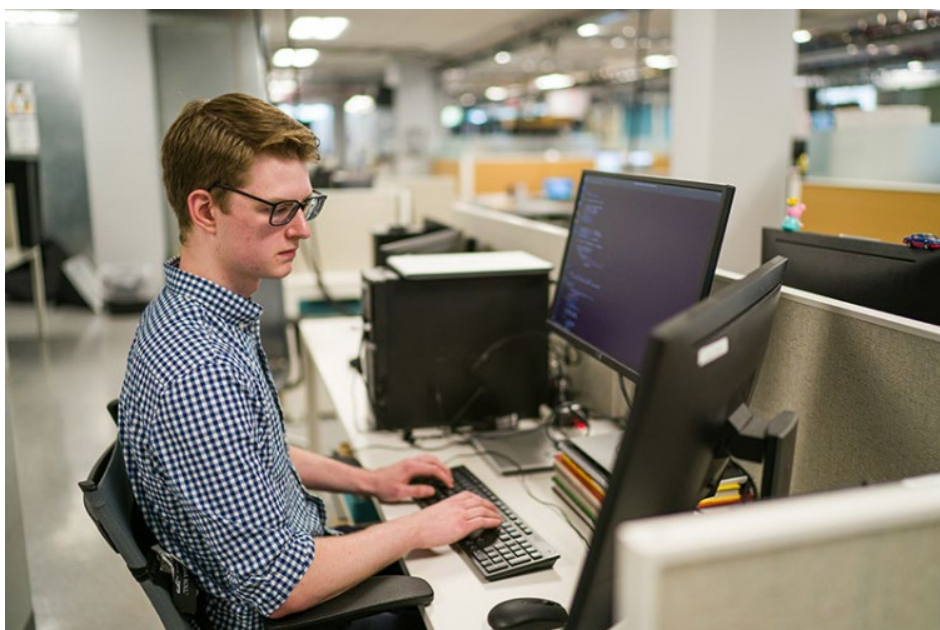


# National Cyber Security Awareness Month
